

Charles Burns Upton ... Civic leader, Charles Upton of Whitley [Co.] Dies at 90 Williamsburg, Ky. -- Charles Burns Upton, a retired Williamsburg attorney and former state senator who held numerous other public offices, died Tuesday at his home after a long illness. He was 90. Upton, a Republican, served Whitley, Knox and Bell counties in the Senate from 1968 to 1971. He lost the Republican nomination in the 1971 primary by 23 votes. During his tenure, he served as Republican caucus chairman and in 1970 was voted outstanding orator by the capital press corps. Upton, who was admitted to the Kentucky Bar in 1928, began a private practice and entered public life shortly thereafter. He served as Whitley County Circuit Court master commissioner from 1932 to 1934 and Whitley County treasurer from 1934 to 1941. In 1942, he was elected Whitley County attorney and served three terms until 1954. In 1956, Gov. A. B. "Happy" Chandler appointed Upton as Republican member of the State Election Commission. Upton resigned from the post in 1958 when Chandler appointed him commonwealth's attorney of the 34th Judicial District, which served Knox, McCreary and Whitley counties. Gov. Wendell Ford appointed Upton to a four-year term on the state Occupational Safety and Health Administration Commission in 1973. Upton was reappointed by Gov. Julian Carroll. In 1980, Upton was elected to the newly created position of district judge for Whitley and McCreary counties, a post he held until he resigned in 1993 because of poor health. Upton, a former Whitley County Republican chairman and member of the Republican State Central Committee, was a delegate to the Republican National Convention in 1944 and 1956. He was a native of Corbin, a member of the Whitley County Bar Association and former president of the Kentucky County Attorneys Association. Survivors include his wife, Opal Smith Upton; three sons, Charles W. Upton of Raleigh, N. C., Allen B. Upton of Lexington and Carlton B. Upton; two daughters, Patricia Sutton of Springfield and Linda B. Upton of Phoenix; a sister, Jessie Borden of Atlanta; 11 grandchildren; and a great-grandson. The funeral will be at 8 p.m. today at First Baptist Church, with private burial tomorrow in Highland Park Cemetery. Visitation at Ellison Funeral Home is from 1 to 5 p.m. today and at the church from 6 to 8 tonight. November 03, 1994, Source: The Courier-Journal Louisville, KY.

Dear Folks:

Please excuse this rather non-personal note about my activities in the fall of 2002. On Sunday, 6 Oct 2002, at about 3 P.M. while lounging at home in my stocking feet, I decided to make a quick trip to the lower level of our home to get some financial data for our church. This could be worked on while watching the Ram's football game. My feet slipped out from under me on the stairs, resulting in clean breaks to the fibula and tibia of my right leg. Fortunately, Sallaine was close at hand to help and within 30 minutes we were in the hospital emergency room.

My right leg is in a cast from toe to mid-thigh. The doctor projects I will have a cast for four months. I plan to heal faster!

The first week has been spent learning how to cope using walker, wheelchair and the constant help of my caregiver - my dear wife. The pain is controlled reasonably well by medication, which I use sparingly. Still, it is hard to concentrate on anything in a creative way. My focus is on getting by day-by-day with the goal of seeing my doctor on 28 OCT 2002 and getting his report on my progress.

For those of you who have sent or are sending in family data, please continue. I'll hope to get downstairs to work on them in due course. We may be a little late in getting out the fall issue of the UB.

There has to be a blessing in disguise here somewhere. It seems I've got a little time to figure out what it is.
