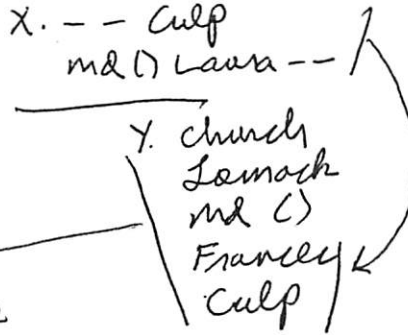

Needham Price Family Cemetery nearly lost to progress

"Greetings, We have discovered the grave sites of Needham Price family in Wake County that have been damaged by developers. We are attempting to locate family members to preserve the site of their ancestors. According to several genealogy sites, this burial location is unknown to their descendants. Please help as time is pressing! Thank you in advance." - SW

This email, that I received mid-September, is how I came to know of the impending doom about to befall a small, nearly lost family grave site in Knightdale. The family plot, its stones long ago toppled, sat forgotten and undetected by most folks, in an overgrown section of the property that was known as the Price-Ingram farm.

The farm, until several years ago, was owned by descendants of Wake county's prominent Price family. Needham Price (1808-1870) was the son of Thomas Price, Jr. (1779-1826) and married Nancy Peters Sanders (1810-1874). His sister was Scheherazade Price Mial Blake (1805-1853). Needham's daughter Elizabeth T. Price (1831-1864) married Alpheus Jones (1822-1854). Needham, Nancy, and daughter, Elizabeth are known to be buried in this plot. Pending evaluation by an archaeologist, there may be others.

These folks have far reaching connections to the history of Wake county and its agricultural community. Between them they ran three large plantations in the area, Oakey Grove, Walnut Hill (Mial), and Seth Jones (now remembered as the restaurant house on 401). They also controlled five mills in the area.

Somehow the family connection was so lost to time and memory that other branches of the Price family were unaware of the burial location of the Needham Price group. How could this have happened? That answer, too, is lost to the past.

The farm property had been desirable for developing for years and much of it has already been developed as the Glenmere subdivision (located south of Knightdale on Smithfield Road). The section containing the home, out-buildings and grave site had been saved for last. There had been some talk of historic preservation of the home site, but there was not enough structural integrity to move forward with that plan.

The time had come to develop the home site portion of the

property. An older, original set of plans drawn up in 2007 showed the cemetery clearly marked and cordoned off from development. All efforts to move forward stalled in 2008 with the national economy. The property sat idle for several years. Plans were redrawn in 2011. Allegedly, a drafting error in this plan resulted in the cemetery being accidently omitted. This is the plan that the workers were using in August of this year when the earth where the Needham Price family quietly rested was scraped asunder.

A concerned group of Knightdale citizens, including Keith Gibbs and his group, the Knightdale History Squadron, were trying to prevent the disaster that they saw happening right before their eyes. They were all but standing in front of the bulldozers to save the cemetery. Police were called, clearing was halted, meetings were held with the developer and, Knightdale town officials. The clock was ticking. They were running out of time.

As Keith so aptly explained on a Facebook post, they needed to find some blood relatives. It was important to have descendants at the table to ensure that the family's memories and interests were respected.

It was at this point in time that SW reached out to WCGS newsletter via email as a last ditch attempt to identify and locate some descendants who might represent the family and the dearly departed. -cont'd next page

I felt the urgency of their request and at the same time felt overwhelmed at how to accomplish anything productive.

The next issue of the newsletter was not scheduled until December. My small part in this was to reach as many folks as possible quickly on through the WCGS Facebook page. An urgent plea was posted and shared to the NCGS page and as many surrounding local genealogy pages as I could find. (Here is where the power of the internet and social media really shine... That page was viewed nearly 8,000 times in the first 48 hours after it was published.) If you would like to view the post, it is here: <https://www.facebook.com/wakecogen/posts/1886814991329975>

For our part, we were not able to do much but raise awareness and rally some interest. I do wish we had been able to do more, but I am very grateful to the folks who saw the post and took it on themselves to take the names and dates and do what genealogists do - research. Special thanks goes to **Tracy McPherson**. I believe she was able to locate two sets of descendants in just those first two days.

According to a report from the town of Knightdale, after the meeting with the developer on September 8, investiga-

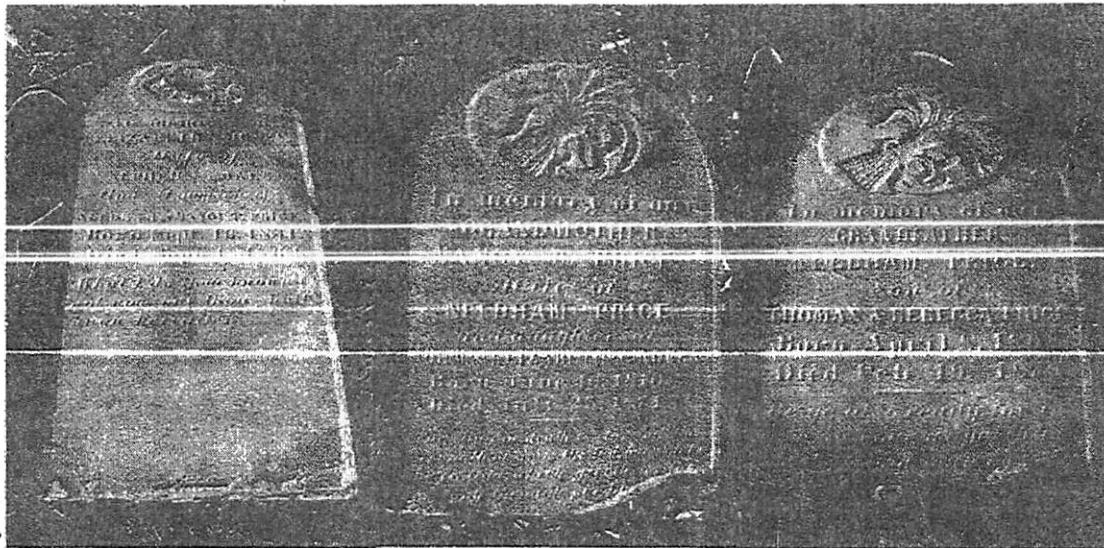
tion by the police and an archaeologist have determined that no remains were disturbed, no disinterment took place, and no intentional wrongdoing occurred.

The developer, **Joe Lassiter**, has stepped up to correct the situation. The area has been cordoned off and the plans redesigned to protect the grave site and provide access to the descendants. The graves will be restored with hand labor and he has made provisions that the Home Owners Association of Glenmere will maintain the site.

The end result is that this grave site is now safer. I have seen it cordoned off myself.

While this seems like a happy ending, watchful eyes are still needed. One descendant has stepped forward to take an active role in the stewardship of the restoration. If you are a descendant or are interested in joining the citizens group, **Knightdale History Squadron**, visit their facebook page or message me for Keith Gibb's contact information.

Volunteer Opportunity: We need someone fluent in Find a Grave to create a cemetery listing and enter their memorials. I would appreciate it very much. We need to reconnect the Price family so they can rest peacefully.



Photos by **Craig Fitzpatrick** (who lived on the Price-Ingram farm in the 70s and 80s) of the original, already toppled stones for the known graves as found in the early 80s. Craig says, "...my first exploration of the cemetery in 1980 ... it was overgrown to the point where I didn't manage to find anything but some old fence and the short foot stones that are still standing there. Over the years I went back several times and once made a fairly serious effort to clear enough to find the head stones which had all fallen over and were laying face down under 6 inches of soil and dead leaves." Protecting and restoring the cemetery is a matter of heart for Craig. He has become very attached to the Price family and their history through this experience.

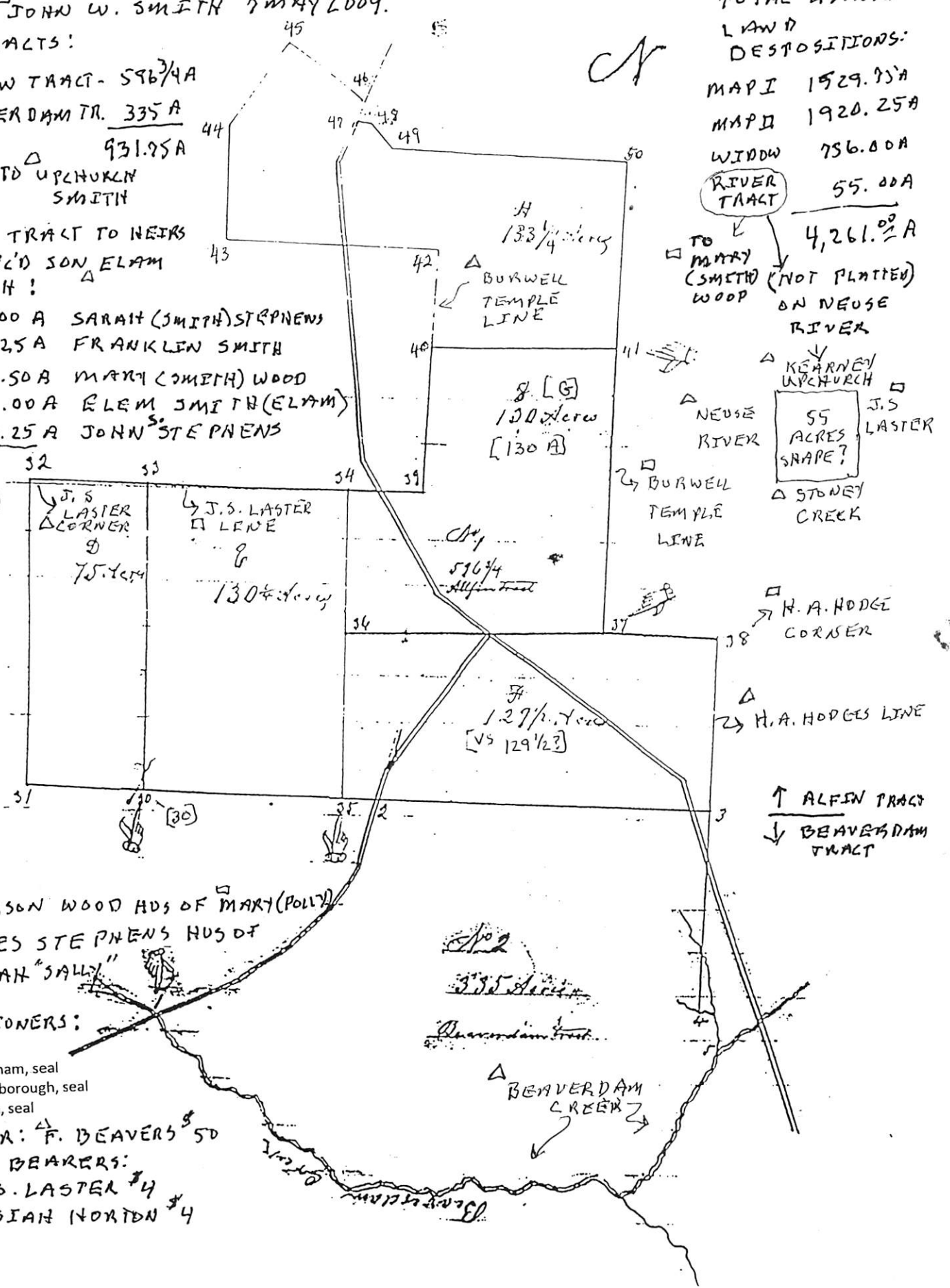

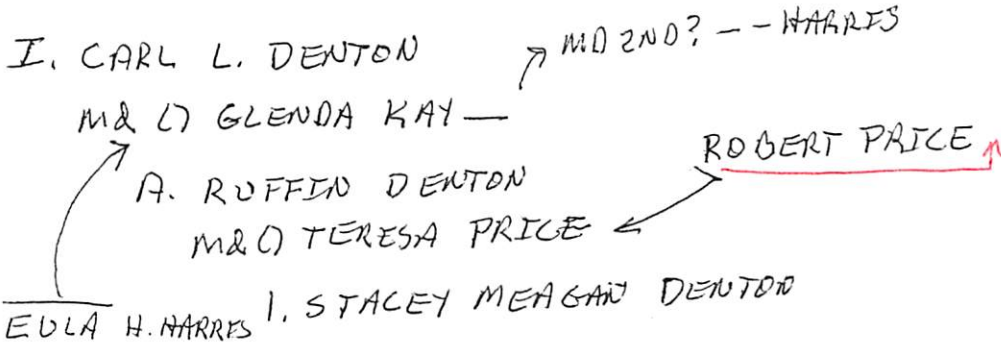

Write it down: Emit grandmother has folklore cure to get rid of warts

Warts. They are hard to the touch, disgusting to feel, horribly unattractive and, worst yet, the most annoying growth to get rid of.

Folks try every known medicine around to rid themselves of these horrible imperfections. Compound W, when applied correctly, can make a wart disappear in three to four weeks, according to advertisements. If that doesn't work, a doctor can try to freeze off that pesky wart in three or four visits. But instead of trying all these modern concoctions, why not try a little good ol' country cure? All it takes is a pen and pad, some tape, and a lot of faith.

Meet Ruth Hinton of Emit. She is 88 years old, has lived in Johnston County her entire life and she knows how to write off warts.

Writing off warts is a type of folklore Hinton has been practicing since 1929. "I can remember people coming over when I had just gotten married, and I would try to write off their warts," she said.

The way she learned this "power" is by listening. "I heard somebody telling someone else the formula, and I decided to try it," Hinton said.

"I had about 20 warts on my hands. Mrs. Ruth looked over them, touched them, wrote on a piece of paper and ... within months, all of my warts, excluding one, were gone."

She explained her talent in almost under a minute, as if it was everyday common knowledge.

"First, I look over the person's warts. Then, I write down on a sheet of paper their full name and how many warts they have. I fold and tape the paper, and tell the person to bury the paper somewhere and never go to that spot again. You must also remember to try not to think about the warts or the paper. If you do what I say, your warts will go away," Hinton explained.

Healing, however, might not be hereditary. Hinton tried to pass her talent along to one of her five daughters, Othell Price. But Price has reported her "power" doesn't seem to work.

"I told her to keep trying," Hinton added.

Close to 100 people have Hinton to thank for getting rid of their grotesque warts. Ben Hocutt of Wendell is one of those. "I had about 20 warts on my hands. Mrs. Ruth looked over them, touched them, wrote on a piece of paper and told me to lose the paper. When I left her house I tossed the paper out my window and, within months, all of my warts, excluding one, were gone," he said.

Some people have gone back to Hinton and told her that her "magic" doesn't work, because their warts were still there. Hinton explained their misfortune in that "they did not believe in it. If you do not have faith that your warts will fall off, then they will not go away."

The most unusual visitor she has received at her house, she recalled, was a dog. Robert Price's dog, Button, had a wart on the tip of his nose. "Mrs.

Writing off warts is a free-of-charge service that Hinton still practice today. It is a piece of folklore that will live forever, through legend and faith, and folks like Ruth Hinton.

Emit daughter takes writing from past to printed page

Jean Price Prince used to keep her feelings in a drawer.

Every now and then, when the mood struck, she would put pen to paper and jot down a bit of prose. Sometimes she would write about her deepest thoughts and emotions, but then she would often hide them away in a kitchen drawer.

In high school, she wrote a poem called "The Night," about an owl, the moon, the stars and gentle breezes blowing. All things that her father, the late William Frank Price, taught her to appreciate. But he didn't know his daughter had ambitions of becoming a writer.

Born and raised in Emit, about eight miles south of Zebulon, she wandered around a bit after graduating from Corinth Holder School, but she never got too far from home.

As many women did 40 years ago, she began secretarial duties which took her to Smithfield and Wilson. Even now, she works for a computer company in Raleigh while living in Apex, but she never lost that desire to write and recall those starry nights with gentle breezes stirring back home in

Four years ago, Mrs. Prince, who was a widow, rekindled an old friendship and married a former schoolmate, who had also lost his spouse. One day, he found those poems stuck away in that kitchen drawer and asked his new bride about them.

"He told me, 'You need to do something about this,' " said Mrs. Prince, referring to the encouraging words of her husband, Bill Prince.

Soon after, she read in an Apex newspaper about a publishing company in Fuquay-Varina, Research Triangle Publishing. She collected all of her favorite works, put them in a bundle and inquired about getting them published. The result is "Wings of a Dove," a work she describes as "simple yet elegant prose" depicting her "love and respect of animals, nature and the outdoors."

Such as in "Sunset," when she tells her readers to "take time to just relax, sit on your steps and watch the sunset," or the poem she wrote about a bird that was perched outside her window during a stay in the hospital.

The Princes had to pay to have the book published, but they are hoping to see a return on their investment with sales from the paperback. Most of the prose is inspirational, she said, adding it would be perfect for almost anyone, especially patients in hospitals or in a nursing home.

She already has a following, which includes Gov. Jim Hunt, she said. "I used to live next to him, and he's already purchased one of my books.

"I have always loved to write," said Mrs. Prince, adding she is now branching out and is currently working on a mystery book about her grandfather, who was a Native American.

Even in high school, she wrote a play titled "Charlie," and her poem, "The Night," was included in the 1983 American Poetry Anthology.

Her first book was dedicated to her husband, who provided her with the encouragement to reveal her poems. And instead of hiding her poems away in a drawer, she is now using a word processor her husband purchased for her and is more willing to share her talents.
