gasoline. That is exactly her position. In fact I am now exploring harvesting and selling hay rather than getting animals to use my pasture. Since I only have 30 acres of pasture that makes sense since 30 acres is too little to feed much for cattle. Now I am exploring the matter of who can harvest my hay as I don't want to spend the money to buy haying equipment. on the other hand my effort to work into the growing of crops is progressing. Just this week I placed an order for a NO-TILL DRILL (#24,750). Tom, my helper, and I will have about 500 acres to tend this year. We will do the planting but hire someone to apply the fertilizer and do the harvesting on a custom basis. If all goes well I'll buy a truck for hauling grain in 1998 and a combine in 1999.

In the meantime I am concentrating on writing my version of the Upshunks story in America. I am trying to squeeze in the 1st 8 generations which would get me up to people who lived & died 1850-1950.

Andrew Jackson Rogers is an 8th generation member.

I hope your experience with the ostrich venture will work out OK. It seems to me that we are now at the point where acceptance at the meat market is the key. I hear mixed stories on that. I will follow your reports with interest. Even if you get out of the business you have certainly had some exciting experience. If you get out - what in the world will you and Brent do with all your spare time!

I'd sure like to talk to you on 19 APR 92 and I want to thank you again for your efforts in contacting Upchurch family members in your area. This has been quite helpful. I am now up to date on extracting and following up on the materials you have sent. There were 8 items for action in the batch you sent about last February and a summary sheet on action dates is enclosed. On 13 APR 92 the item you sent from Vergie Oleta Jones arrived and I have also completely this. In all cases I have called or written to all of the individuals for whose address or phone number were supplied. Vergie named Thomas John U. Jr of the Richard U. III / Column U Solidan. The substantial detail she provided was all new to me.

As regards the DAR situation I looked over the biopile of Harmon U (XID-167) and found nothing

of interest. However, the Biographical file for his father - James U, III XFD-155, copy enclosed, seems to hold some pertinence. see item 3H.

If you can learn anything more about the Upchurch associated with the old cemetery on the grounds of the University of Texas at Arlington, TX it could be quite useful. There are some details in my files somewhere but I just looked in the three most logical places and did not find the details.

Enclosed as per our discussion is a copy of the extract of the 1910 census for TX. It is presumed to include all Upchurch in TX as of that date. You will see my notations.

I'll look forward to any additional response you may get from family members in your area and want to thank you again for your most useful actions. Please let me know if you have questions.

Your letter of 15 AUG 92 has proven to be a challenge but I think everything is now under control. First - thank you for the input. I have corresponded with Pearlene U and appreciate the copy of the letter you sent. The slip on Bernice Ray U was very useful as it provided additional details.

Regarding your Family Group Sheet, I have added some items in red and am returning the set herewith. I have kept a copy. Let me know if you have questions.

It was back in 1981 and 1982 that I worked on Ben James T. U & the Arlington, TX Cemetery. I have never finished this job and had put the packet away to be worked on later. Finally I was able to locate the packet and a copy is provided herewith. I want to publish

an article about this in the UB but would just like to see how he fits into the family. I thought that data collected in the last ten year might make it easy for me to establish his line. I am now close but do not have the final proof.

The thesis on page 1 states that J. T. U was b 29 OCT 1870 in Bosqueville, TX. I make this to be a suburb of Waco, TX which is in McLennan Co, TX. We also know he had a sister Annie M. U b 1869. I find James T. U on the 1910 census in Tarrant Co, TX with his family which all seem in order. He should be on the 1880 census in TX as age 9 with a sister Annie M. U age 13. I thought my 1880 TX census was complete. In 1880 one would expect these two children to be in the homes of their parents and thus would in all likelihood provide the key information needed to establish lineage all the way back to Michael U, I. Of course one might also find Annie M U age 3 in her parents home in 1880 (but J. T. U

would probably not be there as he was not  
born until OCT 1870. I do not have a  
complete census for TX in 1870. of course  
the 1900 might be useful as well. Do  
you have any way of resolving the name  
of the father of J. T. U. I could make  
a guess as to his father based on  
circumstantial evidence but I would  
prefer to have another part or two.

and to have your interest.

## Christmas' 94

Our lives have truly changed. Let us share with you what has happened since last year's Christmas letter and the continuing drama of:

### Days of Our Lives:

Brent finally made the decision that he would take the early retirement package from Johnson & Johnson. He was scheduled to retire on February 1st but was asked to stay until July 1st. In anticipation of moving from Arlington to the Ranch we planned to begin remodeling the ranch house and get our Arlington home ready to list for sale in May. LouWayne ended up having to supervise workmen at both places while Brent was still traveling to new places like Germany & Malaysia. We had no idea that one ranch house project would lead to ten more projects (cutting holes in floors, replacing sheetrock that fell down, finding big holes under the house that we didn't know were there.) Well, lo & behold, the home we had lived in for 23 years sold in less than six weeks and the buyers (who were from Australia) wanted to move in on July 15th. Talk about close timing- our carpet was installed on July 18th and the movers arrived from Arlington on July 19th!

What an experience that was!

Brent gave LouWayne Eight ( 8) Barbardo Sheep for her birthday this year. They follow her around like "Mary had a Little Lamb" wanting to eat all the time. Of course she has them all named. We have cats, kittens, dogs ,a new parakeet named Tweety and Koi goldfish.

## The Guiding Light:

The Guiding Light is our Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ, who is guiding us through all this. We have so much to be thankful for. We still have our son Greg here helping us build the pens. His son Jeffrey loves to come out to the Ranch. He was 11 this year. Cara our granddaughter is four and is always keeping everyone in line and on their toes at all times. Little Brent is a real laid back 19 month old. Chris and LuAnne moved to Arlington 2 weeks before we moved to the Ranch. So we have lots of reasons to go back to Arlington.

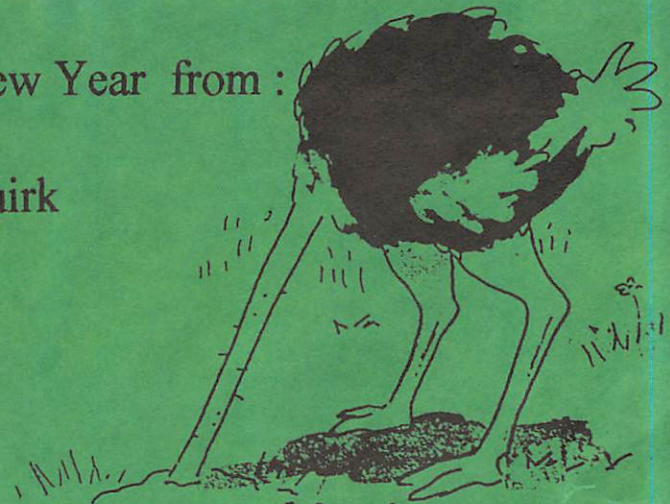

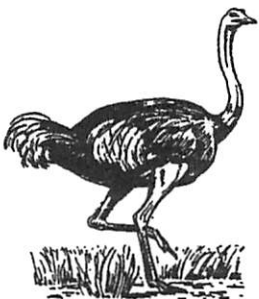

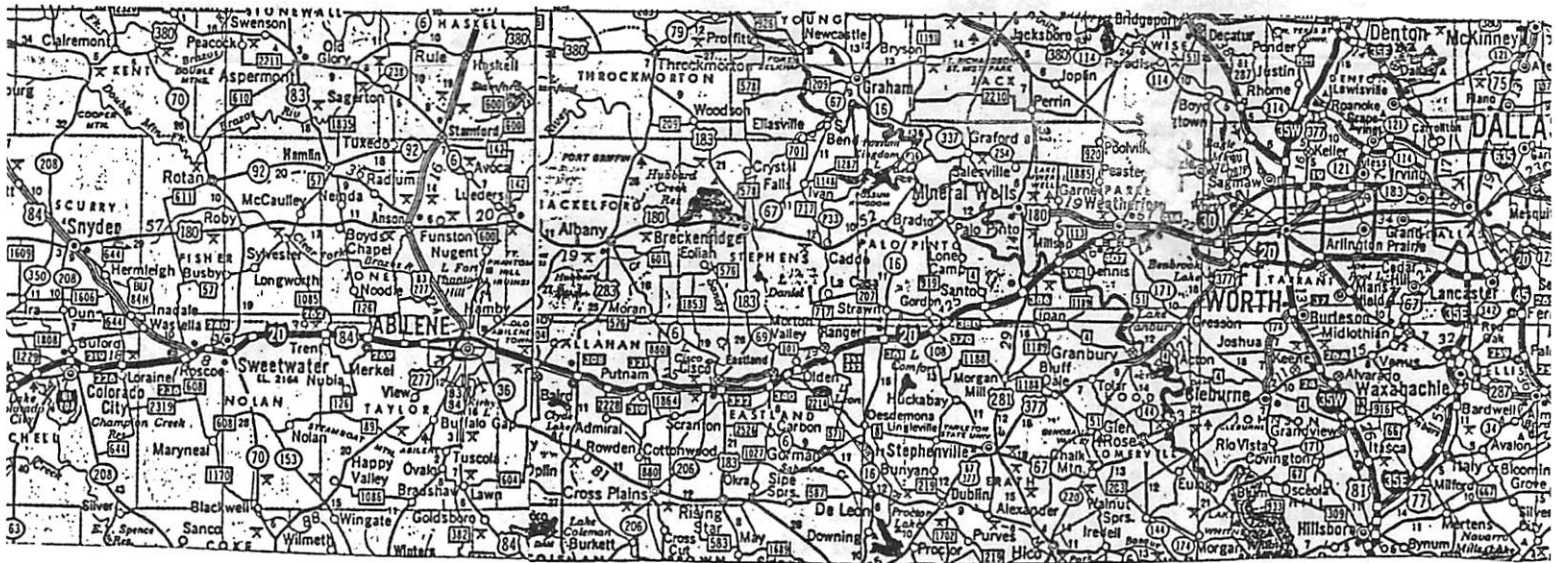
The cotton this year didn't get enough rain at the right time so we don't expect to have a very good crop.

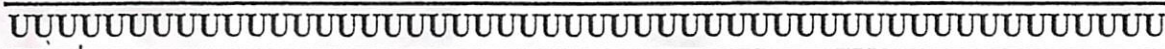

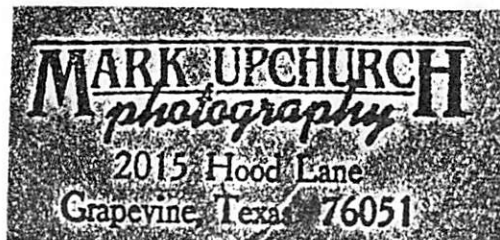

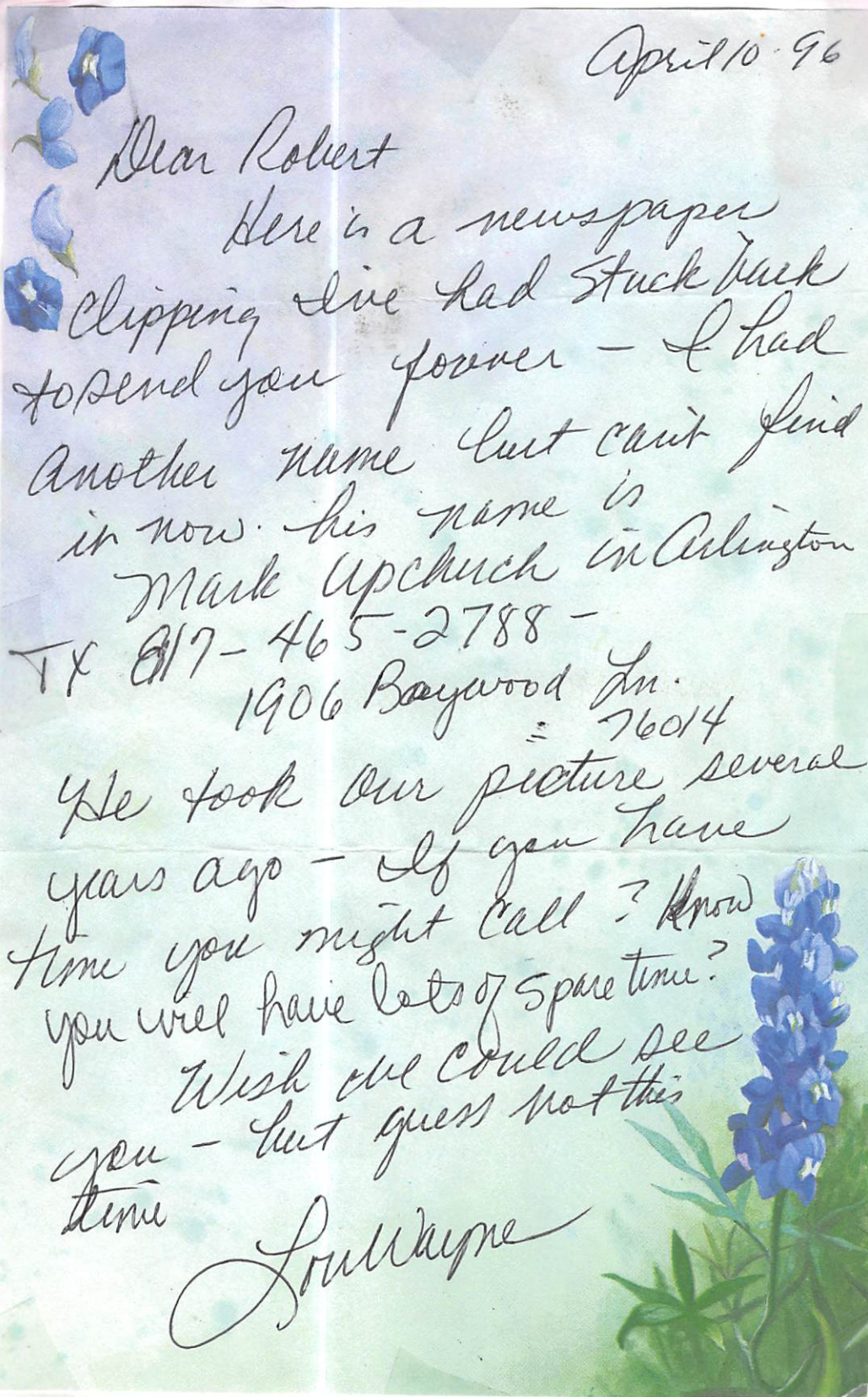

The Lord is either testing us to see what we are made of or he is blessing us abundantly! We choose to believe that He has blessed us abundantly! As you can see by the picture LouWayne loves to dress up the babies. ( She used to do this to her dog when she was a little girl.)

Greg decided he wanted to leave us in January in order to go to truck driving school. He had always wanted to drive one of those big 18 wheelers. Then on August 14th while he was in Denver Colorado, he tripped and took a swan dive out of the back of his trailer. He drove on to Salt Lake City with a load that absolutely had to be delivered. When he went to a doctor in Utah he found out that he had broken his wrist in three places and his elbow.

On January 24th the eggs started coming.. It was freezing cold; needless to say our first egg was frozen. We didn't find it until the next morning. ( Who the heck was looking for eggs?) The next egg got kicked by Foghorn and had a hole in it. ( Does it sound like we are off to a good start?) We had eggs coming every other day. We didn't start building our incubator\hatcher facility until January 18th and we weren't ready. We were desperately looking for a place to incubate our eggs. Luckily we found this wonderful young couple in Sweetwater who agreed to take our eggs and teach LouWayne the science of incubation and hatching. On March 15th our first chick "Stinky" was hatched.

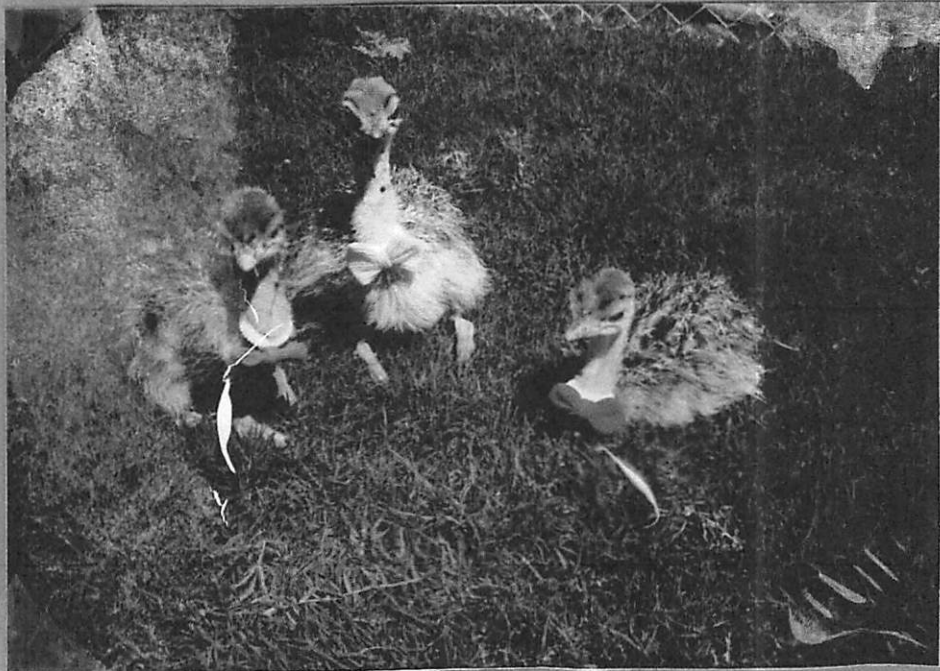
Meanwhile back at the ranch we were having other buildings built: chick barns, chick runs, and more chick barns. We finally finished the buildings in July. By then the eggs quit coming too. The final count was 161 eggs and 104 chicks hatched. We named them all ! Some are pets and some are a nuisance. They are very curious creatures, who love to peck at glasses, rings, buttons, ears and noses. The sad part is that they don't all live; some just aren't strong enough to make it in this world. At final count we have 76 new birds.

It has been a year of learning experiences. Brent spent his boyhood years on a ranch but has had to learn a different way of life from what he was used to for many years . It has been a big adjustment for us both. LouWayne wasn't used to having Brent home all the time and she wasn't used to cooking three meals a day. Brent wasn't used to being at home 7 days a week either. He has missed the excitement of work and travel. However, we are beginning to "settle in" to a new way of life.
