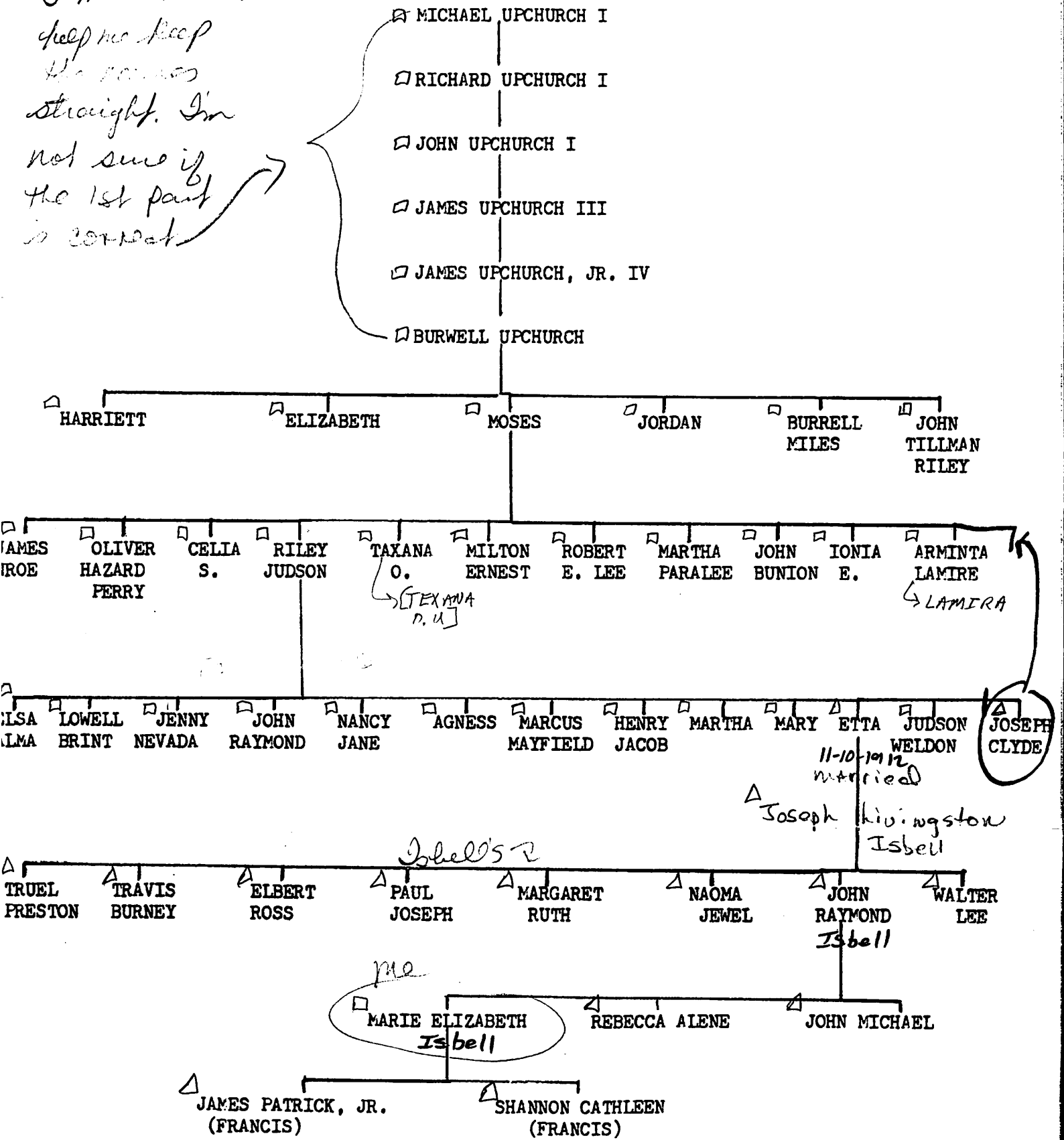

As far as I know, the George W. Isbell in Cooke County, Texas in
1880 is the son of B.F., Sr. He died in Jack County in 1899 and
I have found his eldest son, William Andrew Isbell on the 1900
census for Polk County, Georgia. By 1910, William Andrew was back
in Grimes County. I have not been able to find what happened to
either of the Mary E. Isbells (George W.'s wife and daughter) or
George F. the youngest son. I would guess that the family went
back to Georgia after George W.'s death in 1899 since William A.
is there in 1900, but I can't find the rest of the family on the
1900 census for Georgia or Texas. Have you found any trace of them?

On the sheets you sent with marriages from Franklin County, Georgia -
most of these are descendants of James Isbell who was the eldest
son of Pendleton Isbell born 1757. However, two of the Isbells -
Robert G. who married Elizabeth J. Gant and William F. who married
Mary EMMA Garner - were evidently sons of Daniel Isbell, the third
son of Pendleton Isbell b. 1757. We have had a hard time tracing
the children of Daniel who probably had at least six children. We
have just traced three: Robert, William F. and a daughter, Edith
Rebecca. Daniel died between 1830 and 1840 in Franklin County, GA.
Oh, yes, John M. Isbell who married Nancy Blair in Franklin county
was the twin of B.F. Isbell, Sr. and son of Levingston Isbell.

△ WILLIAM LEVINGSTON ISBELL (1825-1894)

William Levingston Isbell, first child of Pendleton and Susana Cleveland Isbell, was born on April 10, 1825 in Pickens County, South Carolina. He was married on October 17, 1842 to Phebe Creel/Creen in Newton County, Georgia. (A son, George Franklin, told his daughter, Emerald, that his mother's name was Creel. A copy of the marriage licence and marriage certificate shows Pheebe Creen married W.L. Isbell. The longhand is legible, but the copier could have been in error. The certified copy was received by Frances Isbell in February, 1987.) The marriage took place about three years after the Isbells moved from South Carolina to Georgia. Phebe Creel/Creen was born February 4, 1822 in Georgia. She died April 30, 1881 in Grimes County, Texas and is buried in Pankey Cemetery.

All of the children of William ("Billy") and Phebe were born in Georgia. The family moved to Texas in 1872.

In a family history compiled by Howard H. Williamson in 1948 the following description was given of William:

"William was a farmer with a great love for the soil. His great strength of character and his staunch Christian faith were instrumental in organizing several churches; one of these churches he helped to organize was the Shiloh Baptist Church in Pankey, Texas."

In the book, Bedias, My Home Town, we find these words:
"From Pankey comes the record of one of the first Houses of Christian worship in the Bedias area- the Missionary Baptist Church of Christ, the Shiloh Church. Church records, taken from a 67-year-old kidskin-covered book, painstakingly inscribed with quill, reveal that the Shiloh church was organized by the 'Undersigned Presbytery on Saturday before the Lord's Day in March, A.D., 1873; William L. and Phebe Isbell, John C. and Fannie E. Isbell, Sarah M. McWhorter, Mary Upchurch, Ira S. and Sarah E. Camp, George F. Isbell, William L. and Lencie L. Lampkin, J.C. Thomas.' The covenant was approved and the Articles of Faith endorsed by the Presbytery, which included the Reverend Eben Zerch, Elder Jonas Johnson and James Hargroves."

Martha Elizabeth Isbell, daughter of Benjamin Franklin Isbell of Polk County, Georgia, was a cousin of William. She was persuaded by Jerre, a brother of William's, to come to Texas to marry the 56 year old widower. They were married 1 Jan. 1882. Matt was 30 and had never married. Three children born to this union died at birth. An adopted child, Nellie Magness, a nephew Joseph, and Matt's sister, Mary were in their household.

The pension papers of Martha Elizabeth Isbell are in the Archives Texas State Library in Austin. Application No. 505 75 filed Feb. 12, 1932. Affidavit: "I am the widow of William L. Isbell who departed Nov. 13, 1894 in County of Grimes. I was married to him Jan. 1, 1881, (The year should read 1882 since license obtained Dec. 31, 1881; the first wife died April 30, 1881.) Pension allowed from March 1, 1932.

Military records in the Adjutant General's Office, Washington, D.C., dated Dec. 28, 1931 state: The records show that one William Isbell, Private, Company G. (Cavalry), Floyd Legion, Ga., (State Guards), Confederate States Army, enlisted August 4, 1863 at Cedartown, Georgia. He was conscripted August 10, 1863."

Martha Elizabeth Isbell died August 18, 1932; buried in Pankey Cemetery, Grimes County Texas. She was married to a Mr. Barkley briefly. He is buried by his first wife in Bedias Cemetery. "Matt's" sister, Mary Catherine, came to Texas and married a Mr. Howard at Pankey. The parents of Martha and Mary were Franklin and Mary Elizabeth Garner Isbell of Polk County, Georgia; they are buried in Shiloh Cemetery, Esom Hill.

Another child of William L. and Phoebe Creel Isbell may be Mary A. who was listed in the 1850 Census of Cass Co., Georgia (according to Sarah Coon's research) in the household of W.L. along with John, 6; Sarah, 3; Nancy, 2. She was not listed in the 1860 census with this family. We are searching for a record of death before 1960 in Georgia.

A letter received June 25, 1987 from Mrs. Robert Creel of Highlands, Texas gives information on Phebe Creel born Feb. 2, 1822 to John and Polly Belcher Creel in Ga.. Phebe was 9th child in a family of 17 children. A brother was Elijah Creel whose son George was father of twins, Jimmy and Lizzie. The family moved to Alabama in 1837, except Phebe who was already married and stayed in Georgia.

William Levingston Isbell, known as "Uncle Billy," was born in 1825 in South Carolina, the first child of Pendleton and Susana Cleveland Isbell. He married Phoebe Creel about 1843 in Georgia where all seven of their children were born. He had fourteen brothers and sisters. Seven of the nine boys left Georgia to make their home in Texas after reaching maturity — William, Jeremiah, John, James, Samuel, Franklin, and George. Eli was only 22 when killed in the Civil War, and little Andrew died when only two days old. No known death date for one girl, Rebecca M. "Becky" who married William Burkhalter. Mariann died when 41 years of age. Jane Elizabeth died when 18 years old. Martha Adaline and twin Emiline died in infancy. Frances Catherine died when only 22 years old.

The mother, Susana, was brought to Texas by her youngest child, George Pendleton, whose daughter Susana Isbell Orrick, is presently living in Port Arthur, Texas at the age of 96. Pendleton (born 1806) had died in Georgia in 1873 and was buried in Shiloh Cemetery near Cedartown. Susana (also born 1806) died in the home of her son George in 1888 and was buried in Pankey Cemetery.

William ("Billy") Isbell was a farmer with a great love for the soil. His great strength of character and his staunch Christian faith were instrumental in organizing several churches; one of which was the Shiloh Baptist Church of Pankey, organized in 1873. (The book, *Bedias, My Home Town*, lists charter members and gives information concerning the first building.)

Children of William and Phoebe: (1) John — killed in the Civil War; (2) Sarah Elizabeth — married George L. Stone 1868. (3) Nancy Jane — married J. Lewis Whaley; (4) Rebecca Caroline — married Ely John Cleveland; (5) **Samuel Andrew — married Paralee Upchurch**; (6) George Franklin — married Julia Moffett of Bedias; (7) Joe Tom — never married.

Phoebe died in 1881. Billy's brother, Jerry, is supposed to have talked a first cousin, Martha Elizabeth Isbell, into coming to Texas to marry the widower who sent her the money to travel to Grimes County. They were married in 1882. Three children born to this union died at birth. An adopted child, Nellie, married Ennis Mosely.

William Levingston Isbell died in 1894; he was buried in the Pankey Cemetery. His widow, known as "Aunt Matt," later married a Mr. Barkley, father of Ernest Barkley. Matt is

buried in the Pankey Cemetery; so is her sister, Mary Howard.

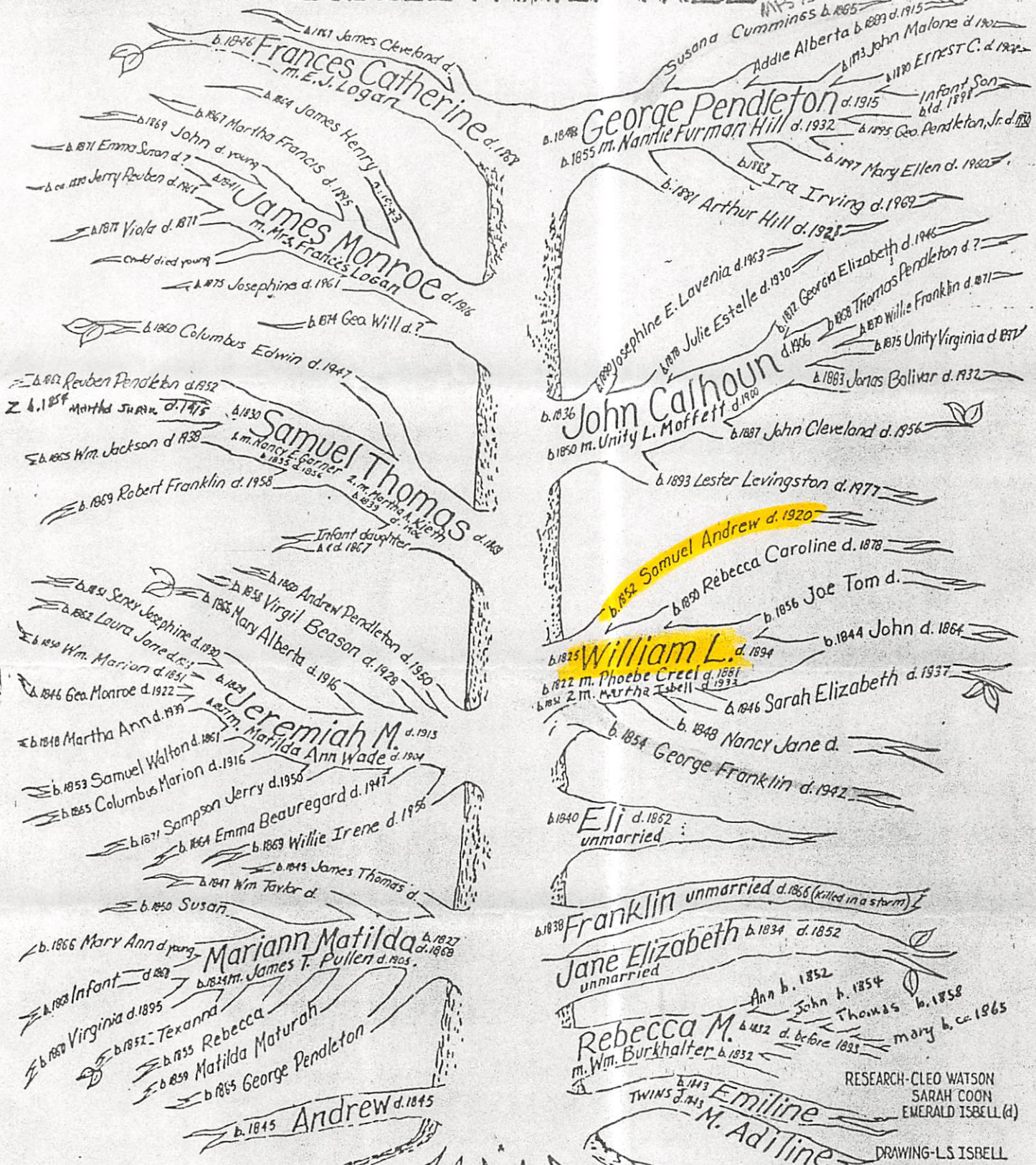
