Dear Mrs Anderson

Many thanks for your letter of August 11, 1980. I am pleased to learn that you and your husband are counting your blessings and bearing up under the hardships which have come your way. It is a great pleasure for me to share Upchurch history with those who are interested. I can tell that you have expended a great deal of energy and effort on family history. In publishing the Upchurch Bulletin I am trying a new approach to sharing and getting material into print.

I would very much like to have a copy of the deed which identifies the children of Samuel U and will plan to publish it in U B. Under separate cover I am sending you the first two issues of U B so you can see what it is like. I would very much like to have

a copy of any material you have which has not already appeared in Morgan's book. In due course it will be published in U B in one form or another. Naturally it is best to have all the papers connected but if not it should still be published.

On August 10, 1900 my wife and I were driving from Saint Louis, MO to Tucson, AZ. We stopped off in Kansas City and had a nice visit with Ada Morgan. She was very cordial and we enjoyed our visit. However, she still not agree to let me have any of her unpublished material. She seems to hope that her daughter, Kay, will carry on for her but I doubt that. Anyway, you can see that I still need material even though it has been sent to her.

If you trust me and the US Mail I would be happy to have your materials for xeroxing and would return the originals promptly. - All the best!

Dear Phil,

It was good to hear from you again (29 June 1980) and to know you are doing well with the Upchurch Bulletin.

Due to the serious illness of my husband - I am merely an arm chair genealogist - and for weeks at a time not even that. Often I don't even have the energy to read the daily paper.

Frankly for past 3 years I have not done anything on Upchurch line except record deaths, marriages, + write ups in local papers on the families. I try to record those so my records will be up to date.

Regarding the two lines not published by Mrs. Morgan. They are not of Samuel Upchurch lines - so far as I can tell. I don't know where they belong. One family lived in Hamilton Co. Ill. (just to north of Saline) & the other lived SW of Harrisburg, Saline Co.

It was a mis understanding on my part - I thought Ada M. intended to publish all Upchurchs that we found that were from N.C. - then I found out when the book came out that she only published those lines that she could



connect to established lines in N.C. + Va.

Here is a brief summary of the two lines - if you wish to publish them I'll send all I have on them to you

△ (1) William Upchurch b. ca 1788 N.C. d. prior to 1/15/1861 in Saline Co - that was date his will was entered for probate. Know nothing of him until his <sup>2nd</sup> marriage in 1841 in Gallatin Co. Ill. But apparently he had lived in Illinois somewhere prior to that time as a son b. ca 1830 was born in Ill. according to Census records.

△ (2) Enoch Upchurch b. ca 1822 Tenn. d. 1882 Hamilton Co, Ill. - ~~was~~ Came to Hamilton Co. Ill. in 1860 from White Co. Tenn. Only have record on two children. There may have been more.

Both came to Hamilton Co. just prior to Civil War.

△ (3) Felix G. Upchurch b. 1820 Tenn., White Co. d. 1878 Hamilton Co. Ill.

I have fairly complete record on the descendants of Felix as two of the descendants helped me. It seems as if a grandson - prior to his death, <sup>in 1961</sup> compiled a record of Felix & his descendants.

According to the family Enoch Upchurch was an uncle of Felix G. Upchurch. Enoch was a brother of Joseph Upchurch, b. 5 Dec 1775 - Joseph Upchurch was the father of Felix G. Upchurch.

Remember these were all compiled + sent to Ada in Jan 1975. I have no new data on them. My traveling is very limited

I still wish Ada had let me know (she wanted to surprise me when book came out - as to parentage of Samuel Upchurch). The <sup>Fall</sup> winter of 1974 - my husband & I made three trips to Durham/Raleigh N.C. - spent one whole week at Duke Univ. reading Johnson Quarterlies, etc. trying to pin Samuel Upchurch to one county. (Latham Co. was next county south of Durham. - I could really have zeroed in & maybe found out more - on Samuel, John, etc. Our son-in-law had to spend a year out there & our dau taught school while there - & since my husband had retired from school - we were really having a good time traveling & doing research. He is as interested as I. In April 1975 - he had to have one lung completely removed. Since then - we have had many problems. But we do the best we can - and we are thankful for many blessings.

Since the publication of the book I have found a deed showing all heirs of Samuel as signing as his heirs - to one of sons who purchased their interests. The deed was not recorded for several years - that is how I had overlooked it. I think the deed was made in 1841 or 1842  
(from memory)

It definitely settles the question as to the children living + those deceased.

you are correct - I spent a lot of time, <sup>telephone calls</sup> gasoline, stamps, etc on the Upchurchs - I couldn't get heads or tails from anyone - everyone knew they were "kin" but didn't know how. No one knew the name of the "Old Man" from whom all were descended. Actually most of my records came from Court records - Cemetery - Census - Bethel Creek Prim. Baptist Church + Wolf Creek Church Records - & interviews with the families. Some were very cooperative - some were positive I was going to make a fortune selling the Book - I did purchase my own book at the same price everyone else paid for theirs.

If you wish to publish the "deed" - I'll also send that to you.

I have never subscribed to a Family Quarterly - I usually take the Ky, Tenn, Ill, Indiana Genealogy Quarterlies - looking for some lead in regard to my families - it pays off in long run. I also order out micro film on inter-library loan as I have my own reader, + can get genealogy books from our State Library. So I am not completely isolated.

Dear Mr. Upchurch,

Your letter arrived this week and naturally having worked so many years on my Upchurch line - I am always interested in the family. I think you have an excellent idea and do hope you can carry it out.

Since you have the West & Morgan books on the Upchurchs- and I furnished all I had to Morgan on my direct line for her to publish, I am afraid there is nothing I can add at this time to help you. I did do some work on two other lines one in Hamilton County, Ill. and the other in Johnson Co. Ill., but I was not able to connect them to the N.C. Or Virginia Upchurch lines. These were not published by Ada.

My arrangement with Ada was that I would furnish the material on the Saline County Illinois Upchurchs- there were so many- (Samuel had 12 children and to our knowledge 11 of them came to Saline County.) I have a sneaking idea that the oldest daughter, who apparently died in Wilson Co. Tenn- and her husband remarried- are the same family of Valentine Vanhoosers that removed in the 1820's to the St. Clair County, Ill. I did not have the time or help to investigate this family in detail. So had to let it alone. Ada was to do the checking in Tennessee and North Carolina- and make the connection. You will notice on page 159 of her book that the connection of Samuel to John(2) Upchurch in Chatham Co. N.C. is actually not proven at all. - only by association. If Ada had let me know that she had found Samuel in Chatham County, I would have zeroed in on that county and really checked it for all it was worth, as I made three trips to Durham and Raleigh, N.C. in one year. I spent all my time trying to locate Upchurchs in the various counties- and never did run across Samuel at all. ( Our daughter and her husband were in Durham for a year- he was in school and she was teaching out there.) I really got well acquainted at Duke Univ. which was very close to their apartment and worked there every day in the library along with my husband doing research. Since Ada's book has come out I have only had one chance to return to N.C. and only went as far as Rutherford County last spring- came on home as my husband was not feeling so well- since then our trips have been very limited- his health is not good. We have to have oxygen available all the time in our home, for his use. One lung out and a heart condition.

So honestly I can't give you a line back to the Colonial Upchurchs. On page 159 of Ada's book there are some errors. None of the children of Samuel were born in Virginia- that I found. The first five children were born in N.C, and the remainder in Tennessee. I disagree completely with Ada in regard to Samuel being in Bedford Co. Va. in 1810. I don't mean there wasnot a Samuel there- but I don't think it was my Samuel- ( If there was only a census for all of Tenn. in 1810 !!) . In regard to the youngest child of Samuel- Ada insists that he is listed in the 1850 Census of Wilson County, Tenn.- True there is a James Upchurch listed as head of a family and about the same age as our James Upchurch- but I think the James Upchurch in Wilson Co. in 1850 was the son of a Sarah Upchurch listed as head of a family in 1840 Census of Wilson County - with one male in the home age 20/30 yrs. I never could find anything at all in Gall.-Saline on this youngest child of Samuel and I assumed he was dead- After the book went to press i finally located a deed filed several years after it was made- by the "heirs of Samuel Upchurch" and James was not listed as an heir- so he was dead when his father died.

I am still adding to my Upchurch file all the time- but so far all has been on the descendants of Samuel Upchurch- none on the ancestors of Samuel. I have located a bible record on the John and Caty Upchurch family (p.162). <sup>for JOHN U</sup> And have found some more lines that I knew nothing about. The way things look right now I doubt my being able to do much on the Upchurchs- except what I can do here at home or in this area.

However if I find out anything I will be glad to share it with you. If I have anything that you can use now just let me know what it is.

To my knowledge I am the only member of Samuel's family that has ever tried to really do any research on the family - plenty are only too willing to receive what I have but no one was willing to do do much work on it. No one knows the days and days I have spent in court houses and reading microfilm and checking cemeteries- probing in cemeteries for missing stones and interviewing people- trading work with a person who was allowed to copy marriage records- when no one else anywhere is allowed to see the marriage books- only if you pay the \$3 for the marriage record. Fortunately my husband has always been very generous with me- and has never said a word as to the amount I drove and used the car on these trips. One woman on my own direct line was so sure I was going to make a fortune on Ada's book that she would never let me see the family bible- and I knew she had it as her brother had told me she had it.- But you can't change those kind of people. She simply cannot understand that I did the Upchurch family because I wanted it done and copied and I was pleased to have Ada publish it- now even though there are mistakes - it is in print. She ca<sup>n</sup>t understand that Ada didnot make anything on the book- that it was a labor of love.

I think I have rambled on enough. We are snow bound in Southern Illinois have between 15 and 18 inches on the ground. Very unusual for us. But last year was a very bad year also. When I can't get out- there are so many places I just have to go to- I get stir crazy after awhile. I can't even get the car out of the garage. The streets are clear but no place to park the cars. Again thank you for thinking of me.

- (2) After the book went to press - located record of the family of John + Catherine (Johnson) Upchurch - I've had that xeroxed for you also. (all in name of Arthur Reed who lives between Raleigh + Galatia. Arthur let me take the family record to Galatia bank for copying.)
- (3) Record made by Caswell B. Upchurch - which I had xeroxed for you.
- (4) Life of Catherine Johnson.

- The man I think about - that
- "Grandmother Milly Johnson - born 1778 died 1853"
- Milly may have been mother of Catey or Catherine

Upchurch. - If she didn't die until 1853, she should be in an 1850 Census somewhere.

NOT in Saline, Hamilton, Gallatin, or Franklin Co.  
All 1850 census - I have just checked these.  
Of course she might be in Wilson Co. Tenn.

I would like more dates, etc on your parent

County - is that my husband was ill by the  
time I discovered for sure that that family  
was a son of Samuel - & I didn't get to

person who worked so hard getting Caswell's descendants  
in order - was not able physically to do  
any Court house work. Both he & his wife  
were in poor health. He made several  
trips to our home sometime to just visit  
& sometimes to bring me data. The last  
time I saw him was the night he came to  
funeral home in Harrodsburg - when my brother  
died. He was a politician if there ever  
was one - but I liked him.

Sorry to ask you to return the notes I have in one batch - but takes too much time to copy. I hope you understand.

All I want is to have notes returned to me - pay for copying + postage. I can't believe my postage is going so high.

P.S. The Reads have had a couple of genealogies on their lines published + the Bramlets have had a book published on their line.

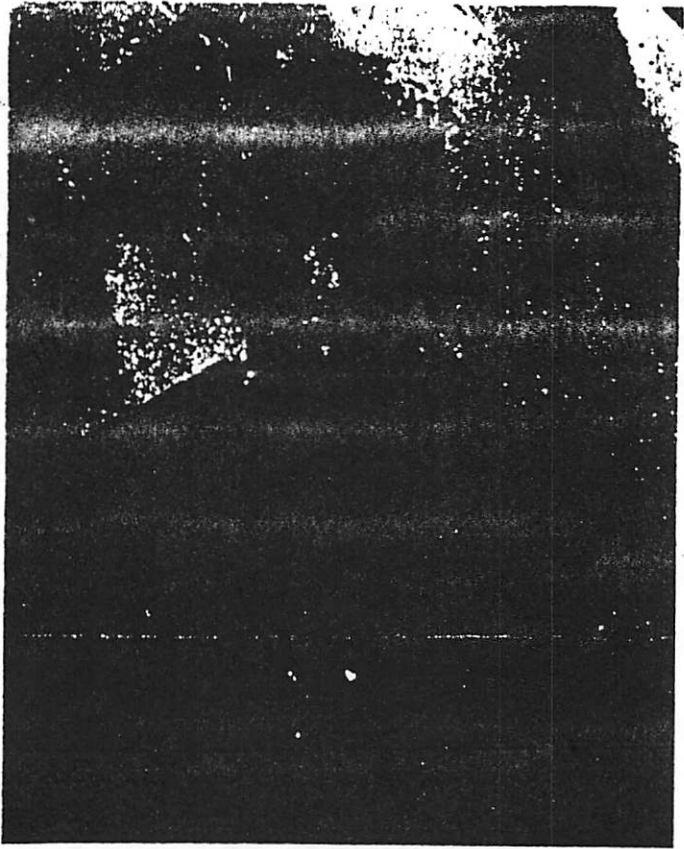
I don't know whether your father was reared in Franklin Co. Ill or not - but if he was - he probably knew the McCreery of Franklin Co - I have really worked on our line also -

## LIFE OF CATHARINE JOHNSON.

The following is a short history of the life of Catharine Johnson, who was born in Nash County, North Carolina, May 7, 1803, near Raleigh, but raised in Wilson County Tennessee.

She was married to John Upchurch in Tennessee, who was born Oct. 18, 1798, in North Carolina, and died in Saline County, Illinois, February 2, 1844. He lived in Saline County, ever since 1825, up till his death. She still lives on the same farm near Raleigh. They raised ten children, five boys and five girls; all of which lived to be men and women and were all married. There are seven yet living, four women and three men. There are three widows. Three married twice. She has about fifty grand children, eighty great grand children, and 10 or 12 great great grand children, and 15 or 20 dead. She is still living, and belongs to the Baptist Church in which they lived ever since 1823. All their children belongs to Christian society except one. They lived in their own house about 20 years with only one death (the husband.) She has been blind and unable to walk for eight or nine years, troubled with rheumatism.

This is the record of C. B. Upchurch, the oldest child of the family, who was born July 24, 1820, now living near Gresham, Ill., Franklin county. He was raised in Saline county and lived there till Oct. 1868. He was a private Soldier in the late war of 1861.

STATE OF TENNESSEE, *Weldon* COUNTY, ss.

To any regular Minister of the Gospel, having the care of souls, or

THE Clerk do hereby authorize you or either of you, to solemnize the rites of Matrimony be-  
tween *John Upchurch* and *Cathy Johnson*  
of your county, in accordance with the direction of an act of Assembly in such case made and  
passed. It is further directed that the said *Cathy Johnson* be an  
actual resident in this county—otherwise these shall be null and void, and shall not be  
accounted any license or authority to you, or either of you, for the purpose aforesaid, more  
than though the same had never been prayed or granted, &c. Given at the clerk's office

of said county court, this *14th* day of *August* 1821

FELIX G. UPCHURCH born 19 Nov 1820 White Co. Tenn.  
[TAUGHT SCHOOL] died 11 October 1878 Hamilton Co. Ill.

The parents of Felix G. Upchurch were Joseph Upchurch and Martha (Bradley) Upchurch. Joseph was born 5 December 1775 and the mother Martha Bradley was born 12 January 1789. In the 1860 Census of Hamilton County, Ill., the mother, Martha, was in the home of Felix, and it states that she was born in North Carolina. She is not listed with any of the family in 1870 Census, so it is assumed she died between 1860 and 1870. According to Mansfield Shuster, a great grandson of Joseph, Joseph Upchurch was a school teacher in Tennessee, and compiled an arithmetic book for use in school which was widely accepted. Felix G. Upchurch came to Hamilton Co. Ill in 1853 from Dekalb Co. Tennessee.

Felix G. Upchurch married Anna Cantrell in Tennessee and most of their children were born in Tennessee. Anna was born 20 Sept 1815 Tenn. and died 9 Oct 1877 in McLeansboro, Illinois. Both Felix and Anna are buried at McLeansboro IOOF Cemetery. Anna Cantrell was the 12th child of Abraham Cantrell, who was married to Sarah Durham in Spartanburg, S.C., and moved to Tennessee about 1813. Abraham Cantrell received a land grant in 1814, which is recorded in Sparta, White Co., Tenn. Anna married Felix G. Upchurch and moved to Hamilton Co. Ill. from CANTRILL-CANTRELL Genealogy Revised Edition published 1973 by Dr. Joseph Caten, McLeansboro, Ill. After the death of Anna, Felix Upchurch married a widow, Eliza Gooden on 16 Jul 1878 in Hamilton Co. Shortly after this marriage, Felix was thrown from his horse in McLeansboro and killed. His estate was entered for probate in Hamilton Co. Ill. on 11 October 1878. The heirs are listed as: Widow, Eliza, and the following children: (all children by Anna Cantrell) Joseph, Enoch, Berry, Robert, James, Martha Shuster, Mary Shuster, and Sarah Holmes. The grandchildren of Felix G. Upchurch were named as Felix and Anna Upchurch, both minor children of the deceased son, George D. Upchurch.
