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



Dear Cousin Fannie,

Your note of last December that you would not renew on the UB for the year 2000 is certainly understandable. I try to make it seem the entire extended Upchurch Family which means that a given individual may only occasionally see something that is of special interest to them. Overall it seems to be worthwhile as we have a distribution list of about 200 which is fairly good for such ventures.

This still leaves me with a quandary as to how to maintain contact with people such as yourself. We are cousins (distant) and also interested in related families in a special geographical area - Missouri Creek Area. An effort to have a more productive ongoing relationship with individuals

having an interest in the Meador Creek Area

have turned to the PEARCE Family and after about 30 hours of effort (I am slow!) have prepared the attached "Perspective" Document dated 15 FEB 2000. I hope it is self explanatory. I would welcome any input or suggestions you might have for this item. It is not intended to be a definitive document on the Pearce Family although we might make real contributions to that end in this venture.

Over time I would like to make Chapter Two as complete as possible covering Nathan Pearce I, his children and Grandchildren. If you have any corrections or additions for this Chapter they would be especially appreciated. I am sure Elizabeth (Pearce) Ray had children but I don't seem to have them. Then there are the two unnamed daughters.

I believe the family of Arthur Pearce disappeared from the Franklin Co, NC scene a few years after he died - hence no upheaval in marriage with his descendants. However - the thought just struck me - maybe Arthur's wife was me

Nancy Upchurch. Note that his wife was named Nancy and also that Richard U, II had a daughter named Nancy U - for whom we have no further record. Note also that Moses U (a brother of Nancy U) became guardian for Arthur + Nancy's minor children.

The most important matter I need to sort out is the name of the Upchurch males who were fathers of the early Upchurch females who married Pearce males. There are three of these three of these U females Susan, Francis^{#1} and Francis^{#2}.

I suspect Susan was the daughter of Benjamin U. The children of Nathan Pearce II and Susan U are covered in great detail in Chapter III of the enclosed document.

Francis U^{#1} was the daughter of Richard U, II and Francis U^{#2} was a granddaughter of Richard U, II. Francis U^{#2} was a daughter of Richard U, III. Thus Francis U^{#2} was a niece of Francis U^{#1}. Both Francis U^{#2} and Francis U^{#1} married a neighbor named John Pearce. There seemed to be only two Pearce by the name of John at that time. I have labeled them John Pearce, I and his nephew

John Pearce, II. The question is which France named which John

Presently I carry the Frances who named John Pearce, II as Clara Frances U and show her as a daughter of Benjamin U (I have their descendants organized under the Benjamin U clan. This would actually make Frances U #3 and she would be another niece of Frances U #1.

My head is now swimming over these Johns & Franceses. In part they can be separated by the fact that the John who named the Frances who was the daughter of Richard U, III left Franklin Co, NC (presumably with his wife & offspring) shortly after Richard U, III died in 1817. Thus the John & Frances who stayed in Franklin Co, NC on into the mid 1800's represent a Frances other than the daughter of Richard U, III. - Still - which John named which Frances. My files probably contain some more hints if I can just get someone to help me think this through. If this John & Frances part does not interest you just ignore it.

I don't know if the enclosed document sets the stage for you and I to have more exchanges about family matters. Please let me know if any aspect of this interests you and if there is more we have to exchange.

After twenty years of trying to serve the entire Upchurch family I am now moving to give more attention to Richard U, II and his descendants. I am working to turn my farm operations over to the men who farm on shares with me, we are reducing our Upchurch publications from 6 to 2 per year, and we are having a new home built. It is a villa with all of the outside labor, care of by others. In six months we should have more freedom including the prospect of a visit to NC periodically

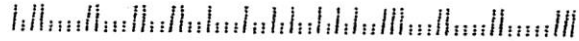

Dear Cousin Fannie,

Thank you for the clipping from the 4 FEB 1999 Wake Forest Newspaper. This is the first I have had of the article itself. However, I have long corresponded with the author Janet Lythell-Pudley. A couple of years ago Sallaine and I visited with her in her home. At that time she lived just outside Oak Ridge, TN. I have today written Janet and sent her a copy of what you sent me including your comments. She will no doubt appreciate your thoughts. Perhaps Janet will let me know if she gets other input.

The Ambrose U she wrote about is a different one from your Ambrose U. The two were distant relatives and probably did not know each other. Among other things

Janet and I have tried to figure out where her Ambrose lived in Franklin Co, NC. We have had no luck other than to conclude that it was further North in Franklin Co than the Pilot/Moccasin Creek Area where your Ambrose lived.

The four children of Ambrose U about whom Janet wrote are of special interest to us and especially the one named John Jordan U as he is the most famous Upchurch of all. He has been treated a number of times in the Upchurch Bulletin. As an example I include herewith pages 87, 89 & 91 of U.B. Vol 4 No 3 - JUL 1983. We do not know anything more about the murder of Ambrose U than Janet has written. It is great to know she is trying all sorts of techniques to locate more information. She is a great researcher and I hope she uncovers a lot more. There is no end to what we can find if we keep looking. Almost every week some new "stuff" turns up.

I hope this finds you and Jimmy well and looking forward to a great spring. You will have read in the recent U.S. when Sallaine and I passed through NC in December. We were concentrating on seeing her brothers & sisters and my sister in Greensboro and my niece in Ayden. We must go back and do "family history". I would like to do it this April as I could then also attend the 50th Anniversary Reunion of my graduating class at N.C. State - but plans are not yet firm.

Thanks again for writing and please do keep me posted on any developments in your part of the family.

Seeks answers to families' history

To the editor:

On Oct. 24, 1824 in Franklin County, North Carolina, Ambrose Upchurch was shot and killed by a man of whom his son says years later "a Mr. Wright, who married the half sister of my mother. What the difficulty was about, I was too young to comprehend. Wright fled the country, and it was said went to Arkansas, while that state was held by Mexico; at any rate, his family followed some time after. I well remember the circumstances of three Negroes and 350 acres of land being taken from us, which led me to believe that property was the cause of the murder."

Ambrose Upchurch was the only son of John Upchurch and Mary "Anne" Harris of Franklin County. He left behind a widow, Elizabeth Hill Upchurch, the only daughter of the Honorable Henry Hill, a magistrate who appears to have been both a prominent and wealthy citizen of Franklin County. He also left behind four small children, my great-great grandfather, John Jordan Upchurch, his younger brother, William Horace Upchurch, and his two older sisters, Priscilla M Upchurch who eventually married Turner Lawrence, and Mary Ann Elizabeth Upchurch who eventually married Ralph Parrish.

Ambrose Upchurch was my three times great-grandfather. I first read the story in his son's memoirs when I was very young, and have been intrigued ever since. So much is left unsaid. Who was "Mr. Wright" and his wife who was half sister to my great-great-great-grandmother? Why did he shoot Ambrose? Why was the land taken? By whom? The event, as you can imagine, had great impact on my great-great-grandfather's life. His mother unable to support him, he and his siblings

are sent to live with their paternal grandfather. It is to be 10 years before they are reunited with their mother when her father deeds a farm to her. He grows up to establish the first fraternal insurance program for widows and orphans in the country. What happened to Elizabeth during that time? She does not appear in her father's household. Who was her mother? Why did her father who was by all accounts a wealthy man wait 10 years to purchase a farm for her, so she could be with her children?

The Upchurch, Hill and Harris families all had sons, daughters, parents, cousins etc. in Wake, Granville, Halifax and Franklin counties. It is my hope that some of your readers may have families who go back to this era and be able to supply some of the answers to these questions through either facts or family tales handed down.



Dear Cousin Fannie,

Thanks for your letter of 20 FEB 1994. I have gotten behind on genealogical mail and am trying to catch up (It is 6:00 AM on Sunday morning as I write this). I'll do my best on your eleven questions. Some are answered on the enclosed copy of the list.

#2 - Angelina U (XID-3569) surfaced as a child of Bushely U. Later it appeared that Angelina U & Ersula U are one and the same but I have never gotten enough information to change my master outline so lists are still named as dau of Bushely U. I hope we can straighten this out. If they are the same, presumably the person is Angelina Ersula U or Ersula Angelina U.

#3 Re Husband of Ersula U - The best we can say is that Ersula had 1 or more common law husbands by whom she had three children and that Ersula U elected to name her children bear her maiden name.

#5 You have found an error in my system. It is a fact that Agnes Ann U (XID-823) and Maggie Ann U (XID-18954) are one and the same. Although the marriage license for Lemm B. Phillips + Maggie Ann Denton show the wording Maggie I am convinced the proper name was Agnes Ann (Upshur) Denton. She was called "Aggie" and I think the people who made the license wrote down Maggie rather than Aggie. Lemm md 1st Mary Perry. I have now given her the XID No of 18954 thereby using one of the two numbers formerly assigned to Agnes Ann U. Thanks for this important correction (see enclosed Profiles for Fenner Denton, Mary Perry, Lemm B. Phillips and Agnes Ann U)

#8. See Master outline Continuation Section 22A-D enclosed. Note especially 22C for Lula May (Ray) Fenell Family. Also, note enclosed Profile sheet for Gertrude Shetwell Fenell (originally thought to be Gertrude Spiney Fenell). The record on this family is confusing because of this name change and possibly because of the confidential note about the offspring. I do not have the details on the offspring.

Thanks for the listing on the Upshur-Bunn Cemetery.

you asked about the prospects of putting more data, etc in the Waltham Bulletin. Let me explain how the press work which may seem to be the stop for you and I to work even closer. I am sure you can manage the large job involved in keeping up with the Waltham Bulletin. The Waltham Bulletin serves the purpose of keeping the many parts of the family informed. One half of each is devoted to a history of newly joined families (600 new XIP's per issue). These numbers are assigned as the names become available. The names are published as received (name & turn out of the money). Dates of birth & death are published if available. This goes a name in the system. Periodically I publish Waltham Bulletin on other documents on certain segments of the family. This is OK if your action of the family happens to get published - but it takes me a long time to get around to all the sections. My way of dealing with this is to offer a set of Waltham Bulletin computers machine copies of material in my files. Some

such items are enclosed in this letter for your use. As another example, I enclose herewith the 25 Page Master Outline on the Richard U, III / Bushely U Subdan through the 9th generations. I keep these Master outlines up-to-date so that one provides you the very latest data on this Subdan. The numbers on the left hand side of the pages show where I have data on even later generations. I am always happy to send copies of these continuation sections where someone has an interest.

I last sent you a copy of the Richard U, III / James U, VII Subdan Master Outline in my letter to you of 21 JUN 92. I can send an update at any time.

I think it good for family members to read the U B and get what they can from each issue. The supplementary materials I can send takes me a step beyond what can be done in the U B.

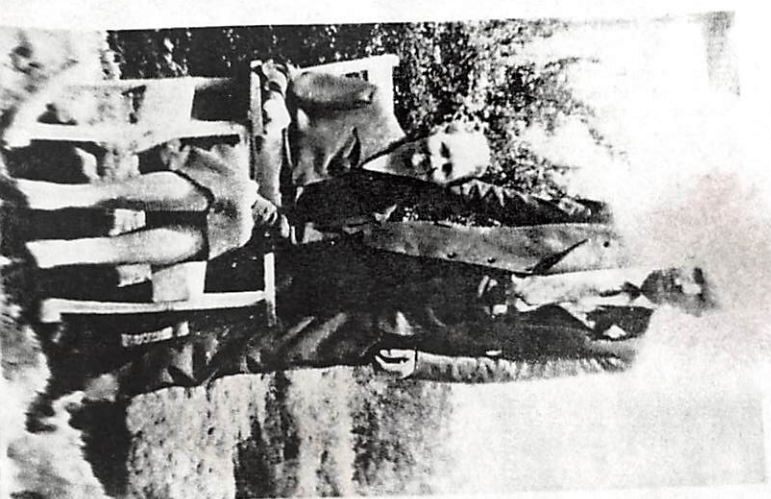

I have just now found time to study the letters of Willie Altan Reid, Jr. dated 7 DEC 1996 to you and to me. In the process I have gone back into some of the records available to me to attempt to resolve the issue of the father of Franklychurch. Within the limits of the time available I could not resolve the issue. For now I will place information in my files showing clearly the two possibilities. I would have hoped of solving this puzzle as I continue to study the records for the Wake/Franklin border for the 1750-1850 era.

I have a huge amount of reference materials for the border area for 1750-1850 and am constantly adding to them. They consist of official records, letters from cousins such as yourself and Willie,

clippings, etc, etc. I am constantly reworking these records and creating Biopiles for specific individuals of interest. These Biopiles are filed alphabetically so I can easily get back to what was added earlier and incorporate more information. Last month I spent about 3 days on documenting the HILL family of Franklin Co, NC and created about 500 new Biopiles on members of this family and related individuals.

As I return to the records to study the descendants of Richard H, II and his 11 children (one of whom was Jubal H & one of whom was Nathan H, I, my GGF) there is no doubt that we will continue to improve our understanding of this family and related individuals. Jubal H has been one of the most difficult to pin down but he is of special interest to me because he had lots of land at one time - over 2,000 acres.

Fannie, it is great to have you as a
 cooperator and I hope you will continue

 on the family. In turn, as you know,
 I am always happy to share what I have.


