✓ Their father George Henry Andrews, Sr. ran a store in Chatham Co, NC as did his father. He was selected by the farmers to run for Chatham Co, NC Sheriff & was elected 4 terms. When Wren Scott became Governor he took an appointive office. He had diabetes which the family hid from the electorate. He was outgoing and loved people & his job. He & Beatrice had most of their lives

in the home where I visited Beatrice year ago (Upon departure we spelled the house - still intact)

They had a Cousin Andrews relative who was a hermit. At the end stayed in the Poor House for a short while.

Beatrice hated her husband's feet which Aunt Ellie thought was gross. [ELEANOR MARKS U, II]

They felt Aunt Ellie (then GM) was poorly served in having to live first with one child & then another in his lengthy widowhood. They were shocked when a postcard arrived from her with writing on front & back giving family secrets - such as James got drunk again last night or was. Aunt Ellie had a teaching certificate.
