Hi Cousin Sherwood---

I am very excited about your response as it would appear the information I and others have worked to collect for so many years will now be of great use to you and Jack as you build your special collection. It is always a great joy for me to share. To be most efficient it will be helpful if you take full advantage of the 4,000+ pages of search-able material I have posted on my website. Would you and/or Jack please make a couple of passes at the posted records and let me know if you are finding interesting information. If necessary, I can provide a few clues in case the right sections do not surface for you. You and I have as a common ancestor Richard U.,II for whom you will find a video posted. You can backtrack from him to see a video on each of his ancestors back to Michael U. I. Richard U.,II had 11 children and you descend from his son Richard U.,III on which tons are posted and I have more. I descend from Nathan U.I, another son of Richard U.,II. Richard U.III had eight children who are well documented one of whom is your ancestor James U.,VII whose son Kearney U. you mention. You will read about my years of searching for the grave-site of James U.,VII and my excitement when I almost assuredly found it. Kearney left the Moccasin Creek Upchurch Enclave sometime before 1840 and settled in the Crossroads district where he is buried.

And now for items we can give more attention to if you so desire:

1. The Kearney U Grave site needs care. We could do something about this under UAFA.
2. The 1840's home of Kearney is still standing and in the family. It would be wonderful it could be preserved/restored.
3. A portion of the Kearney U. plantation has been acquired by the City of Raleigh for a park. It would be great to have it named Upchurch park.
4. Kearney U. had a sister Elizabeth Thaney U who married John Phillips. Their Plantation "Mansion" is still standing and owned by my friend Simon Rogers. Their grandchildren became famous as makeup artists in Hollywood
5. The exact land owned by Richard U. III was identifies when I hired a person n to did out the records. See UB issues.
6. Our Upchurch English records are really great.
7. The given name "Sherwood" stands out in two instances in the family (aside from yours).
8. I am aware of the connection o your family to Duke University and that needs to be documented and preserved. (My son is a Duke graduate.)
9. I keep my records manually and have a nice Master Outline for your part of the family which I will be happy to send hoping you will be willing to help improve it. Since your message I have assigned XID Numbers to your three children.

We can move stepwise on digging into the above items.

Thanks for your \$20 for membership in UAFA for 2014. Let me share a few aspects of the Allied Families project on "enrolling families". For the most part we propose to enroll families starting with an ancestor who lived about the time of the Revolution and proceed to treat the ancestor and descendants by collecting, organizing and sharing information. Importantly, we propose to keep the information online far into the future, hopefully indefinitely and to keep making corrections and additions. Current online presentations are full of conflicts and errors which we propose to minimize. The enrollment fee for a family will be \$500 which can be gamered in steps. Anyone who contributes as much as \$50 will be listed as a Co-Sponsor the enrolled family. When we get to \$200 a 1,000 word narrative will be created for the family and posted on the UAFA website. At \$500 we will add more details. Beyond \$500 the contributions will be put in a long term support fund with the goal of reaching the \$10,000 endowment level . The income from this fund will be used equally to keep UAFA robust and to upgrade the records for the enrolled family. You ancestor Richard U, III would be an excellent candidate family to enroll. We can return to this matter as you like. This would not replace what you and Jack are doing but it would be a great companion effort.

I am well acquainted with Cousin John Perry and especially with his mother who is a delight.

If feasible I would be pleased to have the contact information for Jack.

Looking forward to collaboration with you and Jack.

Several things. First about your name Sherwood. I am not sure if his name relates to yours but the person I had in mind was John Sherwood U. 1870-1950. He was of the Nathan U., I/Nathan U., II Subclan and lived larger than life in Raleigh. He had a high profile in several respects but especially because he was a leader in organizing entertainment events. It is possible but not likely that he was the family friend for whom your Great aunt Dorothy Sherwood Renn was named. That said, he did have a daughter named Dorothy Sherwood U. ---- coincidence?? Let me know if there is any reason/interest to pursue this matter further.

In my looking I have come to realize I have conflicting spellings for your mother. Was she nee Seeman or nee Seaman?

I note your pride in your three grandchildren to which I can relate. We have eight of which three are married and one Great grandchild (so far) named after my dear wife Sallaine. Our close family is always up front in our minds.

The idea of you and Jack writing a book is a grand one and I am sure you would enjoy doing it and would achieve a lot of satisfaction in learning about your heritage. In this connection I hope you will take a look at the three families provisionally enrolled on our website www.alliedfamilies.com. I have great hopes that we can enroll the family of your ancestor Richard U., III and that we can make a video for him. I hope you and Jack will join with us in this effort. As per our exchanges I provide herewith for each of you a partial copy of my Master Outline for the family of the Kearney line in the Richard U. III/James U, III Subline to which line you belong. Kearney was a 2nd cousin of my GF Bailey Jefferson U 1841-1929.

The first six pages cover Kearney and her children & grandchildren. Descendants (if any/known) of the GC are listed in Continuation Section "C5" or shown on the left hand side of the page. I have included any one of these (after the pink sheet) - C5-3. I can send more if you so desire. The notations [C] refer to "Cooperates" or "Members Cooperates"

you will note I include full names (full maiden name of females), dates of births/marriage/deaths and place of birth/marriage/deaths/burial.

(2-2-)

for places I include town/county/state and the names/locations of cemeteries. It is hard to get all of this but a good family history has it all.

In our Allied Families effort we would have an Ancestry.COM Family Tree for each enrolled family but would not make entries for people born after 1940 (A tentative decision). But for a personal family history such as you are preparing you need complete & current details. For this purpose my Master Outline should be helpful for projects such as the one you are writing for your children/grandchildren.

I will welcome any corrections or improvements you can provide for the enclosed Master Outline. Also, I hope you will share with me copies of materials you have or collect that you would consider appropriate for my files - which will ultimately go to the Yelchuk Collection at N. C. State Univ or to the Repository we hope Allied Families will have in Wake Co, NC in due course.
