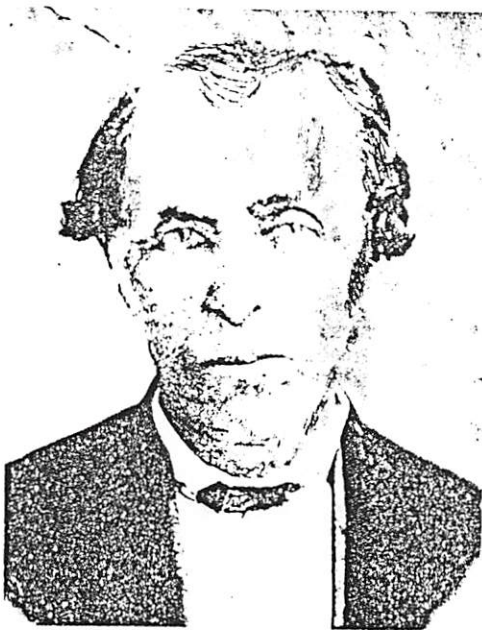
△ JAMES BOLTON
- DESCENDANTS

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△ James Bolton was an early settler and landowner in Wake County. In 1780 he received two land grants for 1,240 acres on the south side of Moccasin Creek and on both sides of Rocky Branch. He received another grant in 1790 for an additional 144 acres on Moccasin Creek. The 1790 census lists James Bolton in the Hillsborough District of Wake County. The household consisted of 3 males over 16, 3 males under 16, and 5 females. His will, dated May 15, 1813, divides his estate among his wife, Sarah; his 5 sons, Sherod, Benjamin, James, John and Ephraim; and his 4 daughters, Easter, Zillah, Caty and Dianah. (Will recorded January 1814, Book 11, page 166).
△ John Bolton was born about 1780-82. He and his wife, Ferebee, had three children. (1) Woodson (1812-1883) married Mary Howerton Pace (marriage bond issued 7/4/1846). (2) Nathan married Winsey Strickland 12/31/1833. His estate record dated 1890 lists seven heirs. (3) Lydia was not married. John Bolton was last reported in the 1860 census for Wake County as being 80 years old.
△ Woodson Bolton, born December 27, 1812, and his wife Mary were married in Wake County in 1846. Mary, one of nine children, was the daughter of Polly Gills and Willis Pace. She was born February 8, 1822 in Wake County,

△ grew up here and died in 1884. Woodson, Mary and several of their children were members of Hephzibah Baptist Church. They were buried at the homeplace about 5 miles from the church. (Sources: Bolton family Bible and Church Records, Volume 5)
△ Woodson Bolton was a farmer who owned approximately 300 acres of land in the Eastern Division of Wake County which produced wheat, rye, corn, cotton, and wool. His livestock consisted of horses, mules, cows, sheep and swine. (1860 Census — Production of Agriculture).
△ Woodson and Mary were the parents of nine children. (1) Lucy Ann first married William H. Jones in 1872 and later married Fab P. Horton in 1886. (2) William Augustus (1850-1926) married Ceranthinie I. Horton in 1872. They had 2 children, William Harvey and Cora Florence. (3) Misouria "Mittie" Cornelia (1853-1918) married J.M. Shadrach in 1885. (4) Mary Helon, born January 31, 1855, married John Manley Watkins in 1874. They had two sons, Rommie O. and Joseph Manley. (5) Eliza C. "Bett" married John C. Ferrell in 1878. (6) John Calvin (1858-1931) married Mertie Mae Horton in 1900. Their daughters: Daphne, married Eugene Bunn in 1922, has 3 children; and Mattie Mae, married James Sledge in 1931, has 1 son. (7) James Richard (1861-1929) married Nuber Phillips Pearce in 1904. (8) Sarah E. (9) Cinda E. (1865-1947) married Charlie B. Liles in 1884. They had four children: Zelma, Maude, Carl and Bessie. (Will dated 7/22/1880 and Wake County marriage records).

△ Martha Jane Liles (1856-1934) and James Algia Phillips (1857-1931). Richard and Nuber Bolton lived on the farm near Wakefield where they raised her son, Carey Pearce, and two children of their own, Willie Worth and Clellie Etta. (Interviews with family members)
△ Richard died November 24, 1929 and was buried in Hephzibah Church cemetery. Nuber was born November 17, 1881-83, died December 2, 1969 and was buried in Hephzibah Church cemetery.
△ Clellie Etta Bolton, born August 16, 1907, married Edgar "Jack" Liles (1901-1955) on January 31, 1926. They had two sons and two daughters: (1) Etta Vee, born April 2, 1927, married W.T. Sherron, Jr. in 1950, has one son, W.T. Sherron III. (2) Wallace Edwin, born April 17, 1929, married Peggy Hickey of Baltimore, Maryland where they now reside. They have two daughters. (3) Phil Ellis (1943-1973) was not married. (4) Hilda Kay was born June 13, 1945.
△ Willie Worth Bolton, born March 20, 1905, married Fannie Mae Whitley on April 2, 1929. Fannie was one of five children of Madora Cornelia Hatcher (1868-1915) and William Thomas Whitley (1872-1952). Willie died suddenly of a heart attack on December 19, 1941. Fannie was born January 4, 1901 and died December 28, 1968. They are buried in Zebulon City Cemetery.
△ Willie and Fannie were the parents of five children. (1) Ann Dora (1930-1932). (2) James Wade (1932-1970) was not married. (3) Willa Mae, born February 28, 1934, married Gordon Wallace Deans on October 27, 1957 in Zebulon. Gordon, born March 31, 1935, is the son of Sudie Mae Strickland and Charles Curtis Deans of Middlesex. Gordon and Willa have two children: Richard Wallace, born May 4, 1961 and Lisa Ann, born December 15, 1967. (4) Willie Hazel, born September 24, 1935, married Bobby Ray Lee on May 11, 1956 in Wakefield. Bobby was born on April 20, 1935 in Middlesex. Bobby and Hazel have two children: Robert Edward, born February 15, 1957 and Christi Lynn, born March 11, 1966. (5) Billy Thomas, born May 14, 1937, married Sylvia Layne Alford on May 2, 1959. Sylvia was born February 23, 1937. Billy and Sylvia have two sons: Kenneth Talman, born November 16, 1960 and William Todd, born October 19, 1965.
△ To my knowledge Billy and his sons, Kenneth and William, are the only descendants of the early settler, James, with the Bolton name living in Wake County.

△△ William Thomas Whitley, son of Needham Whitley, brought his family to Zebulon in late 1920 from Johnston county.

△△ Needham Whitley was a son of Rebecca Stancil and John S. Whitley and grandson of Elizabeth Gulley and Enoch Whitley. Needham married Leah Montgomery December 31, 1867 at Zelpha Mannys (Manning) in Wilson county. (Wilson and Johnston county records)

△△ Needham and Leah were parents of nine children: (1) Lucy (10/10/1868 — 5/14/1942) married H. Berry Phillips. (2) William Thomas (1/16/1872 — 5/30/1952). (3) N. Haywood (1874-1912) was not married. (4) Berea (2/11/1877 — 7/18/1924) married Hackney Boykin. (5) Gerusha (1879-1964) married Robert L. Parker. (6) Rachel (1881-1955) married William G. Hinton. (7) Isaac (3/13/1884 — 1/24/1960) married Trencia Corbett. (8) Thanie married C.C. Needham. (9) Oscar A. (5/7/1888 — 3/6/1935) married (1) Donna Corbett and (2) Rachel Thornton. Needham, Leah and three of their children were buried in the J.B. Whitley cemetery in Johnston county. (Grave markers & family records)

Needham enlisted in the Confederate Army in Raleigh on July 16, 1862 in Company H, 3rd Artillery and was last accounted for on the Dec. 1864 Muster Roll of Company F, 13th Battalion, N.C. Light Artillery. He probably served until the end of the war. According to legend he walked home after the war from another state, either Virginia or Tennessee. (N.C. Troops, Volume 1)

△ Leah was born in 1846 and died August 6, 1916. Needham was born April 28, 1840 and died February 4, 1917. Both were members of Salem Primitive Baptist Church. On Friday, Feb. 23, 1917, the Smithfield Herald reported him as one of Johnston's oldest citizens, being nearly 77 years of age, loved and respected by all who knew him and a man of character unexcelled. The obituary further noted that he "had been in declining health for some time, being confined to his room since early November, although he bore his sickness well, being very cheerful at times, while he suffered a great deal".

△△ William Thomas married Madora "Dora" Cornelia Hatcher on December 15, 1897 in Johnston county. Dora (January 18, 1868 — October 2, 1915) was one of five children of Nancy Brown (1844-1918) and Hiram Hatcher (1843-1895). They were members of Beulah Primitive Baptist Church and were buried in the Hatcher family cemetery in Johnston county.

△△ William Thomas and Dora had five children: (1) Allison Lester (1898-1970) married Mamie Thornton (1898-1952). Their daughter, Mary Elizabeth, married Roger Lynch. They have two daughters, Carolyn and Betty Jean. (2) Fannie Mae (1/4/1901 — 12/28/1968) married Willie Worth Bolton (3/20/1905 — 12/19/1941) on April 2, 1929. Willie was the son of Nuber and James Richard Bolton. Fannie and Willie had five children: Ann Dora (1930-1932); James Wade (1932-1970); Willa Mae (born 2/28/1934) married Gordon Wallace Deans. Their children are Richard Wallace (born 5/4/1961) and Lisa Ann (born 12/15/1967); Willie Hazel (born 9/24/1935) married Bobby Ray Lee. Their children are Robert Edward (born 2/15/1957) and Christi Lynn (born

3/11/1966); and Billy Thomas (born 5/14/1937) married Sylvia Layne Alford. Their children are Kenneth Talman (born 11/16/1960) and William Todd (born 10/19/1965). (3) Lettie Eula (1904-1959) was not married. (4) William Herman (1907-1957) married Lizzie Bissette of Bailey in 1933. They had one son, Ted Wayne (born 9/27/1946). (5) Dalmon Clinton (1912-1970) married Irene Ray (1916-1983) of Pilot. Their two children: Ann Dora (born 10/28/1942) married Duke Alphin, has two children, Duke (born 6/1/1971) and Stephanie DeAnn (born 10/8/1972); and Tommy Ray (born 11/21/1944) married Janet Griswold, has one daughter, Melissa Dawn (born 5/24-1971). (Family records)

△△ William Thomas Whitley married Winnie Victoria Hatcher in 1915 after the death of his first wife, Dora. Winnie (4/19/1878 — 1/11/1921) was the sister of Dora. William Thomas and Winnie were the parents of one daughter, Nancy Nellie, who was born October 30, 1916. She married J. Proctor Alford (1914-1979) on Feb. 12, 1938. They had two sons and one daughter. (1) Jonnie Proctor, Jr. (born 10/27/1939) married Betty Sue Doyles. Their two children are Jonnie P. III (born 1/21/1962) and Wanda Joy (born 10/14/1966). (2) Winnie Evelyn (born 8/14/1942) married Charles W. Kramer, has one daughter, Melissa Leigh (born 8/25/1970). (3) Terry Whitley (born 12/17/1946) married (1) Janet Rosser and (2) Nancy Marie Lane.

Leaving the oldest son, Lester, to manage the family farm, Thomas and Winnie with the other five children moved to Zebulon about Nov. 1920 to provide a better education for the children. They had attended a one-room school named Hatcher in Johnston county. The family first settled on a farm where highway 64 by-pass crosses Arendell Avenue today. Winnie died soon after moving to Wake county. A year or so later the family moved south of Zebulon near the Maylon Temple farm. Thomas delivered ice in town by mule & wagon. Later they moved into a big two story house on Arendell Avenue where he rented second floor rooms to male boarding students who attended Wakelon School. (Interviews with family members)

△△ On May 6, 1923 he married Dullie Temple (1880-1959), daughter of Sallie Liles & George W. Temple.

△ In May 1928 he bought a lot on Glenn Street where he built a house and lived until his death in 1952.

△△ I remember my grandfather sitting in his favorite rocker on the front porch. He also loved to fish and went with his friends every opportunity he had.

I created this Perspective Document because there were so many Pearce-Upchurch interactions I could not otherwise start to understand them. There is obviously much more to unfold.

The Document is presented in 3 chapters. Chapter 1 sets the stage, Chapter 2 is an outline of the Children of Nathan Pearce I to 1750 (1735 (VA) and their descendants (I have highlighted Upchurch interactions) Note that on page 5 of Chapter 2 Susan Upchurch enters the picture. She is probably the daughter of Benjamin U but I need someone to confirm that. At any rate she and her many descendants are the subject of Chapter 3. Note that quite a few of her descendants ~~many other~~ Upchurch descendants making them members of the Upchurch family by two lines of ascent. At some point I hope to formally embrace Susan's family as members of the Upchurch family and assign them XEO numbers - but that depends on developing adequate evidence about the name of her father - a challenge to which I must devote more time.

My tentative conclusion would be that there was not a lot of interaction between the Peases & the Boltons. Perhaps you have evidence to the contrary.

Well please don't let this big document be a burden to you. It is only relevant if it provides a basis for us to help each other. If you have other ideas about how we can proceed, that would be great.

I have had several contacts with Danny Bann recently and am greatly impressed with his land records project.

For comparative purposes I enclose my summary sheet on this same family obtained from Flora Pauline Upchurch [I don't know her name]. To compare these two sheets I have made notes in green on your 17 JAN 2002 input to show differences. Most of the differences are not critical but you can decide that for yourself.

The big difference from my standpoint is for Pearl Pearce and even that is not a big deal for me - My main interest in the family of James Dallas Pearce and his ancestors is that they trace back to Susan U, a granddaughter of Richard U, II who came to the Moccasin Creek Area of Franklin Co, NC about 1755. Susan is no doubt a child of one of the 11 children of Richard U, II. Someday we will resolve this puzzle.

In filing the sheets from your 17 JAN 2002 input I came across a 2nd, more recent, Daniel Herman Pearce which led me to his siblings. A packet of people sheets on this group is enclosed in case they interest you.

The processing of all the materials collected on our NC trip is now nearly complete. I am anxious to get back to NC again and hope to do so in 2002 but plans for that are not yet in place. In April we go to England for two weeks for a tour of Scotland and to see the four letters Michael U, I sent back to England in the 1650's. They are preserved at Cambridge University. We will meet Professor Rawson there. We have used him as a researcher for the past seven years & he is great.

Then in May we go to Arizona to attend the High School Graduation of Grandchild #2. With all of this it looks like it will be summer or fall before we can get back to NC.

Please do let me have any questions you have where you think I might help. I'll be happy to have anything you care to send.

It was great to be with you two and we greatly appreciated your hospitality. I made two more trips back to the Mayflower and will keep it on my list of favorite Raleigh restaurants. Thanks also for getting us to internet with Carla Tate and Danny Bann. We are building a powerful team for ongoing collaboration re our mutual interests in Franklin Co, NC ancestors.

Enclosed is the copy of the Granville Co, NC map you requested. I tried several settings on my copier and this is the best I could do. The problem is that the original is not very clear. If you have specific words that are unclear & of interest, let me know and I will see if a magnifying glass helps.

Gordon, I made copies of your Ancestral chart sufficient to put a copy in the Profile System for each person named. I did not find any special linkages that we need to pursue although some may appear in due course. I know the Stricklands & Perry were heavily linked to families of southern Franklin Co, NC. It was nice to learn that you grew up on Turkey Creek in Nash County. The upper reaches of that creek are of growing interest to me as Benjamin U had land on the headwaters of said creek.

Well, you gave me information on Pearl & Pearlie Pearce. I can fit Pearlie Pearce b 22 SEP 1883 d 26 NOV 1972 and Oliver Phillips into my Martin outline ok. However, I cannot link Pearl Pearce b ? FEB 1886 d 13 DEC 1951 and CATER BRANNON b 1887 d 1971 into my family outlines. Can you give me a hint?

You gave me a Family Group Sheet for 6 of the children of James Algia Phillips & Perry Roger, Johnnie Arkell, Sara Lisa "Sodie", Agnes Brown, Lou Ellen, and Robert Harris, Sr. I have now fully processed these sheets and thank you

very much for them. This added quite a bit of detail to my master outline and to my Biople system. In the process of doing this work I encountered new details & linkages based on my Biople system and have now added this to the master outline. No doubt there are more details in my Biople system waiting to be brought to light.

Enclosed is an updated copy of the Master Outline for the James Algia Phillips Family (Continuation section 23 as sent to you last November). This has grown so large I have modified the numbering system (see lower left hand bottom corner of sheet). A subsection has been created for each of the children or "presumed" children. I say "presumed" children as I have made a subsection 23V for what could have been an as yet unidentified child. Any comments will be welcomed.

I have a question about Sadie Phillips XII-18994, Biople sheet enclosed. This person was shown as a child of Berry Roger Phillips in your letter to me of 16 SEP 1987 but not in the printout you gave me on 3 DEC 2001. I conclude she should be deleted. Do you agree?

Re M. M. Phillips, Sr, son of Berry Roger Phillips, I have some comments. In his Biogfile I have several Zebulon Record newspaper clippings which lead me to conclude that his real name is Milbark Mickey Phillips, Sr and that from time to time he was referred to as "Mickey" or "Bush". His son, James, was referred to as "MIKE". Do we need to exchange more information on this matter?

Please let me know if you spot any errors on the enclosed master outline. I would welcome any additional input you may have which would make this document more complete.


James Algia Phillips is just one of the many grandsons of James U, VII I am trying to track. The Richard U, III / James U, VII Subclass is of much interest to me. It is also of interest to our "team" since of the 7 children of James U, VII only one, Jamison U, is known to have left NC. The others stayed in Central NC and their descendants continued to intermarry with local families leading to mutual interests for our "team"

Thanks to you I have established good relationships with Carla Tate & Danny Bunn and hope to be in touch with them from time to time. You mentioned that Gary Strickland was on your 1 DEC 2001 tour of Franklin Co, NC. Can you tell me more about his interests. If it is appropriate I would like to drop him a note if I could have an address.

Willa, I hope you will give a high priority to writing your Beltan Book. I must do the same on my Yuletide Book. My most optimistic projection is I might do some work on it in the last half of this year.

Please let me know if I have anything you need or if you have questions. I'll look forward to our continued collaboration.

I do have lots more stuff on streams, plantation locations, etc along with more reference from deeds, wills, settlements, etc. I have recently been trying to place these



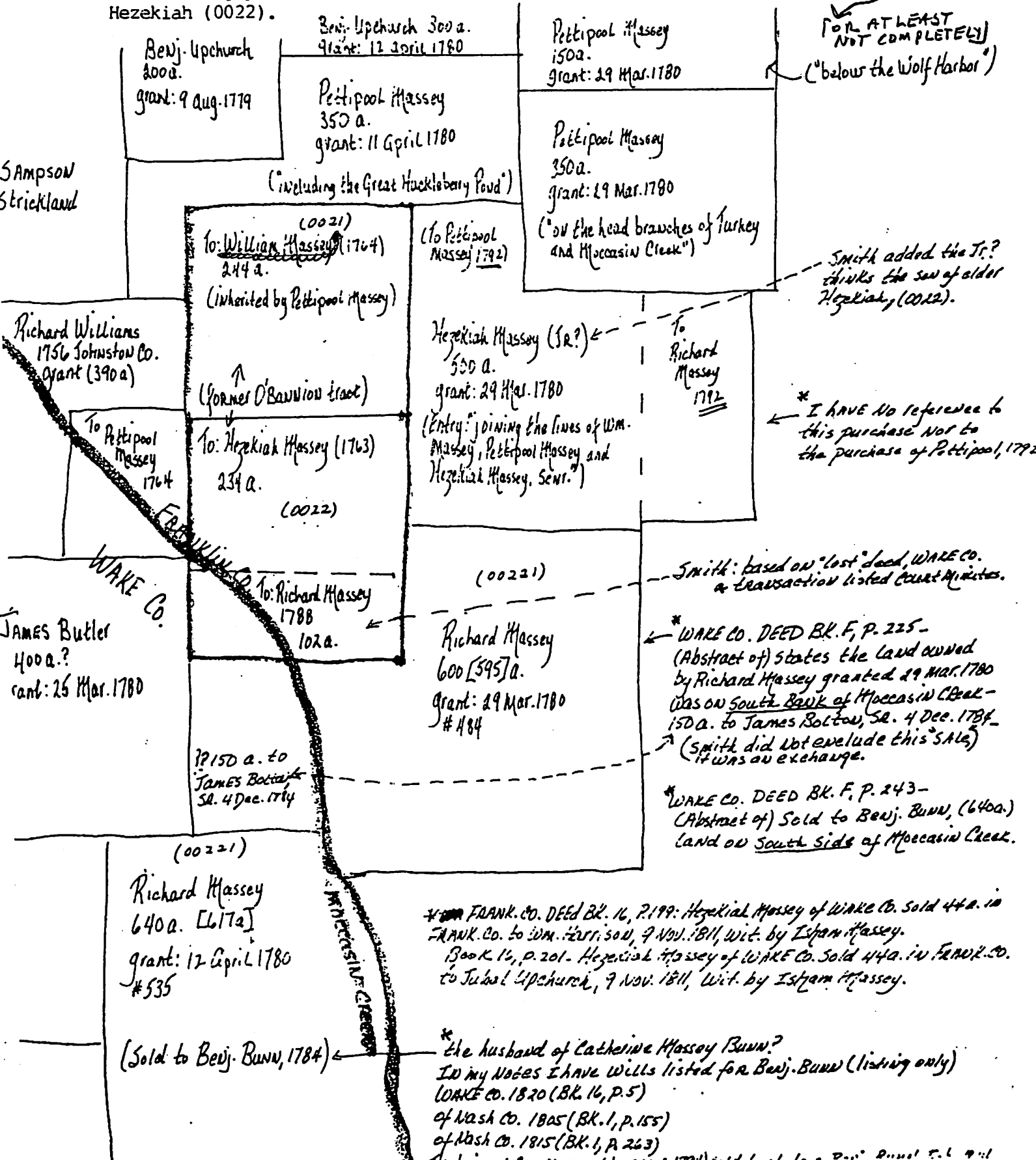

Dear Cousin Willa,

I was delighted to receive your letter and packet of 19 MAR 1996 and put everything else aside to process it. Everything you sent was useful. I have entered all details about each person on the master outline (where appropriate) and in their respective Biopiles, where a Biopile did not exist I created one. I have been creating these Biopiles for years and constantly supplement them. Periodically I go back to a particular Biopile and try to make sense out of all the entries. The families that lived in the Massena Creek Area in the 1750-1800 era were linked in many ways and we can help each other by sharing details.

I was especially pleased to have the map as I have spent much time trying to place Yellards' properties in the area. Your map places two trails for Benjamin U and one for Jubal U for the first time for me. Can you tell me more about the MASSET book you mentioned. Is it available and what is the cost?

You expressed an interest in the Richard U, III / James U, VII Subdan and the Richard U, III / Burhely U Subdan. A complete copy of the forms is provided herewith (no charge) including all 30 continuation sections. Please have a look at this and let me have any corrections, additions, comments, etc. If you have a similar outline available I would be pleased to have a copy and would modify mine to accommodate new information in your outline. Please let me know if this Master Outline is useful to you. If so I can also send the one for the Richard U, III / Burhely U Subdan. I am constantly adding to all of these Master Outlines.

Your immediate family is in section 23 of the enclosed outline. I have provided a specific set of questions and would appreciate any answers you have or can get. I take it from your letter that the marriage of Richard and Deborah did not work out (see enclosed Profile for Richard).

From your letter I take it that T. SMITH of Dallas, TX is descended from BARACHIAS MASSEY of the Mexican Creek Area. The enclosed flyer describes our upcoming Texas Trip. Do you think T. Smith

would be interested? you could send him a flyer or I could. We leave on 4 APR 96 for Texas.

Well, it seems quite clear that you and I have much common interest in the paucity of the Moccasin Creek Area. I hope we can continue our exchanges and help each other.

One question I forgot in ash concern the map you sent me based on the Massey Bosh. Do you have any idea where along Moccasin Creek these properties fall in relation to present day roads or other fixed markers. My guess is that the properties on the map are upstream from the parcel Richard H. III owned at his death in 1817.

By-the-way. I have been creating a file on streams for the Moccasin Creek Area. They are mentioned in various wells & deeds and eventually we should be able to create a map showing these streams by name - another challenge!

- 2) Who were parents of Elizabeth Thamey Butler? - I don't know

- 3) Could J. B. Phillips, son of James Elizabeth (U) Phillips (wd 11 JAN 1877), be the John Barham Phillips who wd 10 OCT 1852 (Wake Co, NC) Charlotte U? and who was Charlotte U?

Your suggestion is a new one for me but seems most likely correct and I will accept it as a working hypothesis. It is reinforced by the fact that the marriage of J. B. P to Charlotte U was witnessed by Presley F. Phillips, a known brother of J. B. Phillips. I don't know for sure who this Charlotte U was but presume she is the same as Charlotte U age 13 on the 1850 census of Franklin Co, NC who was in a two person household the other person being also a Charlotte U age 60. In 1852 the younger Charlotte would have been quite a young bride but still old enough even if barely. One concludes that the younger is dau of the older. One presumes that the older Charlotte is a widow of an Upchurch but I don't know which one.

- 4) Who was Alamine Phillips? Alamine Phillips b 26 JAN 1851 d 14 FEB 1939 (Boy-Franklin Co, NC) wd 23 DEC 1875 Joseph B. Baker. She was dau of William Kearney Phillips & his 1st wife Susan Board, who is son of Elizabeth U, gr of James U & gr of Richard U, III (Head of Class).

Nine days ago I returned from a one week
trip to Colorado to find your letter of 16 SEP 1987.
I have spent every spare moment since that
time extracting the very exciting details you
provided and now have them locked into
place on various outlines and profiles. A
separate profile has been created for each person
mentioned in your packet. Profiles already
existed on several of them.

You and I have a great deal in common.
We are related, both seriously interested in genealogy,
and we both come from ancestors who lived
in the Mexican Creek Area before the Revolution.
There are many hidden bits of information in
the records which ^{are} of great importance to us
and I hope we can continue correspondence
to share details and to uncover more aspects
of our shared heritage.

Provided herewith is a copy of my 3-page
profile on James Bolton with 5 entries. This gives
you an idea of how my files are organized.

Note that James Bolton, your direct ancestor, had land on Maccoson Creek adjoining Uphurndi's land and that he had numerous interactions with them and especially with Nathan Uphurndi, I who was my GGGF. Nathan's brothers included Abel U, Nathan U, Benjamin U, Richard U, III. Their father was Richard U, II. Note entry 30 which mentions Julius Johnson. It is my guess that this person is the father of Mackey Johnson who was Nathan U, I - but no proof and not even good circumstantial evidence. Please let me know if you have insights or questions about either in the James Bolton profile.

You asked about details on William Kearney Phillips (X10-11437), brother of your Presley J. Phillips. A copy of my one sheet profile on X10-11437 is provided herewith. Note in item D that his GM was Susan U. We do not know the father of this Susan U but the dates & place dictate that she was to be a dau of one of the sons of Richard U, II. Do you have a copy of the life history of William Kearney Phillips written by him in his later years. If not I'll send you a copy. I published it in one of the issues of the Uphurndi Bulletin. A good deal of my information on William Kearney Phillips has come from Harold Fritz M'Guffee, Jr and a copy of my profile on Fritz is provided herewith. Included from this are my letters to Fritz which would not be all that helpful to you.

On 3 SEP 1977 I visited the Mowman Creek area and among other visits with Claude E. Board, or "Buddy". Her mother was Theodora Phillips who was a daughter of one of the sons of Presley J. Phillips. Do you know who the father of Theodora was?

From what you send I gather you are writing a history of your family. Can you tell me about the project? when will it be finished? I am anxious to buy a copy if it will be for sale.

Are there any family members you have encountered that help tell the story of those who lived in and around the Mowman Creek Area starting in the 1700's? If so I would be anxious to see copies or they often reveal details which could be of much interest.
