ON 10 OCT 2007 RPH visited the Franklin Co, NC library in Lewisburg, NC and inspected a book with the above title. There was only one Upchurch entry indexed and it is found on pg 226 as follows:

W. C. Upchurch, Adeline C. Upchurch, J. C. L. Harris,
[△]C. L. Harris and [△]I. S. Harris are referenced with a date of 27 DEC 1869

[NOTE. As of 24 NOV 2007 the above notes seem incomplete however I know that on 27 DEC 1869 (Weldon, Halifax Co, NC) Florence Caroline U, d/o William Clinton U, I & [△]Adeline Susan Reyster, and [△]John Columbus Logan Harris Sr. Presume C. L. Harris & I. S. Harris are relatives - possibly parents or siblings of the Grooms. Note that the "C" as a middle initial for Adeline Susan Reyster seems enclosed - RPH

Name, rank, units of service included.
