future. It would be much more

me know how things stand for
the next few months.

children will have grown up and
they won't recognize us at all. Think
a lot about Janet. It is nice
that she is in school. Hope she will
like it. So all time is going to write
her a little note.

Dear Sallaine, Phil and Family:

So glad to get your letter Phil and to know that Sallaine is getting along alright. Sallaine it will take you a while to get over this operation. Just weak for a while I think. Just take it easy and try to have patience which was difficult for Me! Things are something here. The money market and this Watergate is just too much. We have sold our house and I think we will move into the two story colonial by the first of August. Jim is trying his darndest to sell before I can move I guess he thinks we can live in a tent and you know how he hates camping out. Can't even get him to go on a picnic! Oh well it will all work out. We are planning to start two more houses we have to take it easy because of the tight-money market and high interest rates. According to the bankers I know we should have a better picture of the money market by the 1st of August if not it will be six more months before we know very much. Mother is doing so much better with her back since I started her on the vitamins. She robbed the bees and has about 50 qts of Honey. Glad Barry and the girls are enjoying their summer. Hope Salline improves so she can go on some kind of a vacation. Gas is short here too. Most stations are closing on Saturdays and Sundays and early at night. Phil I don't intend that we should put out any money on rebuilding the houses at Mothers. But would like for ^{her} to put back what she can with the money she would get from the houses in case they would burn. You have to realize that Mother has a pretty good income that she can live on and live with. If she would collect the insurance and give to Pat or Chi Chi her favorite people you and I would be forever stuck with giving Mother extra money to live on. I will guarantee you that Pat and Bill would not. The big house is insured for \$18,500.00 and the little one for \$16,500.00 and you had better believe I could get something back that would bring some rent for Mother to live on. (over)

Mother had quite a long discussion with me about this. She said suppose she wanted to take the money instead of building back the houses. I said yes and you would give the money to Pat and Chi Chi and then where would you be...you could not live on your social security and I know they wouldn't be around to help if you wanted or needed more money. She thought about this for a while and decided I was right. Pat is still taking care of that Chi Chi at twenty five years old and she is sitting on her rear end. BB is working taking care of herself and taking some night courses which she is paying for. I hope you understand why I wanted the insurance as it is. Also the insurance had to be in your name, Pats name and my name because you cannot insure property unless it is in your name. This way if I were to die Jim cannot come in claim any of the insurance it will be put back into another building for the estate. It was mainly for the protection of Mother. Because she must have more than the social security to live on. Please tear this letter into bits. I would not like for any of the family to get to read it. Although I sure would not care about Mother reading it because I have told her everything I have written you. If there are anymore questions you would like to ask about this please let me know. Mother has a life time right recorded in the court house which I had done and I may have this recorded. If I am dead and gone I know she will be protected. I would not go to all this trouble for the heck of it.

It is hot as all get out here. I must stop and get to my books I am so far behind and we have an open house tomorrow. When are you all going to get up this way? Janet said she wanted to come to St. Louis next year. Salline is not up to any company when she is so weak from the operation. Glad things are going well with your job. If I move into the 2 story I am going to paint the office and sell it. Will put a field office out at Lake Forest so I won't have to spend so much time on the road between here and there.



Dear Tiny

Both Sallaine & I have signed the agreement regarding the insurance on the houses and I am returning the agreement herewith. I do not understand all of the ramifications as to why this is necessary but I am happy to concur in this arrangement since you and Pat seem to think that it is desirable. As to complications in the future it is always possible that they may occur. For example, should one of the houses be destroyed by fire it is unlikely that the proceeds from the insurance would be adequate to rebuild. At this point I see no advantage in resolving such a problem since it may never occur. However, it should be made clear that the signing of the agreement in no way commits the parties ~~above~~ to finance construction over and above the financial commitment based on funds available from the insurance.

Matters here in St Louis are improving with respect to Sallaine's health. She is doing as well as the doctor expected at this stage of the game. However, she is still quite weak and tires easily. The kids are doing most of the housework. We may have to cancel the trip we had planned for the Pacific Northwest in August because Sallaine

may not be up to the trip and/or because of the gas shortage. We are just delaying the final decision for a while.

The kids seem to be having a good summer. Nelda is getting ~~some~~ good experience at buying groceries and at housekeeping in general. Debby has a tough math course but she is doing well. Barry has a course in tennis and in American Problems. The latter is a discussion course and he really likes that. Barry really broke out into the open on his school work this past year and did better than we expected. Almost every day our kids and the kids next door play tennis. I think a big part of the joy is in driving the car!

My job seems to be progressing satisfactorily but there are certain aspects which should move faster such as getting set up with research groups in Latin America and the Far East. My team in Europe is doing well and I will probably go over for two weeks in October. I participated in taking our new President to our local farm last week. The visit went OK.

It is always good to hear from you. Do come for a visit. Love Phil





Jimmy confided that after the death of Janet (the 1/2 sister) he had passed to him letters which she wrote to her mother [Ernestine Ray U] in Germany saying that she was unhappy and his mother to come get her. Janet was living with my parents at the time but Jimmy thought she was living elsewhere as the return address was not that of my mother - her ^Δ Besie Elvora Cross called "Mammy".

Jimmy says his earliest memories are of Mammy and not of his parents. His first memory of his family being together was in the apartment on Hudson Street in Raleigh, NC. He reports that he was impossible to manage and understands why his parents sent him away to a military academy.

We discussed his memory of his parents and of Pat & Bill Alopauh. Jimmy says Pat was the first to embrace Catholicism and in due course persuaded Ray to join her. Jim converted also led by Ray.

Jimmy recalls being with my parents possibly with his parents being there also. He recalls running away to the BJU home and remembers my Uncle Geter & his who would bring him back home. I suppose mother took care of Jimmy (& Janet?) while Jim & Ray worked.

○ FROM NOTES OF DORIS RUTH U CALL TO RPU 3 JAN 2012

I probed Doris about her memories of my sisters [△] Ernestine Ray U and [△] Patty Jane U. She recalled nothing about their being in high school nor did she recall that they were in training to be nurses after high school. She did recall visiting them at the old place (which I remember also). Doris did volunteer that she knew they married at about age 17 to brothers Bob & Bill [McGeer], she volunteered that Pat had a child born after she married Bill and Doris says she was present when the child died [I had thought it still born - I recall a picture of Pat and the deceased infant taken at the home of BTU]. Doris says the infant was buried at Inwood (I know of no monument or other record of the burial). Doris did not know if the child was given a name. Doris says Frances (Peggy) Wilson contacted the news that Pat had such a child. [I must ask Doris where she was "present" at the death of the child].
