- Jesse Upchurch was born 23 May 1892 in Greenville County, South Carolina, died 10 August 1875 in Henry County, Tennessee, and was there buried in the Hughes Cemetery. He was enumerated as head of household in the 1830-1870 Henry County, Tennessee, census records. Jesse Upchurch served as a juror in August 1845 for the State v. Joseph H. Dillahunty - Bastarday. Jesse was first married to Delana "Dilly" Butts, who was born 29 August 1803 and died 24 February 1866. He was married second 12 June 1869 to Martha Susan Jackson. Jesse and Delana had five known children: Elizabeth Upchurch, Katherine Upchurch, Zenobie Upchurch, Julie Upchurch, and Frances Upchurch.

10/11. Zenobia/Susan - The information that I started with originally was from a family tree drawn in 1961 by Ellie Nance Bowles. Although it provided a great base, I have also found many errors in it. I believe that the listing that showed Zenobia Bradford's parents as Zenobia U. and William Bradford is one of them. There may have been a Zenobia U., but I have not found any record of her or of a William Bradford. However, there is a record of the marriage of Susan U. and James Bradford. In their household in the 1860 census they have a daughter Zenobee B., age 4, which fits with the age of Zenobia Belzora Bradford. I further believe that the Susannah Bradford listed in the Upchurch Cemetery is this Susan as her age in the census records fits with her birth date on the tombstone.

2. Sarah Ann Upchurch m. George W. Jackson - vs. - 8. Elizabeth Upchurch m. John Jackson. The Elizabeth/John family is another one I'm having doubts about. Purportedly their children were named Henry and Jesse. I can find no trace of this family as yet - no marriage record, no census records, no cemetery records. However, the Sarah/George family has sons Henry and Jesse. So don't know if there were really 2 families that similar.

Dear Cousin Jess,

It has been sometime since I have heard from you so I thought I would send you a note. This is prompted by a phone call I made on Sunday to Carreona, TX in search of a 90 year old member of the Richard U. III / Clarence U. Sabalan. There was only one household with the surname Upchurch so I called there and chatted with a very nice Nancy (Scott) U who had read into your part of the family. She gave me a few details which led me to return to my Dekalb Co, TN project - which led me back to my correspondence with you - hence this letter.

As I have researched the TN records for Upchurch many times I have narrowed the area of uncertainty. A focal point here is Dekalb Co, TN where U's were present in the

early 1800². The patriarch of this group was Joseph U who appeared on the 1850 census of DeKalb Co, TN and earlier. I am assuming this was the Joseph U who was in Randolph Co, NC circa 1800 and that he was your ancestor. I have several correspondents ~~who~~, including you, who have supplied a lot of details leading back to DeKalb Co, TN and to Joseph U. I have tried to create a separate profile on each individual mentioned and these details are in my alphabetized profile data bank and can serve to reveal relationships as we keep adding and cross-checking. Several months ago I started a new approach. This involves creating an outline for Joseph U and his descendants. This outline is in the early stages and much needs to be done to flesh it out. It does begin to show the relationships of the various subgroups and highlights those such as yourself who are actively working on the group. I have shared this rough outline with a couple of co-workers already and will be glad to send you a copy if you so desire. Somehow, it is my hope that this outline will provide

a stimulus that will lead us to the father of Joseph U. If we ever get that information the outline will provide us with material to publish in the U B.

The outline is in very crude form at present as I keep adding to it to the point that it has to be reoped so that it will appear more orderly. It takes a lot of time to create such an outline as every entry needs to be cross-referenced with biopiles and this is only one of many Upchurch projects I am working on.

I do appreciate your participation and support and interest over the years and hope, in the final analysis, that we will be rewarded with success in our search for the father of Joseph U.

Have you checked the Bethel Co, TN records in detail? (1800-1890). Our answers could be there?

Dear Jess,

I was delighted to receive your letter of July 26, 1982 which arrived on July 1 just as I was leaving town for a few days. I have now spent about 3 hours on it extracting every detail for my biographer and trying to find linkages. So far I have not found too much but am extremely pleased that you have fixed your ancestor as John W. U. to 1825 (TN) and his father as Ambrose U. ~~U.~~ (possibly Ambrose U. U) to ca 1804 (TN).

I have checked my files in detail to see how an Ambrose U. to 1804 could fit in with known 5th and 6th generations Upchurches. There are only 23 known 5th generation Upchurches and Ambrose U. to 1804 or about certain to be a son or a grandson of one of them. If he is a 6th generation Upchurch we can narrow the field considerably and because of his being a 7th generation Upchurch, find one more bit of information and we could have the answer. It could come from a will or a deed or from knowing more about the Upchurches who lived in nearby areas as TN between 1800 and 1850. When the breakthrough comes it will be great!

Here are some comments

- (1) The more Upchurch records you can get for Warren Co & Wilson Co, TN the better.
- (2) Since the 1870 film for Warren Co TN are poor you may be able to order one on loan from the U.S. Government which could be better.
- (3) I have had in my files for some time the 1850 Warren Co, TN census for Ambrose U & his wife Charity U. My records show Charity as age 38 (not 28 as you show) in 1850. This would mean she would have been 45 in 1860 (rather than 43) ~~if she was indeed 38 in 1850 this could mean that she was the 1st and perhaps only wife of Ambrose U.~~ My Morgan correspondent adds to the 1850 listing for the Ambrose U family the following:
 - a) Martha U age 19 - married in 1852
 - b) Mary U age 17 - married in 1853
 - c) John U age 16 - married in 1857
 - d) Thomas U age 10 - was Thomas Carl U and he served in the Civil War. (ESA)

The civil war records of Thomas Carl U may help if we can get them. Also it is likely that her brother John U (John W. U), James U and Joseph U served in the Civil War as they would have been the right age to serve.
- (4) The name Ambrose was popular in the Upchurch family and I have 6 of them in my files. In due course we may find that some of these help us speculate on a linkage for your Ambrose U b. 1809 (TN). I have tried and so far have not been able to use them as a basis for speculation.
- (5) Here is an extract on one of my 6 Ambrose Upchurches. I can not link this Ambrose U. Maybe you can. I found this in the LDS Genealogical Library in Tucson, AZ on 14 OCT 1977 and can go back for another look if necessary. My

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter of 6 MAY 1982 and of your order for UBRD and 1981 and of your \$20.⁰⁰ check in payment for same. I was delighted to have all of the details you sent and have spent several hours extracting and cross referencing the information provided. So far I have not identified the parents of your ancestor John U b 1840-1850 (TN). With continued searching there is an excellent chance we can find the parents. A search of the 1850 census for the county where McMinnville, TN is located would be a good next step.

The search of my files did reveal a set of Upchurches which appear to arise from your John U b 1840-1850 (TN). By a 28 JUN 81 phone call to Ralph Roland U Sr in Austin, TX I obtained the following from his memory:

3. Joe U - lived in East Texas
4. Jose (or JOSTE) U and — Byghybee

It is also important in stimulating interest and exchanges in the immediate future. We need to place copies of UB in the key National (DAR, Library of Congress) and Regional (Salt Lake City) and State libraries. The cost is \$10/volume if the volumes are unbound or \$20/volume if the volumes are bound. I have bound copies of Volume 1 (1980) and 2 (1981) on hand and will bind Volume 3 as soon as the last 1982 issue appears. If you want to place one or more volumes in one or more libraries, you will be helping a great deal.

I will place a "missing link" item on John U b 1840-1850 (TN) in Upchurch's Bulletin and hope for some response. In the meantime let's keep trying. We can eliminate several clans because we know the descendants so well. It is quite likely that John U b 1840-1850 (TN) is a grandson of one of the 23 Clan Heads.

Warren Co. marriage records show that a John U. married Elizabeth Webb on Feb. 19, 1857. If this is my gggrandfather who I understand was married twice, I am assuming this was his first wife and Lucy, shown on 1880 records, was his second wife.

The 1840 census index did not show any Upchurches in Warren Co. However it did show a A. V. U. living in Wilson Co. which is the second Co. N.W. of Warren Co. I will check the 1840 records for Wilson Co. as soon as time permits, hoping A.V.U. is the Ambrose U. listed in the 1850 Warren Co. records.

J.J. UPCHURCH [JESSIE JACKSON U↑]

The remains of J. J. Upchurch, a native of Lavaca County arrived here on Sunday's West Bound train from Houston and was laid to rest in the Salem Cemetery the same afternoon, a large number of his old friends, neighbors and relatives attended the funeral.

Mr. Upchurch was born 62 years ago in Lavaca Co. in the Salem community and continued to live and farm there about eleven years ago. He lived after then for 8 more years in Goliad, and for the past 3 years in Houston. About 2 years ago he underwent an operation for a cancerous growth on the neck, but the cancer reappeared on his face, and so the end has been long expected. He died in Houston last Friday night.

In the death of Mr. Upchurch, South Texas loses one of its most useful pioneer citizens, one who did more than his share to promote its progress & to establish law & order. In the eighties and nineties he held the office of constable of precinct 4 for several terms and has otherwise been active in the public affairs of his precinct and Lavaca County.

He is survived by his wife, formerly Miss Nannie Castallow, to whom he was married 40 years ago, and by 8 children. They are Mrs. Harvey Farrington of Goliad, Mrs. Field Putney of Houston, Emmett Upchurch of Inex, Lillie Butler who lives in California, Miss Bessie, Willis, Claud, and Fessie Upchurch of Houston and a brother W. A. Upchurch of Salem, and two sisters. Mrs. Lee Hall of Inex, and Mrs. James Lampley of Hope also survive him.

The New Era force has special reason to remember and appreciate Mr. Upchurch as for many years he was the valued Salem correspondent.

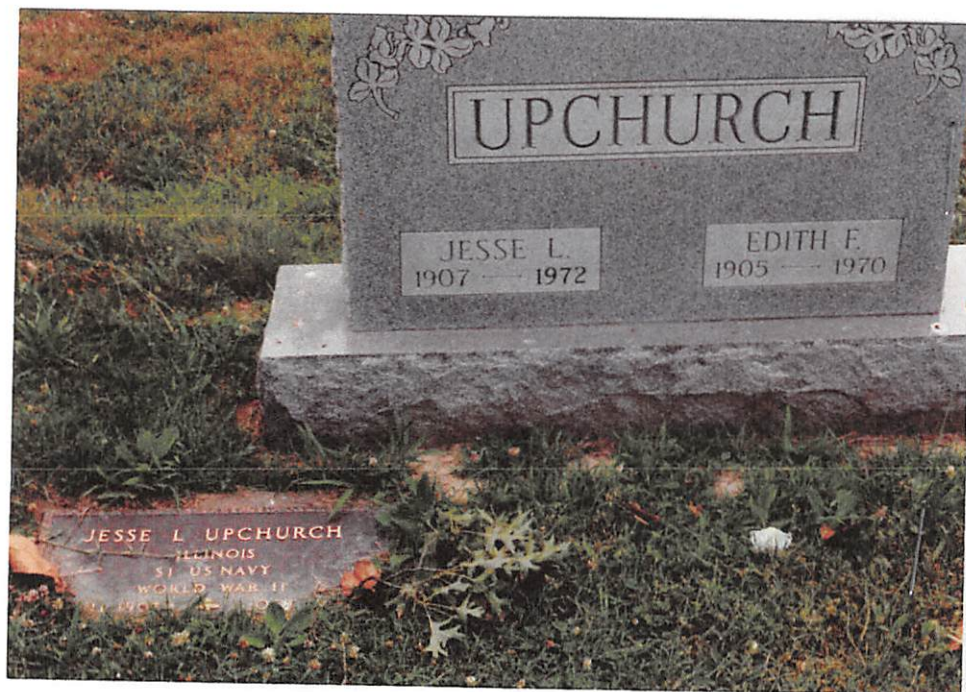

Rising Fortunes

Ailing economy doesn't subtract from assets of state's wealthy



Robert Bass: Shares in family's \$6.3 billion

A soft economy hasn't squeezed the wallets of Texas' richest residents. In fact, they've managed quite well, thank you.

According to *Texas Monthly's* new listing of the 100 wealthiest Texans, a minimum net worth of \$130 million was required to even qualify this year — up \$10 million from 1990's threshold and \$30 million from 1989's bottom line.

"It's true — the rich are getting richer," writes Christine Carroll, the magazine's assistant editor who compiled the ranking. "While most Texans continue to battle the slump, the fortunes of Texas' meg-rich are on the rise."

Only three newcomers made the list — further confirmation that times are good only for those who've already made it, Carroll writes in the magazine's September cover story.

Of the 97 returning members, 46 saw their monetary worth rise, the rankings of 47 remained the same, and four experienced a decline.

The list's newcomers — one of whom bumped Fort Worth resident Jesse Upchurch from the ranking — credit their success to the oil industry and inheritance.

Upchurch is a director of Tandy Corp., owner and operator of Radio Shack stores.

Among those winning a coveted spot on the list, nine call Fort Worth home, including five members of the deal-making Bass family.

Thirty-one come from Dallas and 25 from Houston.

Dallas computer king H. Ross Perot, 61, remained at the top of

the list with a net worth of about \$3 billion. That's roughly unchanged from last year.

Next in ranking is the Bass clan: Perry Richardson Bass, 76; Sid Richardson Bass, 49; Edward Perry Bass, 45; Robert Muse Bass, 43; and Lee Marshall Bass, 35.

Together, Fort Worth's most powerful family share an estimated \$6.3 billion fortune that encompasses real estate, stock holdings and oil and gas. Their holdings are up \$500 million from 1990.

A family friend credits their success to father Perry's early schooling of his boys in business theory, the magazine reports.

"The old man believed you had to bust your tail and get things done," the friend told Carroll. "He

pounded that notion into those kids."

To the benefit of Fort Worth, the Bases have spread their money around. Since the mid-seventies Sid has spent more than \$250 million to revitalize the city's downtown, according to *Texas Monthly*. The Bases also are major contributors to local charities, hospitals and museums.

Richard Rainwater, 47, the financial guru who formerly guided many of the Bases winning investment (More on RICH on next page)

Inconvenience only damage for brothers

For the sons of Fort Worth businessman Jesse L. Upchurch, the earthquake that rocked Central Mexico was little more than an inconvenience.

Matthew Upchurch, 23, and his brother Jesse Jr., 29, were vacationing in Acapulco with friends when the quake struck and their American Airlines return flight to Texas was canceled Thursday.

Both arrived home unharmed at about 8 p.m. Friday, with news that their mother, who is staying in Mexico City, probably is unhurt as well.

The Upchurch sons met acquaintances from Mexico City just before leaving Acapulco and learned that the apartment building where their mother, Connie, was staying was not damaged by the quake.

"That made me feel a lot better," Upchurch said.

Upchurch, who owns a travel and investments company in Fort Worth, said he and his family were

"raised on earthquakes."

"I have watched the chandeliers swing 25 feet in each direction. I have watched water splash out of my pool and over a 10-foot wall," said Upchurch, who has owned a vacation home in Mexico City for 25 years.

Upchurch tried repeatedly to call Central Mexico but said calls within Mexico have compounded communication problems there.

Still, he said, he believes that his many friends there would find a way to contact him if there were a reason to worry.

"I think if it was something serious, they would have gotten word to me somehow. I have so many friends there they would have found a way to contact me, even if it was by private airplane or radio."

Upchurch has plans to join his wife next week in Mexico City. He said he couldn't recall the number of earthquakes the family has witnessed at the Mexico City home.

"It's like me asking you how many showers you've seen in Texas."

I struck up a conversation with the stable boy and finally learned Jesse and his wife, his brother and wife are all on a photo safari in Africa. The stable boy said they sometimes stay several weeks. The boy did tell me Mr. Upchurch was originally from Kentucky and he sometimes buys horses for his polo string there and ships them to his home in Burleson. If I can get next to this gentleman I might strike a bonanza of information. Then again I may get the boot.

'They want to be playing cards or drinking with him'

Wayne's image is preserved

Paintings by the actor's widow set the nostalgic scene for his admirers, including customers of an Arlington restaurant.

ARLINGTON — John Wayne photos spark unusual memories for the late actor's widow. A buckskin-clad Wayne from 1953's *Hondo* makes her think of Lassie.

"There was more than one Lassie, you know," said Pilar Wayne Upchurch, recalling an all-night poker game that included Wayne and the handler of the famous collie. "The Duke won all the Lassies. The next day the man was devastated; that was his livelihood."

Wayne gave the dogs back after a good laugh, she said.

Upchurch, a native of Peru but a longtime Californian, moved to Fort Worth after marrying local businessman and philanthropist Jesse Upchurch in 1998. She is a lifelong artist, who produces paintings of Wayne and his Hollywood cronies, along with landscapes and animals.

Texana Grill, a new restaurant on Interstate 20 near Cooper Street, created a rustic John Wayne Room, furnished with cypress tables, hickory chairs and a wall covered with Wayne photos. The owners purchased an Upchurch print for the room and invited her to the commemoration.

"Even though he's not from Texas, he's a legend here," restaurant owner Gilbert Cuellar said of Wayne. "We'll continue to add to this."

Upchurch marveled at a large picture, laminated on wood, with "The Duke" written in rope across the top. It's the nickname she uses when referring to her late husband.

Not that she talks constantly about Wayne.

Before driving to Arlington yesterday, she relaxed in her 3-story, 11,000-square-foot house in southwest Fort Worth. Jesse Upchurch stood in the back yard, watching their German shepherd, Shako, swim in the pool.

"It's a wonderful thing, to paint," she said. "You get lost and forget everything except mixing your paints and getting the right colors."

The walls are covered with original paintings, some in frames, some painted directly onto the wall. Some feature The Duke, others depict landscapes, animals and her children.

She paints in a small studio on the third floor. Rather than stride the stairs, she rides up in a quiet, wood-paneled elevator — the only bare walls in the house.

"I have no walls left," she said, speaking in a gentle voice with a slight Spanish accent. "I guess I could put a few in the elevator."

The studio, next to a window overlooking a golf course, is cluttered with easels and canvases, although her paint tubes are carefully organized on a table.

She has painted most of her life, but never as prodigiously as she has since Wayne died, in 1979.

"When he was living we were like gypsies, moving from location to location," she said. "The kids were little. It was difficult to find time to paint."

She has stuck with realism but is considering an exploration of expressionism. Still, it's her paintings of Wayne that attract the commissions. Movie fans pay her to paint them in scenes with the actor.

"They love John Wayne, and they want to be playing cards with him or drinking with him," she said.

Pilar Palette was 18 and acting in a movie being shot on location on the Amazon River when she met Wayne, who was traveling in the area. The director arranged a dinner party in the actor's honor, and he was seated beside a nervous Palette. She was unfamiliar with his work but thought he was "incredibly handsome."

Wanting to impress him, she complimented his work in *For Whom the Bell Tolls*.

"I think you've got me mixed up with my friend Gary Cooper," Wayne drawled.

Later, she flew from Peru to a Los Angeles studio to dub the movie.

"I was walking out a door and he was walking in," she said. "He said, 'I remember you. How about having dinner tonight?' I thought, 'Whoa, this guy moves fast.'"

They went to dinner and fell in love.

They married in 1954 and had three children, Ethan, Aissa and Marisa Wayne.

Wayne's movie career began as an extra in silent films and lasted nearly five decades. He won a best actor Oscar for *True Grit* in 1970.

The couple's house was often filled with friends, including Lee Marvin, Ward Bond, Richard Boone and director John Ford.

Upchurch remembers them as a charismatic, fun-loving bunch.

Except for one.

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Tandy stockholder resigns after criticizing CEO

FORT WORTH, Texas - The largest individual holder of Tandy Corp. stock has resigned from the company's board after he was told he would not be renominated because of his criticism of Chief Executive John Roach.

Jesse Upchurch, whose Tandy stock is worth more than \$64 million, served on the annually elected board for 28 years. He controls 1.53 million Tandy shares, or about 2.44% of the total shares outstanding, according to the most recent proxy statement.

Tandy is the parent company to the Incredible Universe and Computer City store chains. The company announced last month that it will shed its Incredible Universe chain and take a \$170 million charge to cover that and the closing of 19 Computer City stores. Tandy is expected to report an annual loss for the first time in decades.

Board members are typically renominated, unless they choose to resign. But Upchurch said the head of the nominating committee told him that he would not be on the next slate because of "an ongoing impasse with the board" over Roach's performance.

Upchurch resigned Wednesday and said he had not decided whether to sell his holdings or join with other shareholders who have called for Roach to step down.

"I don't have a personal vendetta against John Roach," Upchurch told the *Fort Worth Star-Telegram*. "But he's had 15 years to get something done. Things just seem to be going from one bad situation to another."

In a statement, Tandy defended Roach's performance, saying the company had made more money than any other electronics retailer during his tenure.

Upchurch's criticism is the latest by a major Tandy shareholder. Two institutional investors have recently complained about the company's stock price and suggested

It was tough finding someone to fill The Duke's shoes, but after 19 years John Wayne's widow Pilar finally remarried last week during an ocean liner cruise.

On November 18, 62-year-old Pilar and Texas mogul Jesse Upchurch, 73, boarded an ocean liner in Ft. Lauderdale, Fla., and during a 30-minute ceremony in the ship's observation lounge, they were married, surrounded by 24 of their family and 20 close friends.

Pilar told The ENQUIRER: "Jesse has made me feel like a young, cherished bride again. He bought me a fabulous home in Fort Worth and we have the ranch to go to where he

lets his Texas heritage come out and play.

"Whenever I look at Jesse, my heart just goes

flip-flop. That's true love."

Pilar was dressed in a full-length white wedding gown with a glittering tiara hold-

ing back her hair in Spanish style.

"Pilar's son Ethan gave away the bride to Upchurch, a Texas tycoon, aboard the 439-foot cruise ship Seabourne Legend," said an insider.

Jesse paid \$2,000 per person — \$92,000 total — for the wedding voyage which left from Ft. Lauderdale, stopped in Nassau and Key West and returned to Ft. Lauderdale on November 21.

Pilar met Jesse on a blind date arranged by Sandy Rhineberger, her business associate and close friend, during a whirlwind weekend in October 1996.

"I knew there were few men in the world who could fill The Duke's shoes," Sandy said. "I also knew that Jesse Upchurch, a strong, quiet Texan, was such a man."

Will Alliances Fix What's Ailing RadioShack?

If you're shopping for the latest in diodes, RadioShack may be the place to go. But when it comes to computers or other electronics, Circuit City and Best Buy seem to have what consumers want.

That's not the way the RadioShack story was supposed to go. RadioShack, with its small, intimate format, minted the idea of retailing computers.

The \$3.3 billion-in-sales unit of Tandy Corp. built a vast network, selling Tandy PCs, consumer electronics and parts and accessories.

But it was outflanked through the '80s electronics boom. Growth stalled as superstores and mail-order firms moved in on its turf. Tandy's market share slid—and so did profits.

Even now, Tandy is grappling for a response.

Management waited until 1995 to play up its strengths as a service provider and revamp cluttered stores. As a result, CEO John Roach, who's run the company since 1982, is under fire. Just recently, a long-time director and big shareholder quit over differences with Roach.

Roach, for his part, says Tandy will take aim at the next high-tech revolution—personal communication services.

"Our goal is to clearly position ourselves as America's one-stop telephone store," he told *IBD*.

Roach says an alliance with Sprint will jump-start growth in 1997. RadioShack will build co-branded units in each store that offer the full line of Sprint products and services, including personal communications and Internet access. It will be the exclusive retailer of

Sprint residential phones.

All 5,000 of Tandy's company-owned stores will be changed to this format by the fall, says Roach.

The new concept tries to build on RadioShack's positioning in parts and accessories, says Roach. It could also enhance and broaden the chain's position in services, especially with women, who, Roach says, are big buyers of phone products.

This isn't the first time Roach has had a plan.

In the last two years, he has repositioned RadioShack to focus on giving computer and electronic help to less technical shoppers. And that helped boost sales. Also, Roach has cut computer sales—to about 12% of the total from 38% in the late 1980s.

Now, it's clearly positioned as a service provider, says Roach.

But for all the new formats and costly ideas, Roach has yet to come up with a plan that will furnish steady profit growth.

Earnings have been erratic for years. Tandy's net has fallen three quarters in a row. It's expected to earn 92 cents in the fourth quarter, down from \$1.39 a year earlier. For all of 1996, earnings, including special charges, slid by 31%, to about \$2.16 a share in 1996, analysts estimate.

Management had been more reactive than proactive, says analyst Eric Boyce of First Dallas Securities Inc. With a concept like RadioShack, they felt they were "indicators" of change rather than

"participants," he says.

And even as Roach branched out with larger stores and more diverse merchandise, his efforts lacked focus, suffered from poor marketing and fell short in execution, critics add.

In 1991, Roach launched Computer City superstores, which he's since had to shrink and revamp. A year later came the Incredible Universe electronics and appliance superstores. Last month, Roach shuttered that business.

Incredible Universe tried to cover too much ground, say experts, offered too little service, and its sites were too far-flung.

Roach is closing 19 Computer City stores. And he's recasting the ailing chain to serve experienced users.

Tandy took about a \$170 million after-tax charge in 1996's fourth quarter to cover the closings and related changes. That's on top of a \$20 million charge in the period to close another loser—its McDuff stores.

That's one reason Jesse Upchurch, Tandy's largest individual shareholder, bolted the board last month. He wants Roach to invest company funds in RadioShack rather than new concepts.

Roach may be finally coming around. Tandy's strategy is "anchored" by RadioShack, he says, adding that the repositioning has worked well.

It's the No. 1 retailer of cellular phones and services, and it sells about twice the number of direct-to-home satellite subscriptions than other retailers.

Roach looks to more strategic alliances with industry leaders to fuel growth. RadioShack is already the top retailer of IBM's Aptiva desktop PCs. Aptiva is RadioShack's exclusive PC offering, and is serviced at its repair shops.

A TUSSLE AT TANDY

Family heirs square off against chief executive at Fort Worth retail empire

FORT WORTH — The spirit of cigar-chomping master salesman Charles Tandy looms large these days over the vast retailing empire left behind at his death nearly two decades ago.

The man he groomed to take charge of the multibillion-dollar Tandy Corp. — computer whiz John V. Roach — for years has been fending off complaints about mediocre profits and a sluggish stock price. Each time he has pointed to his long-term record, claimed strong Tandy board support and soldiered on.

But now that routine has been shattered, and this city where the legendary Mr. Tandy got his start is witnessing a rare squabble involving two of its more prominent names — each claiming to be the true defender of Mr. Tandy's business legacy.

On one side stands 58-year-old Mr. Roach, bootstrap businessman, civic leader and undisputed Charles Tandy protégé. On the other, two Tandy in-laws: 72-year-old Jesse Upchurch, the company's largest individual shareholder and patriarch of a well-known Fort Worth family, and his 34-year-old son, Matthew, a local business owner.

"The worst thing [directors] could have done was to give the company to John Roach," says Matthew Upchurch, a longtime critic. The senior Mr. Upchurch declined an interview, but last month he broke decades of silence, publicly siding with his son and quitting the board.

On the way out, he fired a broadside at Mr. Roach, alleging years of lackluster performance.

Replying would only give his detractors credibility, Mr. Roach says — though he does contend the younger Mr. Upchurch "has a great ability to use selected information that may not even be fact."

Instead, the silver-haired executive repeats the Tandy mantra he tries to live by: "Work hard, stay focused, build for the future, stay closely involved."

On the face of it, this is like many corporate spat: a famous entrepreneur's heirs question whether the professional management running things is keeping the stock value high enough. The argument is framed by talk of growth curves and profit margins, price-earnings ratios and capital appreciation rates.

And there's plenty of that to argue about at Tandy. While it has grown into a \$6.3 billion giant from \$1.7 billion in sales when Mr. Roach took over, the stock price is down 3.2 percent over 10 years, based on monthly closes. In the same span, the overall stock market has soared 187 percent, as measured by the Standard & Poor's 500 index.

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Several new ventures have failed; right now Tandy is closing its Incredible Universe consumer electronics stores, which didn't draw enough business to justify their massive sites. Such reversals have cost as much as \$760 million during Mr. Roach's tenure, the Upchurches say.

Indeed, as in Mr. Tandy's day, the company's mainstay is still its famous Radio Shack chain.

But on another level, the fight at Tandy Corp. is about much more than stock values and bad business bets. It's a feud based on deep divisions over just who the true followers of the legendary Mr. Tandy are.

All in the family

"Charles Tandy ..." says stepgrandson Matthew Upchurch, halting in midsentence. "He and my father were my mentors. I started working for Radio Shack at 13," selling batteries, antennas and other electronic gear. Mr. Tandy's personal accountant paid him, Matthew says, because he couldn't legally be on the payroll.

Then, it was Saturday-morning visits to Mr. Tandy's Fort Worth home, where executives met to talk shop. "You could cut the cigar smoke with a knife," he recalls.

Eighty-five percent of the Upchurch fortune is tied up in Tandy Corp. today, Matthew says. So he insists the issue isn't personalities. But then, referring to a well-chronicled 1950s financial rescue of the company by Mr. Tandy's wife and the elder Upchurches, he adds: "My family helped bail out Charles Tandy. My family. Then some guy came in. ..."

Mr. Roach is less animated but no less passionate. He avoids discussing Matthew Upchurch, who he says is not "looking at reality." But there's little doubt the young heir is a burr under his saddle.

Mr. Roach is openly proud of nearly quadrupling the company's sales since taking charge. In some ways, he says, that's been tougher than any job his lionized old boss faced. Growth isn't easy when there's already a Radio Shack in every neighborhood in the country.

And even Mr. Tandy had mixed success entering new businesses, often alienating Wall Street, he says.

"I have been told many times by many people that Charles would have been challenged to deal with a company of this size, in the environment we have to operate in today," Mr. Roach says.

Mr. Roach becomes visibly emotional at times speaking of Mr. Tandy. Asked in an interview if his old boss and mentor considered him the son he never had, Mr. Roach hesitates. All employees were Mr. Tandy's family, he says. Then he stops and summons up a difficult memory: When Mr. Tandy died, he says, "I can remember my daughter feeling like we'd lost part of the family."

So far, the dispute hasn't turned into corporate warfare. No proxy fights, no boardroom coups. No noisy firings or late-night changes of executive suite locks. Not even any lawsuits — yet.

But strong feelings are typical when a larger-than-life founder leaves his stock to the flock and the helm to an outside manager, says Jim Hutcheson, a Dallas family-business consultant.

"Conflict is very common between family members and professional managers, [especially] if the family is in some way overseeing the management," such as holding board seats, he says.

Mr. Hutcheson says both sides in such conflicts may have a point. The younger Mr. Upchurch, he says, may want to stay in close touch with the company because he is "staking out the rest of his life — managing the family investments and wealth."

Mr. Roach, meanwhile, isn't part of the family but "may feel he's as close or closer to Charles Tandy than these people. What is family?" Mr. Hutcheson asks.

Such emotions are ignored at both sides' peril, he says. Unhappy holders of even a minority stake can cause major problems for a nonfamily CEO, he says. On the other hand, a nonfamily boss can be an advantage in a difficult business environment: "Blood is thicker than water; but in a fire, water is better."

The founder's story

The charismatic Charles Tandy died in 1978 at age 60, leaving no direct heirs. He had married twice to wealthy widows with children from prior marriages but had none of his own.

He had been such a dominant executive — even routine decisions came from his office — that some people wondered if the business could survive. For three years, it was shepherded by a childhood friend, Phil North. But in 1980, Mr. Roach became president and the following year, chief executive.

About \$28.4 million of Mr. Tandy's fortune, almost all of it Tandy stock, went to his second wife, Anne. She placed the shares into a foundation that later sold them and reinvested the funds.

The estate also included \$13.2 million in trust for Mr. Tandy's "grandchildren." Since he had no direct grandchildren, the proceeds were eventually divided among his two wives' grandchildren, including the then-16-year-old Matthew Upchurch.

The shares bestowed on young Matthew were icing on the family cake. His parents already owned a large block previously acquired by helping Mr. Tandy weather a crucial business crisis.

Charles Tandy had inherited a leather business founded in 1919 from his father, Dave. The modest company supplied materials to shoe-repair shops, but Charles Tandy had bigger dreams.

He wanted a national company listed on the New York Stock Exchange. So in 1955, he engineered a complex sale of Tandy Leather Co. to a firm called American Hide & Leather Co. in a way he thought would give him and his management team control. Instead, the American Hide people outmaneuvered him.

When he called for help, his wife, Gwendolyn, and her daughter and son-in-law, Connie and Jesse Upchurch, opened their checkbooks.

With their money, Mr. Tandy retained control and never looked back. He later acquired and built a host of businesses, from Pier 1 Imports and Wolfe Nursery to Color Tile, Tandy Brands, Tandycrafts and InterTan. In 1963, he bought a nine-store electronics retailer in Boston called Radio Shack.

Eight years later, Mr. Tandy had expanded the chain to 1,000 stores.

Meanwhile, the Upchurches watched their investment grow. Because of the bailout, the largest individual shareholder in Tandy today is Jesse Upchurch, Matthew's

father. Jesse Upchurch joined the Tandy board in 1968 and was the longest-serving member until he quit last month. His 1.5 million shares, worth about \$75 million, equal 2.4 percent of the company.

The Upchurch clan

The Upchurch name is celebrated in Fort Worth, where the clan every year holds a polo match at its Brushy Creek ranch to benefit the Fort Worth Symphony Orchestra.

But despite such cachet, Matthew Upchurch, as a corporate critic, is roundly discounted at Tandy for, among other things, being a college dropout. And he admits he didn't take his days at Texas Christian University seriously. "I wanted to get into the workforce. [Microsoft chairman] Bill Gates doesn't have [a college degree] either," he says.

His father's well-publicized resignation has helped enhance his credibility. Now, he says confidently, he speaks for his family.

"We've been flooded with calls — probably 30 or 40," ranging from a former banker of Charles Tandy to "some of the absolute largest institutional investors in Tandy," he says.

He finally stopped taking calls from investors and consulted a securities lawyer, he says, because he doesn't want to run afoul of federal regulations controlling shareholder communications.

"I always had such great pride in the company," he recalls, explaining his crusade. At prep school in California, wealthy friends kidded him about his Realistic stereo equipment, the Radio Shack house brand. They had fancier gear. "I used to say, 'Say what you want about the equipment. Look at the stock.'"

But these days he wonders. "I've missed out on the greatest bull market of all time," he says.

Although Matthew Upchurch has enough money that he doesn't need to work, he has established his own business credentials. From a downtown perch that offers a direct view of John Roach's corner office at the Tandy Center, he is managing principal of API Travel Consultants. Last month, *Tour & Travel News* listed him among its 25 most influential executives.

Mr. Upchurch insists Tandy has ignored some of his best advice. He says that in 1990 he told Mr. Roach the company faced an identity crisis on Wall Street. Tandy was then manufacturing personal computers, and investors didn't know if Tandy was a PC company or a retailer, Mr. Upchurch says.

He urged a spinoff of the manufacturing businesses but says the idea was dismissed. Later, Tandy did sell its computer-making operation to focus on retail.

Jesse Upchurch only recently converted to his son's side. "I have been arguing with my father for seven years," trying unsuccessfully to get him to resign, says Matthew. The elder Mr. Upchurch changed his mind after being told he wouldn't be renominated because he couldn't control his son, Matthew says.

On leaving, Jesse Upchurch issued a news release saying there "is an ongoing impasse with the board" over Mr. Roach's performance.

Mr. Roach paints a different picture. Jesse Upchurch "was portrayed in his own press release as an active dissident on the board," says the Tandy CEO. "Quite frankly, anyone who has been a part of our board meetings would have a hard time confirming that."

Still, Mr. Roach has felt some public scrutiny since late December, when he announced Tandy would shut down its Incredible Universe chain and some unsuccessful Computer City stores. He had launched both as growth vehicles to complement Radio Shack. Instead, they drained profits.

When asked, some other Tandy relatives who remain shareholders also fret about the company's recent showing. "You look at the performance of the stock, and certain questions have to be asked at some point," says Sherwood Johnston III of Phoenix, also a grandson of Gwendolyn Tandy. "When do you make a change in leadership? I don't know that today is the day. But if something doesn't happen for shareholders, I think you have to look there for alternatives."

A.R. Tandy of Tulsa, Okla., says he feels "the company has failed to progress" since the death of his uncle, Charles Tandy. "I'm not saying I could do any better. But I'm not paid to do better. Those guys are."

The chief executive

John Roach was at the side of Charles Tandy helping him out even before he was on the payroll.

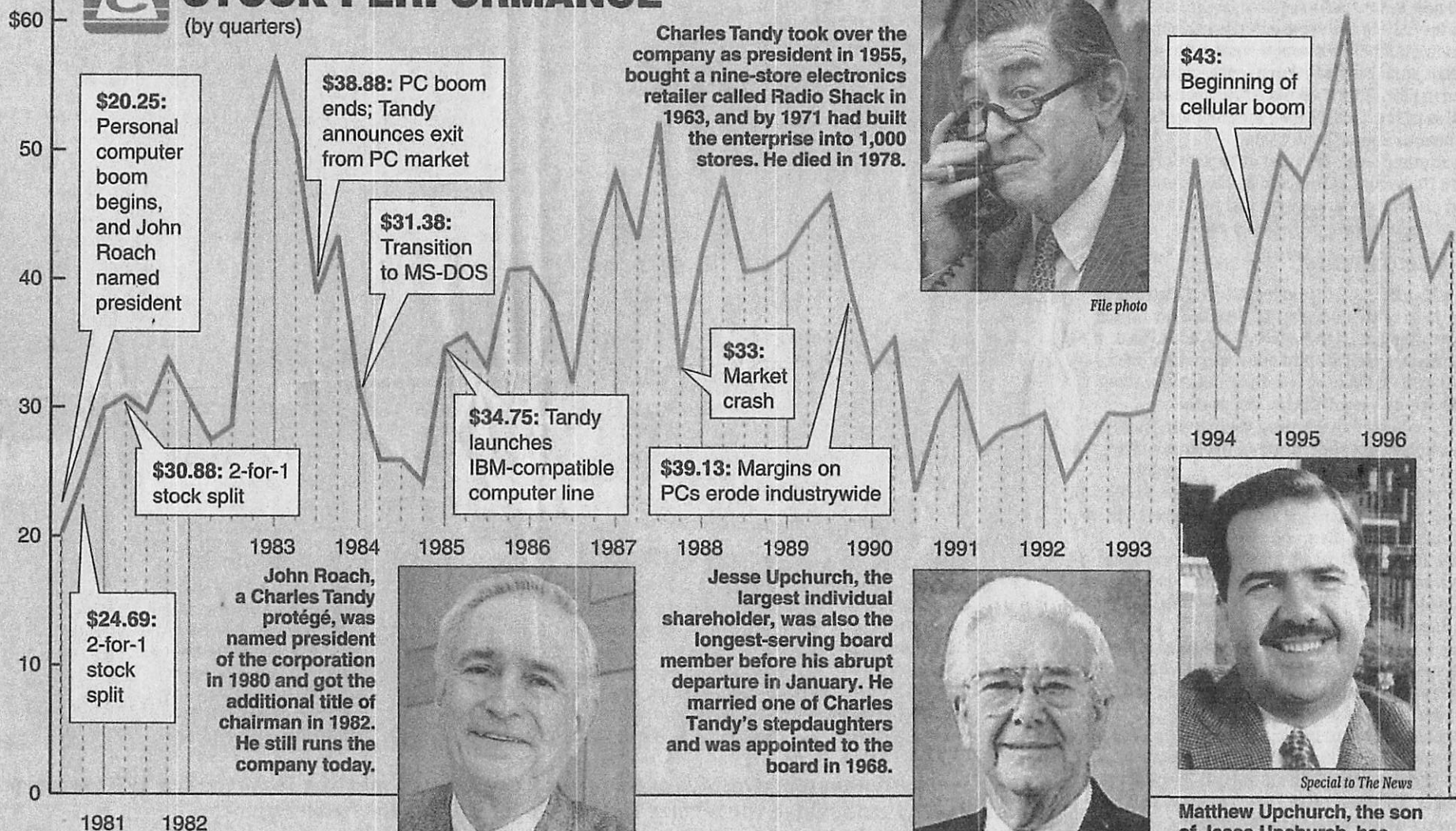
It was May 1967. Mr. Roach, a TCU graduate, was attending a dinner party with Mr. Tandy and others, interviewing for a job, when the phone rang. Fire had broken out at the Tandy Mart retail center, and the guests, — including the young Mr. Roach — piled into Mr. Tandy's Cadillac and raced to the scene. Later Mr. Tandy and Mr. Roach together sorted through the ruins.

Mr. Tandy "thought John [Roach] was a rising young star," says John McDaniel, a retired Tandy official who worked for both men.

(by quarters)

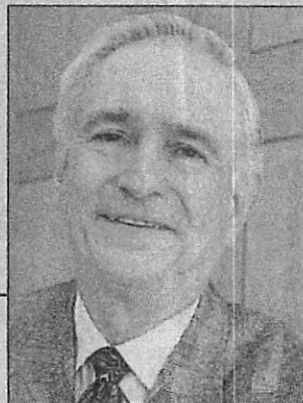

John Roach, a Charles Tandy protégé, was named president of the corporation in 1980 and got the additional title of chairman in 1982. He still runs the company today.

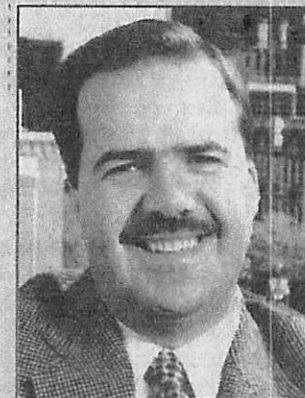

All this isn't to say the relationship between the two was always peaceful. Mr. Tandy was known for constantly upbraiding his senior executives, and Mr. Roach says he got his share of tongue-lashings.

Mr. Roach also contrasts Mr. Tandy's style with his own, saying he allows his senior managers more latitude to lead their troops. But like Mr. Tandy, he is known for being hands-on with details.

"I like to be knowledgeable about what's going on," Mr. Roach says. "I like to make suggestions. Not orders, but suggestions."

As for whether he has Mr. Tandy's force of personality, Mr. Roach concedes he falls short. "Few people I've met in life would have the charisma of Charles Tandy," he says.

"Charles Tandy was an almost larger-than-life character. Very quick. He was a good trainer."

Many of those who attack him don't know enough about the electronics business, which is regularly subject to boom-and-bust cycles, Mr. Roach says. There's more to running a multibillion-dollar corporation than "bragging rights" about investment returns, he says. "Everybody would like to think that their stock hit a new high every day forever. But Newton's laws just don't let that happen."

In the wake of the company's recent setbacks, Mr. Roach has devised some newer — though less grandiose — strategies. Tandy has been repurchasing stock. At Radio Shack he plans to emphasize communications devices, such as wireless telephones and minisatellite dishes. Computer City is shifting gears to cater to small businesses and home offices.

Also, Tandy's future appears more promising now simply because the drag caused by Incredible Universe will disappear, analysts say.

Still, some are skeptical, especially when it comes to reviving Computer City. "Mr. Roach doesn't have the right vision," says Seymour Merrin, president of Merrin Information Services Inc., a Palo Alto, Calif., research and consulting firm. "Once you're in a negative spiral, you've got to break it or you're dead."

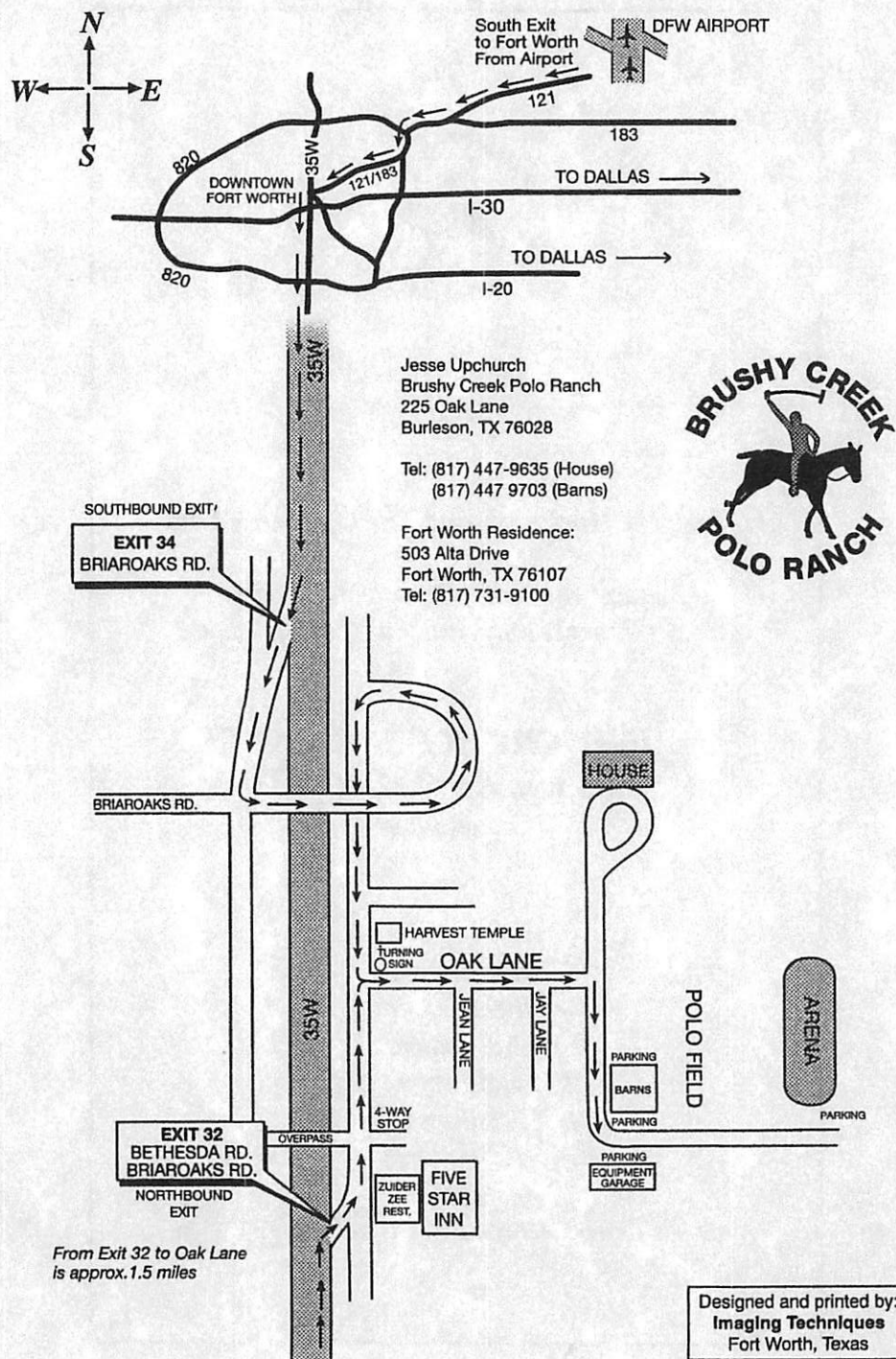
There's no visible movement among directors or institutional investors to remove Mr. Roach. Institutions usually don't get involved in ousting CEOs, analysts say. Those that are unhappy usually just sell their shares and move on.

Critics have long accused the Tandy board of being too friendly to Mr. Roach — a suggestion that clearly irritates him. The board takes its role seriously and includes members with whom he doesn't socialize, he says.

Matthew Upchurch says he's in a holding pattern: "Institutions as well as ourselves are not happy. . . . We know many are unhappy and plan to communicate their displeasure to the board."

Mr. Roach flatly rejects any idea of stepping down.

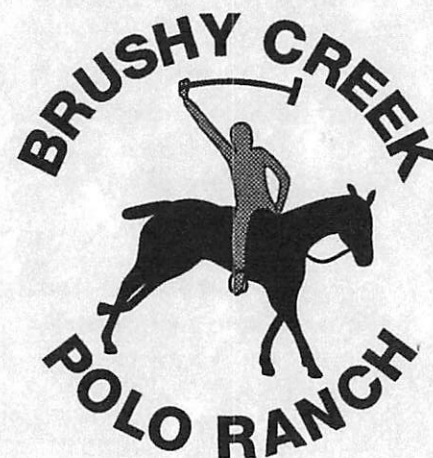
"My job, under the guidance of the board, is to run the company. Clearly, we've got a strong strategic plan," he says. "I will continue to provide the leadership within those guidelines to the best extent possible."

This Jesse Tyre Upchurch in his store on Hwy 81 where Upchurch Road starts. Your Papa Jinks can tell you about the store. He built it in the early 1940's. The store close about 1970. He sold can goods, fresh veggie from his garden, home-made B B Que, and had a single old fashion gas pump. Granny, Minda, would cook pies for Sunday dinner and Granddaddy Jesse would sell them in the store before they could be serve at dinner. If the grandkids got any candy in the store, they would have to pay for it. He did not give anything away.

Many Sundays when his children [uncle Lamar or Aunt Ruth, aunt Mary McCart or us] come home for lunch [Dinner], Granny [Minda] would cook fried chicken. Granddaddy Jesse, would sell the good white pieces in the store before the company could seat down to dinner.

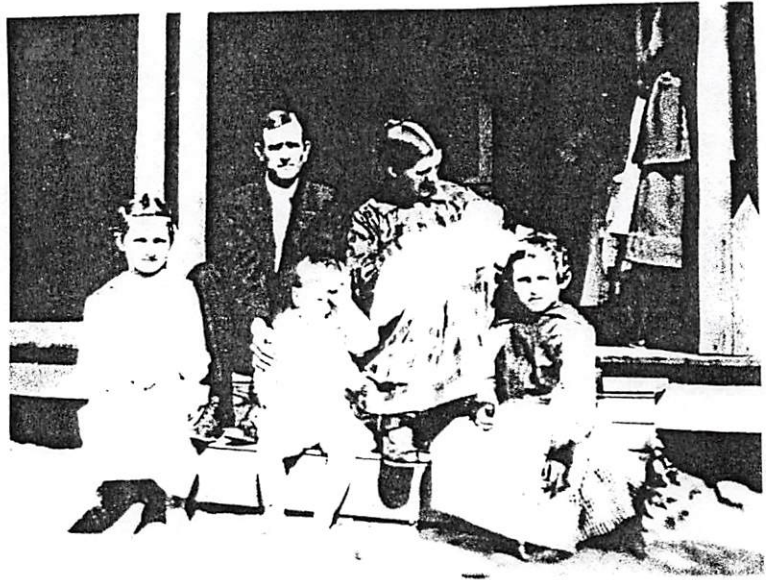

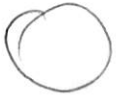
