Family burial grounds preserved beside fairways

Graves dating back to 1810

Local golfers spending a few hours on the Carolina Trace course are likely to get a short course on some of the pre-history of Lee County as they play the back nine holes.

On hole number 14, golfers might look over the old Gilmore family cemetery, begun around 1901, and on holes 12 and 14, golfers might see two family cemeteries begun before Lee County was founded, the Hawley cemetery and the Gaster cemetery.

The oldest of these three cemeteries on the back nine is the Gaster cemetery, and if a golfer gets off a good drive from the tee of number 14, he might land his ball smack dab in the middle of the old site of the Dave Gaster home.

The home isn't there anymore, having burned down in 1922, but it had remained when Carolina Trace was being developed, it might still be there.

Over in the Laurel Thicket area of Carolina Trace, the road makes a complete circle at an intersection, and in the middle of the intersection is the graves of Fran and Doc Wicker, and some of their kin.

"When they laid out the road the Wicker cemetery was smack in the middle of the intersection, so they just made a circle around it," said Trace maintenance Supervisor Melvin Upchurch. The remains of the old Wicker log cabin is nearby, and in addition to the cemetery already named, the Trace property has some other historical significance.

The golf cart rack on hole number 16 is laid out in the same path that the British General Lord Cornwallis, marched down with his army in a raid through this area during the Revolutionary War, according to Lee County historian Marvin Gaster. Gaster is a direct descendant of the Gasters in the cemetery at hole 16, and he has thoroughly researched the lives of those buried there.

According to Gaster's research, the Trace property was originally owned by Henry Gaster Sr. who settled across NC-78 from the present Trace property, near the mouth of Gaster's Creek, which was probably named for him. Henry came into this region in 1754 or 1755, and would have been among the first settlers in the area, Gaster said.

Here Gaster prospered, owning 1,604 acres of land and, according to the 1790 census, at least 14 slaves. One of his sons, Jacob, was captured by the British when he was 16 at the original home site and spent several months on a British prison ship. He survived the ordeal to return to this area and served as a captain in the local militia, which of course eventually

beat the British. Jacob was the father of David, who built the house in the middle of the present 18th fairway.

According to the best records Gaster could turn up, the first burial at the Gaster cemetery was Frances "Fannie" Gaster, who died shortly after childbirth in 1853, at the age of 22.

The Hawley cemetery, over near hole number 12, was begun about the same period. The first burial there was John A. Hawley, and part of this cemetery was destroyed in the 1920's, Gaster said.

A local man who has since moved away plowed up part of the Hawley cemetery, and used some of the grave markers as a door stop for his smokehouse, Gaster said.

The Wicker cemetery over in the Laurel Thicket area of Trace, is dated to about the same period, and is notable by the government marker of Will Wicker, a Confederate war veteran. At the time of his death, Will Wicker was under indictment for his Ku Klux Klan activities, Gaster said. Apparently the Klan activities were strong in this area, as Gaster said six hooded Klansmen attended the funeral of Dave Gaster in 1912, conducting a special burial ceremony on horseback.

Another cemetery on Trace property is located across from the NC 47 entrance, and is popularly known as the Walker cemetery, Gaster said.

The first to be buried there was John Morris, who lived from 1768 to 1850, Gaster said. He was the father of the Morris who founded the Morris Chapel Church on nearby Comhill Road, Gaster said.

While none of the cemeteries was damaged by the development of the Trace property, some have suffered damage since from careless visitors, Gaster said.

He said the last time he visited the Gaster cemetery, he was shocked to find the grave stones of his great-great-grandfather, John M. Gaster, had been broken into three pieces.

"People just don't realize the historical significance of these old cemeteries," Gaster said.

In his research of old family burial grounds in Lee County by The Sanford Herald, this records a visit to the old Edwards, Stone and McNeill burial place of people of those names, dating from 1810 to 1914, by W. E. Horner Sr. who was directed to the place by Tan Walker whose family owns nearby property.

This burial place has nine graves marked with tombstones, many of which are fallen or leaning, plus 10 or more graves, without stones, marked by head and footstones. It is located on

property formerly owned by the Spencer W. Edwards family. Edwards is said to have owned a wide scope of land before and after the Civil War, off present NC 78 highway south, somewhat north of the C. H. (Frank) Wicker and Polly Walker lands.

The cemetery is to the north side of an old wagon road (circa 1925) which led to an old grist mill on Big Juniper Creek said to have been operated by L. L. Stone, an ancestor of Fred Stone, Rt. 11 Sanford, whose ancestors are buried in the Edwards cemetery. This land in 1976 is owned by Chatham Lumber company. Another nearby grist mill on Big Juniper creek, on land owned by Dr. Cade Covington, Fred Stone said was operated by a man whose name he thought was Thigpen. In the Civil War era and up to the late 1800s, small grist mills were situated on nearly every creek and river of any consequence, serving nearby farmers.

From information pieced together from old residents and property owners in the area, a portion of the original Edwards land passed eventually to N. B. (Bright) McNeill, who had a two-story house in the vicinity of a tremendous forked oak, measuring in 1976, 14 feet, six inches in circumference, 30 feet in height.

Family cemetery is a half mile from the old Bright residence. Tombstones existent in 1976, show burials:

Benjamin F. Edwards, son of Spencer W. and A. E. Edwards, born June 13, 1859, died Feb. 10, 1894.

Spencer W. Edwards, born March 10, 1810, died June 1, 1883.

Annie E. Parrish, wife of S. W. Edwards, born Sept. 1, 1830, died Nov. 6, 1913.

Daughter of J. M. and N. C. Stone, born June 2, 1868, died Dec. 15, 1878.

Nancy C. Edwards, wife of J. M. Stone (1842 date with birth and death dates illegible).

Annie L., daughter of L. L. and E. L. Stone, born Dec. 23, 1906, died June 16, 1908.

Jeannette Edwards, born Dec. 12, 1819, died Aug. 9, 1886.

Mattie L., daughter of N. B. (Bright) and N. E. McNeill, born Aug. 11, 1906; died Aug. 21, 1906.

Maggie A. McNeill, daughter of N. B. and N. E. McNeill, born June 6, 1909, died Oct. 31, 1914.

(If Mr. and Mrs. N. B. (Bright) McNeill are buried in this plot, no tombstones exist).

There are at least six old family burying grounds on property owned by the Carolina Trace Golf and Country Club which, with 2,000 acres, covers an area equal to or greater than that of the present city limits of Sanford, according to officials of the Carolina Trace firm.

Adjacent to the present golf course are the Gilmore, Hawley and Gaster cemeteries. The Dock Wicker cemetery is near a second golf course under construction. On the Cox Mill Road is another cemetery, and elsewhere there is a burying ground said to have been for the Buie family slaves.

Carolina Trace management has been careful to preserve all known family cemeteries; burials may still be made in them, but there have been none recently. The Trace Women's Club occasionally clears the burial grounds of undergrowth.

This piece lists people known to have been buried in the Gilmore, Hawley and Wicker plots. Historian Marvin Gaster is compiling a list of burials in the Gaster cemetery, to be published soon.

The old Gilmore family cemetery, for historical purposes, is located beside the green of hole number 10 on the Carolina Trace golf course. Within its rustic rail fence are eight marked graves and two unmarked graves.

The earliest birthdate on the gravestones is that of Elizabeth Gilmore, the wife of J. H. Gilmore. She was born on the first day of 1839, Jan. 1, and died on Aug. 8, 1921.

Beside the grave of Elizabeth is the next oldest birthdate — that of Mary Jane Gilmore, who was also born on the first day of the year 22 years later: Jan. 1, 1861, on the eve of the Civil War. She died on Sept. 23, 1941, in the early days of WW II.

On the other side of Elizabeth, lies Sara C. Gilmore, who was born Nov. 6, 1868, and lived until April 27, 1932. Her life stretched from the hard times of reconstruction

following the Civil War, to the hard times of the Great Depression, rampant in 1932. John B. Gilmore has the next earliest birthdate in the cemetery; born Sept. 21, 1881, died on Nov. 14, 1960.

Annie K. Gilmore, the wife of J. B. Gilmore, was born Oct. 16, 1883 and died on June 27, 1917.

William Jasper Gilmore is next with a birthdate of March 23, 1887, death on June 12, 1961.

The most informative gravestone in the Gilmore cemetery is that of Walter McLenahan Gilmore. His marker informs he died Dec. 3, 1920, at the age of 25 years, four months and 28 days. This would place his birth date on July 6, 1895. The marker also has an inscription which says that he was an Army private in the 120th Infantry, 20th Division, apparently a veteran of WW I.

The most recent of the birthdates is that of the son of John B. and Annie K. Gilmore

who was born on Sept. 21, 1910, and died on Oct. 30, 1912, at the age of "two years, one month and 10 days." No name is given for this two-year-old boy.

Two more recent graves in the cemetery are unmarked, but according to records kept by Miller Funeral Home they are both Gilmores, with one burial in 1967 and one in 1966. William Ernest Gilmore was born June 26, 1907, died on Dec. 13, 1966. The other unmarked grave is that of Mrs. Lina Bain Gilmore, who was born Oct. 6, 1896, and died on Jan. 3, 1967.

The old Hawley burying ground, located on the north side of the fairway of hole 12, near the Trace's water storage and pumping facilities and adjacent to the dogleg on this hole seems to have graves of the earliest settlers. There are three graves with tombstones, and probably a dozen more have only head and footstones. This place is visited occasionally by genealogists seeking family information.

One stone — for William Hawley, born Oct. 11, 1806, died June 5, 1859 — and his wife Margaret — born Dec. 2, 1813, died Oct. 19, 1867 — has a most beautiful epitaph carved on the headstone: "Having finished life's duty, they now sweetly rest."

A stone for Clarence L. Brooks, son of R. W. and C. A. Brooks, records death on Nov. 2, 1876 (birthdate not recorded).

The Dock D. Wicker burying ground is in the Laurel Thicket and Stone Gate areas of Trace, near the first nine holes of a new course under construction. At this graveyard, roads were dual-lined on either side of the cemetery to preserve it.

There are many Wickers in this area, and as late as last week a descendant registered at the Trace gatehouse to see where his grandfather, Charles Wicker, was buried. Fragments of the old Dock Wicker house and barns remain nearby.

There are nine graves with stones; others have flint rocks at head and foot of graves. The Wicker family owned land in the vicinity as early as 1856.

Names and dates copied from stones are:

—Charles Wicker, born March 27, 1856; died Sept. 25, 1911.

—Hattie H. Wicker, born 1869, died 1950.

—Dock D. Wicker, born 1873, died 1950.

—Cameron Wicker, born Oct. 10, 1890, died Feb. 27, 1918.

—Hoyle Wicker, born July 14, 1887, died Feb. 6, 1916.

—May Wicker, died Dec. 4, 1934 (age 1 year, two months).

—Joe B. Wicker, private, 156 Depot Brigade, died April 6, 1939.

—Ruby Lillie Wicker, daughter of C. A. and Susie Wicker, born July 8, 1906, died Oct. 26, 1910.

—Francis Gideon Wicker, died Feb. 18, 1945, age 73 years, 7 months, 16 days.

This is to answer your letter of March 23, 1979 and to relate some "guesses" I have made in the last few days.

Re John U in Virginia about 1650. Could you send me your references on this? ~~and~~ I will check my files to see if we have someone earlier than Michael mentioned. Re Negro U's. The Miller of pre Civil War mentioned slaves often by name. My greatgrandfather who lived in Wake Co, NC had many and named them in his will. I too am interested in how the Upchurches lived and what motivated them to migrate. Some of them gradually appear but it is easier to understand after the family relationships are sorted out. Can you send me any details on any U who served with Sam Houston? I had not heard that before.

I have just come across some fragments which almost fit and which may be related to your line. My records show HARMON U (XID-167 - see Colonial U Chart) moved from VA to Montgomery Co, NC. He was b ca 1740 and d ca 1815. He had 2 sons. Allen U and Howell U. Allen U b ca 1785 and d ca 1848 in Stanley Co, NC which had been formed from Montgomery Co, NC. Allen U had four

sons as follows:

1. WILLIAM U
2. PATRICK B. U.
3. BENJAMIN U.
4. JAMES U.
5. JOHN DUDLEY U b 31 JUL 1824 d 11 MAR 1857

I know quite a bit about John Dudley U now. His widow and several sons moved to Texas and eventually to Hugo, OK. My guess concerns the first 3 children and is that they are the 3 sons of an unknown father in North Carolina who moved to Arkansas (see sheet I sent you earlier). In order to make the sheet I sent you fit with the above it is only necessary to assume that the B. B. Upchurch on the sheet I sent you should have been P. B. Upchurch. This would make your greatgrandfather as P. B. U and not as B. B. U as I wrote to you earlier. If this is true I think we have your line worked out. Of course more proof is desired and in fact I have not yet checked all of the associated known data to make sure it all is consistent. I can send you more details if you like.

Please let me have notes or xerox copies of anything you get.

What a pleasure to get your recent letter filled with interesting details about your family history. A quick look at my files reveals additional information about your line although one or two generations appear to need final proof before we can be certain of your line. First some background.

All American Upchurches descended from Michael U (XID-146) who migrated from England to Virginia about 1650. Provided herewith is a chart on "Colonial Upchurches in America" and an Explanation I have prepared to take the descendants up through the 5th Generation in America. I belong to the Nathan Clan (Clan 3) (XID-18). Nathan was my greatgreat grandfather. He lived in Wake County, NC and served in the Revolutionary War. Although I cannot be certain it is a good guess that you are descended from Benjamin U (XID-163), the brother of Nathan U.

You simply must get a copy of one or both of the two Upchurch Books. Provided herewith is a flyer on the Belle West Book. The other book is the Oline Morgan Upchurch Book.

Books tell the Upchurch story well although the
West Book has a superior literary style.
In the West Book there is considerable emphasis
on the Moser Clan (Clan #1) [XID-1] whereas
Morgan emphasizes the George Clan (Clan #5) [XID-137].
Belle is a very close friend of mine. I have visited
in the home of Olive Morgan.

Now as to your line. I had your father Walter H. U.
in my file and the sheet is reproduced herewith
for your files. Also I have a single sheet showing
S. A. Upchurch (obviously your grandfather Stuckland A. U.)
and three of his brothers. This establishes your great grandfather
as B. B. U. b 1820, moved to Conway AR 1859, died 1885.
This sheet confirms the story given in your letter
about a move from NC to AR. This appeared as
an Attachment 15A to a letter sent to me by West dated
18 MAY 1975. I do not know where she got it. A
copy is provided for your files.

I am in the process of extracting all Upchurch
information from the N.C. Courier Census
for 1790 - 1880. I get the microfilm from the
Mormon Library in Salt Lake. I have finished the
big one, Wake Co, and am part way through
Chatham. Next comes Franklin Co NC. In a few
months when this extracting and collating
has been completed I hope to be able to
have your lineage complete for America.

I have before me the list of Upchurch heads of households for all of NC for the 1850 census. There are 61 names on this list along with the counties in which they resided. Since your gggf B. B. U was born in 1820 and did not move to AR until 1859 it is quite logical that he might have been on this list as a head of a household. The same may be said for his brothers Ben and William. A copy of the list is provided herewith. A detailed inspection of the actual census will provide more information on the members of the various households. In the meantime what does the index tell us? --- In Stanley County there were two Benjamin U. and one William U. This could be a clue and account for two of the brothers (Ben + William) and possibly their father who might (a guess) have also been named Benjamin. B. B. U is not accounted for in this scheme. You may want to examine the microfilm records for ~~Stanley~~ Stanley Co NC for 1840, 1850 & 1860 to get more details.

Another guess is that Benjamin U (XID-163) head of Class # 5 could have been your ancestor. He could have been the father or the grandfather of the three sons Ben, BB & William U. XII-163 appeared to live all his life in Franklin Co, NC. My records show he had land dealings with a Mr ~~Stuck~~ Stuckland - an interesting coincidence with your grandfather's given name!

I will extract all of the information provided in your letter for my files. In the meantime I would appreciate any additional information you can supply on your family. For the files I need birth, death, marriage dates and places and also burial locations. Full names of all children, parents, uncles, aunts, grandparents, cousins, etc are desired. I will continue to work over my records to prove your line. The information you have supplied is most encouraging. I hope that we can continue our correspondence and exchange of information. Perhaps someday we can meet in person.

Dear Phil:

I deeply appreciate your informative letter of last February on the Upchurch family history. You have told me more than I ever thought of knowing and you have prompted my interest in learning still more. Consequently, I have ordered the two books you listed and will do some digging on my own.

You obviously have done a great deal of work constructing the pedigree of the family, but your letter raises more questions in my mind than it answers. One question concerns a John Upchurch who apparently was granted title to some land in Virginia about 1650 for his services in the militia. This suggests that he may have been in the colony several years prior to that date and that Michael U. was not the only--or even the first--Upchurch to emigrate to the New World. △

Another question that interests me is, how did it happen that an apparently large family of Negroes carry the Upchurch name? Of course, it was common for exslaves to assume the family name of former masters after emancipation so I wonder who among the Upchurchs were slave owners before the Civil War.

This raises a topic that interests me more than merely who sired whom. How did these ancestors of ours live and work? What prompted them to leave England? To move from Virginia to North Carolina? From N.C. to Arkansas and Texas? I hear that there was a Lanny Upchurch on the staff of Gen. Sam Houston during the Texas war of independence from Mexico (circa 1836). Who was he and where did he come from? △ + △

Perhaps I'll have even more questions after I read the two books I've ordered. Thanks for your letter and let me know how I may help you in the future.

Dear Prof. Upchurch:

Your inquiry about the Upchurch genealogy is most interesting. I suppose everyone has some curiosity about his "roots", but I must confess that mine has not been strong enough to prompt any systematic study. Ours was not a very close-knit family and neither Dad nor Mother were inclined to talk much about their families. Thus I fear that I cannot tell you very much.

Family legend has it that two Upchurch brothers left North Carolina about the middle of the nineteenth century bound for the California gold fields. They got as far as Arkansas where their wagon broke down so there they remained. I don't know whether this is fact or fiction, but it makes a good story which my grandfather used to tell with some glee.

I do know that grandfather, Strickland A. Upchurch, was born in Conway County, Arkansas Oct, 27, 1861. He married Roxie Brigham who → Δ was born in Poke County, Ark. June 21, 1865. They raised ten children, three boys and seven girls. My father, Walter Herschel, was next to the oldest of this brood having been born in Conway Co, May 26, 1887. Grandmother Roxie used to tell stories about her father, David Brigham, who apparently was an impoverished circuit riding Methodist preacher who roamed western Arkansas and eastern Indian Territory. He had married an Indian woman--I believe a Cherokee--so grandmother Roxie was a half-blood. She lived into her 90's and the older she became, the more she resembled her aboriginal ancestors.

S. A. and Roxie moved their growing family from Arkansas to western Oklahoma about 1890 in anticipation of that part of the state territory being opened to homesteading. They settled on a creek in what later became Custer County; a choice piece of land then because access to wood and water was important. Forty years later with the coming of large-scale machinery, it was one of the poorest farms in the county. Nevertheless, that farm raised some horses and mules, sheep and cattle, and a big family. Granddad farmed there until his death about 1925. Grandmother Roxie outlived him by about thirty years.

My maternal grandfather was David B. Kriner, born in Franklin County Pennsylvania, Dec. 4, 1858, the son of a staunch Mennonite family. He married a saucy girl named Elmira Hollar, also of Franklin County, but not of the faith. My mother was born in Chambersburg, Pa. Dec, 5, 1884; she had a younger brother, Walter, and a younger sister, Ruth. Grandpa Kriner left the church--or was kicked out, I was never sure which--and took his family to Kansas about 1890 where he farmed for a few years. After western Oklahoma was opened, he bought land in Custer County near where the Upchurch's had settled and farmed until his death about 1926. Grandmother Kriner died soon afterward.

Dad and Mother were married in December 1910 at Weatherford, Okla. Early in 1911 they moved to Louisiana where Dad managed the farming part of a large farm-livestock-timber plantation. The next year he managed the farming for the same company on a place in Missouri where my older sister was born. They returned to Oklahoma in 1913 and 1914 where my younger sister and I came along in rapid succession. Then late in 1914 Dad went to Dallham County Texas to run a "demonstration" farm for the Capitol Syndicate Land Co. (the old XIT), the purpose being to show prospective land buyers that the Texas Panhandle could be farmed. About 1917, Dad took the job of field superintendent for the old dry-land experiment station, USDA, at Dalhart, Tex. In 1923 he became the first county agent for Hartley County, Tex., moving to Randall County in 1927 where he remained the rest of his life. He died in 1957 and Mother followed him a few years later.

Dad had two brothers, Ernest and Homer. Ernest was a veteran of World War I and, unfortunately, spent considerable time in and out of VA hospitals from 1920 until his death in the early 1960's. He had two and maybe three sons. Homer, after some hard times during the Depression, eventually got into the oil distributing business in Clinton, Okla. where, I understand he did very well. He had two sons, twins I believe. I'm sorry I cannot tell you anything about these male cousins who bear the Upchurch name. We just never kept track of each other and I remember seeing them only a few times.

Glancing back over what I have written impresses me that I have not told you very much. I do know that I bump into or hear about Upchurch's occasionally, especially throughout the South, the name is rarely even known in the North. Here in Florida I frequently am asked if I am any relation to the banker in St. Augustine or to the wealthy family in Tampa (I never knew an Upchurch who had much wealth, much less be related).

Incidentally, relevant to your project was an experience I had about twenty years ago. I was in the public library in Alexandria, Virginia browsing while my daughter was doing some home-work when a title caught my eye. As I remember it was "Virginia Land Titles, 1620-1700" or approximately that. Being an ag economist, I scanned the book which reproduced deeds in early colonial times. One showed a grant of land to a Capt. John Upchurch for his services in the colonial militia.-- There's always been John's in the family so I suppose this could have been an ancestor. △


Shortly after we moved to Gainesville in 1972 I noticed four Upchurch's listed in the telephone directory, three of them were Negro families. Since then I've met or heard about a number of blacks with the name Upchurch. Of course, it was quite common for blacks to assume as a surname, the name of a former owner or of someone they admired or even of a place. On one occasion a Negro called me seeking information for his "roots". Unfortunately, I could not help him because the high plains of Texas where I grew up was a far cry from the old South. So far as I know, none of my immediate ancestors was a slave holder.

I've had some fun sitting here typing out this little story; it forced me to think about some things that I hadn't thought about for years. I hope this sketchy information is useful to you and I shall be delighted to hear from you and to learn more about the Upchurch clan. You mentioned two books; no, I have not heard of them before. Please tell me more.

Incidentally, yes, I am the Upchurch who headed the Economic Research Service, USDA from 1965 to 1972. Late in 1971 I realized that I had 32 years of government time and the difference between my salary and my retirement pay was growing pretty small. The frustrations of trying to run a govt bureau became more than I wanted to cope with. Alice and I came to Florida where I am now a part-time "visiting professor", whatever that is.
