Reference made to our relatives:

I also spent some days reviewing the Upchurch state hospital records. I sincerely appreciate your including me in the loops of data collection for all these people of our common bloodlines. I essentially agree with your conjectures about the mysteries for which we lack sufficient documentation, although I'm just as tantalized as you probably are also. On the subject of poor Susie, I have the urge to take a flower to her grave should I ever manage to pass through Chattahoochee. If either of her parents or any sibling ever visited her, there is no mention of it in the file. I think I related to you earlier that my mother recalled only "fear" about her Uncle John. As a child and preteen, I knew Aunt Belle only as a stern old woman on the rare occasions that I saw her at all. Aunt Sadie was more the cheerful one who seemed to like the children. It delighted her when Uncle Harry slipped us quarters—which was a fortune then to an 8- or 9-year-old, and which I generally spent promptly anyway. I have no memory of ever actually speaking directly to Aunt Belle.

These details of Rebecca Pearl are extremely sad also. I can offer nothing about her save that my mother told me that Uncle Garland's first wife, Pearl, was mentally ill, and that his second wife, Hilda, had been Pearl's private nurse prior to her commitment to the state hospital. I do not have a marriage record for William Garland and Hilda (or a divorce record for Pearl), but I see that the inquiry from Uncle Garland to the State Hospital in 1919 was more than four years since Pearl's admission there. He remained in Jacksonville at least through the City Directory listing of 1935, and then some time before his death in 1950 he and Hilda moved to Alabama.

It happens that I have recently finished reading *All Quiet on the Western Front*, the powerful novel of the First World War, so when I read the diagnosis description of Fred B.'s problems, my first thought was that he could have had a post-traumatic stress. A cursory Internet search did not find him as a WWI soldier, but he would have been in his 30s and unmarried at the time of that war, so I think it would be worthwhile to try to rule out his conscription and/or participation in 1917 or 1918.

More research would be required to conclude that an "insanity" genetic trait existed in the Nathan U, I Clan. In any family + and - traits are distributed unevenly. With today's medicines some or all of the four might have led more or less normal lives outside of an institution. At the same time we cannot know what environmental conditions may have contributed to their ill health. It is a surprise that all four were declared indigent in view of the wealth of the family - but we judge from afar. The available records fail to show much family concern for those incarcerated (except for Rebecca) but more evidence is needed.

English descendant but rather was the wife of
^aWilliam Garland &. The packet concerning her stay in
the Asylum is extensive. Of the four she was most
clearly truly insane. The Asylum advised against visits.
One relative visited but could not talk with Rebecca.
The records show that ^aher husband ignored of her status
but reading between the lines one concludes he was
building a case for a divorce & remarry - which did
take place.

On the other hand inquiries by her son ^aBruce Royster &
and her daughter ^aMinnie Eleanor (Mrs Hoyt Horace Harrwell)
seemed genuine.

However, it was her siblings who were most persistent
in showing their concern. They wrote repeatedly and tried
to send treats and spending money but this sister
was in no position to acknowledge or enjoy such
items. She was truly a disturbed person. Upon death her
body was shipped to her brother in Lexington, NC
at his expense where she was presumably buried.
Some records show her died in Lexington but she
, in fact, died in the Asylum in Godsden Co., FL.

Object lessons

The story of a man's life is written in the possessions he treasures until the end.

A plush recliner dominates the living room of Cameron Court Apartment S-1B.

Arranged neatly on a table and a bureau, within arm's reach of the chair, are telephone and telephone book, pillbox, inhaler, radio tuned to news/talk station WPTF-AM, half-eaten box of Red Hots candy, pencils and pens, note pad, tissues and lamp.

To the right, a flashlight and more medicine rest on a windowsill. The television listings lie on a radiator. A TV tray leans against the wall.

The man who lived here died Thursday. □ 26 SEP 1991

Thousands of other people also died

that day, leaving behind the tangible evidence of who they were and how they lived.

Like all of them, Glenn Upchurch, the man who lived in Apartment S-1B, built his own memorial.

Mr. Upchurch, 85, was a man who wanted to maintain his independence to the very end. He succeeded.

The recliner was the center of a universe he could control.

Mr. Upchurch, after all, was a man who worked as a Wake County bailiff through October. Until he fell ill with the heart problems that would kill him, he still was planning to go back to work. Idleness, he told his children, would kill him.

The ashtray on the table beside the

chair holds pencils and pens and loose change. A wooden cigarette box contains a watch band

and cotton balls. Mr. Upchurch stopped smoking 20 years ago. He came down with emphysema anyway. He bought the teal blue recliner a year ago because he no longer could sleep lying down in his bed. He repeatedly implored his son to stop smoking and be spared the misery.

The electric alarm clock on the nightstand in the bedroom is stopped at 8:11:06. Mr. Upchurch unplugged it and the lamps there when he moved into his living room. He was a practical man.

Four family photographs stand on a dresser in the bedroom. One shows Mr. Upchurch's daughter, Sarah Hall of Wake Forest, as a high school student. Another △ shows his son, William Upchurch of Dunn, and William's wife, Laura. The third shows Mr. Upchurch with his longtime friend, Ellen Smith.

The largest photograph is of Mr. Upchurch's wife, Dovie. She met the Harnett County farm boy in the early 1930s in Raleigh and followed him to California, where they were married in 1935. She died in 1959.



Glenn Upchurch was an independent gentleman. And when the retired bailiff died last week at the age of 85, he left behind more than 300 favorite photographs and the everyday trappings of life.

Six yogurt cups and twice as many lids sit in two neat piles on the kitchen counter next to a shiny stainless steel sink. There are no dirty dishes. Mr. Upchurch washed, dried and put everything away immediately.

Half-empty boxes of Total, Total Raisin Bran and Post Corn Flakes line the cabinet above the sink. Breakfast was the only meal Mr. Upchurch ate at home. He and Miss Smith ate lunch and dinner at Balentines and K&W cafeterias in Cameron Village. He stopped buying meat and other food that could spoil when he became unable to regularly prepare his own meals.

Two half-gallon cartons of ice cream — one vanilla, the other chocolate — are in the freezer. A tin of butter cookies and two boxes of granola bars lie on the well-worn but tidy two-person kitchen table. He snacked at night.

A Dixie Cup dispenser is fastened to the wall near the refrigerator. He may have dirtied bowls

A film covers the screen of the 19-inch color set. Mr. Upchurch watched only two programs regularly. His favorite was "Murder, She Wrote." Friends and family knew better than to telephone him from 8 to 9 on Sunday nights. He would politely tell them he was busy and promise to call back. He caught an episode of his second favorite, "Matlock," on his last night at home. The TV listing is open to the show: *Conrad tracks Julie's harasser and discovers an unlikely suspect.*

A watercolor of a bartender serving drinks to patrons hangs in the living room. Mr. Upchurch moonlighted as a bartender during World War II in Long Beach, Calif., where he worked in a ship-

yard. Eventually, he returned to Franklin County to open a drive-in restaurant. He came to Raleigh in the early '50s.

Two blue bedroom slippers, size 7½, rest on the floor to the right of the recliner. Mr. Upchurch always complained of cold feet. He wore slippers or wool socks around the apartment, even on the hottest days.

and spoons but never a glass.

Four books of scripture, "Daily Guideposts 1977" and "The New York Times New Testament" among them, are stacked on the bottom shelf of the television stand in the living room. Mr. Upchurch was a member of St. John's Baptist Church.

His Bible collected no dust. His TV did.

A royal blue bathrobe hangs on the back of the bedroom door. Blue was his favorite color.

Two racks of ties — timeless styles ranging from paisleys to stripes — hang on each side of the closet door in the bedroom. A line of blue, brown and gray suits stretch across the closet rod. Arranged among the jackets are some two dozen starched white dress shirts with laundry tags inside the necks. A row of tasseled loafers, brown and black, rest on the closet's top shelf.

A plush recliner dominates the living room of Cameron Court Apartment S-1B.

Arranged neatly on a table and a bureau, within arm's reach of the chair, are telephone and telephone book, pillbox, inhaler, radio tuned to news/talk station WPTF-AM, half-eaten box of Red Hots candy, pencils and pens, note pad, tissues and lamp.

To the right, a flashlight and more medicine rest on a

windowsill. The television listings lie on a radiator. A TV tray leans against the wall.

The man who lived here died Thursday.

Thousands of other people also died that day, leaving behind the tangible evidence of who they were and how they lived.

Like all of them, Glenn **Upchurch**, the man who lived in Apartment S-1B, built his own memorial.

Mr. **Upchurch**, 85, was a man who wanted to maintain his independence to the very end. He succeeded.

The recliner was the center of a universe he could control.

Mr. **Upchurch**, after all, was a man who worked as a Wake County bailiff through October. Until he fell ill with the heart problems that would kill him, he still was planning to go back to work. Idleness, he told his children, would kill him.

The ashtray on the table beside the chair holds pencils and pens and loose change. A wooden cigarette box contains a watch band and cotton balls. Mr **Upchurch** stopped smoking 20 years ago. He came down with emphysema anyway. He bought the teal blue recliner a year ago because he no longer could sleep lying down in his bed. He repeatedly implored his son to stop smoking and be spared the misery.

The electric alarm clock on the nightstand in the bedroom is stopped at 8:11:06. Mr. **Upchurch** unplugged it and the lamps there when he moved into his living room. He was a practical man.

Four family photographs stand on a dresser in the bedroom. One shows Mr. **Upchurch**'s daughter, Sarah Hall of Wake Forest, as a high school student. Another shows his son, William **Upchurch** of Dunn, and William's wife, Laura. The third shows Mr. **Upchurch** with his longtime friend, Ellen Smith.

The largest photograph is of Mr. **Upchurch**'s wife, Dovie. She met the Harnett County farm boy in the early 1930s in Raleigh and followed him to California, where they were married in 1935. She died in 1959.

Six yogurt cups and twice as many lids sit in two neat piles on the kitchen counter next to a shiny stainless steel sink. There are no dirty dishes. Mr. **Upchurch** washed, dried and put everything away immediately.

Half-empty boxes of Total, Total Raisin Bran and Post Corn Flakes line the cabinet above the sink. Breakfast was the only meal Mr. **Upchurch** ate at home. He and Miss Smith ate lunch and dinner at Balentines and K&W cafeterias in Cameron Village. He stopped buying meat and other food that could spoil when he became unable to regularly prepare his own meals.

Two half-gallon cartons of ice cream -- one vanilla, the other chocolate -- are in the freezer. A tin of butter cookies and two boxes of granola bars lie on the well-worn but tidy two-person kitchen table. He snacked at night.

A Dixie Cup dispenser is fastened to the wall near the refrigerator. He may have dirtied bowls and spoons but never a glass.

Four books of scripture, "Daily Guideposts 1977" and "The New York Times New Testament" among them, are stacked on the bottom shelf of the television stand in the living room. Mr. **Upchurch** was a member of St. John's Baptist Church.

His Bible collected no dust.

His TV did.

Two racks of ties — timeless styles ranging from paisleys to stripes — hang on each side of the closet door in the bedroom. A line of blue, brown and gray suits stretch across the closet rod. Arranged among the jackets are some two dozen starched white dress shirts with laundry tags inside the necks. A row of tasseled loafers, brown and black, rest on the closet's top shelf.

I was very excited to read in our local newspaper, "The Elgin Courier", about the Upchurch research you have done. I am sorry that I was not informed in time to attend your lecture in April in Austin. My mother was Mattie Belle Upchurch Smith born to Harvey Upchurch of Williamson Co., Texas. When my mother died in December 1994 I did not know of any Upchurches to contact, as I have lost touch with all of her cousins. I had asked my mother many times about her grandfather, Green Upchurch, and all she knew was that his family came from North Carolina and had at one time been wealthy plantation owners. She did not know if he had any siblings, but I always figured he did.

I will tell you what I know about the Upchurches, which is not too much. First, I question the "Grover" Upchurch born to William Green. I have never been aware of a Grover Upchurch. But I do know there was a Tom Upchurch that was a son of William Green, which you did not list on the family tree. Also, William Green had a daughter named Phoebe, which you did not list. I do not understand this. Mother told me my grandfather, Harvey, had 6 brothers and sisters (some were half siblings): Bulah, William (Bill), Clyde, John, Tom, and Phoebe. William Green U. was married twice-the first wife, Sarah, bore the first four children, and his second wife, Sarah (Wiley, I believe) bore the next three children.
