- △ The first known Strickland in present day Franklin County was Elisha Strickland, son of
- △ Jacob Strickland of Nash County and an unknown mother. His original land, obtained by a Lord Granville land patent, was located on both sides of Moccasin Creek, later the dividing line between Franklin and Wake County.) After the death of Elisha Strickland, most of his children
- △ moved to Madison County, Georgia. (His son Jacob had lived in Anson County, NC for a few years before joining his siblings in Georgia.)

- The land of Sampson Strickland of Wake County was redistricted after his death into Franklin County, and Sampson's descendants lived in Franklin County after 1794 -1799 until they began to leave, moving about 1833 to Pickens Co. AL (Obediah A., the sons of Matthew Strickland who married first Nancy Bunn and second Jane "Jincey" Rice, and some of the sons of Abel) and Nash County, NC (descendants of Sampson Strickland, Jr. who moved into the Rocky Cross area). Later Gideon Strickland, son of Jacob Strickland of Nash County, moved for a few years into Franklin County and then moved back into Nash County where he died. His son
- △ Wilson Taylor Strickland remained in Franklin County, and his descendants remain in the county today.

MARK STRICKLAND, born say 1749 in Edgecombe County, North Carolina. He married MARTHA (-?-) in Edgecombe County after 1768. He died in Nash County, North Carolina, after 6 August 1811.⁹⁸ Martha died after her husband signed his will. Mark is first of record as a witness in court on 8 December 1766.⁹⁹ He received a gift of 280 acres of land from his father on 25 November 1769.¹⁰⁰ He purchased land in two locations in Nash County. I. Gideon Strickland b 1766 - History Notes

On August 28, 1811, Gideon Strickland patented 25 acres south of Turkey Creek in Nash County adjoining Ephriam Perry, John Perry, and Dance. On September 11, 1812, he patented 200 acres at the head of White Oak Swamp adjoining Lazarus Strickland, Westray, and Eason (Johnston County Patent Book 127, p. 5).

Petition for damages caused by raising the water and overflowing several acres of land owned by Gideon Strickland, who possessed a large tract of land on the south side of Toisnot Swamp devised to him by his father. The mill owner and defendant was Isaac Strickland. The petition was for the sheriff to summon a jury to assess the damage, according to the provisions of the Act of 1809, Chapter 15, in "Hogwood's Manual." Feb. Term 1814 (Nash County Petitions 1777-1859). [NOTE: Another source gives the date as 1834]

In November, 1815, Gideon Strickland made a petition to build a gristmill across a small branch on his own land in Nash County.

viii. HENRY STRICKLAND, born say 1753 in Edgecombe County, North Carolina. He married first a woman who remains unidentified about 1775 in Edgecombe County and second MARY (-?-) in Nash County, North Carolina, after 13 February 1792.¹¹⁴ He died in Nash County in March 1796.¹¹⁵ Mary died after 13 November 1798.¹¹⁶ On 28 November 1769, Henry obtained 530 acres of land from his father Jacob.¹¹⁷ Henry helped lay the road from the Nash County courthouse to Edward Clinch's mill on October 1778.¹¹⁸ He continued to accumulate land and had 1,150 acres by 1782.¹¹⁹ His first wife died by February 1792, when Henry's son Carlos was called an orphan in a Nash County court appearance.¹²⁰ Henry did not leave a will, but records from his son Joseph's estate and a petition by wife Mary identify most, if not all, of his children.¹²¹ Henry was in Nash County for the 1790 federal census.¹²² He died in March 1796.¹²³ Henry's estate records also include letters and administrations from Georgia by his wife dated 13 November 1798, indicating that Mary may have relocated to that state.¹²⁴

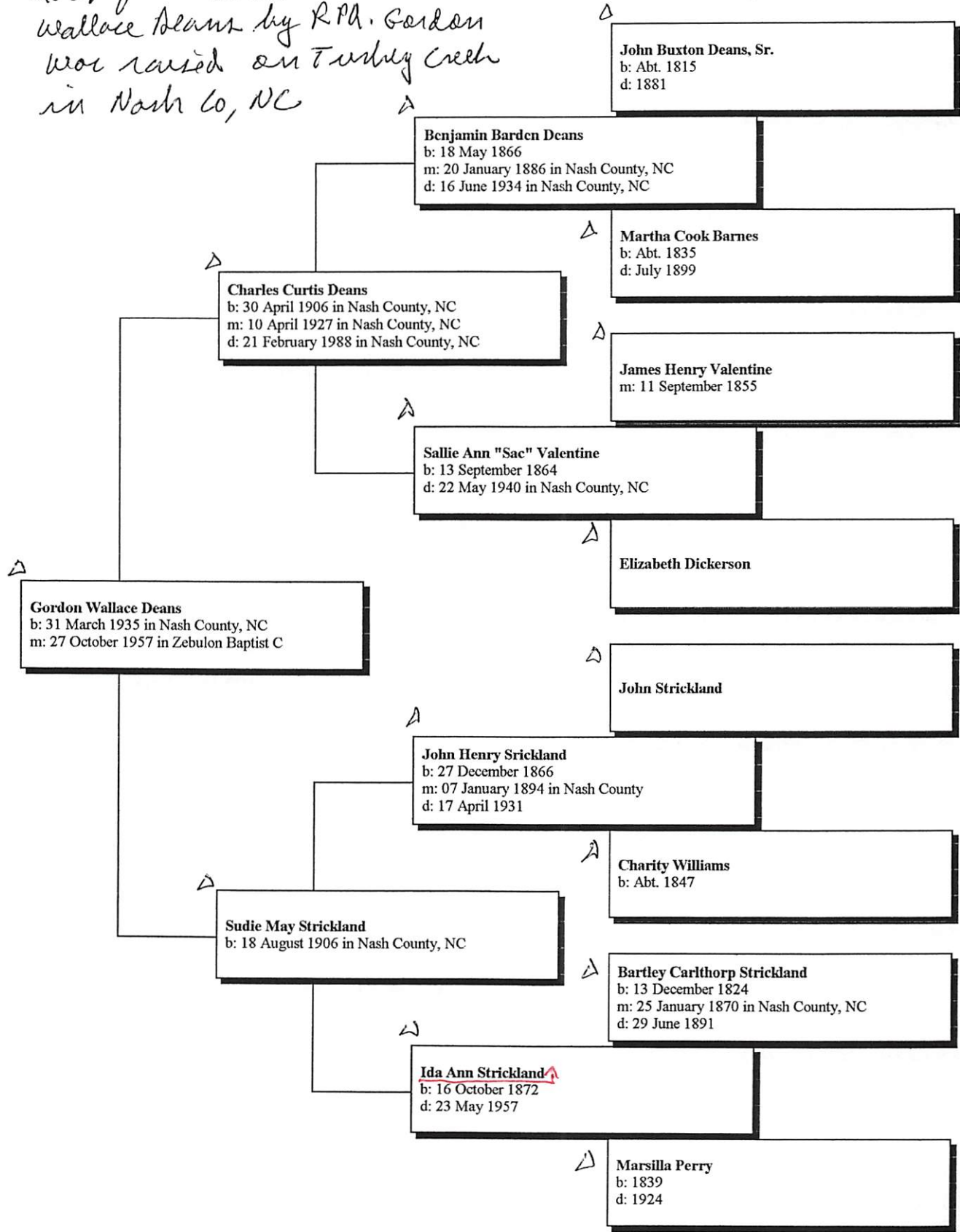

In JUN 1805 Basil Strickland & his wife Polly Strickland [Strickland and Strickland - Polly was dau of Elisha] placed a petition in Wake Co, NC Court to set aside the will of Elisha Strickland - names Isaac Strickland as one of the beneficiaries. and indicates he lives in GA.

Deeds have been located which indicate the approximate time Isaac Strickland and Kinchen Strickland left NC and settled in GA --- on 26 NOV 1802 - Kinchen Strickland living in Franklin Co, NC sold 300 acres to John Pace witness - Isaac Strickland & Nathans Marsey (Franklin Co Deed Bk 12, Pg 78).

Isaac Strickland is on the 1790 Wake Co, NC census with one female. On 26 JUL 1795 Isaac Strickland of Franklin Co, NC sold William Morgan of Nash Co 95 acres on both sides of Turkey Creek, adjoining Morgan, Wm. Martin, Wolf Harbor branch, Spring Branch & witnessed by Obadiah Strickland

and William Bryant. on 7 AUG 1799. Isaac Strickland & sold Wm Martin 12 acres on Turkey Creek, on the County Line, Piney Prong, & Boon's line (Franklin Co Deed Book 3, Pg 109) - also witnessed by Obadiah Strickland & William Bryant. The last parcel sold by Isaac Strickland in NC was purchased by Phillip Pearce on 10 DEC 1802 in Franklin Co, NC. It consisted of 250 acres on the N. Prong of Meccason Creek, adjoining Stephen Pearce, South Prong, Bunn's Branch, Jesse Barry, Meadow Branch, Guy & the orphan James Pearce (Franklin Co Deed Bk 12 Pg 87). The 250 acres had been bequeathed to Isaac Strickland by his father Elsha Strickland. Isaac Strickland apparently moved to GA in 1802 after selling his legacy.

→ Δ iv. ISAAC STRICKLAND born say 1743, probably in Isle of Wight County, Virginia. He likely died in Franklin County, North Carolina, after 1800. Isaac made only a few appearances in records. In addition to receiving a legacy from his father's will, he witnessed a land purchase by Jacob Strickland on Little River in Johnston County on 16 November 1790.⁹¹ An Isaac Strickland appears in the 1800 federal census in Franklin County.⁹² This Isaac is probably too young to be the son of Jacob because he was twenty-six to forty-five years old when that census was taken.

This appears to me to have been Elisha Strickland's
land earlier ^{to} land of Ambrose Upchurch and
possibly Shaw Driner appears to have been
Sampson Strickland's land. Elisha's executor - son James
sold some land to Phillip Pearce in 1802.

Sampson Strickland's daughter - in - law Nancy
(widow of Abel) married ^{to} Driner ^{in 1806} after her
husband's death. I believe Shaw Driner was
Nancy's stepson. Abel's land then passed to Kinman
Strickland.

I also believe William Privett (wife Anna Upchurch)
was the son of Zachariah Privett ^{to} Lavinia
Massey of Little River District Wake County
but no actual proof exists that the Wm. who was
their son is this William
