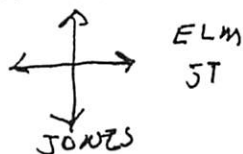

A. B. ANDREWS

① The social clubs and the genteel set of Raleigh, NC, in general had on their central location the 300 to 500 blocks of Blount St. since 1900 Raleigh had revolved around this area of the city, because it was home to Colonel A. B. Andrews of the Southern Railroad, several state leaders, successful businessmen and some of the well established families of the city. Blount St was to retain its social distinction until the WWII years. (37, pg 103)

## ALEXANDER BOYD ANDREWS

① (See reference for photo) Alexander Boyd Andrews (1841-1915) constructed 5 railroads in N.C., served as President of 5 more lines and completed the Western N.C. Railroad. He was General Agent of the receiver of the Richmond & Danville Railroad when the Co went bankrupt in 1892. Andrews stayed with the firm after its reorganization as the Southern Railway Co. A Raleigh native, he refused presidency of the Southern because the job required moving to Washington, DC (37, Pg 88)

## ALEXANDER BOYD ANDREWS

- ① Alexander Boyd Andrews was wounded at Jackson's shop in VA in the Civil War and settled in Raleigh, NC to become a railroad magnate, an aloof personality, and perhaps the most powerful man in the city. (37, Pg 53)

**ANDREWS, B. W.** Corporal

Enlisted in Alamance County at age 25, 14 June 1861, for the war. Mustered in as a Private. Captured at Sharpsburg, Maryland, 17 September 1862, and paroled at Winchester, Virginia, 4 October 1862. Promoted to Corporal on 1 November 1864. Present or accounted for until paroled at Appomattox Court House, Virginia, 9 April 1865.

**ANDREWS, James Logan**, Sergeant

Resided in Chatham County and enlisted in Alamance County at age 27, 14 June 1861, for the war. Mustered in as Private and promoted to Corporal on 1 December 1862. Wounded in the breast at Gettysburg, Pennsylvania, 1 July 1863, and captured in hospital at Gettysburg on 5 July 1863. Hospitalized at Baltimore, Maryland, until paroled and transferred to City Point, Virginia, where he was received 17 November 1863, for exchange. Promoted to Sergeant on 1 December 1864. Paroled at Appomattox Court House, Virginia, 9 April 1865.

The company, known as "Cedar Forks Rifles," was from Wake and Chatham Counties and enlisted in Wake County on 28 May 1861. It went into the camp of instruction near Company Shops (Burlington), Alamance County, 1 June 1861, and was assigned to this regiment [Sixth Regiment] as Company I. After joining the regiment, the company functioned as a part of the regiment, and its history for the war period is recorded as a part of the regimental history.

The information contained in the following roster of the company was compiled principally from company muster rolls for 20 June 1861, through February 1864, and 15 September through December 1864. No company muster rolls were found for the period prior to 20 June 1861; for March through 14 September 1864; or for the period after December 1864. In addition to the company muster rolls, Roll of Honor records, receipt rolls, hospital records, prisoner of war records, and other primary records, supplemented by state pension applications, United Daughters of the Confederacy records, and postwar rosters and histories, all provided useful information.

Jane Andrews Wilmot of Raleigh died December 8, 2018 at Springmoor's Stewart Health Center. She was the mother of three, stepmother of three, grandmother of eight, great grandmother of nine and good friend to many.

Jane was born June 15, 1927 in Siler City, NC to Beatrice and George Henry Andrews. She attended Meredith College graduating in 1948. It was at Meredith that she would meet women who would remain life-long friends, including Roselind Steele (with whom she shared the superlative "Wit of the class of 1948") and Lefty Barefoot, her neighbor at Springmoor.

Her children will remember her as always being in the audience at plays, on the sidelines at games or cheering them at swim meets. She willingly spent many days playing bridge by the pool so that her children could spend all day in the water. And even though she couldn't swim, she loved the beach. Often she would lead long marches up and down the shore looking for shells and offering posture lessons.

Jane never met a stranger. Upon the dissolution of her first marriage, she found the perfect way to utilize her talents and time by serving as the family liaison at the intensive care waiting room at Rex Hospital where she should provide information and comfort anxious family members.

In 1983 her son Richard introduced her to "the love of her life": Bill Wilmot. Bill shared her love of bridge, scotch and cigarettes (although, together they ultimately quit smoking). He brought to their marriage a love of travel as well three children, adding to Jane's adoring audience.

Jane transitioned from a leopard-jumpsuit-gogo-boots-wearing cool mom to cool grandmother. After Bill's death her new traveling companions became her grandchildren: safaris in Africa, the Rock of Gibraltar in Spain and the Parthenon in Greece.

Though age and dementia took its toll, Jane always remained gracious: inviting those who visited her room to lunch or offering to walk them to the elevator when they left. Jane is survived by her sister, Barbara Andrews Jones of Pittsboro; son, Richard Hewitt and wife Louise of Raleigh; daughters, Rachel Hewitt and husband, Eric Whiteside of Charlotte and Martha O'Neill and husband, Dan of Caswell Beach. She is also survived by her beloved step-children; sons, Garry Wilmot and wife Elaine of Atlanta, Scott Wilmot of Virginia Beach; and daughter, Wendy Wilmot and husband Andy Sayre of Bald Head Island.

We met in the home of Barbara Martin (Andrews) James (DIV - one child) b 1933. Her sister Eleanor Jane (Andrews) (Hewitt) (undiv) arrived shortly & we had a 2 1/2 hour chat. There brother George did not come as Barbara had hoped.

Their father George Henry Andrews, Sr. ran a store in Chatham Co, NC as did his father. He was selected by the voters to run for Chatham Co, NC Sheriff & was elected 4 terms. When Ben Scott became Governor he took an appointive office. He had diabetes which the family hid from the electorate. He was outgoing and loved people & his job. He & Beatrice had most of their lives

in the home where I would Beatrice year ago (Upon departure we spotted the house - still intact)

They had a Cousin Andrews relative who was a hermit. At the end stayed in the Poor House for a short while.

Beatrice bathed her husband's feet which Aunt Ellie thought was gross. [ELEANOR MARKS U, II]

They felt Aunt Ellie (then GM) was poorly served in having to live first with one child & then another in his lengthy widowhood. They were shocked when a post card arrived from his wife writing on front & back giving family secrets - such as James got drunk again last night or so. Aunt Ellie had a teaching certificate.

Jane said Dan's MIL lived with Dan & Suzanne. Jane complains that Suzanne had been married before she met Dan. Re them having no children Jane said Suzanne was nearing the end of her childbearing years when she married and they also probably decided not to have children because of their close kinship.

The Martin children probably got a break on education costs in college as they went to Baptist institutions.

Dan apparently had severe reactions to drugs & was institutionalized twice following such reactions. He was handsome but a hard taskmaster. He was in the Philippines during the war. Jane recalls to him that Aunt Elsie owned Jane's mantle to be his heir.
