

Watkins Cemetery - Cross Roads District - Wake Co, NC

Notes Re Watkins Cemetery in Crossroads Area of Wake Co, NC. Taken by RPH on site 7 DEC 2001. About 20-30 stones. Directions. Cross Neuse River on Hwy 401. Take 1st right to Wake Cross Roads. Pass through Wake Cross Roads & take next right on WATKINS ROAD - pass between two ponds - Take next right on WATKINS ROAD. Cemetery is on right about 1/2 mile down road. Noted one Upwards Stone as follows:

△ DANIEL W. UPCHURCH 24 SEP 1956 - 7 JUN 1988

A local lady stopped by and related the following:

□ I man u - buried in this area

□ A. CARY u md (?) Ella Watkins

△ 1. Daniel W. u.

△ Daniel died young of an aneurysm. His father is buried at the Knightdale Methodist Church Cemetery

□ □ with a wife other than nee Ella Watkins. Ella

△ elected to have her son Daniel buried in this cemetery with Watkins relatives which is presumably where Ella will be buried.

○ Note from 13 DEC 2001 inspection of Poole-Jones Cem in SW corner of Forestville & Buffalo Roads in the Cross Roads Area of Wake Co, NC by Emma Jean Clifton & RPH

Next inspected a double cemetery on the west side of Forestville Rd about 100 yards south of the crossroads and 25 yards off of the Road. Jean says a house once stood just North of the cemetery - hence in the corner of the cross roads. The south cemetery is opened and the adjoining cemetery to the north is not. [Maybe someone wanted to pay for fencing in only their folks and it really was once a single cemetery?? - RPH] Some names come but not all
