Dear Mr. Upchurch:

I have your letter of September 6, 1968 concerning the family history.

I have glanced through some of my records, but can find no John Winton Upchurch in High Falls, North Carolina, however, I found a John Winston Upchurch in Wake County, North Carolina who was a grandson of Nathan Upchurch, who in turn was a brother of Moses Upchurch. I don't know whether this will help you or not.

Mr. Roy White of Houston, Texas spent an entire day in my office the early part of the year and it took him approximately fifteen hours to photostat the information I have on hand, which covers some several inches of files. You can understand from this that it would be somewhat expensive to have all of this copied, whereas it might be of no use whatever to you. In time to time, as the opportunity affords, I will search my records to see if I can find anything in connection with your grandfather or his parents.

In connection with C. E. Upchurch, I knew a Dr. C. E. Upchurch of Union City, Tennessee and had a letter from him two or three years ago. He was one of some five or six brothers, all of whom originated in Greene or Pickens County, Alabama. I knew him quite well. I have looked through the telephone directory of Atlanta and can find no C. E. Upchurch, although there are some twenty to twenty-five Upchurch's listed. Our people came to Alabama in about 1815 or 1816 from Wake County, North Carolina. At the present time I lack only one name in being able to tie our family into the North Carolina and Virginia line. For your information, the Virginia line originated at Jamestown, Virginia in 1642 and so far as we know, the first Upchurch was a Michael Upchurch who immigrated from England to America and apparently married the daughter of the Lt. Governor of the Virginia Company, whose name was Farrar. I have his line down to approximately the year 1785 or 1790, but as mentioned above, lack one name at about that time.

If there is anything further I can do to help you, please let me know.

Thanks for your letter of 11 NOV 1981 and for  
your very prompt response & my note.

To answer the census part of your question I include  
a copy of a draft of a missing index item which  
was to appear in UB Vol 2-4 but which had to  
be left out because of space constraints. The only  
name on the 9 person list for Kelly U 1850 Cumberland  
Co, NC which matches the 5 children of F. U  
& Jane (Eason) U is Caroline U. She was age 2 on  
the 1850 list and hence b. ca. 1848. Does this  
match your Caroline, age-wise? See UB Vol 1 Pg 27, 73  
for the 5 children of F. U. -

William Henry U b. 1852 - (name not on 1850 census)

George H. U b. 1872 (my records must be in  
error - birth date should  
be earlier)

John Winston U b. 1858 (name not on 1850 census)

Annie U - b. ?

Caroline U - b. ? (mentioned above)

one they name would be to find Kelly U on  
the 1860 census. I do not have a listing of all  
Upchurch heads of households for 1860 (as I do for earlier

decades) so I cannot tell if he is in NC in 1860 & if so in what county. From what you have sent I would ~~not~~ suspect Pitt County. In 1860 I don't believe he is in Crutchen, Wake, Franklin, ~~Guilford~~ or Johnston.

In UB Vol 2 #4 pg 748 you will see a write-up on Moses Ruffin - Kelly U. This goes in the mail 17NOV81 and will be to you soon.

Re Ruffin Union - We have made a lot of progress but do not have a complete story. From the Ruffin U 1812 was Payer (submitted by his wife Martha U in her bid for a pension) we learn that Martha Goodwin (sometimes called Patsey) was his wife for 40 years beginning about 1825 and that she was his last wife having lived with Ruffin U until her death in 1866. We also learn that before his marriage to Martha Goodwin he was wed to Elizabeth Kelley and that Elizabeth died young after she and Ruffin had several children. Whether Ruffin wed before he wed Elizabeth Kelley needs more documentation. I think the current evidence that his first wife was ~~was~~ — William comes from an affidavit of Ora U (mother of Belle West). My guess is that this affidavit was given in the 1950's when Ora U was old and that she may have been relying on memory from word of mouth.

passed down over many decades. Although the Elizabeth Kelley connection seems firm we always have to look for corroborating evidence.

One weak point (among several) is that we don't really know that Ruffin U had a son Kelly U. The circumstantial evidence looks good. He was of the right age and at the right place and Ruffin U was of the right age. Of course we are anxious to identify the full set of Ruffin children by all his names. One thing that bothers me is that father

U III (XID-197) lived in Chatham Co, NC (died there in 1795) and left two sons who could have had offspring being born in the early 1800's. Son Samuel U (XID-417) is well documented and would be ID IL so I don't worry about him. Son John U (XID-416) is not well documented and he could be the father of some of our Upchurchs who were born in the early 1800's and for whom we do not have a connection.

After you have studied the information and the info in UB Vol 2 #4, please let me know your further thoughts. Let's keep looking & hoping!

Dear Phil,

Your letter arrived Monday and I am estatic over your speculation of my family line. I have spent the past two days searching through all my notes, etc. and could not find any new information that I haven't already sent you.

My oldest sister, who is 62 years of age, still maintains that my Great Grand Father was Kelly Upchurch but as I said before, she can not document it. Also as I reread the letters I received from Annie Upchurch back in the 1960's, the places she mentioned in which my ancestors lived, very much corresponds to the places you have mentioned in your letter of this week. I am enclosing one of her letters.

The "F Upchurch" on the death certificate still remains a mystery to me but perhaps you were right when you suggested that it could have very well been "F. Kelly Upchurch".

You wrote in your letter I received this week that Ruffin Upchurch's first wife was Elizabeth Kelley. However, on page 33 of Belle Lewter West's Upchurch Family, Ruffin's first wife is \_\_\_\_\_ Williams and his second wife was Pasty Goodwin. This confuses me.

I do have a paper that Mrs. West sent me stating that Kelly Upchurch and Sara Jane Eason were married in Chatham County, N.C. on 19 Sep 1837 and William Goodwin was Bondsman at this marriage. I think I sent you a copy of this paper some time ago.

Do you have the names of the children, other than Caroline, from the Cumberland Co. N.C. Census in 1850 of Kelly Upchurch? Was John Winton, William Henry, George or Annie listed? There may have been others in this family but these are the only names I have so far.

I just feel that we are so close in putting the pieces together with your new speculation that I am just over-whelmed. I can never thank you enough for all your efforts and interest you have shown in my family line. I will continue to keep searching and will send you any information that I may obtain.

Dear Calvin,

over the past several weeks I have encountered some items that allow me to speculate about your Upchurch line. I tried to call you today but could not get a phone number for you so will drop this note to you. Actually I am in the midst of preparing Vol 2<sup>nd</sup> 4 of UB and will include the new speculation in it in part.

New information shows that Puffer U, son of Moses U the head of the Moses U line, had a first wife Elizabeth Kelley and that they had several children born in the decade 1810-1820. The initial speculation is that Puffer + Elizabeth could have named a son Kelly U after the mother's family name. Other circumstances are that Puffer did have a son born 1815-1820, that there was a Kelly U b ca 1816 on the Wake/Chatham line, and that several potential sons of Kelly U (who appear on 1840 Chatham census) can be eliminated and that only a few prospects are left of which Puffer U is a prime candidate. I saw Kelly U on the Cumberland Co, NC census in 1850



and some of the names of Kelly's children match up with the names you sent me on children of your Kelly II (Caroline II, for example). We now need Kelly II on the 1860 census to help firm the linkage. I don't think he is on the Cumberland Co records but might be on the Put Co NC census (from what you have sent) or on the Burnett Co records.

With more research on the records now at hand and on those readily available, I am sure we can make our speculation more firm. I would certainly appreciate any additional details you can get on your Upchurch relatives so we can fill out the group.

Remember - what I have written above is still speculation based on circumstantial evidence but it is so exciting I just had to give you this tip.

Mrs. E. F. Byington of Salt Lake City has sent me her first report on her research authorized under the Upchurch Research Fund. I sent her a list of the Upchurch Missing Links as published in the UB and told her to do <sup>to</sup> 60%<sup>00</sup> month of work on one of them. She picked Missing Link No 1 (UB Vol 1 No 1 p 27) which happens to be yours. A copy of her full report (except for pages 15 & 16 which are pages 27 & 28 in UB Vol 1 No 1) is provided herewith for your file. While we do not learn too much new from her work in this case I am still pleased with her approach and her productivity. She was thrown off by the "F" Upchurch which I think is really "K" Upchurch. Also you happened to have made some progress yourself. I think I already had all the other stuff she sent. She did not know what I already had and I asked her to

send no copies of all Upchurch matters encountered.

For the next round with Mrs Byington I am going to ask her to search the Franklin Co, NC census records for every decade from 1790 to 1810 for all Upchurch listed. I will then publish this in the U.B. In this way I can make sure she is working to produce material that I do not have. If this works I can shift from county to county and state to state on the census records and get a lot of output from her that will be meaningful. At some point I can shift and have her generate records of Upchurch marriages, etc. I haven't given up on having her search for missing links but think a slightly different task is better for now with the limited funds available in the Upchurch Research Fund.

There is the possibility of a special project involving you. If you are willing to provide some financial support we could ask Mrs Byington to search for the father of Kelly U b 1816 and particularly for the project

that he could be the son of J. Edgar Hoover. If you are interested I would be willing to take money out of the Upchurch Research Fund to match your contribution \$ for \$ to finance this little search. If we could authorize her to spend a total of \$60 or maybe up to \$100 we could expect a nice little piece of work. Let me know if this has any appeal to you. If not that is OK. We all have competition for our resources.

I imagine you are just about getting back into school now. Our classes start Monday. In a few minutes I have to go to the University for the first faculty meeting of the year. It is a luncheon hosted by the President with a few upbeat comments from him to start off the year.

Your letter of August 5, 1983 arrived yesterday. Congratulations on your discovery. I have worked all the details you provided into my files. There can be no question now of the following:

- (1) The Kelly U age 4 on the Harnett Co, NC census in 1860 is your grandfather
- (2) The Kelly U age 38 on the 1860 census is your GGF
- (3) The Kelly U age 34 on the Cumberland Co, NC census is also your GGF (There should be about 10 yr age difference not if but such little circumstances are not unusual - could be a clerical error - Also the person listing the age sometimes put in age to suit themselves or just guessed)
- (4) While not absolutely certain there is an extremely high probability that the Kelly U age 10-30 on the Chatham Co, NC census is your GGF.

Now the tricky part is who is the father of the Kelly U mentioned in (2), (3) & (4) above. I think it is still most likely Suffer U (ATD-9). We simply must keep searching until we are more sure of this linkage. All the hope for Suffer U being the father as stated in U # Vol 3 No 2 Pg 77 still holds. Your finding

just shows that the 1840-1850-1860 and later  
burial records are down to you are valid.

you ask what steps to take next. I am  
not sure I can give good advice but here are  
thoughts that occur to me: (There is no place  
that I know where you can expect to find the  
children of Puffer & by his first ~~wife~~ wife  
listed under his name).

- (1) Write to the appropriate officer in Cumberland Co, NC  
and Harnett Co, NC and ask for a listing of any  
wills or deeds for Upchurches in the period

- (2) Check Guardianship records for children Co, NC and  
Harnett Co, NC for the period 1810-1830 on the

- (5) Invest \$20-40 with the searcher I am in Salt Lake  
city and get her to plot an approach to the

so don't know how good she is. Our Cousin  
Ray White Jr says she is good. I'll send you

Both Kelly U & Ruffen U are likely to be  
on Monroe Day rolls but that would only  
help to show you where they were at a  
given point. Dulls and deeds for children  
of Kelly or her spouse might reveal  
something. remember ~~only~~ Ruffen U had  
2 or more sons and 3 or more dau by her  
first wife. So far Kelly is the only name  
out of the batch of 5 or more that we have  
to work on. Sooner or later we should  
come up with some of the others and  
when we do this might provide some  
more clue on Kelly U. One thing is for  
sure - the more complete we get the  
early 1800 records on the Upchurches in NC  
the easier it is to narrow down the  
logic of any particular relationship.

Good news! Good news! I am really excited! Last night I spent down at the Merman Branch Genealogical Library here in Las Vegas searching the 1860 North Carolina Census Microfilm of Harnett County and I found my KELLY UPCHURCH!! I am enclosing the information that I copied from the microfilm for your files. I do believe that the John as shown on this microfilm is my Grandfather. All the names check out except the Julia, and I think that I can explain her name later on in this letter.

I kept studying the Upchurch Bulletin Missing Link No. 8 - Kelly Upchurch, Volume 3, Number 2, dated April 1982. It suddenly occurred to me that many of the names that appeared on the 1840 Cumberland County, NC census that you listed match the names that I found on the 1860 Harnett County Census that I saw last night, but the problem was in the spelling of the names. If you will take a look at this Missing Link of the Upchurch Bulletin now, I will explain:

Julia A. U - This is probably Julia Ann and they called her "Annie".  
Julia appeared on the 1860 Census of Harnett County.

Geb. A. - This was a mis-reading. It should have been Geo. (for George) A. (He left N.C. with my Grandfather John for Georgia.)

Caroline U.- This is correct.

Aizabah & Isabella - The only names I cannot explain.

William Upchurch and John Upchurch did not appear on the list as they had not been born.

Earlier during the summer, I had searched the 1860 Census for Pitt County, N.C. There were no Upchurches listed at all.

I am enclosing notes that I took from your correspondence to me in regards to Kelly Upchurch and Ruffin Upchurch. I'm sure that you have all this information, but I tried to summarize the main points.

I am also enclosing a sheet of information that I found on Ben Upchurch as I searched the 1860 N.C. Census for Harnett County. This may help someone else who is searching like me. *→ H*

Now my big question.... where do I go from here? I have been floating on Cloud 9 and had difficulty in even sleeping last night as a result of my find. I really do not know what my next step should be. Please advise me.

- 1837 - Chatham County, N.C. marriage bonds show that Kelly Upchurch and Sarah Jane Eason were married September 19, 1837
- 1840 - N.C. Census shows one Kelly Upchurch in Chatham County. There are 3 people: 1 male age 20-30 (Kelly U); one female age 15-20 (his wife) and one daughter less than 5 years
- 1850 - N.C. Census shows a Kelly Upchurch in Northern Section of Cumberland County according to Jackson and Peoples computer print out of all Upchurches for NC in 1850 Census. 3 of the 5 names matches those of Kelly Upchurch on the 1860 Census of Harnett County.
- 1860 - NC. Census of Pitt County show no Upchurches at all.
- 1860 - NC. Census of Harnett County show Kelly Upchurch and wife Jane Upchurch and their five children.

RUFFIN UPCHURCH:

From the Ruffin Upchurch 1812 War Papers (submitted by the wife Martha Upchurch in her bid for a pension) we learn that Martha Goodwin (sometimes called Patsey) was his wife for 40 years beginning about 1825 and that she was his last wife until his death in 1866. We also learn that before Ruffin's marriage to Martha Goodwin, he was married to Elizabeth Kelley and that Elizabeth died young after she and Ruffin had several children. (Possibly Kelly Upchurch was one of these children.) Whether Ruffin married before he married Elizabeth Kelley needs more documentation. The current evidence that his first wife was \_\_\_\_\_ Williams comes from an affidavit of Ora Upchurch (Mother of Belle West) in about 1950 and who was old and may have been relying on memory from word of mouth passed down over many decades.

I have started reworking some papers related to your line and will start this letter in order to make comments as the extracting is done.

1) Re the E. N. U who was informant for death certificate of William Henry U (brother of your GF) who d in Moore Co, NC 21 OCT 1925. I presume E N U is son of William Henry U in whose home he appears on the 1900 census of Moore Co, NC - b SEP 1892 age 7 yrs. He is listed as Eddie N. Upchurch.

2) A listing I have of the 1900 census for Moore Co, NC shows a Sarah U white - b JUL 1820 (NC) age 79 in a mother-in-law of Henry E. Stewart and in her home. This is all the info my extract shows but I presume the actual census shows more - (wife & children of H. E. Stewart). My guess is that this Sarah U is the widow of Kelly U & thus your GGM the former Sarah Jane Erwin. Her son William Henry U was also on the 1800 census of Moore Co, NC as indicated in 1) above. I presume might have a chance of locating a tombstone for her.

3) I have notes on the family of a Charles Kelly U, Jr who is Senior VP of Citizens Bank in Greensboro, NC. His father was Charles Kelly U Sr who was born in Chatham Co, NC. It is highly likely that he is also descended from one of the <sup>first</sup> four sons of Ruffin U. I am speculating that the Kelly name came from Ruffin's wife just as yours did. So far I can't locate a GF for Charles Kelly U Jr but with more research that should be possible. A most interesting thing here is that Charles Kelly U Jr has a brother named Jerry U. I wonder if this Winton name originated from the same source as the Winton name in your line?

4) While final proof is lacking, the circumstances point more and more to your GGF being Kelly U and in fact to him being Kelly F. U. Looking at all the Frank and Franklin names in your line I would be willing to bet that his name was Kelly Franklin U, as you suggested earlier. Also while final proof is lacking, circumstances strongly support the proposition that Kelly Franklin U was the son of Ruffin U and thus the G of More U, Head of class.

Let's keep working on all the bits and pieces. Every new piece of the puzzle we put in place helps us to see the whole picture.

It has been a long time since I have corresponded with you. Much has happened since then... beginning with my retirement in September 1990. I decided that after thirty-five years of teaching, it was time to call it "quits"! However, I still do some occasional substitute teaching to-day.

For years, I have been meaning to put my family line, beginning with Kelly Upchurch (XID 22540) in some sort of order. Being that I have more time on my hands now, I began to make out the attached outline. I used The Register of American Ancestors, UB, Vol 10, Number 2, as the basis for my outline. However, I added a lot of names, in my immediate family line, that were not in the family register, thus they do not have XID numbers.

As you can readily see, of the seven children of Sara Jane Eason and Kelly Upchurch, detailed information is given on four (Julia Ann, George A., William Henry, and John Winton). There is only a listing of names for the remaining three children (Isabella, Elizabeth, Caroline). I do not know if you have received any additional information on these last three.

(KID 22667) → In rereading several of your past letters, you mentioned that you did not have any direct on-going contact with members of this particular family line. Although you did say that as far as you knew in 1987, Annie Ruth Upchurch in Highfalls, N.C. was still living. At one time, she was most helpful and interested in our family line. However, she did not respond to a letter I had written her a year or so ago. I have no idea as to why she didn't.

It was from Vickie Marie Barefoot that we received documents giving us conclusive proof that Kelly Upchurch was a son of Ruffin Upchurch. I wonder if she would have additional information on Kelly's three children on which we have only very limited information?

I will keep working on this end to make this family line as complete as possible. In the meantime, you are free to use any of the information in this outline as you would like.

It is WONDERFUL to be able to connect all of my lines, now, back to Moses (Ruffin U., Kelly U., John Winton U. Sr., John Winton U. Jr.) Without your help, I could have never done it. Thank you, again.

Dear Phil,

I am long overdue in thanking you for the telephone call last month telling me of the wonderful research Mrs. Scott Warren Gersh has been doing and of her breakthrough in finding positive evidence that Kelly Upchurch is definitely a son of Ruffin Upchurch. I was absolutely thrilled as was every member of my family! That was the one missing link to my line of heritage.

Thank you also for the wonderful Upchurch Bulletin of April 1989 (Volume 10, Number 2). I know that I have read and reread it at least a dozen times. I took the information you had recorded for the Moses/Ruffin Clan and Subclan in the Register of American Ancestors and plotted out family trees. It was done with much excitement.

In October and November of 1968 I was corresponding with a Miss Annie Ruth Upchurch, Box 62, Highfalls, N.C. 27259. Her grandfather was William Henry Upchurch. In her letter, she referred to Roland H. Upchurch of Highfalls, N.C. and Frank H. Upchurch of Robbins, N.C. as our uncles. At the time, she seemed quite interested in tracing our particular line, but somehow or other we stopped corresponding. I tried to resume correspondence ten years or so later, but there was no reply. I have no idea which one of William Henry Upchurch's seven sons would be her father. She did not say. My question to you is: Have you had any correspondence from any of the descendants from this particular family line?

I would really appreciate you letting me know just exactly what the positive evidence was that Mrs. Scott Warren Gersh found stating that Kelly U. is definitely a son of Ruffin Upchurch. I would like to include that proof in my geneological records. Maybe I could write the N.C. Archives for a photostatic copy of this document or perhaps Mrs. Gersh would be kind enough to send me a copy.

I am enclosing a card that may be of interest to you. It was sent to my brother. I received one, too, but did not know if this book would be of that much value to me. You probably have already received one through the mail, also.

Dear Phil,

Your letter was waiting for me upon our arrival home from our summer vacation in the Pacific Northwest. Thank you for all the time you spent in putting all the pieces of information together for me. I feel so helpless when I cannot offer you more bits and pieces to go on. However, I have done some work this summer which I will give in detail later on in this letter, but first to answer the questions in your letter and respond to your speculations.

1. I was elated when I read the material on Ruffin Upchurch which appeared in UB, Vol 5, No. 2. You did a beautiful job of putting all the information together that related to Ruffin. I am so glad that you included your speculations along with the facts.
2. In reference to the Charles Kelly Upchurch Jr. in Greensboro, N.C... There may be a connection between his family and mine. My father had a brother named James Franklin Upchurch, who had a son named  
A Charles Jack Upchurch
3. About the name Winton.... I had never heard that name before other than my Grandfather, John Winton U., who named my father, John Winton Jr. However my Dad changed his named (unofficially) at about the age of 12 to Julian Winton. He changed his name (according to my mother) because there was another man in town at that time with the name of John who had a notorious reputation throughout the area and my Dad did not like having the same name as this unsavory character.
4. I read through all the material that Byington sent you and did not see anything new on my family line. I was so in hopes that she would be able to make the connection of Kelly to Ruffin. I still feel that we will find it in time. Positive thinking!


During the summer, the attempts I made to connect Kelly Upchurch to Ruffin Upchurch are as follows:

1. I wrote the Clerk of Superior Court of Cumberland County Courthouse in Fayetteville, N.C. asking for them to check their indexes and send me a listing of any will or deed for the Upchurch surname for the period 1830-1870. Their reply was, "No record of wills."
2. I also wrote the Clerk of Superior Court, Harnett County, Lillington, N.C. for the same information. They wrote that they did not have any names for that period of time due to the courthouse burning in 1892 the last time.
3. I ordered a film from the Geneological Library here on Probate Records - Administrator's Records 1857-1868, Cumberland County, N.C. The film has not come in yet. I just called the library and they are trying to find out what happened to the order.

4. I have ordered from National Archives and Records Services the entire Pension Records file on Ruffin Upchurch from the War 1812 requested by Martha Goodwin, his second wife. I know that you already have this information but I thought maybe I would detect something extra when looking through the entire file. I should have this information within the week as they have already notified me they have located the file and for me to send the search fee, which I did.

Thank you again for all the help that you have given me over the years. Any further suggestions for searching my line, which you may have, would be appreciated.


