Hoses Up church sold in Franklin County, in 1803 to Thomas Gay 160 acres for 90 pounds. MOses must have moved to Chatham County about the year 180s; for the records at Pittsboro show that on July 25,1803 he purchased 555 acres from Joel Cook for 400 zounds. In 1807 he purchased 100 acres from Joseph Brankley. In 1823 he got 50 acres from the State in a Grant.
