Another factual item on a John U in Brunswick Co, VA
the time in 1765. From Order Book No 9 from 1765

"APRIL 1765 - Wm Persons & Peterson Tharp, Execr of
Timothy Tharp, Deed; Plts against John U¹⁷⁶⁵ Dft"

-- The attachment awarded against the Dft's estate being
returned executed on a spoon and the Dft not appearing
to in the same ?? solemnly called on the motion
of the Pet by his attorney it is considered by the
Court that the Pet recover against the Dft Ten pounds
five shillings the debt in the declaration mentioned
and his costs by him ~~on~~ ⁱⁿ his behalf expended and
the said Dft in Mercy & C. But the judgement
(the costs excepted) is to be discharged by the payment
of Five pounds Two shillings and six pence and ~~plus~~ ^{less}
interest for the same - to be computed after the rate
of five percentum per annum from the 14th day of
JUL 1763 till payment & by consent & parties it is
ordered that the attached effects be released "

Ray says "There is no indication that the party as
John is deceased (in 1765) and the circumstances very
much resemble the procedure against the John in 1756.
At that time the Plaintiff, John Madin, was awarded
10 sh 6 schillings & $\frac{1}{2}$ penny, & the son James U declared
that he had his father (John U) possession consisting
of one old pair of harness, 3 bottles, one old rags, and a spoon".

A quick ch of Brunswick Co, VA will & probate records
revealed no Timothy Tharp estate nor were there conveyance
for him. I will the Southampton Co, VA. Clearly some
proceedings were initiated against the John U during
1760-1765, for which period records are missing.

whether there are two people or the same person with
the name repeated is unclear. They will be
identified as John U A and John U B for the
present - R.P.A

Prior research have concluded that the William
U alone is William U, II (XID-161) - a 4th generation U
& son of James d. I.

The only John U on the current chart outline
of the first six generations of U in America that
would fit a John U to sign an oath 30 MAY 1778
would be John U, III (XID-151) - Head of clan son
of James U, III. He had previously been known in VA
and later was in Chatham Co, NC but this is the
first placing of him in Granville Co, NC. Is this
placement valid? [JOHN U, III b abt 1741 hence age 37 in 1778]

As to a second John U {John U B}↑ John U, I
& John U, II d 1778, John U, II was not old enough
to have signed an oath in 1778. If John U B↑ exists he is
not on the 6 generations chart and must be a new
4th or 5th generation U
