3 Thomas Upchurch born ca 1788 VA died prior to 10-24-1855. He did not marry. On 12-17-1832 he has a land grant from the "Grants West of the Tennessee River" of 120 acres. On 3-10-1829 Miles Keeton and Rebecca his wife sell to Thomas Upchurch 100 acres of land for \$500 on head waters of Little South Fork. Reg. 9-22-1829. Bk E-113. No date on this deed, recorded in Bk M 208 places it before 1854: Roswell Marsh sells to Thomas Upchurch for \$10 fifty acres on LSF head waters. Wit: James Upchurch, William Chriswell. Thomas' last land deal was made in 1849 reg. Bk L-213 1-27-1851; James Crabtree sells to Thomas Upchurch for \$1100 fifty acres. Wit: John W. Marion and Washington Young.

Thomas usually had one of his brother's sons helping on the farm. He left a will, written 5-18-1853 Proved 10-24-1855: Brother John, brother Joseph, nephew Silas Upchurch, nephew Archibald Dishman, nephew Joseph Dishman, niece Sinah Brown, balance of estate to be divided between brothers Shadrack and Moses. ↑ Exec. brother, John Upchurch. Wit: Joel Keeton, Cyrus Keeton, W.G. Redmond. Signed, Thomas Upchurch. → PG 70

4 Moses Upchurch born 1790 NC probable in Iredell County. He died about 1859. Moses did not apply for a land grant in KY. In 1820 he was still in Iredell Co. NC. In 1838, Jan. 25, Deed Bk D-343, John Upchurch sells to Moses Upchurch for \$200 75 acres on Otter Creek. Reg. 4-12-1838. Moses md Catherine (Katie) Barker in NC. She was the daughter of either John Barker or Solomon Barker of Iredell Co. NC. Moses and his brother Shadrack followed the family names in naming their children. Each had a son George; a son Thomas; Moses had a son Shadrack, Shadrack had a son Moses. No daughter Rachel was found for Moses, the dau Rachel of Shadrack was with him on the 1850 Census. Katie Barker was born in 1795 VA. She was with her son John after Moses died.

- 17 Thomas Upchurch b 1815 NC md (1) Sophia Prewitt b 1815 d 2-8-1852 daughter of Samuel and Elizabeth Prewitt. Thomas m(2) Mary Grimes nee Marsh, thought to be a sister of David Marsh.
- 18 Nancy Mason Upchurch b 4-20-1816 died about 1883 KY. md Silas Upchurch.
- 19 Millie Upchurch b ca 1817 NC md Moses Dishman b ca 1817 NC son of Jefferson and Lydia (Upchurch) Dishman.

John Williams seems to be a brother of Keeling Williams. His wife Lydia and Moses, father of George, were brother and sister. In 1860 George is head of his own house on the Fentress Census. In January, 1859, George began disposing of his property, getting ready to go elsewhere. He sold some town lots to Jeremiah Smith which included the lots where 'George W. Upchurch now lives'. A deed made in Jan., 1860 seems to be the last deed. He migrated with his family to parts unknown.
- 25 Shadrack Thomas Upchurch b 1831 KY d ca 1900 in MO. md 1851 Louisa Jane Craig b 1828 KY. They were md by Calvin Smith of Fentress, TN. Shadrack served in the Civil War, Union Army from 10-19-1863 to 15 September, 1865, Co. I, 39th KY Regt. His application for a pension was made in Douglas Co. MO where he and brother John were before 1880.
- 26 John Upchurch b 1834 KY md Louisa Woods dau of John Woods. They migrated to Missouri with Shadrack after the 1870 census was taken. Catherine, widow of Moses, was making her home with John in 1860. John and Louisa with their children were in Douglas Co. MO in the town of Ava which is near Springfield, MO. Descendants are living today in Ava and Springfield.

Fourth Generation in America

Since much research on the Upchurch Family of Virginia and North Carolina has been completed, I am starting with George and Rachel Upchurch. This is a listing of their descendents. George and Rachel moved from Virginia to North Carolina and then on to Wayne County, Kentucky. All of their children moved to Wayne County, Kentucky and several moved from Wayne County, Kentucky to Fentress County, Tennessee.

3. George Upchurch was born about 1757 in Brunswick County, Virginia and died 1830-31 in Wayne County, Kentucky. His wife was Rachel Bethshares who was born about 1759 Brunswick County, Virginia. Rachel was the daughter of Thomas and Ruth Bethshares. George and Rachel were listed in the tax list of Brunswick County, Virginia in 1782 & 1788. They were living near his father Michael and Uncle James Upchurch in 1782 and 1788.

George and Rachel moved to Salisbury district, Iredell County, North Carolina before 1790. They were listed in the 1790 census of Iredell County, North Carolina with 4 sons under 16 and 1 daughter. They were also listed in the census records of 1800 and 1810 living in Iredell County, North Carolina. George sold his land in North Carolina to his sons, Moses, Thomas and Shadrack and moved to Wayne County, Kentucky.

George received his land grant of 100 acres on Little South Fork, Kentucky on 10-12-1814. He was listed in the census records of 1820 Wayne County, Kentucky. Listed in his household were 2 males 18-25, 1 male 26-44, 1 male 45+, 1 female 45+, there were 4 individual engaged in agriculture. George and Rachel are buried at the Little South Fork Cemetery in Cumberland County, Kentucky. Their children:

They were listed in the census records of 1810 Iredell County, North Carolina. Moses and Catherine had moved to Wayne County, Kentucky since they were listed in the 1830 and 1850 census of Wayne County, Kentucky. Catherine is listed with son John in 1860. Their children

James/Thomas, Dishman married Kiziah (possibly Doublehead) (1755-1850) (Guion Miller Rolls gives his name as James Dishman,)

Jefferson Dishman married Lydia Upchurch about 1802 in Virginia. She was daughter of George Upchurch and Rachel Bethshares.

Their known 11 children and their spouses:

Mary/Polly Jane Dishman (12-21-1803-1843) and Charles Campbell Ramsey married 01-21-1827 in Morgan Co, TN. His parents were William Ramsey and Catherine Gray

Sinah "Siney Brown" Dishman (1805-07-16-1870 married Riley Brown (1824-11-19-1857) His parents: Abraham Brown and (?).

Archibald Dishman (12-18-1806-06-22-1879) married Jane Cooper (05-04-1804-04 Jul 1879)

Marcus/"Markey" Dishman (1807-1894) married Serilda Martha Smith (1813-1869) Her parents: William and Mary (?) Smith.

Mr. Asahel Dishman (1808-?)

Thomas Jefferson Dishman (1809-1860) married Elizabeth (?) (1809-?)

Milus/"Miles" Dishman (1811-1880) married Susannah Raines (1816-1858). Milus' second wife was Margaret McCulley (1830-1880)

Joseph Dishman (06-12-1812-11-08-1903) married Millie Ann Williams (1817-1880).

Joseph's second marriage was to Rhoda Gooding (12-?-1839-1900). Rhoda's parents: William and Mary (?) Gooding.

Elender/"Nellie" Dishman (09-27-1814-?)

Moses Dishman (1817-08-?-1864) married Millie Upchurch (1817-1861). His parents: Moses Upchurch and Catherine Barker

Burrel/"Big Bird" Tremont Dishman (10-27-1820-05-23-1901) married Nancy Upchurch (04-09-1825-1884) on 22 Nov 1843 Her parents: John C. Upchurch and Sarah Bertram

Many of these Dishman families lived in Dry Holler in the southern part of Wayne County and Tennessee.
