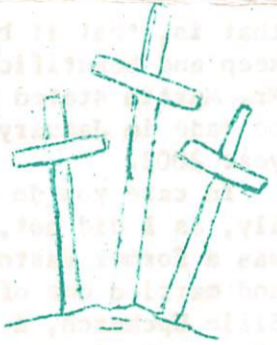

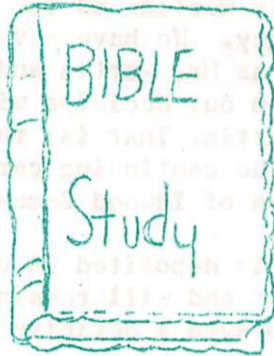

CARE, UPKEEP AND BEAUTIFICATION OF INWOOD CEMETARY - This is possibly the best means to announce what early planning by a friend of Inwood has done toward remembering the heritage left by those who have gone before.

On March 18, 1977, (Mr. T. King Martin) presented to Inwood, through a meeting with this writer, a check in the amount of \$2,000 as the first two of \$1,000 annual gifts to us for the upkeep and care of our cemetery. Mr. Martin is the executor of the estate of Dr. James Martin, Jr. and is complying with the terms of Dr. Martin's will. These monies have only one stipulation, and that is, that it be used for the care, upkeep and beautification of our cemetery. Mr. Martin stated the annual bequests would be made in January of each year through the year 2002.

In case you do not know the Martin family, as I did not, Rev. James Martin, Sr. was a former Pastor - 1902-1907, who met and married one of Inwood's fair ladies, Ellie Upchurch, a sister of Miss Maude and others. Moving on to the Lumberton area and later farther south into South Carolina. He had reserved a burial plot in our cemetery and consequently he and the wife were buried in the same plot, with space for the remaining son. This remaining son has relinquished this space to the heirs of Dr. James Martin and it is their intention that this be used for the interment of their mother, Mrs. James Martin, Jr.

This fund - call it what you will - gift, bequest, donation or what - will be on the agenda of our Deacons meeting, April. We hope to make definite recommendations to the church following this meeting as to how best to use this money. We have several options open to us as Mr. Martin and I discussed. Uppermost in our decision will be the request of Dr. Martin. That is: that this money be used for the continuing care, upkeep and beautification of Inwood Cemetery.

Presently, the money is deposited in our Pass-book Savings Account and will remain until the church has approved a definite plan of distribution.

A note of thanks to all who helped make our Centennial Celebration a success. Also, our sincere thanks for Bros. Cain, Victor Dowd and Bennett Straughn and all who participated in our recent Revival. Our prayer is that we at Inwood may go forward in our zeal for lost people and the Christian fellowship at Inwood. Yours in Christ, Robert L. Baird, Chmn. Deacons

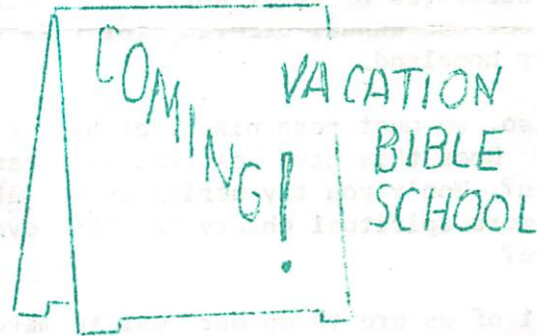

Uncle James & Aunt Tammie separated but never divorced since he did not believe in divorce.
