Thanks Phil for the post. I give you a hearty well done. This is the type of historical information I like and wish I had more of.

I live in Fentress County TN and my grandfather used to tell me that a trail in the woods about 1/2 mile south of the present Jamestown city limits was a fairly major Indian road east and west. I can't add any more to what you told about the Old KY Road.

I do know that the Old Walton Road crossed from approximately Clarkrange (?) and on to Monterey. The famous Standing Stone, a large natural (?) monument looking like a dog standing on his back "honches", used to be just to the west of Monterey and was a gathering place for Indian Tribes. I believe I remember reading that the Old Walton road ran down Brotherton Mountain and into present day Cookeville where it intersected with the road you mentioned.

some of your Bertram information on the Eleanor Louise (Baker) Bertram who researched her husband's Bertram line of Wayne Co, KY. We'll see if she has a response.

As promised, I looked up my Rogers book to see if I could connect any in it with your Rogers line. I found no such connection. This Rogers family lived near Upland in VA, NC & TN but I have never been able to connect the two families. As far as I can tell none of this Rogers family got to Wayne Co, KY. Enclosed are four pages from the book. Let me know if you want more information.

Thanks for the information on the scanner.

I want to make sure some Upland information gets in the Wayne Co Heritage Book. I'll contact Cousin Melva and see how to proceed.

It is wonderful that the Wayne Co Historical Society has acquired the old Hotel. Over the years this should prove to be a big boost to history interests in the county.

Based on our discussion I am prepared to donate a full set of the Upland Bulletin and England's to the Wayne Co Historical Society. I understand that they will have to be stored until space

is available in the renovated Hotel. Can you have someone from the Historical Society (you perhaps?) and let me know that this donation will be acceptable, or I would be glad to write a more formal letter to the Society making this offer. We would start sending current issues and then send back issues over time as we are making bulk mailings. The normal sales value of this donation for the Uplands Bulletin 1980-1999 would be \$400 and for four years of Englandia \$40.

In view of the above anticipated arrangement do you suppose the Historical Society could arrange to copy a small amount of material from their files for me? I am thinking for the moment about the Uplands Outtakes you showed me. They would be quite useful to me.

In the next Uplands Bulletin I will be reporting on our trip to Wayne Co, KY. This report will tell the overall story of George Uplund who came to Wayne Co, KY. I'll send you a personal copy and perhaps copies could also be placed on the shelves in the Historical Society and in the Wayne Co Public Library.

We found Wayne County to be a beautiful place and these days to be a prosperous area. There are lots of very nice homes in the county.

About ten of us had a nice field trip to the Little South Fork River where George Uphurch settled. Milton Roberts owns the land where the Uphurch cemetery is located. He escorted us to the cemetery and we observed the inscribed monument for Ruth Uphurch, who was the daughter-in-law of the original settler - George. This site was just a few hundred yards south of the old Parsonly School which was still in operation in 1929.

It is hard to tell where our continued effort to document the Uphurch Family of Wayne Co, KY will lead us - but it is an exciting venture. Thank you again for your help and for your upbeat approach to family history.
