Children of Michael (3) Upchurch, son of James 1 1. GEORGE UPCHURCH, born in VA about 1757, probably in the County of Brunswick, died in Wayne Co. KY 1830/31. He md Rachel Bethshares of VA, dau of Thomas and Ruth Bethshares. Thomas Bethshares was the Administrator for the estate of Michael Upchurch (3) when Michael died in 1795. The recorded history of George and his family begins with the taxes of the first levy of 1782. George was living in the sixth Dist of Brunswick, also in that district were Michael 3 and Jas. 2 By 1788, Michael was preparing to leave Virginia. He scemed to own no land, paying personal property taxes only. and his father, Michael 3, were the only taxable Upchurches remaining in the district. Another probable son of Michael, Sherwood Upchurch, was already in Rutherford Co. NC. Elizabeth Upchurch, a sister of George, married 11-27-1786 Thomas Bethshares. They were md by Rev. John King, Bantist. (Bruns. Co. VA Marriages, compiled by Knorr).

George and his family were in Iredell, NC before 1790. are listed on the Census of the Salisbury District with four sons under age 16 and one daughter. Later, the family was called back to VA for an appearance in Chancery Court. A suit had been filed by the Bethshares children, of whom Rachel was one, against John H. Bass the Adm, and the widow, Elizabeth Bethshares to require them to settle the estate of Thomas Bethshares, dec'd. (Bruns. Order Bk. 18, 2-25-1799). The Bethshares children are identified: Ruth Bethshares; George Upchurch and Rachel his wife, late Rachel Bethshares; Thomas Moseley and Tabitha his wife, late Tabitha Bethshares; Thomas Linch and Elizabeth his wife, late Elizabeth Bethshares; Patsy Bethshares; Jesse Bethshares; Milliam Bethshares; Molly Bethshares, and Sally Rethshares. Two daughters of the James Upchurch 3 family married into the Moseley family, Tabitha Bethshares md Thomas Moseley. Thomas Moseley patented land in 1746: 400 acres on Pea Hill Creek. William Moseley patented land in 1755, 684 A. both sides Lizard Creek, adjoining John Lynch. John Randle was a neighbor with 470 acres on Lightfoot's Creek. William Eaton patented land-325 acres on south side of Moore's Swamp; Rich Moore had 450 acres on north side of Roanoke River and east side of Pea Hill Creek. Asa Holloway lived on Pea Hill Creek and Daniel Hufflived in the vicinity. All were neighbors: The Upchurches, Holloways, Moseleys, the Bethshares.

The Chancery Court ruled that the land must be sold and the proceeds divided. Allen Love purchased the land for 815,10%. There are a number of marriages in the Bethshares family recorded by Knorr: Thomas Moseley -Tabitha Bethshares 11-24-88, Tabitha, age 21, dau od Thomas, surety John Moseley. Wit: James Huff. By Rev. John King, Baptist p 51. Betsy Shell, married 11-24-1795 James Bethshares (Beshears) when she was twenty-one. James was not mentioned as a son of Thomas. Thomas Moore and Lucy Shell were witnesses. George Hermon and Nancy Bethshares, dau of Ruth, md 11-5-1800 surety Wm. Bethshares by Balaam Ezell, Baptist. Nancy, diminutive of Ann, not named in court order. Possibly the younger children were not named. The surname 'Hermon' may be Harmon.

George Upchurch and family returned to Iredell County after the court settlement and appeared on the 1800 census there. George and Rachel, ages 26-45; two sons 16-26; one son 10-16, 2 sons under 10, a dau 16-26 and a dau 10-16. How sad not to have the children listed by name! One day cannot be identified, one son cannot be found .. (The purchase or land grant for George's land has not been found. There is a record of the sale of that land recorded in Iredell Co. Deed Bks. G, and H. George Upchurch sells to Moses Upchurch (his son): This Indenture (mane) 16 Feb. 1810 for 100 L...all that tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Iredell on the north side of Rocky Creek adjoining Rubin Fletcher's line.. Bogle's line.. in the Trumpet Meadow. Land consisting of 124 acres, more or less. George Upchurch, his mark. Wit: Julius Keeton, John Johnson. Proved 19 March, 1810., John Nesbit, clerk.

George Upchurch to Thomas Upchurch (a son) 113 A. Brother's line..Bogle's line..in the Trumpet Meadow. Proved 19 Mar 1310 George Upchurch to Shadrack Upchurch (a son) 113 A 3-19-1810. George Upchurch to Abel Sheriff..100 A...Whitehead's corner post Oak..to a chestnut on the mountain in Griffith's line. Proved 4-1-1816. William Allen Jurat, James Hartness.. George Upchurch, his mark. George was disposing of his land preparing to move on into Kentucky, the Promised Land.His sons Moses, Shadrack and Thomas were the buyers. They soon sold the land and were in Kentucky with their father. Abel Sherrif does not seem to be related. Between the years of the first sale in 1810 and the one in 1813 the monetary system changed from pounds to dollars. The price of land seemed to be stable at one dollar per acre.

Wilson Rouse Jillson's book The Kentucky Land Grants describes the Grants where the land of George Upchurch was located: This small and unique group of land grants recorded between the years 1803 and 1853 embraces the grants issued upon warrants from the Register of the Land Office upon what is known as the Tellico Claims. They apply to lands ceded to the United States by the Cherokee Indians under the treaty of 1805. There are 572 grants in the Tellico records, the surveys of this system being recorded in a book labeled "Tellico Surveys No. 1". Of the 572 grants, George Upchurch was issued Grant #58 by the Circuit Court of Wayne County, July, 1913,...100 acres bearing date Oct. 12, 1814..on the Little South Fork.. bounded as followeth to wit: Beginning at Miler Keaton's corner a White Oak thence south 62 and west 120 poles to a Beech and White Oak thence south 12 and west 60 poles to a large Walnut and Sugartree thence south 60 poles east 165 poles to a stake binding on Keaton line to the beginning...By the Governor, Isaac Shelby..D.W. Hardin, Sec. This deed for the homestead on the Little South Fork of the Cumberland River calls attention to the large number of trees of different kinds in Kentucky, also to the absence of neighbors.

It must have been a remote and beautiful country when George and his family arrived in 1812 or 1813. The Kentucky Gazette carried an article datelined 12-22-1796 which generally sums up the way people felt about Kentucky (and still do): "Moses Austin arrived in Standford, Ky after two weeks on the Wilderness Trail. Austin noted that the tide of migration had not abated. He was moved by their pathetic faith in what they would find at the end of the journy. Ask these Pilgrims what they expect when they git to Kentucky and the Answer is Land. have you any. No, but I expect I can git it. have you anything to pay for land. No. did you ever see the Country. No but everybody says it is good land. can anything be more Absurd the the Conduct of man, here is hundreds Traveling hundreds of Miles, they know not for what Nor Whither, except its to Kentucky, passing land almost as good and easy obtained, the Proprietors of which would gladly give on any terms, but it will not do its not Kentucky, its not the Promised Land." At any rate, this was the land that George and Rachel had been seeking. They arrived in KY in about 1811, the land was surveyed and in 1814 it was theirs. A forest of trees of many kinds produced wood for houses and barns, fuel to warm the house and for cooking. Clear, unpoluted streams gave many kinds of

wild game roamed the countryside. Kitchen gardens flourished. Tobacco was laid by. Houses began to appear on the Ridge above the Cumberland.

fresh water fish for the table, carried logs to the sawmill.

George and Rachel lived a full and eventful life on the LSF until his death in 1830/31. After his death, the land was sold and the proceeds divided. Shadrack, one of the sons, bought the land from the other heirs. The names of those who sold the land and the buyer are recorded in Wayne County Deed Book F, page 27: "John Upchurch, Joseph Upchurch, Jeptha Dishman, Thomas Upchurch, Moses Upchurch, and Keeling Williaims sell to Shadrack Upchurch..a grant bearing date of October 12, 1814, 100 acres Little South Fork, Miler Kaeton's corner...proved 8-13-1831. Wit: Moses Upchurch." All of the signers made their marks except Joseph Upchurch, the youngest son. He signed his name. Whenevr a sale of land was taking place, it was customary for the clerk to find out if the sale was agreeable to the wife, and sign her name with her husband's. This evidently was not done, so another opportunity was lost to find out the

given name of the Upchurch daughter who married Keeling Williams. Lydia was the wife of Jeptha (Jefferson) Dishman.

George and Rachel Upchurch were settled on the land at Little South Fork in Wayne Co. KY by 1814. George, one of the sons of Michael Upchurch (3), had moved on for the last time. He was of the fifth Generation of Upchurches in America. His friends and neighbors on the LSF with the dates of their land patents were: Wm. Bell 1814; Jacob Bertram, 1815; Isaac Cooper, 1815; Azariah Denney, 1814; Fleming Gregory, 1813; Miles Keeton, 1815; John Parmley, 1810 and George Upchurch, 1814.

Children of George Upchurch:

- 1 Lydia Upchurch born about 1782 in VA, died about 1848 md Jefferson Dishman d about 1847. Jeffery Dishman was counted on the census of Wayne Co. KY in 1820. He lists his wife, age 26-45 years; himself as 45 or up; Two persons, ages 45 up were with them, possibly the parents of Jefferson Dishman. He bought land in Wayne: "Jeptha Dishman buys from Abraham Van Winkle 50 acres in Sandy Valley on Otter Creek. Wit: Moses and Archibald Dishman. 3-24-1836 recorded Bk H 2, page 429 on 4-15-1836. This is the same land that Jefferson sold to Moses Dishman on 10-7-1842. The taxes must not have been paid for the land was sold on the courthouse steps. a deed reads: Jefferson Dishman, my late husband, sold 10-7-1842, fifty acres; now I, Lydia Dizmonz, sell to Moses Dishman. Lydia Dizmonz, her mark. Another deed made by John Upchurch restores the land to Lydia who then was able to deed it to Moses Dishman, for whom Jefferson had intended it: John Upchurch to Lydia Dishman and her three children, minor heirs, Catherine, Jane, and Jefferson T. Dishman, on waters of Otter Creek, bing part of the land that was sold by the sheriff at the Courthouse door in favor of Thomas Jones and against Jefferson Dishman and by Micajah Phillips-transferred to John Upchurch on 22 of February, 1847. Three months later Lydia had transferred the land to Moses Dishman.
- 2 Shadrack Upchurch b 1784 VA died about 1863. md Ruth...b 1784 NC died March, 1860. The Federal Death List for 1860 lists her age as 76, cause of death "old age". Shadrack bought land on LSF and was near his parents throughout their lifetime. Shadrack bought land for \$10. by purchasing a warrant for 50 acres in the land distribution act passed in 1815 by KY: Upchurch, Chadrick 50 A. BK M page 49 on 4-10-1822 Wayne County on Muddy Fork of South Fork. It was Shadrack who bought the land from the heirs of George Upchurch when George's estate was settled. On the 1850 Wayne Census he had a daughter Rachel, at home and a son, Joseph. In 1860 after the death of Ruth in March, he was at home with a daughter and granddaughter looking after him.

Shadrack and Ruth reared a large family on the LSF. Houses were built along the ridge above the river. Later the settlement was to be known as Mount Pisgah, Kentucky.

3 Thomas Upchurch born ca 1788 VA died prior to 10-24-1855. He did not marry. On 12-17-1832 he has a land grant from the "Grants West of the Tennessee River" of 120 acres. On 3-10-1829 Miles Keeton and Rebecca his wife sell to Thomas Upchurch 100 acres of land for \$500 on head waters of Little South Fork. Reg. 9-22-1829.Bk E-113. No date on this deed, recorded in Bk M 208 places it before 1854: Roswell Marsh sells to Thomas Upchurch for \$10 fifty acres on LSF head waters. Wit: James Upchurch, William Chriswell. Thomas last land deal was made in 1849 reg. Bk L-213 1-27-1851; James Crabtree sells to Thomas Upchurch for \$1100 fifty acres. Wit: John W.Marion and Washington Young.

Thomas usually had one of his brother's sons helping on the farm. He left a will, written 5-18-1853 Proved 10-24-1855: Brother John, brother Joseph, nephew Silas Upchurch, nephew Archibald Dishman, nephew Joseph Dishman, niece Sinah Brown, balance of estate to be divided between brothers Shadrack and Moses. Exec. brother, John Upchurch. Wit: Joel Keeton, Cyrus Keeton, W.G. Redmond. Signed, Thomas Upchurch.

- 4 Moses Upchurch born 1790 NC probable in Iredell County. He died about 1859. Moses did not apply for a land grant in KY. In 1820 he was still in Iredell Co. NC. In 1838, Jan. 25, Deed Bk D-343, John Upchurch sells to Moses Upchurch for \$200 75 acres on Otter Creek. Reg. 4-12-1838. Moses md Catherine (Katie) Barker in NC. She was the daughter of either John Barker or Solomon Barker of Iredell Co. NC. Moses and his brother Shadrack followed the family names in naming their children. Each had a son George; a son Thomas; Moses had a son Shadrack, Shadrack had a son Moses. No daughter Rachel was found for Moses, the dau Rachel of Shadrack was with him on the 1850 Census. Katie Barker was born in 1795 VA. She was with her son John after Moses died.
- 5 The 1790 Census of Iredell Co. for George Upchurch carried two tally marks for two females; one wife, one daughter. So, the earliest date for the next daughter's birth had to be 1792, for Moses was born in 1790. Her name has not been found. It is almost sure to be Rachel, after her mother. There were only two daughters . To identify this daughter, she will be known as 'Rachel'. It may be that someone will have her given name recorded, in some place. 'Rachel' Upchurch, born ca 1792 died early in her married life. married Keeling Williams who possibly is the progenitor of the Williams families of Wolf River. Keeling, also called Keeton, Kelon, Keelon Williams received a land grant for 50 acres of land on the North Fork of the LSF 5-1-1822, Bk M p51. The land was sold to Hiram Upchurch on 2-25-1843 for \$100. In 1839 Keeling bought land on Beaver Creek (Bk 4-532). 'Rachel' died sometime before 1844. Keeling Williams m 5-18-1845 Dorothy McClendon. The land on Beaver Creek was sold to George Upchurch for \$12.50 9-24-1846. The deed was signed by Keelon Williams and Dorothy Williams, his wife. If his first wife's name had been included on the deed where he sold their share of her father's land to Shadrack Upchurch, we would know her first name. John Williams on the 1850 Census of Fentress Co.

seems to be a brother of Keeling Williams. John Williams, b ca 1794 married 3-20-1817 Lavina Bertram dau of Jacob Bertram. Keeling was born ca 1792. In 1850 George Upchurch was making his home with John and Lavina Williams. George was a son of Moses Upchurch who was a brother of 'Rachel's.

Diligent search has not found sons of Keeling Williams, although there is a listing for Keeling on the Census of Overton Co. TN in 1820 of two males under ten years of age. There is also an 1820 Census of Wayne Co. KY on which he lists 3 females between 10 and 16 years. The 1830 Fentress Co. TN Census: Keeland Williams 1 male 30-40; 1f between 30 and 40; 2f 10-15; 3f 5-10; 2f under 5 years of age. So it seems that 'Rachel and Keeland Williams had at least seven daus, only two of them are identified.

6 John Upchurch was born about 1799 in North Carolina. He died prior to 23 June, 1873, when his will was proved. John md Sarah Bertram, daughter of Nicholas Bertram. He was 73 years old when he died. John had many land dealings, taking care of his children and looking out for those less fortunate. He had a strong sense of family pride and loyalty. Here are some of his land deeds: John and Sally Dearing sell to John Upchurch ...land on Otter Creek October 11, 1828 recorded 3-18-1844 Bk J-283. Nicholas Kenaston and wife Katie Kenaston of Fentress County sell to John Upchurch for \$150..100 acres on LSF. Bk D 478. John Upchurch to Moses Upchurch 75 A. Otter Creek. 1-25-1838 G-343. The 1850 Census of Wayne Co. KY and the will of John Upchurch gives a record of the family. In 1850 Nicholas Bertram was making his home with John and Sarah. John's will written in 1868 names the married daughters. His will was proved 6-23-1873.

7 Joseph Upchurch born 8-10-1800 NC died ca 1865. Joseph m 3-2-1823 Jane Crouch. At an early age, Joseph began acquiring land, most of which fell into Tennessee later. He bought 50 acres on Rotten's Fork in Wayne County KY for \$10, part of the Kentucky Land Act, passed in the year 1815, called the Land Distribution Act. This Act offered land for \$20 per 100 acres. This part of KY fell into TN in 1823 and Joseph became known as Tennessee Joe. The year also happened to coincide with the year of his marriage. Joseph Upchurch was a fair minded citizen of Fentress County and a kind father and husband. He was public spirited and was soon called for civic duty. He served on juries, was a Justice of the Peace, on many of the marriages of Fentress County gave those his name marriages a head start. The Upchurch Cemetery at Pall Mall was set aside by Joseph. One of the graves in the center of the cemetery is the grave of Joseph Upchurch. A simple rock, uninscribed, marks his grave. This land is his land and ever shall be.

Fourth Generation in America

Since much research on the Upchurch Family of Virginia and North Carolina has been completed, I am starting with George and Rachel Upchurch. This is a listing of their descendents. George and Rachel moved from Virginia to North Carolina and then on to Wayne County, Kentucky. All of their children moved to Wayne County, Kentucky and several moved from Wayne County, Kentucky to Fentress County, Tennessee.

3. George Upchurch was born about 1757 in Brunswick County, Virginia and died 1830-31 in Wayne County, Kentucky. His wife was Rachel Bethshares who was born about 1759 Brunswick County, Virginia. 

The Upchurch family was one of the first to settle what was later to become Fentress County, Tenn. When they first arrived and acquired land, part of the northern section of Fentress County was then part of Wayne county, Kentucky.

Most, if not all, of the Upchurches in Fentress county today are descendants of George Upchurch who settled on the Little South Fork of the Cumberland River, near the chimney Rock, Wayne county, Kentucky, in the year 1810. George and his wife, Rachel, came from Virginia to Iredell County, North Carolina, before 1790. There is evidence that George visited our area sometime in the 1780's - probably hunting. He returned, looking for land, in 1805 when the Cherokee Nation ceded, under the Tellico Treaty, their lands west of the Tennessee River to the United States. He moved his family to the Little south Fork in 1810. In 1814 he received a grant, number 58 of 572 Tellico Claims grants, for 100 acres on the Little south Fork, Wayne County, Kentucky.

The youngest son of George, Joseph bought 50 acres of land on the Rottens Fork section of Wolf River in 1815. This land became part of Tennessee in 1823 and later Fentress County. Joseph set aside the Upchurch Cemetery in Pall Mall.

The Upchurch family came to America from England. George Upchurch was a fifth generation American. They have served in all our country's wars, including the Revolution and on both sides in the Civil War. Contributed by Willie Upchurch

UPCHURCH FAMILY

The Upchurch family of Travisville and Forbus are descendants of Michael Upchurch, who came from England to Virginia about 1654. One of their ancestors, George Upchurch, was a soldier of the Revolutionary War and was at Valley Forge under General George Washington. The Upchurches came to the Pickett area soon after 1800. From that time on they have contributed to the history of the area. Joseph Upchurch was a member of the Fentress County Court in 1813; George Washington Upchurch was a deputy Fentress clerk in 1856; Drewry and Henderson Upchurch fought for the Union under Captain "Tinker" Dave Beatty in the Civil War; Grady Upchurch (1902-65) was tax assessor of Pickett and was a member of the Pickett County Court at his death.

Thomas Bethshares was Administrator for the Estate of Michael Upchurch III when he died in 1795. I believe it was Thomas Bethshares Senior who died in 1799, not a Thomas Jr. as he was not mentioned in the Chancery Court proceedings of the Children of Thomas Bethshares (Bruns, Order Bk. 18, 2-25-1799) Elizabeth, his wife, may have been a second marriage, or she could have been a widow of an Upchurch, as Ruth was his first wife, deceased before, 25 February 1786. Thomas Jr. he would have not been married long enough to have adult married children as designated in the Suit against John Bass and widow, Elizabeth Bethshares. It gave his children as follows: Ruth Bethshares; George Upchurch and Rachel his wife, late Rachel Bethshares; (daughter of Thomas and Ruth); Thomas Moseleyand Tabitha his wife, late Tabitha Bethshares. Thomas Linch and Elizabeth his wife, late Elizabeth Bethshares; Patsy Bethshares; Jesse Bethshares, (male?); William Bethshares; Molly Bethshares; and Sally Bethshares. (This is an assessment of this family as I see it; Eleanor L. Bertram)

Upchurch

In 1790 the U.S. Census, Iredell County, Salisbury District, N.C. reveals that one George Upchurch was residing in the said County and State. This George Upchurch seems to have been the George Upchurch who married Rachel Bethshares and disappears from the Tax Lists in Brunswick County, Virginia after 1788. There seems to be no evidence that the said George Upchurch owned land in Brunswick.

It seems to me that George Upchurch was the son of the Elizabeth Upchurch who married Thomas Bethshares in 1786. (Three men by the name of James Upchurch died between 1762 and 1784 all leaving widows named Elizabeth) Michael was also her son as Thomas Bethshares was the Administrator of Michael's estate. Michael died Oct 24, 1795. No record of marriage for Michael has been uncovered to this time. Michael Upchurch sold the 200 acres of land left by the will of his father in 1765. Michael's father James had purchased these 200 acres in 1762 and Michael sold them in 1793 to Greif Harwell.

My original source of information about the Upchurch family of Wayne County, Kentucky, Fentress County, Tennessee, and Pickett County, Tennessee was my Uncle Shelly Crouch. Uncle Shelly was my father's eldest brother.

Uncle Shelly was reared in the Pickett County, Tennessee and the Fentress County, Tennessee area. He joined the US Navy in the early 1930s. Uncle Shelly retired from the US Navy in the mid 1950s. He returned to Pickett County, Tennessee and lived the rest of his life there. Uncle Shelly knew from personal memories his generation, his father's generation and parts of his grandfather's generation. Most of his material has been correct.


