of real interest that could be gleaned, or I should say, that the county historian and I could find. We did determine Joseph died intestate, and Ambrose U., Joseph's son, was appointed as administrator of his estate. Ambrose died before the estate was finalized and his brother Felix G. U was appointed to administer both estates.

I have a copy of the microfilm of the court records but they are basically illegible. The film is of the original documents, and they were in a building which caught on fire and the pages were waterlogged and as a result the paper is discolored and the ink was not stable.

I did find the records of land transactions regarding the Upchurch clan in Dekalb county, but as is always the case of that era, the descriptions were from such and so rock to some tree and thence to somebody else's boundry.

I also determined Joseph was probably not buried in a cemetery and there was no headstone to mark his grave. Pretty much felt like I struck out on this trip, but am going to try to get to Rutherford County NC later this Summer in hopes of finding something to give me direction.

Thanks for your emails of the 15th and 16th. I had trouble printing a readable copy of the attachments so called upon my wife who is a notch swifter than I am on computers. After about two hours of fiddling she got excellent copies. That is the good news. The bad is that we leave next Wednesday for three weeks in NC and I am substantially over booked on things to do before we leave. So, I will have to defer going into depth on the aspects you have raised until we return. Even then I know we will be pressed to catch up on "stuff" when we return. So please be patient with me

The above being said I do have a plan. I have a geographical file. For TN I have a general file and then special files on counties. So far I have four -Jackson, Henry, Greene and Fentress. I now need, with your help, to create a Dekalb County file and to put in it what we know about Upchurch history there. There a several ways you need to organize family history information and sometimes you just need to have a County perspective. It is time consuming but really helpful.

Also, I need to update my summary of just which issues of the UB contain materials about Joseph U b 1775. Then I can tell if the issues you have include all of the references to him.

The same can be said for Rutherford County, NC. I do have a file for it and need to study what is in it, hopefully before you make your trip there this summer. My guess is that you will find no living people with the name Upchurch there but I'll bet there are people there who descend from Upchurch females. Also, there should be quite a few written Upchurch references going back to the early 1800's.

Do keep me informed and I will catch up at this end as time allows.

Hi John---

The DNA approach has tremendous possibilities and especially for your Upchurch group descending from Joseph U. b. 1775. I have created a file to have aspects of this subject readily available. However, due to my time consuming efforts to organize the entire Upchurch family I have resisted getting into the DNA process in spite of its great potential.

So, to respond to your question more directly and to hint at a way forward I will offer some thoughts.

1. There are several sets of notes in my files that could be of interest to you. If you want to pursue the matter further I will be happy to sort through them and mail you selected items. But as a short cut for now I will make reference to an exchange I had on July, 16, 2012. My late good friend Jim Jones, who was quite well informed about DNA work, suggested I call Thomas Stuart Howland "Tom" for guidance. I did on the 16th and he offered advice. He said there was no Upchurch DNA project but he found out there were 7 Upchurches who had carried out DNA analyses. Tom offered that if I wanted to have my DNA sample processed he would have an interpretation done for me. I did not go that route. Since Tom was so helpful I now provide you with his contact information in case you want to get in touch with him <tshj@comcast.net> phone (215) 766 2126. Let me know if you want me to mail you materials.

2. It so happens that I am now contemplating the creation of some sort of formal organization that I can put some energy behind and that will carry on the work I with the cooperation of others have been carrying on in the area of family history. If this can be brought into existence I am thinking there would be components including a committee and membership subgroup dealing with the issue of DNA. The effort and outputs could be put on the special website that would be created to serve the membership of the Organization (Association). At present I am dealing with the issue of how to have a name and a purpose that would attract membership and still qualify for IRS 501 (c) 3 status so contributions could be tax deductible. It is a real balancing act. In my DNA file I will now list you as one of those who have inquired about DNA work.

I do hope you will follow through on this matter and keep me informed.

In the meantime I hope you are following my website www.upchurchstory.com and especially the videos we are producing.

I continue to work on getting my backlog under control and am making good progress. Upon reflection I now recognize that the past 2 months have had more requirements (mostly pleasant) than I could stay on top of

So I have now caught up on processing your inputs going back to last May. The Cantrell stuff all fit nicely into the family records for the Joseph U. b. 1775 Group and most of it was already on hand - no surprises. Most of the Cemetery inputs were likewise.

However, the NEWTON Cemetery entries were new to me and drove me to my Profile Systems and to Ancestry.com to fit the details into a pattern. See enclosed Extract sheet. These people do not fit into your Joseph U. b. 1775 Group but in fact belong to a secular unrelated Upchurch Group headed by William U. b. 1778. This

William was never in Rutherford Co, NC so far as I know. He moved from NC to Jackson Co, TN and we have a substantial body of information there for him. I even visited the County once and interviewed locals including one Yelund, descendant. As with Joseph I have a substantial notebook where I keep the William & Family in the format of a master outline.

The location of Newton Cemetery #2 is not clear to me. I somehow doubt it is in Beulah County, TN.

I have made notes in the proper place that a GS of Joseph & 1775 had the name SHERROD (SHERRAD)/SHERWOOD. I carry the GS as ENOCH SHERRAD & but it could easily be SHERROD and in fact could be SHERWOOD. As you imply, the similarity of the name of the GS to the name of the Sherwood Upchurch, Head of a Clan is worth reflection. We know Joseph & Sherwood were both in Rutherford Co, NC about 1800 so it is very tempting to try to make something of the similarity of names. Let's be alert for more supporting information.

I am very glad Rutherford Twp did not yield more. Be alert for Internet sources - they are getting better all the time.

Where descendants of greatgrandchildren are known they are listed in continuation sections as indicated by number on the left hand side of the page - copies of continuation sections 1-4 are also enclosed.

If we learn that Joseph II b 1775 is indeed a member of the 5th generation the records will be set for me to assign XFD's using the master outline as now reorganized. In any case I now feel better organized than before.

Provided hereunder is a sheet re missing items for the family of your father. I will be grateful for any answers you have or can get.

It has been a long time since I have written but thought I should contest your hypotheses that my Joseph U. R. is the brother of David Philip U. as you suggest in UB volume 6 number 4.

In UB volume 5 number 3 (missing links, you list Joseph U. as being born 5 Dec 1775. This would make David U. a father at 10 years old if he was b. ca 1765 as you state in UB 6-4. There you also move Joseph's b. to ca 1779. David would then be 19 yrs which would help

Assuming your 5 Dec 1775 is an accurate date, I then suggest Joseph U. R. is the brother of, not the son of David U. This would then give William U.^{IV} an eleventh child. Lacking any documentation this remains

conjecture.

There were three (3) male Upchurch's that were married in Rutherford Co NC in 1804. Sherwood to Polly Pell 2 Jan 1804; my Joseph to "Patsy" Bradley 21 July 1804; and James to Nancy Bradley 29 Dec 1804 with Joseph as bondsman. I would like to think Joseph & James were brothers who married sisters. This would seem logical but doesn't get me to the absolute family connection as I don't know the parents of James.

Sherwood had a brother named Joseph but I don't think the ages are right to fit these two together.

The heirs of George U sold his Wayne Co Ky land to Sherwood after his death in 1830/31. Joseph was the only one to sign the documents, all

others made their mark. This may be significant as my Joseph was a school teacher, probably in the winter when he couldn't farm.

I wrote to DeKalb Co Tm for estate papers / will of Joseph. They returned my check saying they could find nothing on him. I used 1850 as his date of death. Can you give me any direction on where you found these documents?

Dear Cousin John,

Your letter of 4 JUL 1988 has been in my "to process" stack for quite a time. I got up at 4:30 AM today and spent three hours on it. Got everything nicely tucked away on the Master Outliner and in the narrow Profile. Thanks for your input. It is greatly appreciated.

I have deleted the Jones Green U section from the "Dehals Co, TN" outline. It did not belong there and I have salvaged that line. Wish I could say the same for yours. Most of the rest of today has been spent upgrading the organization on my census file for the 1700's & early 1800's in NC. I thought maybe at the end I could spot a place for Joseph it b 1775 - but no such luck. So far the early records are too complex and there are too many openings. However, the upgrading was needed for all sorts of reason. The simplest segment is a three page outline for the Upchurch on the 1790 census. There are 11 households with

a total of 63 individuals. Of these 63 there are 35 males. Theoretically one of these 35 should be Joseph U b 1775. Of the 35 I can eliminate 26 in that they have a name associated with the entry (assuming I have assigned names to the entries correctly). The lower 9 slots to ponder but there my mind stops working for the moment. Of course it is possible the 1790 census taker may have missed Joseph U at the household where he was located. They missed the entire Harmon class. There is a number of other ways of narrowing the search & we should all continue. I'll be glad to send you a copy of the 3 page 1790 outline if you want to play with it.

The missing details on John Archibald & descendants are listed on two attached sheets. Hope you can help with some of these.

Re the birth date for Joseph U of 5 DEC 1775 came to me in a letter from Mary Afton Irwin (Mrs H D. Anderson) dated 11 AUG 1930. I don't know how reliable it is. She had lots of records and searched church history for many years. She had contact with various early descendants of Joseph U. She is not very responsive these days.

Early Tm Tax List by B & B Sistler, Evanston, IL show Joseph U paying taxes in White Co in 1811. If Jones was born in NC in 1816 we may have a problem.

You have written me several letters over the last year or so and my brief efforts to be responsive have left something to be desired. I still don't have a break through to report but at least some of the data pools are becoming more fixed in my mind. In the last year or so the data on the TN uplander has come more into focus. I have an excellent set of census records of TN for 1850, 1860 and 1880 and many of the entries now fall under one or the other of the uplander subclans (Not that everything is yet connected). Two big groups remain to be connected. They are the uplander of Jackson Co, TN & those of DeKalb Co, TN - the latter being your group. I have now prepared a start of making rough outlines for these two groups. The one on the DeKalb Group is enclosed for your files and use. You will note that I have attributed 10 children (A-J) to Joseph U & 5 DEC 1775 (VA) [I presume this is

the name Joseph U² / name called Joseph U² before
 he lived in Rutherford Co, NC. I have made no
 more progress in identifying the father
 of that Joseph U but we are certainly narrowing
 the field. We have recently made some
 breakthroughs in Craven Co, NC but I don't
 see any obvious help there. However, you
 might study the recent issue of the U²
 to see if you see a slot for a male b

At this time I would like to ask that you

Finally, I found the 1860 census of Tenn. that proved our theory, John Archibal U. was the son of Enoch S. U. Also Joseph H. U., Amanda C. U. & Martha S. U. were his siblings.

Joseph ^{→ [JOSEPH H. U.]} moved to Hamilton Co. Ill. in 1860 where he married Susan Hutson on 22 Feb 1868, she was born 10 Jun 1848 & died 18 Nov 1876. Her father was Uel H. Hutson. Joseph married Ida Hutson after Susans death, and she died in Jul 1885. Her father was Harrison Hutson the brother of Uel.

The 1870 census of Hamilton Co Ill. shows that Felix U. ^{→ [FELIX G. U.]} aged 50 was living there with his sons Joseph 21, James 18, Enoch 17, & Robert 12. His wife had apparently died prior to that as he had a house keeper living in his home.

Enoch's ^{→ [ENOCH S. U.]} family during this census consisted of his wife Louisa, her ~~sister~~ Catherine Shuster, and his son John A my G father

During this same census there was a ^ΔMartha U. aged 6 yrs b in Ill. living in the home of ^ΔJessie & ^ΔMartha Porter and their 1yr old dau ⁻Rozetta.

^ΔJoseph U. (Enoch's father?) ^{→ [ENOCH S. U.]} was on the tax lists for White Co Tn in 1811 but not in 1825 (no Upchurchs were). This info from "Early Tennessee Tax Lists" compiled by Byron & Barbara Sittler, Evanston Ill 1977.

The White Co Tn surveys from 27 Apr 1824 through 28 Mar 1828 show that in "book A" at the Tn Land Office on pages 89, 362, & 374 are records for ^ΔJoseph U., & on page 359, ^ΔF. Ambrose U.

The 1840 Tn census shows ^ΔFelix U., ^ΔJoseph U. & ^ΔWilson U. living in DeKalb Co. The 1850 Tn census reflects that ^ΔFelix & ^ΔJoseph remained in DeKalb Co. but that ^ΔWilson had moved to White Co.

The 1820 census also reflects that ^ΔJoseph U.'s family consisted of 2 males 10-16 yrs & 1 male 26-45, there were 5 females 10 yrs or less, 1, 10-16 & 1, 26-45. I don't know where all of these gals went----?? You seem to have identified Rachel as one of these, do you have any other ideas on the others?

Thanks for your letter of recent date which arrived 7 SEP 1984. I have spent several hours (it's hard to believe) entering and cross-referencing all of the details you provided. They make very nice additions to the family of Joseph U b 5 DEC 1775 (NC) & 1850 (DeKalb, TN). Have you had a chance to study the Program Report on Missing Links No 9 (UB Vol 5 No 3 pp 97-101)? I would appreciate any comments you may have.

It is currently my intent to use some of the money from the Upchurch Research Fund to hire a professional genealogist in NC to collect all possible data on Upchurches from Granville Co, NC. Hopefully this will bring some new information to light.

You mentioned Martha U age 6 b IL on the 1870 IL census in the home of one of Martha Porter. Any idea as to the parents of this Martha U?

I have reviewed our previous correspondence and note that you have sent certain details on your, father, grandfather & GGF and their brother & sister (all of which have been recorded in separate biopiles for each of them). I am in a poor position to ask for specific missing details as I do not yet have a master outline prepared for Joseph U.R. Hemenes, I sense that you are continuing to collect the kinds of details that are needed for the master files. I will welcome any additional materials you can send.

You asked about the daughters of Joseph U.R. other than Rachel U. I have no indications as to the names of these females. Perhaps continued research will reveal their names through marriage records, wills, or other documents.

Dear John,

Thanks for your recent letter which arrived on 20 JUL 1984. I have extracted all of the details and recorded them in the separate biofiles of the various individuals.

Like you, I have no proof, but the hypothesis that your John Archibald U is the son of Enoch S. U seems reasonable. In fact I am working on a broader hypothesis that there were 5 brothers and sisters of TN including Enoch S. U, who were children of one Joseph U who was on the 1800 census of Puttiferd Co, NC - hence referred to as Joseph U R. The broad

outline:

I. Joseph U R b 5 DEC 1775 d 1850 (Puttiferd Co, TN)
on 1800 census Puttiferd Co, NC; on 1820 & 1830
census of White Co TN.

- A. Wilson U b before 1810 (NC) wife Elizabeth —
- B. Ambrose F. U b 1804 (1810?) (NC) d 1851 (Warren Co, TN)
- C. Enoch S. U b 1825 (1822?) (TN) wife Lavinia Ann Schuster
 - 1. Joseph A. U b 1847 (TN)
 - 2. Amanda C. U b 1848 (TN)
 - 3. John Archibald U
- D. Rachel U b 1818 (TN) and co. 1840 Thomas Holland
- E. Felix G. U b 1870 (White Co TN) d 1878 Hamlet Co, IL

There are varying amounts of circumstantial evidence bearing upon their proposed linkage but we still need more information, circumstances or otherwise, beyond being satisfied with the proposal. In a future U B I'll try to summarize the situation as shown above plus add whatever I can glean from the records.

We do not have a hypothesis at this time as to the parents of Joseph U R. In the 1800 census of Rutherford Co, NC he was present as head of a household, age 16-24, with no other people in the home. In 1808 he witnessed a deed in Rutherford Co, NC for James U (don't know who he was either), on 21 JUL 1804 ~~he~~ he (one for U) and in Rutherford Co, NC Patsy Bradley, bought land in Rutherford Co, NC in 1801 or 1802, sold land in Rutherford Co, NC in 1817 to Joshua Ketter.

Please continue to send me any details you can collect on present day and recent members of your line as well as any details on the earlier generations. The evidence is building up and there is an excellent chance we will be able to add to the information for your line and eventually establish a linkage back to Michael U I.


