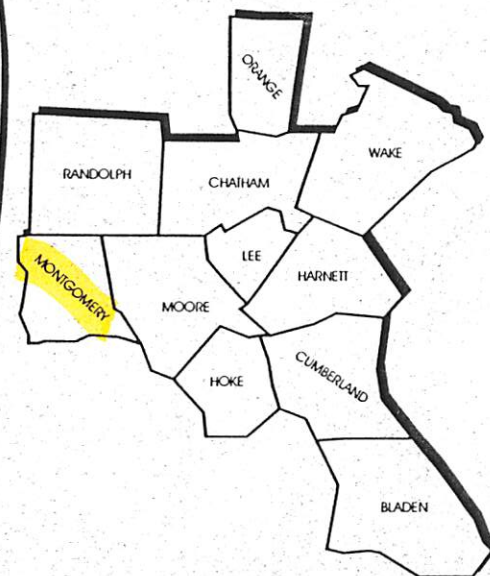

Allen Upchurch & Wife to Wiley Ross

This indenture made this 17<sup>th</sup> day of September  
in the year of our Lord 1835 between Allen  
Upchurch and Mary Upchurch his wife and  
Wiley Ross of the latter part, witnesses that  
for and in consideration of the sum of  
thirty seven dollars in hand paid at as before  
the sealing of these presents, we the said  
Allen and Mary Upchurch do by these presents  
bargain, sell, give and assign a certain  
tract or parcel of land to the said  
Wiley Ross by and bounded as follows  
being in the County of Montgomery and  
State of North Carolina and lying on the  
south west side of the Pe Dee River and  
on the south side of Jacob Creek bounded  
as follows on the North by Jacob Creek,  
East by Howell Upchurch, south by Fern  
Shankle, west by George Shankle \$ sum ?  
the above land being bequeathed to  
Elizabeth Dodney during her natural life  
and at her death to Nancy Page, Mary  
Upchurch, Elizabeth Upchurch and Sarah  
Ross lawful heirs of said John Dodney,  
and the same being undivided, we  
do hereby then promise, bargain, sell and  
deliver all aforesaid right to said land  
either by will or any other way from ourselves  
our heirs or assigns forever to the said  
Wiley Ross his heirs or assigns forever to  
have and to hold in simple fee and behoof,  
whereunto we have this day set our hands  
and affixed our seals, signed sealed and  
delivered this day and date first written in  
presence of

This indenture made this 17<sup>th</sup> day of September in the year of our Lord 1835 between Allen Upchurch & Mary Upchurch his wife, & Wiley Rofs of the other part, Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of thirty seven Dollars in hand paid at or before the sealing of these presents, we the sd Allen and Mary Upchurch do by these presents bargain, sell, give & alien a certain tract or parcel of Land to the sd Wiley Rofs his & bounded as follows lying in the County of Montgomery and State of N. Carolina & lying on the South West side of Pe De River & on the South side of Jacobs Creek bounded as follows on the N<sup>o</sup> by Jacobs creek West by Howell Upchurch, So by Levi Shankle, West by George Shankle Sur, the above land being bequeathed to Elizabeth Dudney during her her natural life & at her death to Nancy Page, Mary Upchurch, Elizabeth Upchurch and Sarah Rofs lawful heirs of sd John Dudney, and the same being undivided, we do hereby these presents, bargain, sell and deliver all of our right to sd land with by will or any other wise from ourselves, our heirs, or assigns forever to the sd Wiley Rofs his heirs, or assigns forever, to have & to hold in simple fee & behoof, whereunto we have this day set our hands & affixed our seals, signs seals and names as follows the day and date first above written in presence of
