Secretaries: Not Just File Clerks

"Lots of people have the title of secretary who are really just stenographers or filing clerks," complained Miss Peggy Creighton, newly-elected international president of the National Secretaries Association (NSA).

Miss Creighton began her one-year term as international president last week at the conclusion of the NSA annual convention in Denver, Colo. An NSA member since 1960, the new officer served on the international board for four years.

As international president, Miss Creighton will represent the association at national conferences and will preside over board meetings. She will also be a trustee of the Home Trust Foundation which runs a center in Albuquerque, N. M., for retired secretaries, and chairman of the Research and Education Foundation which provides secretarial scholarships.

With many appointments and speaking engagements ahead Miss Creighton plans to work overtime to keep up with her office work.

"I can schedule my time away," she explained, "so I catch up on my work before I leave. I'm determined to fulfill my responsibilities here in the office first."

Achieving professional status for secretaries is the goal of NSA and its new president. A Raleigh native, Miss Creighton has worked 22 years with the architectural firm of Carter F. Williams.

"Most people don't look on the secretary as a professional person," she observed, "but the secretary is really an executive assistant. Today she's being forced to put more emphasis on administrative rather than technical skills."

Defining the role of the secretary, Miss Creighton named three essential qualifications: mastery of office skills, initiative and motivation and the ability to assume responsibility and make decisions.

A woman's title should be determined by her duties, she emphasized. "You don't become a secretary just by having basic skills. You have to have experience before you become a secretary."

As a means of elevating the secretary's status, the new NSA president firmly believes a secretary can't afford to be emotional or involved in personal business. She should, however, give her opinion on business matters.

"If a secretary doesn't speak out, she's not very valuable to her executive," insisted the slim blonde. "She is his assistant. His thoughts have priority but she should be heard."

Of the estimated one million United States secretaries now employed, Miss Creighton feels many view a secretarial position as a steppingstone to a managerial post. For her, the role of a secretary provides a challenging career.

"I'm perfectly happy being a secretary," she said. "I don't feel that I'm in a stagnated position because I can promote myself by being a better secretary."

As part of the changing professional status of secretaries, emphasis is increasingly placed on training. Some employers now require prospective secretaries pass the certified professional secretarial exam. The two-day examination covers six major areas of business, including economics, business math and law, office

procedures, communication and decision-making and environmental relationships.

"One of the weakest areas in secretarial training is economics and business administration, yet it's one of the most vital," noted the Peace College graduate, who advises a minimal two years of college before pursuing a secretarial career.

The NSA officer also mentioned salaries as another area long in need of change. Since she feels women should be paid according to their responsibility, she finds most of the salary discrimination with top executive secretaries.

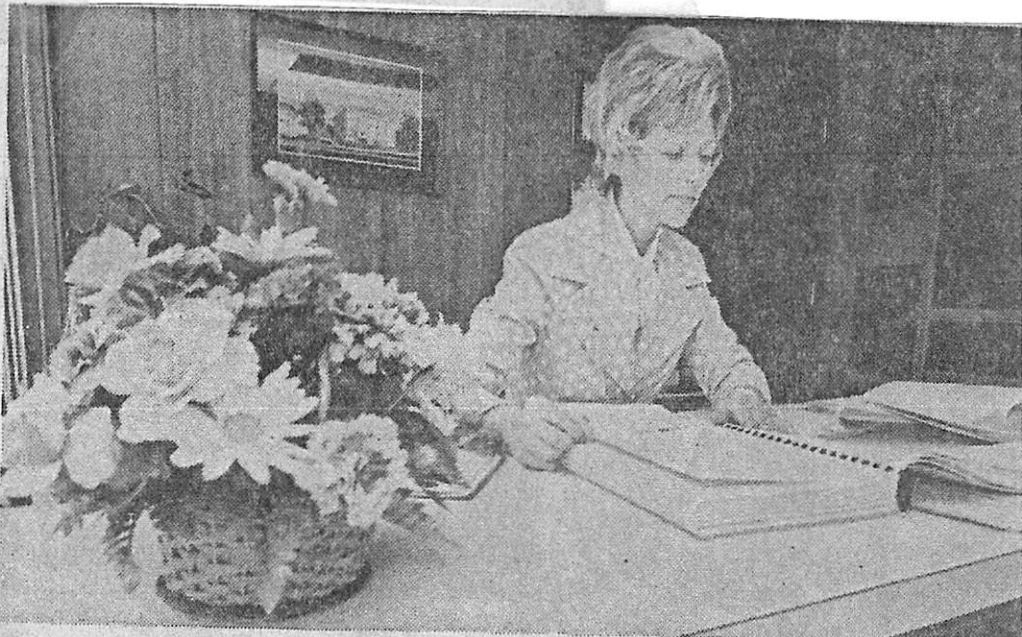
"Management often doesn't realize the difference in training and knowledge between a top level secretary and a stenographer," she observed.

With increasing automation, it is likely the secretary's future role will center on administrative duties with typing and shorthand almost eliminated, Miss Creighton said.

"The typewriter is now a standard piece of equipment, but in 10 or 15 years it'll be gone," she predicted. "The secretary will be relieved of manual tasks which will just be a matter of pushing buttons. Dictation and typing are very minor responsibilities and they take time away from the secretary being able to use her initiative."

As president of NSA Miss Creighton hopes the group will become more involved in public and world affairs. During their recent annual convention, the 30,000-member organization voted to support the Equal Rights Amendment, legislation the new president strongly favors.

"I feel I have a responsibility to the other secretaries in the world," she said. "Many are made to feel subservient and they won't stand up for themselves."

Dear Cousin Peggy

We returned home on 1 JUL 2006 after 3 weeks and 3,000 miles on the road. We held up quite well and I got lots of data which now must be processed. Also I met with quite a few people including some I had not seen since the 7th grade.

It was a real pleasure to meet with you and Ray and to find that you are both doing well. Your work habits are similar to mine. I can't seem to find a stopping place.

As a follow-up to our visit I wanted to send you some family history details. Sheets A-F are enclosed. I'll comment on each one briefly.

A. This is rather straight forward concerning your grand father, his siblings and their parents. Note the question re Martha Kearson.

B. Here are four names from Mid-Pines Cemetery including your family. Note that your GGM is styled as Mary Jane Clayton [vs "Martha" in A.] The Joe A. Nypser is the same as the Joe Nypser who named your Great Aunts Dora & Vallie.

C. This a summary of what I found on my visit to the Vital Records office in the Register of Deeds office on Salisbury Street in Raleigh. The only supposal on the Crigsten side is that the Death Certificate of your GF "Doll" shows his mother is MARY CARSON. Note her name is Martha in A and is Mary Jane in B. Her maiden name is shown as KEARSON in A and as CARSON in C. Need to learn the correct spelling. Page C gives little help re the ancestors of MATTIE, your GM and mine. At one place she is shown as nee EDWARDS and at another as ABRAMS

D. This sheet I get from my sister Ernestine. Item ① is how she recalled the relationships. I had forgotten about Item ② I have never followed up on this entry

E. Another effort to organize Mattie & her family I can go to when Mattie is buried in North Raleigh.

F. Here are some hard census records. Note that Mattie is age 19 and my mother is 1. Both here go by the name Edwards as do two of Mattie's sisters. I am pretty sure the G.MOT was nee Sally Waney and that she married welder Edwards and had a daughter Pauline Edwards "Coney". There really is a challenge to sort all of this out?

I am sure there are records somewhere that would allow us to make sense of all of this - maybe - someday.

I promised to send you a picture of Mattie but have looked without finding it. My pictures are not as well organized as the rest of my stuff. I still plan to send you the picture. Be sure to hold my feet to the fire on this.

We plan to be back in Raleigh for a number of days in late October. The special reason is to help celebrate the marriage of Sallaine's 44 year old nephew. We have been a hatcher for long enough. I always have more family history work to do in NC so will program extra time.

Peggy, I do hope we can visit again. You may or may not wish to give a little attention to the family history matter. Not everyone is as attracted to this subject as I am. I don't like to make a pest of myself. In any case you and I still have a lot of memories to share and experience to relate.

Again may I say how enjoyable it was to chat with you and Ray after so many years of traveling different paths. Our very best to you both

A. Obtained Death Certificate for ADOLPHUS C. CREIGHTON b 3 NOV 1883 () d 23 MAR 1964 (Meredith TSP, Wake Co, NC) s/o William Creighton & Mary Carson. Information supplied by Mrs A.C. Creighton (LORENA). He buried Oakwood Cem.

B. Could not locate a death certificate for Mattie - - under the names EDWARDS, CREIGHTON, CRAYTON. This is strange as she died 1 DEC 1918 one day after the birth of her 7th child Ruby Elnora Creighton as shown below - all in Wake Co, NC.

C. The mother of MATTIE is supposed to be PAULINE who d about 1940. Could not find her as EDWARDS or ABRAMS - Maybe look using first name "COUSY" she could have died in Durham Co, NC (first guess - RPH)

D. The mother of PAULINE is supposed to be SALLIE (SALLY) possibly EDWARDS or ABRAMS called "MOM" - died 1915 I S years. Could not locate her under EDWARDS or ABRAMS.

Lorena does not recall Cousey having the name Pauline. Cousey left MUTT with all the little children and the Lynn family came to the rescue - WARD LYNN, 1800+ LYNN & EMMA LYNN - siblings. Cousey had been living on the Union Place - Bessie was born on "the corner" [HWY 50 & 6 FORKS RD?] Lorena was living at Hamie Super Creek when Bessie was born.
