# Upchurch honored for 'reputation for fairness'

The St. Louis-based East-West Gateway Coordinating Council honored former Monroe County Commissioner Carl Upchurch at the St. Louis Regional Congress of Governments 11th annual meeting and luncheon recently.

Upchurch, who held a County Board seat from 1982 through 1994, has been a Columbia resident for 26 years. Prior to his stint on the board, which he chaired for four years, Upchurch was a long-

time school administrator. The Coordinating Council named Upchurch among 10 individuals and governmental units who exemplified dedication, hard work and noteworthy community and regional service at the Nov. 13 gathering. (See HONOR, Page 4A)

Upchurch was recognized by the regional group as having "established a reputation for fairness and getting things done." His passing the 911 emergency number referendum, joining 10 counties in creating a self-insurance pool, establishing the Bi-County Health Department, renovating the county courthouse and aiding in the rebuilding of flood-devastated Valmeyer were cited among his accomplishments.

"I was very proud the first time I was elected to county office," said Upchurch in a later interview. "The first time out, it's a popularity contest. When you're re-elected, it shows that people have confidence in you."

Upchurch remarked at the vast growth that challenged the county during his tenure as a board member. "Monroe County is among the fastest growing (counties) in the region, percentage-wise.

"With that growth comes the need for services; with that comes extra work as far as water, utilities, infrastructure, the sheriff's department and traps. We had to take on a lot of projects," he said.

"You find out a lot about what the county needs are and what people's concerns are when you become commissioner and automatically take a seat on the various committees and councils that go along with that," Upchurch said.

Still active with the Illinois County Insurance Trust, he sees the county's growth boom continuing.

"About the time Columbia ran out of room, Waterloo started to pick up. The four-lane (Illinois 30) has had a lot to do with that, and it'll bring more growth," Upchurch said.

Upchurch's former colleagues said he was an energetic public servant.

"He enjoyed what he did. He took a lot of interest in it," said County Commissioner Dan Dietz, who served with Upchurch on the board. "He took his committee assignments seriously and put a lot into them."

County Board Chairman Robert Rippelmeyer calls Upchurch "a gentleman he was proud to serve with."

"Honesty and integrity always shone in his actions," Rippelmeyer said. "He always had good common sense in considering matters for the county."

## Carl E. Upchurch

Retired school administrator,  
Monroe County commissioner

Carl E. Upchurch, a retired school administrator and Monroe County commissioner, died Friday (Jan. 3, 2003) at Barnes-Jewish Medical Center from complications of heart disease. He was 75 and lived in Columbia, Ill.

A native of Cahokia, Mr. Upchurch received a bachelor's degree in 1955 and a master's in 1958, both from Washington University.

In 1953, Mr. Upchurch married Jean A. Haman of Cape Girardeau, Mo.

Mr. Upchurch began his teaching career in 1957 and became a principal in 1959. He served as principal of several schools in the Cahokia district, including Cahokia Grade School, Penniman Elementary, Pitzman Elementary and Chartrand Elementary Schools.

6 JAN 2003 (MON)

In the 1960s, Mr. Upchurch was named school administrator of the Cahokia School District. He retired in 1976 after more than 15 years with the district.

Mr. Upchurch served as chairman of the Monroe County Commission and played an instrumental part in getting the 911 emergency telephone system expanded and getting the new Monroe County Courthouse built.

He also served as the county representative and founder of the Illinois County Insurance Trust, where a group of counties pulled together to form a self insurance trust to offset high deductibles of standard insurance.

Mr. Upchurch was co-owner and operator of Upchurch Properties with his wife. He was also a real estate broker and served as vice president of Columbia Savings and Loan.

Mr. Upchurch was a member of the Illinois Retired Teachers Association, East-West Gateway Coordinating Council, St. Paul United Church of Christ and the Monroe County Republican Central Committee.

Among the survivors are his wife, Jean A. Upchurch; four daughters, Jill Lively of Marietta, Ga., Joy Wellman of Columbia and Carla Cobb and Julie Gummersheimer, both of Waterloo; two brothers, James Upchurch of Dupo and Robert Upchurch of Columbia; two sisters, Catherine Harberding of St. Louis and Johann Reynolds of Columbia; and seven grandchildren.

The funeral will be held at 10 a.m. today at Lawlor Funeral Home, 218 South Metter Avenue, Columbia. Burial will be at Valhalla Garden of Memory in Belleville.
