The girls were gifted musicians and played guitar and organ. Gene was a specialist in bicycle riding and swimming. After attending York Institute, both girls went to Tennessee Tech and, after graduating from Pickett County High School, Gene went into the U.S. Navy.

They married the following mates: Glyna married Frank Joyce Martin, son of Truman and Nora Vann Martin of Livingston, on August 27, 1954, and they lived in Livingston for several years, working in the Sutton's "shirt factory" there. They moved to North Carolina and lived there for awhile before transferring to Altus, Oklahoma where they now live. Glyna attended Tenn. Tech and later got her degree from a college in Jackson, Tennessee.

Gene Crouch has driven a truck on longdistance hauls for about twenty years. He is divorced but is the father of two children. Michael Joe was born February 14, 1961 whose mother was Peggy Dooley of Albany, Ky. Regina Lynne was born July 16, 1965, and her mother was Cedell Cox of New Tazewell, Tennessee. When not trucking, Gene spends as much time as he can with his parents on Caney Creek.
