Apex native Mrs. Mabel Powell, 73, dies

Mrs. Mabel Martin Powell, 73, an Apex native long involved in the religious and cultural life of the town, died Monday, Aug. 15 at the Springmoor Retirement Community in Raleigh.

Mrs. Powell graduated in 1935 from Meredith College where she majored in voice. She later taught voice and directed youth choirs at Apex Baptist Church where she was a member. She taught Sunday School for more than 20 years and established the first regular training classes for Sunday School teachers at Apex Baptist.

She was a past president of the Apex Woman's Club and PTA.

She was also an active supporter of the N.C. Symphony and served for a time on the symphony's board of directors.

More recently, she served as a volunteer with the Life Enrichment Center in Raleigh, working with that organization's marriage enrichment groups.

Mrs. Powell was remembered last week as an active Christian whose involvements ranged from the public library to alcohol abuse counseling.

A funeral for Mrs. Powell was held Thursday at the Apex Baptist Church. Burial followed in the Apex Cemetery. Out-of-town guests and residents of the Springmoor Retirement Com-

munity were guests at a luncheon following the funeral at the C.C. Jones Community Building.

Mrs. Powell is survived by her husband, J. Dewey Powell, a retired businessman; daughters, Mrs. Susan P. Brinkley of Wake Forest, Mrs. Janet P. Hendricks of Boulder, Colo.; brother, Ralph Martin of Apex; seven grandchildren.

They moved to North Carolina and lived there for awhile before transferring to Altus, Oklahoma where they now live. Glynna attended Tenn. Tech and later got her degree from a college in Jackson, Tennessee.

Gene Crouch has driven a truck on long-distance hauls for about twenty years. He is divorced but is the father of two children. Michael Joe was born February 14, 1961 whose mother was Peggy Dooley of Albany, Ky. Regina Lynne was born July 16, 1965, and her mother was Cedell Cox of New Tazewell, Tennessee. When not trucking, Gene spends as much time as he can with his parents on Caney Creek.
