Fill, ~~23~~ ³¹ Pearce, 80, his children were: Halley, 70; Nathan, 86; Eley, 80; Hardy went to Alabama. Fill's wife was Nancey.

Benjamin Pearce's mother was Frankie Upchurch, 82, and Frankie Upchurch's mother was Nancey Ledbetter, 85. Nancey Ledbetter married Ben Upchurch.

Ben Upchurch's sisters -- Frankie, Bettie, Nancey. Frankie Upchurch's brothers: Juble Upchurch, 80; Frankie's sister Winnie Upchurch.

Benjamin Pearce's wife was Linda Denton, 47; Linda Denton's mother was Nancey Denton, 45; Nancy's mother was Cherry Denton, 75. Drew Denton was the father of Nancy Denton.

Children of William Upchurch (1) ↑ son of James 1

The 1800 Census of Granville Co. NC lists the family of William (1) ↑ William and his wife were ages 45 upward. The name of his wife is not known. If born 1755 William 1 was age 65 in 1800. They were living in the Oxford District with a son and dau ages 16 to 26 years. The State Census of North Carolina taken in 1786 shows them to have two sons. One of the sons is married and is listed apart. Marriages of Granville County lists William Upchurch m 3-2-1808 Anrita Jenkins. This is William (2), if born 1774 age 26 in 1800.

* Another marriage of Granville Co. shows Frances Upchurch married 12-1-1808 John Pearce. Frances seems to be the dau of William (1). If born 1776, Frances would have been 24 at the taking of the 1800 census.

The third child of William 1 is proved to be John Upchurch 4 (fourth of the given name of John in the Upchurch families). John 4 was born 1770. He married Anna Harris 6-21-1790. Annie was the dau of Edward Harris. In 1807 in Chatham Co. North Carolina, Anna Upchurch is named in the will of her father, Edward Harris "To his daughter Ann Upchurch" 1807 Granville County Wills 1772-1943 Vol.6-380.

* This excerpt from Morgan shows she claims this Frances U to be a dau of William U, I (RPU designation William U, II). I think it more likely that Frances U is a part of the Richard U, II group. Need to confirm this my way in Granville Co, NC - RPU 10 AUG 1999

③ Circumstantial evidence shows Frances U I ↑ was dau of Richard U Sr (XID-152). She was therefore sister of Rich Jr, Benjamin, Nathan, etc & a 1790 Progenitor
