## Generation 1

1. George ${ }^{1}$ Pearce was born before 1648 (On 10 Jan 1669 (Isle of Wight Co., VA, Will and Deed Book 2, p. 80), Geo. Peirce was paid for Smiths work. This is the first record in which he can be identified. If he was at least 21 years old in 1669, then he was born in or before 1648.). He died about 1705 in Isle of Wight Co., VA (The appraisal and inventory of George Peirce was recorded on 09 Apr 1705 (Isle of Wight Co., VA, Will Book 2, p. 466), showing he had died before this date.). He married Anne Pearce before 1674 in Isle of Wight Co., Virginia (On 20 Nov 1674, George Peirce, smith, and Ann Peirce of Isle of Wight Co., VA, assigned a tract in Nansemond Co., VA, to Hodges Council. (Isle of Wight Co, VA, Deed Book 1 1688-1704, p. 30), showing they were married by that date.). She died about 1719 in Isle of Wight Co., VA (Her will was dated 14 Mar 1718/19 and recorded 22 Jun 1719 (Book II or the Great Book, p. 1). In it she mentions John Keighly, John Teasley's son John, and Patience Carver, but does not state her relationship to them.).
George Pearce and Anne Pearce had the following children:
2. i. JOHN ${ }^{2}$ Pearce was born before 1680 in Isle of Wight Co., VA (The first record for John Pearce was when he recorded his mark on 09 Oct 1680 to identify his livestock (Isle of Wight Co., VA, Will and Deed Book 1, p 449), showing he was born before then. He might also have been a brother to George Pearce, Sr.). He died after 1751 in Isle of Wight Co., VA (His will was dated 19 Dec 1751 and recorded 02 Jul 1752). Identified were his wife Esther and daughters Elizabeth and Mourning. John Segraves, son of Susanna Seagraves, was also a legatee. (Isle of Wight Co., VA, Will Book 5, p. 440)). He married Esther Hutchins, daughter of Richard Hutchins, before 1735 (Deed of gift recorded 28 Jul 1735 from Richard Hutchins to his son-in-law and daughter John Pearce and Esther Pearce, respectively. (Isle of Wight Co., VA, Deed Book 4, 1729-1736, p. 439), showing they were married before then.).
3. ii. Phillip Pearce (SR.) was born before 1684 in Isle of Wight Co., VA (Nathan Pearce sold 100 acres to Robert Holland (Isle of Wight Co., VA, Deed Book 9, pp. 466-467) and stated that the land was part of a patent to George Pearce, Blacksmith, who gave it to Phillip on 09 Sep 1684, indicating Phillip was born before then.). He died in 1728 in Isle of Wight Co., VA (His will was dated 16 Jan $1727 / 1728$ and probated 22 Apr 1728 (Isle of Wight Co., VA, Will Book 3, pp. 77-78). Identified are his wife Sarah and his sons Nathan, Arthur, Simon, Richard, and Thomas.). He married Sarah Pearce before 1724 in Virginia? (In a deed dated 23 Jan 1724, Philip Pierce, Sr., and Sarah (his wife) of the upper parish sold 100a to John Teasley of the lower parish (Isle of Wight Co., VA, Great Book Vol. 2, 1715-1726, p. 693), indicating they were married before then.). She died after Jul 1738 in Isle of Wight Co., VA (The account of the estate of Philip Pearce signed by Sarah Pearce and examined by Richard Hardy and Etheldred Taylor was recorded 24 Jul 1738 (Isle of Wight Co., VA, Will Book 4, p. 209).).
4. iii. Richard Pearce was born before 1684 in Isle of Wight Co., VA (A deed (Isle of Wight Co., VA, Deed Book 11, p. 334) stated the land sold was part of a patent to George Pearce, blacksmith, who gave it to Richard Pearce on 09 Sep 1684, indicating that Richard was born before that date.). He died before 14 Feb 1752 in Isle of Wight Co., VA (He died before 14 Feb 1752, the date his son, William, sold land inherited from his father Richard Pearce (Isle of Wight Co., VA, Deed Book 8, p. 447).).
iv. George Pearce (JR.) was born before 09 Jun 1694 in Isle of Wight Co., VA (On 09 Jun 1694, George Pierce, Sr., had mark of son George Pierce (Jr.) recorded in court (Isle of Wight Co., VA, County Court Orders 1693-1695, p. 34), indicating that his son was born before that date.).
5. v. (name Unknown Maybe Margaret?) Pearce was born before 09 Mar 1704 (On 09 Mar 1703/1704, George Pearce and Anne (his wife) gave 200 acres called Seacock Swamp to their grandson William Jones (Isle of Wight Co., VA, Deed Book 1, 409), showing that William's mother was their daughter born before 1704.). She married William (?) Jones (This marriage is suspected because William Jones was a servant for George Pearce and then lived in Isle of Wight Co., VA, afterward (see

the story).).
6. vi. (NAME UNKNOWN) Pearce. She married John Teasley before 1719 (Ann Pearce, widow of George Pearce, left her plantation to John Teasley, son of John Teasley (Isle of Wight Co., VA, Book II or the Great Book, p. 1), indicating their daughter might have been John Jr.'s mother.). He died before 26 Jun 1738 in Isle of Wight Co., VA (On 26 Jun 1738, an appraisal of the estate of John Teasly was ordered (Isle of Wight Co., VA, Will Book 4, p. 217), indicating that he had died before this date.).

He died in 1728 in Isle of Wight Co., VA (His will was dated 16 Jan $1727 / 1728$ and probated 22 Apr 1728 (Isle of Wight Co., VA, Will Book 3, pp. 77-78). Identified are his wife Sarah and his sons Nathan, Arthur, Simon, Richard, and Thomas.). He married Sarah Pearce before 1724 in Virginia? He died before 05 Aug 1746 in Isle of Wight Co., VA (George appears to have died before 05 Aug 1746, when his uncle John Peirce sold 100 acres to Patience Pearce, his presumed widow, without mentioning George Pearce. (Isle of Wight Co., VA, Deed Book 7, p. 350)). He married Patience Pearce before 1733 (George's wife Patience was named in the 1733 deed (Isle of Wight Co., VA, Deed Book 4, pp. 306-307) in which they sold 100 acres to Thomas Pearce.).
ii. Phillip Pearce Jr. was born about 1709 in Isle of Wight Co., VA (If Philip, Jr., was at least 21 years old when he was first mentioned in a county record in 1730 (Isle of Wight Co., VA, Deed Book 4, p. 83), then he would have been born in 1709 or before.). He married Sarah before 1731 in Isle of Wight Co., VA (On 23 Nov 1731, Philip Pearce and his wife Sarah sold part of a 2500-acre patent to John Pearce (Isle of Wight Co., VA, Deed Book 4, pp. 184-185), indicating they were married before this time.).
iii. SIMON PEARCE was born about 1719 (If he was 21 when he first appeared as an adult in a record on 21 Mar 1740 (Isle of Wight Co., VA, Deed Book 5, p. 588)).
4. iv. Nathan Pearce was born before 1725 in Isle of Wight Co., VA (If Nathan was 21

years old when he was first mentioned as an adult in a 1746 deed (10 Jun 1746, Isle of Wight Co., VA, Deed Book 7, p. 339), then he would have been born in or before 1725.). He died about 1796 in Franklin Co., NC (He died before 26 Mar 1796, when Nancy Peirce, widow of Nathan Peirce, received her dower land of 63 acres in Franklin Co., NC (Will Book B, p. 36).). He married Ann Westray, daughter of John Westray (Sr.) and Ann Exum, between 1752-1755 in Isle of Wight Co., Virginia (For analysis, see the attached article on Nathan Pearce's wife Ann Westray.). She was born about 1734 in Isle of Wight Co., VA (If Ann was about 20 years old when her oldest child Phillip Pearce was born in 1754, then Ann would have been born about 1735. In his will (Isle of Wight Co., VA, Will Book 6, p. 205), John Westray identified Ann Pearce as his daughter.). She died after 1815 in Franklin Co., NC (The year 1815 was the last year that Ann Pearce paid Land Taxes on her approximately 63 acres in Franklin Co., NC, that she received from the estate of Nathan Pearce.).
v. Thomas Pearce was born before 1728 in Isle of Wight Co., VA (Phillip Pearce identified Thomas as a son in his will (Isle of Wight Co., VA, Will Book 3, pp. 77-78).).
8. vi. RIChard Pearce was born before 1728 in Isie of Wight Co., VA (Richard was mentioned in the will of his father Phillip Pearce (dated 16 Jan 1727/1728 and probated 22 Apr 1728, Isle of Wight Co., VA, Will Book 3, pp. 77-78), indicating he was born before 1728.). He died about Nov 1790 in Johnston Co., NC (Will of Richard Pearce (dated 20 Nov 1790, probated Nov Court 1790) identified wife Sarah Pearcesons Simon, Everet, Ephraim, Richard, Phillip, and John Pearcedaughters Martha Nichols, Ann Runnels, and Unity Pearce. (Will Book 1, p. 29)). He married Sarah (Will of Richard Pearce (dated 20 Nov 1790, probated Nov Court 1790) identified wife Sarah Pearcesons Simon, Everet, Ephraim, Richard, Phillip, and John Pearcedaughters Martha Nichols, Ann Runnels, and Unity Pearce. (Will Book 1, p. 29)). She died before Apr 1796 in Johnston Co., NC (Will of Sarah Pearce (dated 20 May 1795, probated April Court 1796) identified sons Simon, Everett, Ephriam, John, and Phillip Pearcedaughters Martha Nichols, Unity Talton, and Ann Runnals. (Will Book 1, p. 106)).
9. vii. ARTHUR PEARCE was born before 1728 in Isle of Wight Co., VA (Arthur was mentioned in the will of his father Phillip Pearce (dated 16 Jan 1727/1728 and probated 22 Apr 1728, Isle of Wight Co., VA, Will Book 3, pp. 77-78), indicating he was born before 1728.). He died on 02 Oct 1792 in Johnston Co., NC (Will of Arthur Pearce (dated 02 Oct 1792 and probated Nov Court 1792) identified his wife Mary Pearce, his sons Theophilous Pearce and Jesse Pearce, and his daughters Winiford Fulgum and Mornen Watkins. (Johnston Co., NC, Will Book 1, p. 60)). He married Mary Pearce (Mary was identified as the wife of Arthur Pearce in his will (Johnston Co., NC, Will Book 1, p. 60).). She was born in 1725 in North Carolina. She died before 17 Mar 1815 in Johnston Co., NC (Will of Mary Pearce (dated 17 March 1815, probated May Court 1816) identified daughters Winefred Fulgum, Ann / Mourning Watkins. (Will Book 1, p. 266)).
4. Richard ${ }^{2}$ Pearce (George ${ }^{1}$ ) was born before 1684 in Isle of Wight Co., VA (A deed (Isle of Wight Co., VA, Deed Book 11, p. 334) stated the land sold was part of a patent to George Pearce, blacksmith, who gave it to Richard Pearce on 09 Sep 1684, indicating that Richard was born before that date.). He died before 14 Feb 1752 in Isle of Wight Co., VA (He died before 14 Feb 1752, the date his son, William, sold land inherited from his father Richard Pearce (Isle of Wight Co., VA, Deed Book 8, p. 447).).
Richard Pearce had the following child:
10. i. William ${ }^{3}$ Pearce was born on 1715 or before in Isle of Wight Co., VA (If William was at least 21 years old when he was first mentioned in a county record in 1736 (Isle of Wight Co., VA, Deed Book 5, p. 55), he would have to have been born in 1715 or before.). He married Martha (In his will (Isle of Wight Co., VA, Will Book 10, p. 217), he mentioned his wife

Nathan ${ }^{3}$ Pearce (Phillip ${ }^{2}$ (Sr.), George ${ }^{1}$ ) was born before 1725 in Isle of Wight Co., VA (If Nathan was 21 years old when he was first mentioned as an adult in a 1746 deed ( 10 Jun 1746, Isle of Wight Co., VA, Deed Book 7, p. 339), then he would have been born in or before 1725.). He died about 1796 in Franklin Co., NC (He died before 26 Mar 1796, when Nancy Peirce, widow of Nathan Peirce, received her dower land of 63 acres in Franklin Co., NC (Will Book B, p. 36).). He married Ann Westray, daughter of John Westray (Sr.) and Ann Exum, between 1752-1755 in Isle of Wight Co., Virginia (For analysis, see the attached article on Nathan Pearce's wife Ann Westray.). She was born about 1734 in Isle of Wight Co., VA (If Ann was about 20 years old when her oldest child Phillip Pearce was born in 1754, then Ann would have been born about 1735. In his will (Isle of Wight Co., VA, Will Book 6, p. 205), John Westray identified Ann Pearce as his daughter.). She died after 1815 in Franklin Co., NC (The year 1815 was the last year that Ann Pearce paid Land Taxes on her approximately 63 acres in Franklin Co., NC, that she received from the estate of Nathan Pearce.).
Nathan Pearce and Ann Westray had the following children:
8. i. Stephen ${ }^{4}$ Pearce was born between 1751-1756 in North Carolina or Virginia (Estimated from age ranges in the 1800, 1810, and 1830 Federal Censuses for Stephen.). He died before Aug 1831 in Wake Co., NC (His will was probated during the August 1831 Court Term in Wake Co., NC (Record Book 22, p. 121), and thus his death occurred before that date.). He married (1) (NAME UNKNOWN). She died between 1790-1800 in Franklin Co., NC (In the 1790 Census for Franklin Co., NC, Stephen's family has 3 sons younger than 16, Stephen (older then 16 years), and 5 white women. In the 1800 Census, Stephen's family has 2 sons, himself, and 3 daughters. So, his 1st wife probably died before 1800.). He married (2) ElIZABETH BRYANT (STALLINGS) about 1810 (This was the second marriage for each).
9. ii. Philip Pearce was born on 24 Jul 1754 in Isle of Wight Co., VA. He died on 24 Feb 1812 in near Moccasin Creek, Franklin Co., NC. He married Nancy Bunn in 1778 (From a DAR application papers for a descendant).
10. iii. JAMES PEARCE was born between 1760-1765 in Northampton Co., NC (Very rough estimate if he was born after his brothers Phillip and Stephen but before his sister Elizabeth.). He died before 1795 in Franklin Co., NC (His will was dated 07 Feb 1794 (Will Book A, p 114). He identified his wife Mary and children Bedey, Bitsey, Penney, Patsey, and Wille, all minors. His inventory was returned 08 Mar 1794 (Loose Papers of Franklin Co., NC).). He married Mary Pearce (As shown in the will of James Pearce (Will Book A, p 114) and the 1794 Loose Estate Papers for Franklin Co., NC, when Polly Pearce requested or sued for her dower from the estate of her deceased husband James Pearce.). She died before Mar 1810 in

Franklin Co., NC (The inventory of the estate of Polley Pearce, John Carpenter, admr. and sale of her estate, dated Mar Court, 1810 (Franklin Co., NC, Will Book C, p. 172).).
14. iv. ARTHUR Pearce was born between 1760-1765 in Northampton Co., NC (Very rough estimate if he was born after his brothers Phillip and Stephen but before his sister Elizabeth.). He died before 26 Mar 1796 in Franklin Co., NC (Arthur died before 26 Mar 1796 when Nancy Peirce, widow of Arthur Peirce, was granted 41 acres for her dower land in Franklin Co., NC. (Franklin Co., NC, Will Book B, p. 36)). He married Nancy Pearce (On 26 Mar 1796, Nancy Peirce, widow of Arthur Peirce, was granted 41 acres for her dower land in Franklin Co., NC. (Franklin Co., NC, Will Book B, p. 36)).
15. V. Elizabeth "betsey" Pearce was born about 1767 in Northampton Co., NC (Because her parents were living in Northampton Co., NC, in the 1760s, Elizabeth was likely born there.). She died on 27 Oct 1844 in Shelby Co., IN (This date is from her tombstone. Her date of death as shown in her Revolutionary War Pension Documents is 13 Nov 1844.). She married Thomas Ray, son of William Ray Sr and Mary Ray, on 29 Mar 1783 in Wake Co., NC (The marriage bond was dated 29 Mar 1783. They were married in her father's home, presumably on or shortly after 29 Mar 1783.). He was born about 1762 in Virginia or North Carolina. He died on 16 Nov 1829 in Shelby Co., IN (Will of Thomas Ray/ Ray, Dated 26 Feb 1827 and filed 04 Jan 1830. He identified his wife Elizabeth and children Hutson, James, Gilley, Susannna, Patsey, and Chaney. Executors: his sons Hutson and James Ray. (Probate Record Book 1, 1822-1833, p. 134)).
16. vi. John Pearce was born in 1768 in Northampton Co., NC. He died on 03 Jan 1845 in Shelby Co., IN. He married CLARISSA Or CLARA UpCHURCH?. She was bom on 14 Oct 1764 in North Carolina. She died on 04 Nov 1869 in Poweshiek Co., IA (The Federal Mortality Schedule has Mar 1870 for her death date and age at death as 107. Her tombstone has her age as 105 years and 20 days.).
8. Richard ${ }^{3}$ Pearce (Phillip ${ }^{2}$ (Sr.), George ${ }^{1}$ ) was born before 1728 in Isle of Wight Co., VA (Richard was mentioned in the will of his father Phillip Pearce (dated 16 Jan 1727/1728 and probated 22 Apr 1728, Isle of Wight Co., VA, Will Book 3, pp. 77-78), indicating he was born before 1728.). He died about Nov 1790 in Johnston Co., NC (Will of Richard Pearce (dated 20 Nov 1790, probated Nov Court 1790) identified wife Sarah Pearcesons Simon, Everet, Ephraim, Richard, Phillip, and John Pearcedaughters Martha Nichols, Ann Runnels, and Unity Pearce. (Will Book 1, p. 29)). 17. i. JOHN ${ }^{4}$ Pearce was born between 1751-1760 (In the 1830 Census, John Pearce was listed as being age 70-79, indicating he was born 1751-1760.).
ii. Philuip Pearce was born on 1756 or before (Phillip was listed in the 1787 North Carolina State Census as being 21-60 years old, indicating that he was born in 1756 or earlier.). He married Patience Oliver.
iii. RICHARD PEARCE was born on 1763 or before (In the 1784 North Carolina State Census, Richard was listed as being 21-60 years old, indicating that he was born 1763 or before.).
18. iv. EPHRAIM PEARCE was born on 1763 or before (The 1784 North Carolina State Census for Johnston Co., NC, listed Ephraim's age as 21-60, indicating he was born in or before 1763. This birth date is consistent with the birth dates in the 1810 and 1820 Censuses for Johnston Co., NC.). He died before Aug 1826 in Johnston Co., NC (Will of Ephriam Pearce (dated 01 October 1825, probated August Court 1826) identified wife Edith Pearce and daughter Chacy Pearce. (Johnston County Will Abstracts 1746-1870, vol I \& II, by Elizabeth E. Ross, 1991 revised ed.)). He
