Silas Cross was born in Wake County in 1828. As was the case with previous male members of the family, he had little, if any, schooling and never learned to read or write. He helped his father farm the land until he reached the age of 24. He then married Frances (Fannie) Chappell (born 1826) on May 27, 1852.

Silas and Fannie had seven children: Virginia Adelaide, Bettie Green, Fanny, Louvenia, Columbus, Eugene D., and Leviticus. Silas apparently demonstrated sternness with tendencies to be overbearing. Children seemed to leave home as soon as possible, and only three are named in the division of his estate. One daughter also rebelled against his control and had two children out of wedlock.

Silas moved his family out of Wake County when he bought 65 acres on Beaver Dam Creek in Granville County for \$260. The price would indicate that a modest house existed on the property. The farm lay in Dutchville Township in the vicinity of present-day Creedmore. It is not clear whether Silas lost title to the land, traded it in exchange for a tenant interest, or simply failed to farm it with any success. In any event, land value listed at his death was 0.

On February 25, 1879, James B. Beck and R. G. Hall were appointed by the court to lay off and allot the personal property of Silas Cross to the widow, Fannie, and her children: Virginia Adelaide, Betsy (Bettie) Green, and Fanny Meacans. The date of the court order indicates that Silas died between November 1878 and February 24, 1879. There was no will.

The inventory of his estate showed that Silas grew mostly corn on his farm, some for the family and some for the hogs and sheep. He dabbled in tobacco but never raised it on a large scale. The listing of his farm items was as follows: 15 barrels of corn, pea vines and fodder, 27 bushels wheat, 1 pen shuck, 1 lot of tobacco (valued at \$30.00), wheat straw, and 250 lbs. of pork. Livestock included 5 head cattle, 1 gray horse, 1 Sorrell horse, 10 head sheep, 7 head hogs, and 10 geese. All of the above were valued at a total of \$237.00. The inventory also listed household and kitchen furniture valued at \$100. This was a small, but sufficient, estate for the family's survival for another year. How Fannie managed to keep her head above water for the next 20+ years was not discovered in the course of this research. She died between 1900 and 1910.

I, too, am descended from Silas Cross and Frances "Fannie" Chappell. They were my great-great grandparents; therefore we are distant cousins. Let me begin with them and work backwards to show how our family tree was put together.

Silas Cross was born in 1828 in Wake County, North Carolina. On May 27, 1852 he married Frances Chappell who was born in 1826. They had the following children: Louvenia (1853), Columbus (1854), Eugene D. (1856), Leviticus (1858), Bettie Green (1865), and Virginia Adelaide (?). Silas was a farmer who moved to Granville County and struggled to make ends meet. He died between November, 1878 and February, 1879, and Fannie survived him by more than twenty years (died sometime between 1900 and 1910). Silas was the son of Richard Cross.

"For love and affection I bear my children and one dollar all right, title, interest to
land on which I now live lying on waters of Fall Creek which was allotted to me
in the division between myself, my brother Thomas, and my brother Silas..."

This record clearly established the family relationships and proves that Ariadne
was the mother of John Richard Cross and that Silas was his uncle. It also shows
that Ariadne inherited the land on Fall Creek, not far from the Cross cemetery,
through a land division.

Silas Cross to Ariadne Cross
November 30, 1850
"For natural love and affection for my sister all my part of land received from my
grandmother Rachel Cross" along with personal property.

This not only establishes Silas and Ariadne as grandchildren of William and
Rachel but indicates that the land came from Rachel's estate. However, William
had directed in his will that his land was to go to son Thomas after Rachel's
death. Later evidence, which will be listed, indicates that son Thomas died before
his mother, thus leaving the property to be divided among her grandchildren.

For \$75, "...all right title and interest to the land on waters of Fall Creek...
Being one-third of whole."

This deed clearly shows that the property on Fall Creek, on which Ariadne
and her children lived, had been the property of William and Rachel Cross and had
passed to the children of Richard Cross, son of William, after Rachel's death
sometime before 1856. By 1860, Ariadne had consolidated all the property.

To Richard Cross 100 acres vacant land adjoining lands of George Cain and
Richard Cross heirs.

I believe that the clerk confused the heirs and placed Richard's name when it
should have been Thomas. This would be a correction to my Cross Ties reference
to this transfer. Richard, son of William, was still alive in 1850, and the Richard
whom I believed married Ariadne (see previous e-mail) was not active until the
1850s.

The key marriage for this follow-up research is that of Thomas Cross and Chloe

Wake County, N.C. by Frances Holloway Wynne, pp. 35, 97.

The logical interpretation of this material, combined with what you have accumulated
from local tradition, is that the land on Fall Creek belonged to William Cross who left his
wife, Rachel, a life estate in the property. It was to go to his son, Thomas [not to be
confused with Thomas L., son of Richard and brother of Silas], but this Thomas died
before his mother. At least some of the Fall Creek land then went to Ariadne, Silas, and
Thomas L., children of Richard and grandchildren of William and Rachel. Ariadne
acquired all the land and had a home there. She seems to have married a Richard Cross,
son of Thomas and a cousin, who died in late 1859 or early 1860. In the latter year,
Ariadne gave the property to her three children: Anne Rebecca (Becky), John Richard,
and Nicholas. John Richard later married Louvenia Cross, his first cousin, and
apparently made his home on the property about where the Cross Cemetery is now.
