

Abel Upchurch Sr. and his Family UAFA Enrolled Family AFEF No. 15

I. Introduction

This compendium for the descendants of Abel is being created, maintained, and updated by the Upchurch and Allied Families Association and cooperators with the purpose of having at one online site details about this UAFA “enrolled” family. Today, thousands can trace their heritage back to Abel.

Each UAFA enrolled family is served by a coordinator. Initially, the default coordinator of all enrolled families is Phil Upchurch, the founder of UAFA. Financial support is required to enroll and augment records for an enrolled family and to keep it online for the long term. The financial co-sponsors of the Abel Upchurch Sr. Family and active supporters will be reported in periodic e-newsletters to the Abel Upchurch Sr. family. The ultimate goal is to have a minimal endowment of \$10,000 for this family, the earnings of which will support the records of this particular family and UAFA.

Historically, the records for the Abel Upchurch Sr. Family have been found in a great many places. By “enrolling” this family under the auspices of UAFA, the intent is to have a central portal which will readily allow a member of this family to see and understand reference materials about their heritage. Much of this material exists in the Allied Family Archives amassed by Phil Upchurch over a forty year period. This and other resources will set the stage for further research, or for the creation of a comprehensive family history. Progress will depend on collaboration.

Readers are aware of the large amount of conflicting data for any given family on Ancestry.com and other sites. It is difficult and essentially impossible to get these conflicts resolved online. Furthermore, some of these sites fade from view over time. The plan and intent of UAFA is to resolve both of those issues. It is our intent that content portrayed by UAFA for an enrolled family will be factual and subject to ongoing validation and that the content will remain online for the long term under the auspices of UAFA. To make this a reality, UAFA must be sustained by an active volunteer Board of Directors, volunteer cooperators must be active participants, and some hired help must be available. II. An Overview of Abel Upchurch Sr. and his Family

A. A Brief Review of the Life of Abel Upchurch, Sr.

Abel Upchurch was born about 1775, most likely in Franklin County, NC and died in December 1846 in Greene County, AL. His probable father Richard Upchurch II (ca. 1725-1798) had moved to North Carolina from Virginia about 1755. His grandfather James Upchurch was born in Virginia and died there in 1765. His great grandfather Richard Upchurch was born ca. 1658 and died in 1700. His great great grandfather Michael Upchurch (ca. 1624-1681) was the original American Upchurch immigrant who came to America about 1638.

Abel was the brother of Nathan, Richard Jr, Moses, Charles, James, Jubal, and Benjamin. A 1790 Federal Census record for Richard Upchurch II in Franklin County, NC lists four white males between the age of 0 – 16. One of these slots could logically be filled by 15 year old Abel. In the 1800 Federal Census, Abel appears as the head of household, age 26 – 44, while his wife, Bethenia “Theny” fits nicely into a 16 – 25 year old free white female slot. Abel’s wife Bethenia “Theny” would live in to her eighties, outliving her husband by at least 15 years.

In 1810, there is no listing for Abel in either a Franklin County or a Wake County federal census record. However there is a listing for Abel in the tax rolls for the Little River District in Wake County, NC. Abel is shown with 375 acres of land in this document. As indicated by deed records and court minutes from Wake County, North Carolina, Abel was active in the first years of the nineteenth century purchasing and selling land and other items. The land purchased by Abel was near Moccasin Creek in the Little River District area of Wake County.

There is no census available for Wake County, NC for 1820. Nevertheless, Abel Sr. is presumed to still be in the Little River District.

For the year 1830, one cannot find a listing for Abel Sr. in either the Wake County, NC census or in Greene County, AL census records. It appears however that Abel and his children migrated to Greene County around the year 1825. Therefore it is thought that Abel should be in Greene County, as his children in 1830 had their own households in this county.

The last listing for Abel is in the 1840 Greene County AL federal census. Here he is listed as head of household filling a slot for a white male age 60 – 70 years. His wife Bethenia also would fill the slot for a white female age 60 – 70 years. Abel Sr. would pass away in December of 1846.

Abel’s wife Bethenia, age 71, would appear in the 1850 census living in the home of her son Abel Jr. In 1860, Bethenia, would be listed as being 83 years of age, in the home of her son John.

B. A Presentation of Abel Upchurch Sr., his Children, and Grandchildren

Abel Upchurch (born ca. 1775 and died 1846) married Bethenia “Theny” in 1800 in Wake County, NC. Bethenia was born in 1779 in North Carolina and would die circa 1863 in Greene County, AL. It is most likely that they had 9 children, Bartley, Nancy, Benjamin J., Dolly, James Laton, Mary, Lynia, John, and Abel Jr.

1. Bartley Upchurch (19 Dec 1800 – 24 Oct 1879) would marry Penelope A. Williams. They would have the following children:

* Nancy is a recent discovery, or addition to the Abel Sr. family. Confusion over Nancy occurs because she seems to make her first appearance in Greene County, AL records. More research may need to be undertaken to fully understand her place in the Abel Sr. family.

3. Benjamin J. (1805 – 8 Feb 1863), would marry Cinderilla Tant. Records suggest that they had eight children.

6. Mary “Polly” (born abt 1810), married Clemmons Martin. No records have been found indicating children for this couple.

7. Lynia “Linny” (1812 – 1845), married Joseph J. Rich. There are no records of any children for this couple.

8. John (22 Apr 1814 – 25 Jun 1871) had children by two wives. His first wife was Jane Wilder (1819 – 1840). There were two children born of this union.

FOOTPRINTS OF THE ABEL UPCHURCH, SR., CLAN MADE IN MOVING FROM NC TO AL TO MS

I. Abel U., Sr. was born about 1775 (Franklin Co., NC). For the next 50 years he resided in Franklin Co., NC or in adjoining Wake Co., NC where he married about 1795 Bethenia. He had eight children all born in NC and the two oldest, Bartley, & Benjamin, married in NC. The third child, Dolly, is thought to have been married in Greene Co., AL in 1826 and it is presumed Abel U., Sr. must have moved from NC to Greene Co., AL prior to this date - presumably about 1825. It is presumed that Abel U., Sr., his wife and all his children, married and unmarried, made the 1825 move to AL together or at least over a very short period of time, say a few months or a year or so. Abel U., Sr. died in Greene Co., AL in DEC 1846 and his wife died there in 1860. So far as is known all eight of the children of Abel U., Sr. remained in AL until they died. Only one daughter-in-law of Abel U. Sr., moved to MS - namely, the widow of Abel U. Jr. who moved to Choctaw Co., AL with her children. Therefore, it was the grandchildren of Abel U., Sr. (or at least some of them) who moved west to MS. So far as is known none of the children of the three daughters of Able U., Sr. moved to MS but more research on this point is needed. Four of the five sons of Abel U., Sr. had children who moved to MS. These would have been grandchildren of Abel U. Sr. and they were either siblings or first cousins. They moved in "batches" to four different areas of MS as follows:

- Batch 1. North Central MS - Yalobusha & Lafayette Counties.
- Batch 2. South Central MS - Choctaw County.
- Batch 3. Northeastern MS - Lawrence and Itawamba Counties.
- Batch 4. Southeastern MS - Clarke and Lauderdale Counties.

Batches 3 & 4 moved just across the MS state line only a few miles from Greene Co., AL.

Comments on the eight children of Abel U., Sr. are as follows:

- A. Bartley U., d. 1879 Greene Co., AL. None of his children moved to MS.
- B. Benjamin U., d 1863 Greene Co., AL. His sons William U. and Noah P. U. lived in Clarke Co., MS. His son Churchwell U. lived in Lauderdale Co., MS while his son Benjamin Newton U. lived in both Clarke and Lauderdale Counties.
- C. Dolly U. and Pullam Carver. Did children move to MS?
- D. James Laton U., Sr., d. 1860 Greene Co., AL.
- Son John C. U. died about 1878. Did he move to MS? His wife nee: Nancy Brown, d. 1887 Choctaw Co., MS where their children lived.
 - Son Charles B. U. had descendants who lived in LA.
 - Son Samuel Pirese U. moved to MS. His descendants lived in Lafayette and Yalobusha Counties, MS.
- E. Mary U. and Clemmons Martin. Did children move to MS?
- F. Lynia U. and Joseph J. Rick. Did children move to MS?
- G. John U., d. 1871 Greene Co., AL.
- Son Robert Burton U., Sr. moved to Yalobusha Co., MS about 1876.
 - Daughter Sarah Isabella U. and Alonzo A Bradner. Moved to Yalobusha Co., MS. Had no issue but raised children of her brother William H. U. in Yalobusha Co., MS.
 - Son William H. U. Lived in Yalobusha Co. and Sunflower Co., MS.
 - Son Joseph Benjamin U. died in Greene Co., AL. Some of his children lived in Lawrence Co., MS.
- H. Abel U., Jr., d. Greene Co., AL. His widow and children are later found in Itawamba Co., MS and even later in Denton Co., TX.

How Records for the Abel Upchurch, Sr. Family Unfolded

While we now know the story of the Abel Upchurch Sr. family, it is a fact that in the time period 1960 – 1985 researchers followed a false trail. This error may be traced to a wrong conclusion made by Belle West and her colleagues, one of whom was William Kendrick Upchurch, Sr., a descendent of Abel Upchurch, Sr. Their error became simple enough to understand, but not before many public records were polluted with the idea that Abel Upchurch Sr. was the son of William Upchurch IV, whereas he was in fact the son of Richard Upchurch II (1725 – 1798). The reason for this error was a false conclusion based on the will of William Upchurch IV who died in 1787 in Wilkes County, NC. Among his children named in the will was a certain “Asal U” whom the researchers eventually concluded was Abel Upchurch Sr. While later research proved this to be false, the damage had been done. Further details on “Asal U” have not been found.

This error has been presented in more detail in the narrative for the enrolled family of William Upchurch IV (found on alliedfamilies.com) to which the reader is referred.

More details about segments of the Abel Upchurch Sr. family have been presented in various issues of the Upchurch Bulletin. Some of these will be brought forward and made a part of this narrative. There are still puzzling issues about the Abel Upchurch Sr. family that need more study. For now we will mention a few highlights revealing that we have more work to do.

We can be reasonably comfortable saying that Abel Upchurch Sr. was born in Dunn Township in southern Franklin County, NC and that he most likely married there. However, this community extended across Moccasin Creek into Wake County so at times the family of Richard Upchurch II might be found on one side or the other of the creek. We think that Abel Upchurch moved to Greene County, AL about 1825. But so far we have not been satisfied with the accounting of his family records as found in NC and AL. Did he have two families?

Another puzzle is that the AL records show that some of the family of Abel Upchurch Sr. had lived in Johnston County, NC. Dunn Township of Franklin County NC borders Johnston County. Even if this distance is not great, we still need more careful study of this Johnston County aspect.

However, the move of Abel Upchurch Sr. to AL brings us a bonus. The names of neighbors of the family at both locations cause us to think that families, neighbors, and friends trekked together. This pattern repeats in other movements to GA, TN and elsewhere. We hope to mine these records more, and to report these patterns in a periodical we hope Allied Families will sponsor under the name “*Footprints*”.

More of the story can be found among the 35 fifteen-minute videos accessible using www.upchurchstory.com (password 2013 upchurch#). Although there is not yet a video on Abel Upchurch Sr., there are two on his father, Richard Upchurch II. As well there are videos on the early American ancestors of Abel and details on the English heritage of our family.

As our Allied Families Association has evolved, we have become more aware of the exceptional roles some parts have played in society. We look forward to these details becoming a part of the Abel Upchurch Sr. story we plan to report on in the months ahead.

C. ANOTHER BREAKTHROUGH.

During the last six months correspondence has been started with James Clayton Harmon of Paris, Mississippi. This young man is deeply interested in his ancestors and we are fortunate that his mother is an Upchurch, namely, Gloria Ann (Upchurch) Harmon. She was the dau of James Doris U., the gd of Lafon Franklin U. and the ggd of Samuel P. U., b. August 1852 in Alabama. Although James Clayton Harmon had collected information on a large number of descendants of Samuel P. U., he was unable to establish the father of Samuel. We now have a letter dated April 30, 1981 in which he announces the big breakthrough. Samuel P. U. was the son of Laton U. (XID 3774), b. 13 JAN 1807 (NC), d. 24 APR 1860 (Greene Co., AL). Laton was the son of Abel U., Sr. (XID 589), b. 1775 (NC), d. 1846 (Greene Co., AL). Abel U. Sr. was the son of William U. IV (XID 160), the Head of Upchurch Clan 9 who died and left a will in Wilkes Co., NC in 1787. This hard work on the part of James Clayton Harmon adds many branches to the Upchurch family tree and we congratulate him on his success.

He was Captain Burton U., b. 7 JUL 1828 (1838?) in Pickens Co., AL, d. 3 JUN 1895. He was the son of Bartley U. of the William U. IV/Abel U. Sr. Subclan. And my worldly estate, I give and devise as follows:

First, I give and devise to my son Bartlet Upchurch the sum of Five Dollars. Also I give and devise to my son Benjamin Upchurch the sum of Five Dollars. Also I give and devise to my daughter Dolly Carver the sum of Five Dollars. Also I give and devise to my son Laton Upchurch the sum of Five Dollars. Also I give and devise to my daughter Mary Martin the sum of Five Dollars. Also I give and devise to my Three grandchildren (viz) William Rich, Zackry Rich, and John Rich (Being the children of Joseph Rich by marriage with my daughter Linny) Five Dollars each, the said money is to be kept in the hands of my administrator untill said children shall marry, or come of age, at 3 percent interest, and at their or any one marrying, or coming to lawful age, the administrator, is to pay it over to each one or his or their lawful agent, with said interest. 590

Also, I give and devise to my son Able Upchurch, Jr. all my whole messuage (?) lands and Tenements containing one hundred and twenty acres, situate lying and being in the County of Green State of Alabama, To have and to hold to my said son Able Upchurch, Jr. his heirs and assigns forever. Also, I give and devise to my son Able Upchurch, Jr all my personal property viz, my servant man, Nelson (his wife Amy, her son Tom, Lenny, Mary, Harriet, and Jane, being children of the said black man, and his wife Amy) to have and to hold to my said son Able Upchurch Jr. his heirs and assigns forever. 3779

Also I give and devise to my son Able Upchurch Jr all my horses cattle and stock, and all the house hold furniture.

Also, I do hereby appoint my trusty friend and son Able Upchurch Jr. Administrator of this my last will and testament and do direct that he shall receive pay for all his pains and trouble he will have in the execution of this my will.

Also, For the better security of my wife, Theny, I do declare that the property shall all stay together after my death, if I should die first, untill her death, befor the said distributions as I have bequeath them, shall take place.

And also, that it shall and may be lawful for him my said administrator in the first place to pay himself for all his trouble and all the rest, residue and remainder of all my estate and effects real and personal, whatever, after the payment of my just debts, legacies and funeral expences and other charges and deductions as aforesaid, all after complying with my will aforesaid, to be my son Able Upchurch Jr. and his heirs and assigns forever.

The WILL of Abel U., Sr. contributes a solid block of information	589
for the William U. IV Clan. Abel U., Sr. was b. ca 1775 in Wilkes Co., NC. After his father, William U. IV, died in Wilkes Co., NC in 1787	160

the family of ten children scattered. We have already reported how
 one of the ten, John U., moved first to Greenville Co., SC and then
 via KY to Henry Co., TN, arriving there about 1800. (UB, Vol. 2, No. 2,
 pg. 19).

Abel U., Sr. lived in Wake Co., NC for about twenty years. There
 in 1795 he md. Betania (Thany) _____, bought land in 1803 and 1809
 and had several children born. We do not know where Abel U., Sr. was
 located in Wake Co., NC, if he had any brothers or sisters with him
 or if he consorted with any of his second cousins (children of Nathan U. I,
 Moses U., Richard U. III) who resided in Wake Co. at that time. About
 1818 - 1820 he moved to Green Co., AL, where he died in late 1846.

The WILL shows a son, Bartlett U., but subsequent records reflect
 the spelling as Bartley U. which has become the accepted version.
 Other records show that dau Mary Martin mentioned in the WILL had the
 nickname "Polly" and that she married 1 JAN 1828 Clemmons Martin.
 Dau Linny (also spelled Lynia U.) md. 27 JAN 1836 Joseph Rich. Dau
 Dolly U. md. 19 SEP 1826 Pullum Carver.

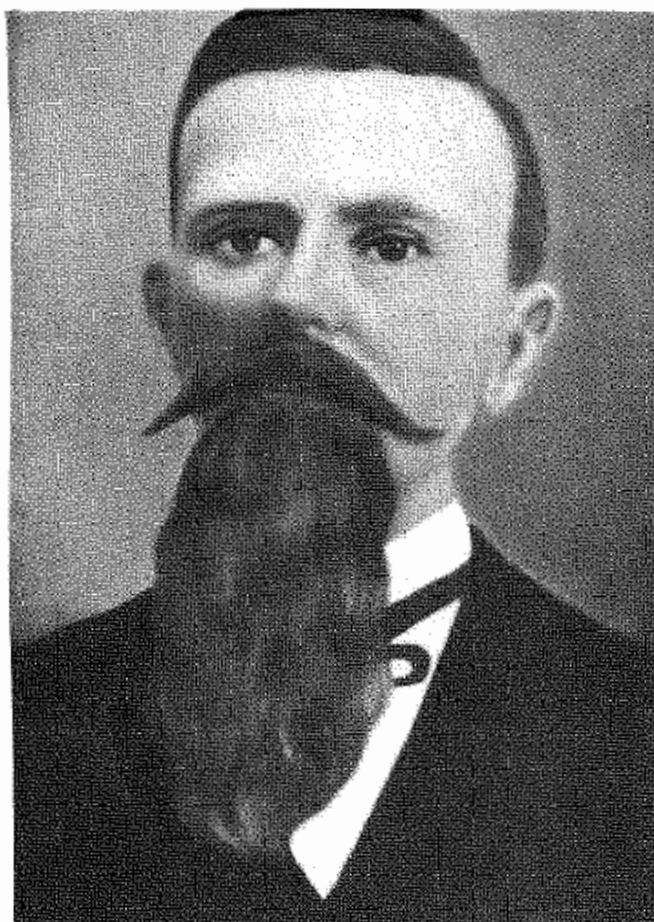
The WILL seems to reflect the concern of Abel U., Sr. for his
 wife and he obviously thought that Abel U., Jr. was the appropriate
 person to execute the WILL. Perhaps this was because Abel U. Jr. was
 the one at or on the home place. Still, one gets the impression that
 Abel U., Sr. intended for Abel U., Jr. to benefit from his WILL more
 than the other children.

The Abel U., Sr. WILL was admitted to probate on 11 JAN 1847 with
 all of the heirs consenting to probate and with Abel U., Jr. being
 certified as the Executor. The certification revealed the names of
 witnesses Griffin B. Coleman, John Hall and the third individual whose
 name appears on the WILL approximately as J. S. M Millson. In the
 certification this third individual is shown as James S. McWellson
 (approximately). Help is needed on the correct spelling of this
 witness.

Burton Upchurch was a greatgrandson of William U.IV, 563,160
Head of Upchurch Clan No. 9. When William U., IV died 160
in Wilkes Co., NC in 1787, he left a widow and several
children including twelve-year old minor, Abel U., Sr. 589
The children scattered and in due course we find Abel U., Sr. 589
in Wake Co., NC at about age 20, at which time and in which
place he married Bethania _____. We know little of the
existence of Abel U., Sr. in Wake Co., NC, but some or all 589
of his eight children were born there between 1800 and 1821.
The first of these was Bartley U., b. 19 DEC 1800 (Wake Co. 590
NC). Abel U., Sr. is believed to have moved his family 589

to Pickens Co., AL prior to the time any of his children married. Bartley U., md. 23 JAN 1823, possibly in Pickens Co., AL, and he and his wife Penelope (Williams) U. had eight children between 1824 and 1842, the seventh of these being Burton U., whose picture is shown above.

The bare facts of Burton U. are known but surely a closer study of the records will reveal more. He was born 7 JUL 1838 (Pickens Co., AL), d. 3 JUN 1895 (Pickens Co., AL)(Bur. Bethesda Cem., Benevola Road, Pickens Co., AL), md. 15 JAN 1868 (Pickens Co., AL) Emily Teresa Hanson, b. 3 AUG 1845 (Pickens Co., AL), d. 5 JUL 1885 (Pickens Co., AL)(Bur. AS HUSBAND). This couple had seven children of whom six lived to adulthood, married and had children. Recent correspondents have supplied much new information on the descendants of Burton U.

We know that Burton U. served the Confederacy. The sketchy record we have is as follows:

1. Enrolled - Pickens Co., AL, 17 SEP 1861, age 22.
2. Burt Upchurch - Private Co. B Lane Guards 2nd Regt. Ala. Vol (12 mos) Capt Thomas C. Lanier.
3. B. Upchurch - 2nd Lieutenant Co. B, 42nd Ala. Inf. Reg. Bst Ft Pillow. 19 MAR 1862 Mustered Columbus, MS, 16 MAY 1862.
4. B. Upchurch - 2nd Lieutenant Co. B, 42nd Ala Infantry. Elected 25 JUN 1862 Roster of field staff and Co. Officer made at Camp Hardee, Columbus, MS, 30 JUN 1862 - Approved by Col. Pertia.

Today we refer to this cousin as Captain Burton Upchurch. Whether he was formally appointed to this rank or whether it was conferred in an honorary manner after the war is yet to be determined.

The original of the above photograph of Captain Burton Upchurch hangs in the home of William Kendrick U. Sr. in Montgomery, AL. It was first observed by your editor when my son and I were overnight guests in this home on the evening of 31 DEC 1978. At that time Ken, Sr. related, as I now recall, that the painting was commissioned by him and that it was based on a photograph which hung (does it still?) in the Courthouse in Pickens Co., AL. I gained the impression that Capt. Burt U. was a Judge in Pickens Co., AL in the years before his death in 1895.

We are indebted to Ken, Jr. who supplied the copy from which the above photograph was made. We are sorry to report that Ken, Sr., a grandson of Capt. Burton U. is now attended in a nursing home and that he is not in the best of health.

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In the above photo, Capt. Burt Upchurch appears to be about 35 years old, which would have been about 1872. Our original photograph shows the hair of Capt. Burt to be quite red, which would be the same for the portrait now hanging in the home of Ken U., Sr. Upon inquiry, Ken, Jr. and our Cousin Eleanor (Upchurch) Kennedy, Jr. a ggd of Capt. Burt, have both advised that they do not believe Capt. Burt had red hair. Rather they think the artist who painted the picture from the original photograph elected to depict the subject as having red hair.

Franklin Co., NC, and was on the 1800 Federal Census in
that county as a married head of a seven member household.
The prospects that the children in this 1800 household
represent a different batch of children than the group
later found with Abel U., Sr. in Greene Co., AL, has 589
already been treated in UB, Vol. 13, No. 1, Pg. 17-25,
JAN 1992. (Remember Abel U. II = Abel U., Sr.). 589
This earlier treatment also shows the activity of Abel U., 589
Sr. in various land and other transactions in Franklin
and Wake Cos., NC, in the 1790-1830 era. We have
speculated that Abel U., Sr. arrived in Greene Co., AL 589
between 1825 and 1835. His children may well have arrived
in Greene Co., AL, prior to the arrival of Abel U., Sr. 589
We now have enough evidence to place Abel U. Sr. 589
on the border of Franklin and Wake Cos. in NC for a fifty
year period from about 1775 to about 1825. We still need
a great deal more information to fully understand about
his wife (or wives?) and about his two batches of children.
His first batch appeared to have been born in Franklin Co.,

NC; whereas, those of his second batch (1800-1821) appear
to have been born in Wake Co., NC. The WILL of Abel U.,
Sr. was written 12 SEP 1846 (Greene Co., AL) and probated
in that county on 11 JAN 1847. XID 589

The oldest son of the second batch of children for
Abel U., Sr. was Bartley U. Bartley U., md. 23 JAN 589,590
1823, Penelope A. Williams and we presume this marriage 2054
was in Wake Co., NC. Their first two children were born in
NC (presumably Wake Co., NC) in 1824 and 1826; whereas,
the third, Calvin U., was b. in 1828 in AL (presumably 11801
Greene Co., AL). This would seem to fix the move of
Bartley U. from NC to AL as being between 1826 and 1828. 590
Subsequently, Bartley U. moved to Pickens Co., AL, where 590
we presume his last two children to have been born in
1838 and 1842.

VI. OUTLINE OF SELECTED CLANS OR SUBCLANS

A. COMMENTS ON THE ABEL U., SR. CLAN

The reader is referred to UB, Volume 13, No. 3 (July 1992) for details on our revised understanding of Abel U., Sr. and his descendants. We have now fixed clearly that Abel U., Sr. is the Head of Clan No. 8 and more particularly we have recognized that his children are heads of subclans. The oldest of his children was Bartley U. In UB, Volume 13, No. 3, and Outline of the Abel U., Sr./Bartley U. Subclan was published. The intent now is to continue the publication of the remainder of the subclans (through the ninth generation in each case) in succeeding issues of the UB until outlines for all subclans in the Abel U., Sr. Clan have been published. To the best of our knowledge the eight children of Abel U., Sr. listed above were all born in NC. This would place Abel U., Sr. and his family in NC for the period 1800-1821. From the dates of birth of the eight children, it would appear that Abel U., Sr. could have had additional children. If so, they have not appeared on the record. If such additional children were born, it is quite likely they died at birth, in infancy, or in early childhood. In that era such early deaths were common.

C. ABEL U., SR./BENJAMIN U. SUBCLAN 589/3773

1. Comments.

So far, Benjamin U. has been shown to have 3773
eight children. However, two of these were daughters
born in 1824 and 1826 for whom we do not have names.
It is suspected that one of the daughters of
Benjamin U. married a Williams. The evidence for 3773
this is that the 1860 census for the Benjamin U. 3773
household shows three children: S. H. Williams 19,
Elen Williams 17, and Wesley Williams 3. It presumed

For many segments of this subclan we have an excellent outline, thanks to many very interested and dedicated descendants. Continued improvement in the outline is expected. One of the unusual circumstances of this subclan concerns the first marriage of John U. and the children therefrom. Our best information is that Jane Wilder, the first wife of John U., was b. in 1819 in Johnston Co., NC, that they md. in 1835 in Greene Co., AL, and that she died in 1840 in Greene Co., AL. What is peculiar is that their two children were born in Johnston Co., NC in 1838 and 1840. This is all physically possible. One wonders if the couple did move back and forth between Greene Co., AL and Johnston Co., NC, as would seem to be indicated. Of special interest is the prospect that more details on this Johnston Co., NC, connection just might shed more light on the Abel U., Sr. family overall for the 1800-1850 era. 3776

We have satisfied ourselves that Abel U., Sr. was 589
 the Head of Upchurch Clan 8, that he was the son of

Richard U. II, that he was born and raised in southern Franklin Co., NC, spent some of his young adult life in eastern Wake Co., NC, and that he moved his family to AL in the 1820-1830 era. We are naturally anxious to have hard evidence of the exact location of Abel U., Sr. at various times in his life. One such bit of information has now surfaced that places him firmly in Wake Co., NC on 17 SEP 1818 and on the third Monday of NOV 1818. This is consistent with our prior knowledge.

The new information appears in the Bastardy Bonds and Records for Wake Co., NC for 1818 (CR 099.102.1) and this record has been compiled and published in WAKE TREASURES Vol. 2, No. 4, Winter 1993 by Elizabeth Dees and Madilyn Jamison. The record reads as follows:

"2. Elizabeth Burn (Bunn) Nehemiah Privett

THE STATE vs ELIZABETH BURNE. WARRANT: To any Constable or other Lawfull officer to Execute. Whereas information hath been made to us two of the Justices - that Elizabeth BURN Single Woman - hath been deliverd of a base begotten Child and may become Chargeable to the County - to apprehend & bring before us or any two Justices - said Elizabeth BURN to answer the matters alleged against her - 28th of

March 1818. Signed: M. STRICKLAND JP, Chas King JP.
Added note: J. Rhodes Const. Ext.

EXAMINATION: Elizabeth BURN Single woman - on oath before us Matthew STRICKLAND & Seth Jones Justices - 25 April AD 1818 who saith She hath delivered a bastard Child - likely to become Chargable to the County - that Nehemiah PRIVETT of Wake County, planter, is the father - Taken before us & signed. 25 April 1818. Elizabeth (mark) BURN, M. STRICKLAND, Jr. JP, Seth JONES JP.

Signed: M. STRICKLAND, Jr., JP, Seth JONES JP. Added note: Ext J. Rhodes Const.

Betsy BUNN(BURN)/Nehemiah PRIVETT, BASTARDY BOND. Be it remembered that on 17 September 1818 - Bondsmen: Nemeah PRIVET, planter, Able Upchurch & Jeremiah Rhodes, planters - came before us Samuel COOK & Charles L HINTON Justices.

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Two Hundred pounds (viz), Nimeah PRIVET One Hundred pounds, Abel UPCHURCH & Jeremiah RHODES fifty pounds each. Condition of Obligation: bounden Nemeah PRIVET Charged by Betsy BUNN of being Father of bastard Child delivered by said Betsy BUNN - said Nemeah PRIVET to appear before Justices of Court of Pleas and Quarter in Raleigh on 3r Monday of November -. Signed: Nehemiah PRIVETT, Able (x) UPCHURCH, Jeremiah RHODES. Chas. L. HINTON JP, Len'l COOKE JP."

We are especially interested in this record because it fixes Abel U., Sr. in a time and place. The circumstances are also of interest. We assume that Abel U., Sr. was a neighbor of many of the individuals listed in the record and that they lived in eastern Wake Co., NC, in Little River Township. We wonder why Abel U., Sr. (referred to as Able U. in the record) would put up a bond of 50 pounds in this case. One assumes the 200 pounds in bond money was posted to insure that the child of Betsy Bunn did not become a ward of the county. To have done this Abel U. Sr. must have been a good friend of the parties at risk and perhaps there was even somehow a family relationship. We wonder about these matters and also about the relationship between Abel U., Sr. and the other individuals listed in the record. Perhaps some of our readers can offer enlightenment.

B. Exciting News in the Abel U., Sr. Clan.

We have recently started exchanging information with Mrs. Edith D. Bourque of Escatawpa, MS. She is descended from a Nancy U., said to be the daughter of Abel U., Sr. This is a child of Abel U., Sr. which we do not have in our records. The verification of this entry would mean the establishment of the Abel U., Sr./Nancy U. Subclan. Nancy U. is reported to have been born in 1800 (NC) and to have married John "Jake" Walker, b. 1790 (SC). Their first child was born in 1827 in Greene Co., AL, as were the next three children. Their fifth child was born in 1836 in Newton, MS, as were some additional children. We look forward to sorting out this new development and encourage anyone with details or interest to come forward. We welcome Edith as a collaborator.

CLAN 8. (ABEL UPCHURCH, SR.).

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We are engaged in an exciting exchange of information with Mrs. James Henry Bourque (nee: Edith Carolyn Denham) of Escatawpa, MS. In her initial letter of 9 APR 1994 she wrote:

"Dear Dr. Upchurch

Mrs. Eleanor Kennedy of Alexandria, VA gave me your name and address. Six generations back I'm related to Abel and Bethania Upchurch from N.C. Their daughter Nancy married John Walker and they lived in Greene Co., AL before moving to Newton Co., MS. This is my line. I would like to request any information you have on Abel and his family and also going back as far as possible".

Without question the Abel U. to whom Cousin Carolyn refers is Abel U., Sr., Head of Upchurch Clan No. 8. However, this is the first we have heard of Abel U., Sr. having a daughter named Nancy. Frankly, there is some circumstantial evidence for and some against such a prospect. Naturally, we are engaging in an intensive exchange with Carolyn and hope soon

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to announce the existence of a new subclan, namely the Abel U.,Sr./Nancy U. Subclan. Input is requested from anyone who can help.

The Genealogical Society of Wake Co., NC. Produces a publication WAKE TREASURES. In Vol. 2, No. 4 (winter 1993) of this publication reference was made to one Able Upchurch whom we take to be Abel U., Sr., Head of Upchurch 589 Clan No. 8. This issue of WAKE TREASURES included a reprinting of certain court records for Wake Co., NC. for the year 1818. The mention of Able U. (Abel U., Sr.) in these records is significant in that it shows he was still in Wake Co., NC in 1818 and thus had not yet moved to Greene Co., AL, where he died about 1846. The court record states more specifically:

“....Be it remembered that on 17 September 1818 - Bondsman:
Nimeah Privet, planter, Able Upchurch and Jeremiah Rhodes,
planters - came before us Samuel Cook and Charles L Hinton,
Justices”.

This appearance concerned a certain civil matter in which Abel U., Sr. Posted a bond of fifty pounds to guarantee that Nimeah Privett would live up to certain obligations. Several other citizens are listed in the court record. It seems likely that Abel U., Sr. had a more-or-less close association with some of these individuals. Certainly, one would not post bond for an individual without having some kind of relationship with that individual. (We can presume Abel U., Sr. was not a professional bond poster). A closer study of the individuals involved would probably reveal the section of Wake Co., NC in which the civil matter involved took place. Most likely it was in eastern Wake Co., NC. A copy of the complete article will be made available to anyone who requests same.

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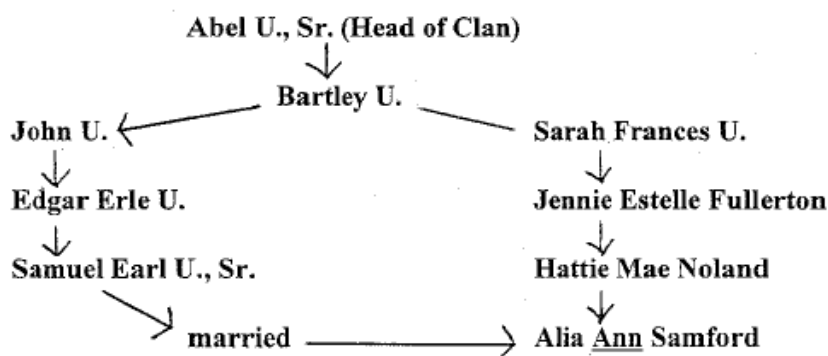

We regret to report the passing of Alia Ann (Samford) U. in Birmingham, AL on 10 MAR 1996. She was the widow of Dr. Samuel Earl U., Sr. They were second cousins, once removed, and both were members of the Abel U.Sr./Bartley U. 589/590 Subclan. Both Sam and Ann were outstanding citizens and praiseworthy members of our extended Upchurch family. Only recently has the full scope of their accomplishments come to our attention. Their lines are as follows:

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Sam was a noted plastic surgeon in Birmingham, AL, who died in 1968. He and Ann had three children and nine grandchildren. Their daughters were twins and both are physicians. Daughter Katherine Samford (Upchurch) Takvorian resides in Concord, MA and daughter Virginia Samford (Upchurch) Collier resides in Chestertown, MD. Son Samuel Earl U., Jr. Resides in Birmingham and is general counsel of First Alabama Bank and Regions Financial Corporation. Sam was the son of Edgar Erle U. of Clanton, AL. According to a personal communication from Ann, her husband's middle name was spelled Erle, as was his father's middle name, but Sam changed the spelling to Earl. Edgar owned and operated a drugstore in Clanton, and was President of the Clanton Bank. A scholarship fund was established at the Auburn University School of Agriculture in honor of Dr. Samuel Earl U., Sr. In due course, perhaps we shall learn more about the life of Dr. Sam. U.

Ann was born in Philadelphia, PA, but she was a lifelong resident of Birmingham, AL. Her mother, nee: Hattie Mae Noland, was a granddaughter of Sarah Frances (U.) Fullerton. Her father, Frank Park Samford, was the founder of Liberty National Life Insurance Company, the predecessor of Torchmark Corporation. He established a pattern of community and educational philanthropy which was passed to Ann. Samford University in Birmingham, AL was named for him.

Ann was a graduate of Sweet Briar College in VA and later served on the Board of Overseers and in 1993 received the Outstanding Alumna Award. She was a past president of the Junior League of Birmingham and was chairman of the Women's Committee of the United Way. Her two special interests were golfing and cattle ranching and she excelled in both. She received many honors for her golfing activities, including the highest honors of the Birmingham Golf Association Hall of Fame. She operated Grey Rocks Ranch in Autauga Co., AL where she raised prized Santa Gertrudis cattle, for which she received many honors. She was the first woman inducted into the Alabama Livestock Association Hall of Fame.

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In 1994 Ann was one of 25 charter members inducted into the 1856 Society which honors individuals who have given \$1 million or more in lifetime support to Auburn University. In 1995 she was selected as the first woman to be named to the Alabama Agriculture Hall of Honor..

These achievements and honors represent the culmination of dozens of significant but lesser recognitions which have come to Cousin Ann Upchurch.

Dr. Edgar Earl U., Sr. and his wife, Ann, trace their ancestry to humble Upchurch beginnings in Pickens Co., AL. They were blessed with opportunities and made much of their lives. We are proud to have them as exalted members of our Upchurch family and trust that their accomplishments and service will be seen as examples to emulate.

This picture appeared in the 27 JUL 1972 edition of The Coffeeville Courier of Coffeeville, MS with the notation that it was brought into the Courier by Mrs. Elizabeth Pittman (nee: Elizabeth Hazelwood Duncan) who was at that time the widow of Samuel Ira Pittman, a grandson of the Upchurch patriarch shown in the picture. The clipping of the article was forwarded to your editor by Julia Elizabeth U. in a letter dated 12 JUN 1979. We are indebted to Julia for her steadfast interest in her Upchurch heritage. She noted in the letter that this photo was made in 1900 when her father, Burt (Robert Burton U., Jr.) (shown as "M" in the photo) was 16 years old.

Robert Burton U., Sr. "Bob", the patriarch of the family shown, appears as "B" in the photo. He is the head of the Robert Burton U., Sr. Line in the Abel U., Sr./John U. Subclan. Shown in the picture are he and his wife and seven children who were living at the time. Four of his children died as infants before the picture was taken. One adult daughter had married and was deceased by 1900. She was Armenia Elvira U. "Minnie". She is represented by her widower husband, William Edwin Womack "Willie" as entry "N" in the photo and by her daughter (entry "H") Minnie Womack, age 6. A second married daughter, Elizabeth Ridgeway U. "Bessie" appears as entry "E" but without her husband. Their young children appear as entries "D", "F", and "G".

This is a rather spectacular photo which illustrates how this portion of the Upchurch family shifted its base from Greene Co., AL to Yalobusha Co., MS about 1876. This family had been based in Greene Co., AL and nearby areas for about 50 years from about 1825 to about 1875. Prior to about 1825, the family had been based for about 75 years east of Raleigh, NC, along the border of Wake and Franklin Counties, NC. At each move some siblings stayed behind. The result as of today is that members of the Abel U., Sr. Clan have relatives concentrated in various counties in NC, AL, and MS, but in fact located all over the country.

While Ruth is an Upchurch by marriage she has an interesting linkage to Fentress Co., TN which is Upchurch County. Her Grandfather, James Yatchman Crowley settled in Jamestown, TN and ran the Crowley Hotel (later Mark Twain Hotel). Her father Alphonso Claude Crowley was born in Jamestown. Martha Elvira U. appears to have spent her entire life in Greene Co.,
AL. An important segment of our Upchurch heritage unfolded in this
county, starting when her grandfather Abel U. Sr. arrived about 1830+/- 5 years.
We continue to explore threads of this heritage both in Greene Co., AL and
in the Wake Co., NC./Franklin Co., NC., area from whence Abel U. Sr. came.
These two geographical nodes of our heritage come more clearly into focus
each year as information is assembled and interpreted. In recent years we have
come to feel that the 1820-1850 migration from central NC to Greene Co., AL
involved numerous families. It is our belief that unfolding information about
these migrations will reveal that the Abel U. Sr. family had close association
with some of these co-migrating families in NC and in AL and that there were
intermarriages between the various families both in NC and in AL. The emerging
pattern of the Abel U., Sr. Clan is thus unfolding against a broader background of
related families who moved in a stream of migration which flowed from north to
south prior to 1850. This southward and western movement of our Upchurch family
continues a pattern which started in Surry Co., VA about 1700 and continued

MADE IN MOVING FROM NC TO AL TO MS

By Robert Phillip Upchurch

- I. Abel U., Sr. was born about 1775 (Franklin Co., NC). For the next 50 years he resided in Franklin Co., NC or in adjoining Wake Co., NC where he married about 1795 Bethenia _____. He had eight children all born in NC and the two oldest, Bartley & Benjamin, married in NC. The third child, Dolly, is thought to have been married in Greene Co., AL in 1826 and it is presumed Abel U., Sr. must have moved from NC to Greene Co., AL prior to this date - presumably about 1825. It is presumed that Abel U., Sr., his wife and all his children, married and unmarried, made the 1825 move to AL together or at least over a very short period of time, say a few months or a year or so. Abel U., Sr. died in Greene Co., AL in DEC 1846 and his wife died there in 1860. So far as is known all eight of the children of Abel U., Sr. remained in AL until they died. Only one daughter-in-law of Abel U. Sr., moved to MS - namely, the widow of Abel U. Jr. who moved to Choctaw Co., AL with her children. Therefore, it was the grandchildren of Abel U., Sr. (or at least some of them) who moved west to MS. So far as is known none of the children of the three daughters of Able U., Sr. moved to MS but more research on this point is needed. Four of the five sons of Abel U., Sr. had children who moved to MS. These would have been grandchildren of Abel U. Sr. and they were either siblings or first cousins. They moved in "batches" to four different areas of MS as follows:

- Batch 1. North Central MS - Yalobusha & Lafayette Counties.
- Batch 2. South Central MS - Choctaw County.
- Batch 3. Northeastern MS - Lawrence and Itawamba Counties.
- Batch 4. Southeastern MS - Clarke and Lauderdale Counties.

Batches 3 & 4 moved just across the MS state line only a few miles from Greene Co., AL.

Comments on the eight children of Abel U., Sr. are as follows:

- A. Bartley U., d. 1879 Greene Co., AL. None of his children moved to MS.
- B. Benjamin U., d 1863 Greene Co., AL. His sons William U. and Noah P. U. lived in Clarke Co., MS. His son Churchwell U. lived in Lauderdale Co., MS while his son Benjamin Newton U. lived in both Clarke and Lauderdale Counties.
- C. Dolly U. md Pullam Carver. Did children move to MS?
- D. James Laton U., Sr., d. 1860 Greene Co., AL.
 - Son John C. U. died about 1878. Did he move to MS? His wife nee: Nancy Brown, d. 1887 Choctaw Co., MS where their children lived.
 - Son Charles B. U. had descendants who lived in LA.
 - Son Samuel Pirese U. moved to MS. His descendants lived in Lafayette and Yalobusha Counties, MS.
- E. Mary U. md Clemmons Martin. Did children move to MS?
- F. Lynia U. md Joseph J. Rick. Did children move to MS?

G. John U., d. 1871 Greene Co., AL.

- Son Robert Burton U., Sr. moved to Yalobusha Co., MS about 1876.
- Daughter Sarah Isabella U. md Alonzo A Bradner. Moved to Yalobusha Co., MS. Had no issue but raised children of her brother William H. U. in Yalobusha Co., MS.
- Son William H. U. Lived in Yalobusha Co. and Sunflower Co., MS.
- Son Joseph Benjamin U. died in Greene Co., AL. Some of his children lived in Lawrence Co., MS.

H. Abel U., Jr., d. Greene Co., AL. His widow and children are later found in Itawamba Co., MS and even later in Denton Co., TX.

Abel U., Sr. was b. 1775 in Franklin Co., NC and died in 1846 in Greene Co., AL. He is found on the 1800 census of Franklin Co., NC with a wife and six children - 3 under 10 and 3 ages 10-16. It seems unlikely that all of these children are his but some, especially the younger ones could certainly be his. He was in Greene Co., AL by 1830 where a second batch of his children are found. The NC clutch did not seem to make it to AL. Therein lies a story yet to be learned. The AL children of Abel U., Sr. were Bartley, Benjamin, Dolly, James Laton U., Sr., Mary, Lynia, John and Abel U., Jr. One researcher reports that there was also an Upchurch daughter Nancy U., but other researchers did not include Nancy. Could she be from the NC clutch? We need this plot to thicken some more. As time went by the descendants of Able U., Sr. were divided, some staying in AL and some going to MS.

The informal pathway to the Upchurch building name is best revealed by the words of a member of the Animal Sciences Department at Auburn who provided the following story to your editor on 14 MAR 2011.

"

As for the name on our Animal Sciences Building - Ann Samford Upchurch, it's a bit of a long story, but I'll summarize as best as I know. Samuel E. Upchurch was an accomplished physician in Birmingham and started Liberty National Life Insurance company (now a part of TorchMark Corporation) to provide low-cost insurance to his low-income patients. He married Ann Samford of THE Alabama Samford Family which included many lawyers, I believe two Alabama governors, etc., etc. - including the Governor whose name is on our main administrative building - Samford Hall. Ann Samford Upchurch was high society and an avid golfer (even brought an LPGA charter to Alabama), but she fancied herself as a rough and tumble country girl who could drink (Scotch was her favorite) and cuss the equal of any sailor - but with class. She took a liking to the Santa Gertrudis breed of beef cattle, and the family purchases a large ranch about 30 miles outside of Montgomery that they named Grey Rocks Ranch, and that's where they would take their three children (twin daughters and a son) on weekends and holidays to get them out of the city. Our Department of Animal Sciences helped them get their herd established, and our Beef Extension Specialists got a lot of calls and answered a lot of questions, and the Samfords initially rewarded our efforts with a series of four full-ride+ undergraduate scholarships. We would always take the scholarship winners to their annual cattle sales to visit with Ann (her husband Sam had passed away before I started taking the students to the sales). In her will (she passed away about 8 or so years ago now), Ann left a sizable amount of money wanting Auburn to build a new Animal Science Building and name it for her husband, Sam.

It wasn't nearly enough money to do what she wished, and the children said anything related to Animal Sciences should really be named for their mother, not their dad, because the cows were her thing. So as a compromise between Auburn and the Upchurch children, the Upchurch name was put on our old building, and the money was endowed in our University Foundation with the interest income to be used each year to sponsor Departmental programs related to livestock production and educating students in Animal Sciences. If I'm not mistaken the two daughters are both medical doctors in the New York/Boston area, and the son, Sam Upchurch Jr., is a lawyer in Birmingham and takes care of the various family holdings related to Liberty National Life Insurance and TorchMark. I don't know if there are aunts and uncles or cousins, but I don't specifically recall any other family members being at the funeral of "Miss Ann".

Much of the above is from memory, so I'm sure there are flaws, but it's close enough you get the idea.

Named for Ann S. Upchurch, Upchurch Hall is home to the Department of Animal Sciences at Auburn University. The original building was constructed in 1929, and an additional wing was completed in the 1960's. Faculty and staff offices and research laboratories are spread throughout the three floors. Upchurch Hall is part of the "Ag Hill" section of campus, with Comer Hall, Funchess Hall, Smith Hall, and Rouse Life Sciences Building in close proximity. "

Your editor was fortunate to have exchanges with Ann Samford U. in the 1980s. She passed away on 10 MAR 1996. This brief presentation, another Upchurch footnote in history, is but a small part of what our Biofiles contain on the Abel U., Sr. Clan.
