ACRIL L. UPCHURCH XID-84

Commentary: Acril L. Upchurch was born 1805 in Green Level, Wake County, NC and died 1860 in Tipton County, Tennessee. He was the son of Nathan Upchurch I, head of Upchurch Clan #3. Acril married Mary Olive in Wake County in 1833 thus linking the Upchurches to the prominent Olive Family of Western Wake County. Using his inheritance following the death of his father in 1835, he migrated to Tipton County, TN where he resed a family. We are yet to learn the circumstances that led to his move – a topic for research.


Margaret Loyce (McFarland) Alket was a descendant of Acril Upchurch who gained DAR membership based on her relationship to Acril. We have a few snippets of her research and more can be uncovered. As of the 1970s, she had become unresponsive to family inquiries.

The circumstances of the marriage and movement of Aril to TN provide numerous insights into the record of the Nathan Upchurch I family and more research on Acril should be rewarding.
