# **Adaline Susan Royster**

# Commentary:

In the era of the American Revolution, there were a large number of closely related Roysters who lived in Granville County, NC. In 1802, David Royster, Sr., a scion of the larger group, married Susan Sims in Granville County. The couple was soon in residence in Raleigh, NC, where David was given accolades for his skills as a cabinet maker, some of his outputs being used to furnish the new Capitol building. His twelve children cut a wide swath in Raleigh in the nineteenth century and beyond. Among them was Adaline Susan Royster (1820-1894), who, in 1840, married William Clinton Upchurch I (1813-1906). He had come to Raleigh in 1833 to seek his fortune and for seven decades, was successful in the mercantile grocery business. He and Adaline also produced twelve children, of whom ten reached adulthood and married. They made significant societal contributions. If one accounts for all the families raised up by William Clinton Upchurch I and Adaline and their siblings, the telling would equate to a large part of the history of Raleigh for the 1800s.

## 21 Jun 1894

--Raleigh *News and Observer*: Monday evening at 5 o'clock, at her home on Wilmington street, Mrs. Adalaide Upchurch, wife of Mr. W. C. Upchurch, died in the 75<sup>th</sup> year of her age. Mrs. Upchurch was about a week ago stricken with paralysis of her right side and because of her advanced age but little hopes were entertained for her recovery. She lingered until yesterday evening and quietly died.

# I. Elisha Sims of Warren Co, NC

A. Susan Sims b. about 1779 (presumably in Warren Co, NC)- came to Raleigh, NC as a bride about 1802 and lived the remainder of her life in Raleigh, She was married for 62 years to David Royster. She died in Raleigh, NC. They had 12 children of whom 8 are now living. They had 64 grandchildren of whom 44 are now living. They have 15 great grandchildren. Of the 4 deceased children, one died beyond the Mississippi, one at Gettysburg, and two in Virginia hospitals- CSA. Susan died 25 Oct 1864.

The deceased was a highly-esteemed member of the Raleigh First Baptist church. Nine children and many grandchildren survive her. We sympathize with our aged brother in his great loss.

#### Historical Facts

Jacob Royster was from Mecklenburg Co., Va., around 1730. His will was dated July 1798. The last name of his wife is unknown, but there were nine children from this union: Jacob, Jr., Dennis, John, David, Pattie, Frankie, Mary, Sarah (Suky), and one who married a Wilkins.

David Royster married Mary Daniel and they had two sons, <u>David</u>, <u>Jr.</u> and Jethro. In the early 1800's, they went out to Tennessee and Kentucky, but a letter to David, <u>Jr.</u>, in Raleigh, dated 1810, states that he was teaching in Warren County, N. C.

David Royster, Jr., married Susan Simms of Warren Co., N. C. Their ten children were named: William Howard, James Daniel, Sarah Sanders, Madison Bulluck, Leonard Henderson, Adeline Susan Trene Nichols, David L., Mary Daniel, and Amanda Alvina. All ten children lived to be grown and married. James Daniel, who married Mary Ashley, named all of his children for states so everyone would know their father was James and not one of his brothers. Their names were: Virginia Carolina, Indiana Georgia, Iowa Michigan, Arkansas Delaware, Wisconsin Illinois, Vermont Connecticut, Oregon Minnesota, and Louisiana Maryland (died in infancy). Vermont Connecticut married his first cousin, Hallie Lee High, who was Amanda's daughter.

Adeline Susan Royster married William Clinton Upchurch, one of ten sons of Bertus Upchurch and Margaret Yates who lived near Morrisville in the Green Level community. They had twelve children, ten of which lived to be grown and married. Their names were: Afabian (died in infancy), Roxanna, Eleanor, Charles, George, Florence, Reid, John, Annie (died in infancy), Virginia, Pattie Aline, and Bettie Miller.

Pattie Aline married Frank O'Kelly Moring.

(The following information on the extended families of David Royster, Sr. and David Royster, Jr. is detailed as we received many questions, particularly while living in R Raleigh, about our family's relationship to the Roysters who were doctors, or the P Roysters who owned the candy store in Raleigh, and to Vermont Royster, Editor/Publisher of the Wall Street Journal.)

David Royster, Sr., son of Jacob, married Mary Daniel on 11 Jan 1775 in Granville County. As noted earlier, David, Sr. was a school teacher who taught in VA, NC, Ky. and TN. Around 1800 or 1802, David, Jr. a cabinet maker, moved to Raleigh to make furniture for the new State Capital Building being designed and built. In 1802 David, Jr. married Susan Sims in Granville County. Their 12 children were:

William Howard Royster, who married Mary Stevens/Stephens, and they had 7 children. James Daniel Royster, b.1807, d. 1890, a paper manufacturer in Raleigh amarried Mary Smoothly Ashley, and they had the following children that DAUSP

they named after the states to distinguish their children from the other

25 Royster children: Vermont Connecticut Royster; Dr. Wisconsin Illinois A. Royster who married Mary Willis Finch and they had 4 children, Hubert

Ashley, Frank Willis, James Finch, and one that died early; Oregon

المراجي Minnesota Royster; Virginia Carolina Royster; Indiana Georgia Royster; محت Iowa Michigan Royster; and Arkansas Delaware Royster. Vermont

Connecticut had two sons, Wilbur High and Percy Hoke. Wilbur High married Olivette James Broadway of Monroe, LA, and they named their

first son, Vermont Connecticut Royster, after his grandfather. Wilbur High Royster owned and managed the Royster Candy Store on Fayetteville Street in Raleigh. Vermont Royster, the grandson, became very famous and highly respected as Editor and Publisher of The Wall Street Journal. (Information about the Royster Family, as included in Vermont Royster's book, My Own, My Country's Times has been included in this family history summary.)

Madison Bullock Royster who married Martha Terry.

# (25) Marriages- Halifax Co, NC 1758-1872

On 10 Oct 2007 RPU visited the Franklin Co, NC Library in Louisburg, NC and inspected a book with the above title. There was only one Upchurch entry indexed and it is found on pg. 226 as follows:

W. C. Upchurch, <u>Adaline C. Upchurch</u>, J. C. L. Harris, C. L. Harris and I. S. Harris are referenced with a date of 27 Dec 1869.

[Note: As of 24 Nov 2007 the above notes seem incomplete. However, I know that on 27 Dec 1869 (Weldon, Halifax, Co, NC) Florence Caroline Upchurch, daughter of William Clinton Upchurch, I & <u>Adeline Susan Royster</u>, married John Coburn Logan Harris Sr. Presence C. L. Harris and I. S. Harris are relatives- possibly parents or siblings of the groom. Note that the "c" as a middle initial for Adeline Susan Royster seems incorrect- RPU]
