

started their families. Then about 1804 these two brothers moved to the boundary of Wake & Chatham Counties, NC - with more settling just across the line in Chatham Co and Nathan just inside Wake Co at Green Level.

You asked about the LEATHA UPCHURCH who mtd Hezekiah Massey in 180? in Franklin Co, NC. Enclosed is my profile on this Hezekiah Massey whom I carry as XFD-4. My best estimate is that this Leatha U is a daughter of the above mentioned Mose U. I have no record of children of this Leatha & Hezekiah but would love to know more about them. This Hezekiah has to be different from the one you report named LYDIA (U??) because of the ages involved. I have a number of references to the several individuals with the name Hezekiah Massey and imagine you have a lot more. They are confusing to me.

Richard U, III was a brother of Nathan & Mose. Richard U, III had 8 children (I think Frances & Clara on your list are the same person). I have records on thousands of descendants of Richard U, III and can supply you copies of Master Outlines of those parts of this family which are of most interest.

To you. To avoid confusion in this family you may need to be aware of the following:

- I. Richard U, III and (2nd) Susannah -- "Sooky"
 - A. Britton U, I and 20 FEB 1808 Elizabeth Macey
 - 1. Claburn U, II
 - B. Claburn U, I
 - 1. Britton U, II

So far we have not identified the name of the ^{1st} wife of Richard U, III by whom he had some & possibly all of his children. Nor do we know the family name of his 2nd wife. Both of these were no doubt came from the McCalister Creek Area.

Enclosed is a copy of the 10 Page Master Outline for the Richard U, III / Britton U, I Subclass covering Britton U, I and his children, grandchildren & greatgrandchildren. Descendants of the Greatgrandchildren (if any/if known) are covered in continuation sections as indicated on the left hand side of the page (A2, for example 1 A for Henry Columbus U)

Do you have any additions or corrections to make to the Master outline.

Enclosed is a copy of my 4 stem people on Elizabeth Massey (XFD-2784) who in 1808 married Rezekiah Massey. From this I conclude she was a daughter of Bethpool Massey. Do you agree?

Enclosed is a set of sheets on the Upchurch Publications so you can see what I am doing these days. Also, I am in the process of writing an Upchurch book tentatively entitled "Upchurch Ancestors - Eight American Generations" we have about 100 pages out of the computer with 200-300 pages to go. With any luck it will be completed in 1997.

[Butter U, I was of the 6th generation in America so the book would get down through her grand children]

D'Ann - I'll hope to hear from you in due course and will try to be more prompt in my reply next time

P.S. - Do you have a printout for the Massey Family of the Moccasin Creek Area for the 1750-1850 era you could send me? we will no doubt find more Upchurch - Massey connections. Phil U.

Thanks for the compilation of notes on the Massey family which arrived 4 MAR 1996. I have highlighted each Upchurch mentioned and placed this as a reference document in my Massey Family file for future reference.

I have gone through my Massey bibles and identified each case where a Massey married an Upchurch or an Upchurch descendant plus any offspring which resulted from such marriage and had a Massey name. There were 35 such events. I have summarized them on the enclosed chart (outline) (2 pages). The events have been placed under the appropriate descendant of Michael U, I (XFA-46) going down to the 6th Upchurch Generation. There were two cases where an event involved directly a 6th generation Upchurch and a Massey - Leatha U and Bezekiah Massey and Button U, I

and Elizabeth Massey. The rest of the events involved descendants of a 6th generation Upchurch. If you want me to send you copies of the 35 Massey profiles involved please let me know.

I don't know how helpful this exercise is - it just occurred to me as something I could do.

There are, without question, interactions between Massey and Upchurch family members not captured in the above analysis. Such events would involve descendants of Upchurch female and Massey female whose descendants would not bear either the Massey or the Upchurch name.

From what I hear from all the many, many histories I have on that family, Dilly was near the children's age and was resented. You can see that in the court fights.

It is interesting that the descendants of John & Olive Richardson (or Dilly Strickland) Chamblee stayed in the area, and the remainder of the Robert Chamblee descendants seemed to move on to other parts, the James Chamblee line to Blount Co, Alabama, the Jarred Chamblee kin to Mississippi, and old Jacob Chamlee's family to South Carolina and then over into Georgia and Texas. This would account for the many, many family histories I have of John Chamblee's family with less information coming from the others.

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③

As you know, Carla Tate has been digging into the Pearce/Pierce connection with the Bolton family. There are so many, many families that have great impact with the Chamblees: Bunns, Stricklands, Boltons, Masseys, Pendergrass, Pippins, etc., etc. She is trying to find "Rocky Branch" on Moccasin Creek via old maps (what old maps?!) I've always found the names of these places by looking at old land divisions and plat maps, which I will hopefully will start soon. If you happen to have information on any OLD maps of the four-corner counties (Nash, Wake, Franklin, Johnston), please let me know.

I am very interested in your wife's lineage. You may not know that my Stricklands are both from Franklin and
△ Nash County (mostly northern Nash). A Chamblee cousin in Raleigh springs from the Reuben Strickland tribe (anyone know his father?) from southern Nash County. My other Stricklands lived in Franklin County, and I my
△ grandfather's first cousin, Henry Raymond Wood, former county clerk of Franklin County still lives in Louisburg
△+△(born 1906). I plan on visiting him the first part of October. He married Sallie Mitchell. When I was 8 and 15 I stayed a week or so with relatives in Nash County. My mother took me to many homesites in all counties which are no longer in existence. Even as an eight year old I was mesmerized by family history.

Enclosed is my family group sheet and a pedigree chart on my grandfather per your request. I have MANY other lines in my computer if I but knew what you would like to see. Perhaps your wife's line and mine could possibly meet. That would be interesting! I would also like to know if you were raised in that area, and what your mother's name was etc. Family history is a "disease" of curiosity, isn't it? Always wondering if we might be connected to the next person in some convoluted way.

Certainly you will be placed on the Chamblee mailing list. I know one day as the subscribing (and most deserved) list grows longer I will have to charge to handle costs, but until then I simply rely on donations or swaps. I'm afraid if I ever have to attach a stipend to the newsletter the material therein will actually have to be accurate! Oh, no, can't have that!

I hope you are enjoying Missouri, I have been through there a half a dozen times and found it very beautiful. Lucky you!



Dear D'Ann,

I am writing in response to your item #25 in the Spring 1992 issue of Wake Treasures. My connection with the families you mention is somewhat indirect so I don't want to get your hopes up too much. However, there is always a chance we might help each other so I thought a letter might be in order.

My connections with the families you mention are several. The first was established in the early 1940's when I met Douglas Scales Chambliss who was then & for a lifetime employed at N. C. State University. We were close friends for many years and he became my mentor and best man at my wedding in Raleigh, NC in 1948. He comes, more or less, from the Little River District you mentioned. He is about 69 and is the son of Cleveland Scales Chambliss and the grandson of Sidney Columbus Chambliss. My contact with Doug in the last 30 years has been irregular as I have been away from NC. He had earlier not expressed much interest in family history although I do recall

that he said his mother side of the family had much interest. His mother was a HORTON. They were numerous in the Little River District.

I was born 9 FEB 1928 in Wake Co, NC in Supt Creek Township and grew to be a young man there. Many years later I became seriously interested in Upland Family History and since 1980 have published the Upland Bulletin on which details are enclosed. I have identified and published on 30,000 members of the Extended Upland Family. I have about one million biofiles on specific members of the family or on individuals related by circumstance (nurses, neighbors, etc).

My ancestor Richard Upland, II arrived in what is present day Franklin Co, NC about 1755. The center of Upland activity there was in the Mowson Creek Area which is just across the creek from the Little River District you mention. In fact, many descendants spilled over into Little River District. I have collected huge amounts of detail about this particular branch of Upland, some of which I have published. I continue to work with

the various kinds³ of records from 1750 up to the present time. For the last ten years I have subscribed to the Zelman, NC newspaper and have clipped out all items re births, marriages, deaths, etc and have created profiles for a key member of each article. At present I have a local person hired to locate the land sites of Richard Upchurch, II, his children & grandchildren in the Moccasin Creek Area. I have several correspondents in the area.

I have profiles on 69 individuals with the last name Chambliss including the names in your article. There are several Upchurch/Chambliss interactions in these profiles. The earliest one is for Rebecca Chambliss, for whom the profile is enclosed. I have some details on her descendants. I do not know her parents. Stephen Upchurch is the son of Jubal Upchurch and the grandson of the aforementioned Richard Upchurch, II.

The other families you mention are also well represented in my profile system especially the Beltan's, Massey's & Denton's & Stuchlands. These families and the Upchurches lived

our neighbors and their members often internamed and continue to do so today. My biographies represent quite an array of dates, some of the references are in the 1750-1850 era but some are for the last decade or so.

If after reading the above you think we can help each other, please let me know. Do keep me on your list and let me know when it will be available and the cost as I might like to purchase a copy.

My Upchurch Bulletin is sent regularly to Michael D. Kirley, Genealogy Dept, Los Angeles Public Library, 630 W. 5th Street, Los Angeles, CA 90071. I assume this is different than the Family History Center to which you refer. Would it be justified to have a set at the Family History Center as well? I prefer to sell copies but will donate copies to my library if necessary and if there is good logic for placement at the location in question.

Thanks so much for your letter of 31 JUL 1995 and for the initial issue of Chambler. This will be an important publication for me and I hope you will place me on the regular mailing list. Let me know if there is a charge. Since I am not a Chambler descendant and only collect Chambler information you may not wish to list me as a "Chambler Researcher". However, if you decide to do so I have no objection.

Could you give me a sketch of your family history going back to Franklin Co, NC. I would like these names in my Biofile system. Also I would like to have your full maiden name as I file that may if possible

Douglas Scaler Chambler is the son of Cleveland Scaler Chambler. I have never heard that he has a particular interest in his family heritage but I can give you his phone no and address in Raleigh, NC if you so desire. The Unit and

details you provided on the Cleveland State Chamberlain seem basically correct but I have some comments. Are you convinced Dolly Strickland was the mother of Sidney Columbus Chamberlain. She was born 1793 and he was born 1847. - possible but not likely. For the 1920 census I have no idea who the Isham age 9/12 is - other than that this occupies the spot appropriate for Graham Vance Chamberlain. On this list OLETA is misspelled OLEADA. I knew Doug's brother Graham and his sister Oleta as well as their parents. Cleveland had two brothers with medical degrees. One practiced in Spring Hope, NC and in May of this year I saw his gravestone in the Spring Hope cemetery. My wife knew him as she lived in that area. The other brother practiced in NM (Las Cruces I believe). In about 1953 I passed through NM and had a brief visit with this brother. He had a great fear of disease and would not shake hands. Doug married Edythe - - . They had 3 children - a son Gary who is married and I think has issue; Doug's other children were daughters Gale and Marie - turns - who have never married. Enclosed is my profile sheet on Doug's sister OLETA (note misspelling of her maiden name *?911)

As we continue to exchange information I am sure we will find more ways to help each other. My wife was born in Franklin Co, NC and raised in Nash Co, NC. She is descended from the Stricklands. The Stricklands & Upchurch lived side by side in the Moccasin Creek Area of Franklin Co, NC starting in the 1750's. I have Waver's in my background.

Details on the Upchurch Bulletin are enclosed

You asked about proof that Jubal U is the father of Stephen U. My profiles on these two are enclosed (Jubal 10 Pages 33 Items; Stephen 3 Pages 15 Items). From these documents you can get some circumstantial evidence on the relationship. Maybe you can add more to this. My sense of the relationship is stronger because of what I know of the total Upchurch family in the area. I can do more of an analysis on this if you desire.

A copy of my Master outline on Stephen U is enclosed. We have a long way to go on this family. Since Stephen and Ann Medlin's 1841 I presume Rebecca died or left Stephen some time before this second marriage. The 1830 census shows seven people in the household of Stephen U (see entry #7 on Stephen U profile) I presume Rebecca in the female 20-30

and that Stephen is one of the said males 20-30.

Further I presume that the male 25 is a child of Rebecca & Stephen. I do not know who the other 4 members of the household are. A first look at the siblings of Stephen does not lead one easily to the prospect that the 4 are siblings & children of siblings of Stephen. Maybe they are siblings & children of siblings of Rebecca ?? I have not yet located Stephen on the 1840 census of Franklin or Wake (Surely he is there or in a nearby county). I presume the 1840 census could reveal more children of Rebecca & Stephen.

on the enclosed Master Outline for Stephen I have entered 8 names as children: However, XID numbers have not been assigned to #7 & 8 as they seem more likely to be grandchildren rather than children.

The family of Julia U has been slow to unfold but over the years I have made some progress. I am sure there are many more details in the records to help us define this family.

I have profiles on about 75 Crumlee family members. Contained within these profiles would be enough added Crumlee names to boost the total to around 300 (wild guess). These individuals come from the era

of pre-1800 to current day, heavily weighted to the latter. Most of these are not Upchurch related but then you never can tell. Many of these came from clippings from the Zebulon Record newspaper from which I clip all births, deaths, marriages, etc. in direct regard to their family connections. (I just hope they will help me or someone else in due course). Do these 75/300 Crumpler people interest you?

It is great to have you as a collaborator. Please give me your ideas on how we can proceed from here.




