Ellie Upchurch lived with my grandfather, Lex Upchurch to help take care of my father, Larry and his two sisters, Agnes and Marjorie after the death of their mother Elsie. Ellie gave the family Bible belonging to John Upchurch to my aunt Agnes. She kept it until her death and shortly after the funeral Marjorie ended up with it. I wish I had photo copied it or written down the information, but I did not see it until she was leaving with it. Unfortunately it will most likely end up in the trash if it hasn't already.

Ellie was Cherokee, but I am unsure if she was full-blooded. She knew a lot of native american medicine and tried to pass it on, but the racism was prevalent at the time and no one in the family seemed to be interested in claiming their heritage.

I have heard that John Upchurch had illegitimate children, but I was unsure of how many or who they were. My dad remembers Cora and Vallie very well. They would often come to visit. Mark and Benton also came to live with them to help raise the kids and provide financial support. Mark amassed a large sum of money from some businesses he owned in Louisiana and brought the cash back to TN. He provided the majority of financial support and parental guidance for all 3 kids until his death.
