

DETAILS RE CO "I"

AUSLEY, Joseph D. Corporal

Enlisted in Wake County at age 24, 28 May 1861, for the war. Mustered in as Private. Wounded at the first battle of Manassas, Virginia, 21 July 1861. Promoted to Corporal on 15 March 1862. Killed at Seven Pines, Virginia, 31 May 1862.

The company, known as "Cedar Forks Rifles," was from Wake and Chatham Counties and enlisted in Wake County on 28 May 1861. It went into the camp of instruction near Company Shops (Burlington), Alamance County, 1 June 1861, and was assigned to this regiment [Sixth Regiment] as Company I. After joining the regiment, the company functioned as a part of the regiment, and its history for the war period is recorded as a part of the regimental history.

The information contained in the following roster of the company was compiled principally from company muster rolls for 20 June 1861, through February 1864, and 15 September through December 1864. No company muster rolls were found for the period prior to 20 June 1861; for March through 14 September 1864; or for the period after December 1864. In addition to the company muster rolls, Roll of Honor records, receipt rolls, hospital records, prisoner of war records, and other primary records, supplemented by state pension applications, United Daughters of the Confederacy records, and postwar rosters and histories, all provided useful information.

Thomas Frazier, Jr moved from Sampson Co., NC and to Henry Co., TN prior to 1824 and before or after married JANE AUTRY. Daniel Frazier (brother of TFG) came to TN later & there and 2 SEP 1838 Sarah Ann U D/o David U & G D/o William U, II, Head of clan.

Jane Autry had a brother MICAJAH AUTRY for whom Richard Holt provides the following:

Jane Autry Frazier, widow of Thomas, Frazier, Jr. at some point in time accepted faith in the Church of Latter Day Saints (Mormon Church) & moved north from Henry Co., TN after 7 MAY 1844 to Illinois & joined the Mormon trek to Utah along with several of her children. Her son, Thomas L., joined the Mormon Battalion in JUL 1846. Her brother, Micajah Autry, had moved from Sampson Co., NC to Davidson Co., TN in 1823, passed the bar and became a lawyer. Between 1831 and 1835, he practiced law at Jackson in Madison Co., TN. Seeking greater opportunities, he went to Texas, joined the volunteers fighting for independence from Mexico and was at the Battle of the Alamo, dying there along with the other defenders of the fort in 1836. It has been reported that Micajah was an expert marksman and was supposed to have taken a sniper shot at Gen. Santa Anna that barely missed.

 Enlisted in Wake County on July 5, 1862, for the war. Died October 31, 1862.

 Enlisted in Wake County on July 15, 1862, for the war. January-February, 1863, muster roll carries him with the remark: "Docked one months pay by sentence of Regimental Court Martial."

Federal Provost Marshal records report him as a rebel deserter received at Washington, D.C., April 12, 1865, from City Point, Virginia.  Enlisted in Wake County on August 28, 1862, for the war. First reported on company muster roll for the period May 1-August 31, 1864. September-October, 1864, muster roll reports him as "absent wounded since July 18, 1864." Paroled at Greensboro on May 10, 1865.
- △ ★ SILLS, JOHN, Private  
 Enlisted in Wake County on June 6, 1863, for the war. First reported on company muster roll for the period May 1-August 31, 1864. Muster rolls indicate that he was wounded July 18, 1864. Present or accounted for until paroled at Appomattox Court House, Virginia, April 9, 1865.

Declared exchanged on June 12, 1863. Reported as absent wounded until detailed in hospital at Richmond, Virginia, February 22, 1864. Company muster rolls report him as absent on detail through October, 1864.
