



1794 March term, County Court Minutes (original), p. 398(?). The Last Will and Testament of James Pierce was exhibited and proved by Benjamin Wheeler and Moses Upchurch, two of the subscribing witnesses thereto and on M.O.R. and at the same time Thomas Ray qualified as executor thereto and returned an inventory of the estate of oath (?work) M.O.R. Ordered that the executor of James Pierce sell such part of the parishable estate as he thinks necessary and make report to the next court.

1794 March 24, Will Book A. p. 174. Sale of estate of James Pierce, dec'd. Buyers on 24 March 1794 were Mary Pierce, James Sanders, David Jones, James Butler, Richard Pierce, and John Crawley. 

May 10, 1952, brought spate of violence as police chief killed 2

The evening of Saturday, May 10, 1952, brought unexpected violence to the town of Apex when Apex Police Chief S.L. Bagwell shot and killed two brothers in the Apex Town Hall (now the site of the Apex Recreation Department) first-floor courtroom after being slashed with a knife. Killed at close range by Bagwell's .38-caliber revolver were Thomas and Oscar Mitchell of Bunn Level. A third brother, James Mitchell, was moved after the shootings from Apex to the Wake County Jail and charged with speeding.

The incident described in detail by News & Observer reporter Charles Craven included grisly photographs of one of the dead men clutching a knife and another one of Bagwell in bed at Rex Hospital wrapped in bandages. Ironically, it was Bagwell's large stomach that probably saved his life, for the knife blade was unable to penetrate past his body fat into his abdominal cavity.

In a newspaper interview the following day, Bagwell stated he was patrolling Highway 55 inside the town limits when he stopped a 1940 Chevrolet containing three men and a woman. The car was speeding and weaving across the road around 7 p.m. While writing a ticket an argument ensued over the speeding violation, and Bagwell ordered the driver, James Mitchell, to follow him to Town Hall, where he would have to post bail. Arriving at Town Hall, Bagwell received a report of a drunk driver and instructed Mitchell to stay in his car until he returned with the other driver. According to Bagwell's account, still another argument began over the speeding ticket and when he attempted to place a struggling James Mitchell into a jail cell, he was attacked by Thomas and Oscar Mitchell, who attempted to free their brother. During the scuffle the police chief was cut in the hand and abdomen. He fired a fusillade of bullets at close range, killing Thomas and Oscar Mitchell instantly.

The only other person in Town Hall was a high school student who worked on weekends answering

the phone. The student said he witnessed the struggle in the between the four men but left the room and returned only after the shots had been fired. Bagwell ordered the young boy to stay with the remaining brother and he went outside on Salem Street and hailed a passing motorist who took him to a local doctor. From there he was taken, in serious condition, to Rex Hospital, where he received 42 stitches in the chest and stomach during emergency surgery.

Alerted to the shootings, highway patrol and sheriff officers from all over Wake County descended on Apex and found the two dead men on the blood-covered floor and James Mitchell locked in a jail cell, where he had been placed by the wounded Bagwell. That same night Bagwell was exonerated of the shootings by a coroner's inquest hastily empaneled by Wake County Sheriff Robert Pleasants on the orders of W.P. Whitley, acting coroner and director of the City-County Bureau of Identification.

Six men were selected for the inquest. Two from Apex and four more from the county outside of the Apex jurisdiction. During the inquiry neither Chief Bagwell nor James Mitchell was questioned, and a verdict of justifiable homicide was apparently based largely on the evidence of the high school student.

A second investigation headed by William Y. Bickett, solicitor of the Seventh Judicial District, also cleared Bagwell of any blame.

On Tuesday, May 13, James Mitchell was released from jail on a \$500 bond so that he could attend the funeral of his two brothers. In a statement made to a Wake County Deputy, Mitchell said that his brother Thomas had recently been released from prison after serving five years for the murder of a Bunn Level man.

Chief Bagwell would later leave Apex and become the head of security for the Harriet-Henderson Mills in Henderson. The Vance County cotton plants became the scene of the state's longest labor strike in 1959 and received national attention when the National Guard was mobilized to bring order to the textile town.
