Commentary: Controversy surrounds James B Baker. It is thought that he was born in 1835 and died in 1865 at Point Lookout, MD. He appears and disappears on documents that should include him. Nevertheless, James B. Baker is listed as being the son of Blake and Frances Upchurch, daughter of Jubal, head of Upchurch clan 6.

She married Blake Baker November 16, 1829 in Wake Co, NC, son of Henry Baker and Rebecca Perry. He was born about 1798, and died 1865 in Wake Co, NC.

Notes for Atlas J Stallings, CSA:

Atlas enlisted in Co K, 24th Regt on Jun 17, 1861 as a Sgt at the age of 22. He was wounded May, 1864. He was present at Appomattox.
