RSB was the executor of the estate of his father Blake Baker who died intestate 21 Jan 1863 (Wake Co, NC). The use of "Sanders" as a middle name is presumed to show the close relationship of the Upchurch/Blake/Sanders families.

RSB was CSA Co K, 24th NC Regiment – was wounded late in the war and was released at Fort Delaware. He enlisted as a 3rd Lt and came home a captain. I have his original commissioning paper when the unit was first formed as the "Poplar Spring Greys".

He married Elizabeth Margaret Baker December 20. 1865 in Franklin Co, NC. She was born January 19, 1841, and died November 7, 1902.
