**Commentary:** Thomas H. Baker, born about 1831, was the son of Blake and Frances Upchurch Baker. He was a grandson of Jubal, head of Upchurch clan 6. Thomas and several of his siblings served the CSA during the Civil War.

- 1. **Thomas H Baker** born circa 1831 died 21 May 1865 (CSA, POW, Ft McHenry Post Hospital, Baltimore, MD) (Buried – “near hospital”) No known marriage or issue.

**THB** was in CSA, Co K, 24<sup>th</sup> NC Regiment. He was wounded “gunshot with ilium fracture” at Sailor’s Creek, VA, captured and later died.
