Enlisted in Wake County on April 22, 1864, for the war. Wounded and captured at Winchester, Virginia, September 19, 1864. Died in hospital at Winchester on October 22, 1864, of "gangrene of stump and exhaustion."
- △ **BARNES, JAMES R.**, Private  
Enlisted in Wake County at age 37, August 29, 1862, for the war. Wounded at Chancellorsville, Virginia, May 3, 1863. Reported as absent on furlough through October, 1863, and as absent without leave after that date.
- △ **BARNHART, HENRY**, Private  
Enlisted in Wake County on April 26, 1864, for the war. Died in hospital at Staunton, Virginia, August 12, 1864.
- △ **BLACK, ALEXANDER**, Private  
Enlisted in Wake County on June 4, 1864, for the war. Killed at Cedar Creek, Virginia, October 19, 1864.
- △ **BOWLES, WILLIAM H.**, Private  
Enlisted in Wake County on April 8, 1864, for the war. Reported as absent sick on company muster rolls through October, 1864. Admitted to hospital at Charlottesville, Virginia, December 22, 1864, with "debility" and returned to duty December 24, 1864.
- △ **BURRUSS, SOLOMON**, Private  
Enlisted in Wake County on April 22, 1864, for the war. Reported as absent sick on company muster rolls through October, 1864. Paroled at Salisbury on May 15, 1865.
- △ **COBB, MICAHAH**, Private  
Resided in Wilson County and enlisted in Wake County at age 29, September 3, 1862, for the war. Captured and paroled at Paris, Virginia, November 5, 1862. Died in hospital at Richmond, Virginia, December 20, 1862, of "variola."

- △ **HARRIS, JOHN H.**, Private  
Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 29, August 15, 1862, for the war. Wounded at Chancellorsville, Virginia, May 3, 1863, and died the next day.
- △ **HASTY, SAMUEL W.**, Private  
Resided in Richmond County and enlisted in Wake County at age 30, July 17, 1862, for the war. Present or accounted for on company muster rolls through October, 1864. Captured in hospital at Richmond, Virginia, April 3, 1865, and confined at Point Lookout, Maryland, where he died June 19, 1865, of "bronchitis."
- △ **KARRIKER, WILEY**, Private  
Enlisted in Wake County on April 26, 1864, for the war. Wounded and captured at Winchester, Virginia, September 19, 1864. Confined in hospital at Baltimore, Maryland, until transferred to Point Lookout, Maryland, January 2, 1865. Paroled at Point Lookout and transferred for exchange to Boulware's Wharf, James River, Virginia, January 17, 1865. Admitted to hospital at Richmond, Virginia, January 22, 1865, and furloughed for 60 days on January 24, 1865.
- △ **KOONCE, MICHAEL**, Private  
Enlisted in Wake County on April 8, 1864, for the war. Present or accounted for until reported on the September-October, 1864, muster roll with the remark: "Absent missing since the battle of Cedar Creek, October 19, 1864."
- △ **LANE, WILLIAM A.**, Private  
Resided in Forsyth County and enlisted in Wake County at age 27, August 28, 1862, for the war. Wounded at Chancellorsville, Virginia, May 3, 1863. Present or accounted for until captured at Spotsylvania Court House, Virginia, May 20, 1864. Confined at Point Lookout, Maryland, until released after taking the Oath of Allegiance and joining the U.S. service on June 7, 1864. Assigned to Company E, 1st Regiment U.S. Volunteer Infantry.

JAMES RAY and wife WENNIFRED sold land to BENJAMIN WATTS by deed dated February, 1772 in Book A at page 62; in 1773 they deeded lands in CHATHAM to ROBERT RUTHERFORD, Book A p. 142; in 1778 they sold land to WILLIAM PERRY, JR. which is recorded in Book d p. 515.

A section on fraternal orders describes several most if not all of which appear to be MASON LODGES, of which the following is presumed to be one:

George Washington Lodge No. 174

George Washington Lodge No. 174, located at Lassiter's Crossroads, was chartered December 5, 1855. William C. Mason was master; J. Broodwell, senior warden; M. C. Lewter, junior warden; Hinton Hudson, secretary; Sims Upchurch, treasurer; William Womble, senior deacon; Joseph Bell, junior deacon; and A. Barbee, tyler.

Dues for the year 1858 were one dollar per member and 75 members are listed in the lodge minute book.

The cornerstone of the lodge was laid by Columbus Lodge No. 102 on September 29, 1859.

In 1882 the lodge moved to Bell's Crossroads and on July 24, 1908, S. M. Baldwin sold the lodge a lot located behind the present Bell's Baptist Church where the lodge now stands.

With the coming of the New Hope Dam the members of George Washington Lodge will be forced to move from the Bell's Community and the Lodge will probably unite with some nearby lodge.
