



Humphrey and Edney Ballard

Fourth-great-grandparents Humphrey and Edney Ballard were residing in Wilkes County in northeastern Georgia as early as 1785, where Humphrey is recorded as being a member of the land court and paying taxes in that year.<sup>1</sup>

Wilkes County had been created several years earlier in 1777 and had been named in honor of John Wilkes, a distinguished member of the British Parliament who had strenuously opposed those harsh and unjust measures towards the colonies which had finally led to the Revolution.<sup>2</sup>


Humphrey (probably about age 45-50 at this time) and Edney were the parents of three sons -- Nathan, third-great-grandfather Philip, and Ransom. On February 18, 1787, Humphrey purchased 200 acres of second quality oak and hickory land for \$100 on Fishing Creek, a tributary of the Savannah River, from Sanders and Sarah Walker. This land in Wilkes County had been part of an original grant to Sanders Walker dated September 24, 1784.<sup>3</sup>

On March 22, 1799, Humphrey and Edney sold 50 acres of their land to son Philip for \$200.<sup>4</sup> In October of that year, Humphrey's son Nathan, along with 21 others, was hauled into court for "retailing Spirituous Liquours, Cidar, Beer, &c" without a license.<sup>5</sup>

Humphrey died sometime in 1801. His will, written September 19, 1800, was probated in July 1801.<sup>6</sup> We have no further record of Edney. In his will, Humphrey left to son Nathan one bed and (bed) furniture and one large pewter dish, which he wasn't to have until after Edney's death. To son Philip he left the sum of \$50, "being a part of a note I have on my son Nathan of \$216 also being the interest of the above \$200 note for one year." To son Ransom he gave the sum of \$150, "the balance of the note due me by Nathan Ballard, and one bed and (bed) furniture, one brown filly colt and all \_\_\_\_\_ of my lawful property after the decease of me and my wife...."

In October of 1801, Ransom Ballard was one of six witnesses in a trial charging a Gustavus Gaines with breaking into the house of William Brooker and assaulting Peter L. Van Allen.<sup>7</sup> Nathan Ballard died in 1803, leaving a widow Mary, and four children, John, James, Edne, and Nancy.<sup>8</sup>




Prior to Humphrey Ballard's known residence in Wilkes Co., Georgia (in 1785,) Humphrey Ballard appears in North Carolina as follows:

Who married

Samuel Atkins Johnson

Charity Isabella Ballard was born Feb. 8, 1844. Her father was John Ballard whose Irish ancestors settled in what is now Buncombe County. He probably went down into Cumberland County to see relatives for the oldest lawyer mentioned in Harnett County history was a Ballard. In Cumberland he met and married a Scotch girl, Susan Goodman, whose parents settled along the Cape Fear country. She was a stern Scotch woman, who spoke Scotch dialect rapidly when her happy-go-lucky Irish husband occasionally took more than one toddy! And her daughters knew to scrub the floors until they shined.

This couple had six children..Mary, Alex, David, Marshall, Susan, and Isabella, and it seems that the family fortune, which had always been meager, became worse and they moved into Harnett County before the Civil War. They attended the Old Bluff Presbyterian Church where Isabella learned to read, and of course she learned the catechism which she later taught to all her children. She was so impressed with the doctrine of this church that throughout her life she never felt it quite right to visit on Sunday except with the sick.

When the Civil War began her brothers enlisted. David died of pneumonia and was buried at Wilmington, N. C. Alex was wounded but lived to middle age. Marshall was wounded at Gettysburg, but lived to a ripe old age.

Her sister had married a handsome man by the name of Bryant Bowden. They had several children and lived at Averysboro. During the war he ran away ten times to see his wife and children. Once he was up for courtmartial and expected to be shot, however his commanding officer made a plea for him, saying he always came back and that he was too fine a soldier to be shot.

Toward the end of the war there was a battle or skirmish at Averysboro.

The Ballard father, mother and two girls heard the guns and cannons booming all day long and knew it must be near their daughter's home. Early the next morning Susan and Isabella were sent walking to learn what had happened to Mary and the children. They reached Averysboro late in the afternoon. As they approached their sister's house they heard crying and mourning. Mary like others had taken into her home wounded soldiers, both Confederate and Union. Men in gray lay on pallets beside men in blue; their uniforms spotted with blood. The crying was that of a young Union soldier who had been shot in the eye. The girls burst into tears at the sight of so much suffering. Mary had to scold them and put them to helping her to stop their weeping.

When the Yankees left they had rifled every home. Mary had not one bite to eat in her house. Every chicken was taken. They had spilled a bag of peas and dropped some pieces of meat as they left. She raked up the peas and cooked them with the scraps of meat. That was all she had for her family and the soldiers to eat. She was a brave wonderful woman. The battle was fought so near her house that the soldiers hid behind the corners of her house to shoot; yet she never faltered. She calmed her children and kept the wounded, waiting on them until help came and took them away.

Isabella had learned to spin, weave, and dye cloth from native plants; poke-berries, red oak bark, and indigo. She had knit socks for her brothers and neighbors in the army.

When she was twenty-three she married a personable bachelor from a well-to-do family, Samuel A. Johnson. Although she had little education, she compensated in good judgment, wisdom and personality. Since he was a teacher he naturally helped her, and it was fortunate that this girl of Scotch-Irish ancestry was strong in body and soul, for she had much to endure in the years ahead. Her husband came to depend upon her in business matters. She made the decisions and was a much better business manager than he. She had all

the nursing and care of their eight children in sickness and in health. He prayed for them, but she was the main stay.


After her husband's death at age 84 in 1914, she sold the home and lived with her children. All her daughters-in-law loved her, and her one son-in-law made her as welcome as he could have his own mother; yet she missed her community and her old friends so that her sweet serenity was in accepting fate rather than the joy of fellowship in neighboring visits, and the routine of her own home.

She was so gentle and kind. There was no talking-back to her, for she was so polite to her children that they knew no other than to be polite to her. She taught them to love each other. When there was bickering among her children all she had to do was to put her hand to her head and say, "Well, it looks like you will kill me." All her children rose up to call her blessed.


In her last years she spent most of the time in the home of her son John, in Lillington, N.C. It was there she did a second turn at knitting for soldiers in World War I. And it was there she died January 22, 1922.

Phillip and Mary (Petit) Ballard

Third-great-grandparents Philip Ballard and Mary Petit were married in Wilkes County, probably about 1797. After the deaths of Humphrey and his son Nathan, Philip and Ransom moved a little to the southwest to Georgia's Putnam County. Here, Ransom and Mary Elizabeth (Polly) Marshall were married, on March 7, 1811.

In the 1820 census for Putnam County, Philip and Mary already had a large family of three sons and six daughters. These would be Jane, John, Sarah, Edna, Elizabeth, Gideon, Mary, Philip Jr, and Emily. On November 30, 1821, their last child, second-great-grandfather James Ballard was born. Their home here was 200+ acres on the waters of Bea Camp Creek, a branch of the Oconee river. They had five slaves here, probably the slaves "Paris, Sabra, and Fanny, and the increase of said Sabra and Fanny", who were willed to Mary Petit Ballard by her mother Jane Petit in 1818.

On September 13, 1822, Philip purchased 300 acres of land, a little to the northwest, in Newton County, Georgia, on the waters of the Alcovy river, paying \$1500 for the land; and after selling the 200+ acres in Putnam County, for which he received \$1400, Philip moved his family to the plantation in Newton County. This is where young James Ballard grew up.

This plantation was just about self-sustaining. There was livestock — 31 hogs, a yoke of steers and cart, 1 work steer, 6 head of cattle, and a black horse valued at \$50 — a cotton gin and gin gear, farm equipment, shoemaker tools, spinning wheels, weaving loom, churn, and coffee mill; also Philip's carpenter tools.

In 1827, Philip sold 70 acres to Elijah Horton for \$300. This would leave 230 acres of the original purchase. In 1830, Philip's was still the only Ballard family in Newton County. They were recorded as having four slaves now — 1 male and 3 females.

Philip Ballard died in 1839. The inventory and appraisal of his considerable estate are dated May 9, 1839; and a public sale of his personal property was held on May 10. Many of the family's possessions were sold to the friends, neighbors, and relatives who attended the sale. Mary herself bought back a few of their former belongings, including a spinning wheel, coffee mill, and a pair of flatirons. She legally retained the slaves, as these had been willed to her by her mother Jane Petit in 1818; and these were not considered part of her husband's estate. Philip Jr. bought back the black horse.

Sold at the public sale were the following books, which would seem to indicate that the family was well-educated:

After Philip's death, more of the plantation--120 acres-- was "knocked off" at public sale to neighbor Solomon Zellars for \$642.50. This would leave about 110 acres, unless more was deeded away earlier that isn't on record.

(Philip's brother Ransom had remained in Putnam County, and lived there until his death in the spring of 1844. He had a family, but how many or what their names were isn't known, as they were not listed in his will, which left his considerable property, including a female slave "Delpha", to his wife.)

In the 1850 census, Philip's widow Mary was living in neighboring Henry County. Mary now age 73, had her own residence and was recorded as having 7 slaves. These would be Fanny, age 52 (the negress inherited by Mary from her mother's estate in 1818) and six children -- George Washington 16, Frances 13, John Henry 11, Adam (a mulatto) 9, Paris 6, and Cyrus 4. There were no adult male slaves listed, so Fanny's husband Sabra and the elder Paris were no longer with Mary.

Sometime after December of 1850, Mary moved to the town of Barnesville in what was then Pike County, but is now Lamar County. Mary passed away here not long after this, sometime between August and November of 1851. From her will, we learn that her eldest son John had passed away sometime earlier. Her will mentioned only provisions for the disposition of her slaves, as follows:

To her son Philip, she left George Washington and John Henry.

To her son James, she left Frances and Adam.

To her daughter Edna Osborn, she left Paris.

The negro Mammy Fanny and little Cyrus were to be sold at public auction, and the proceeds divided among her other six children -- Jane Trammel, Sarah Dennis, Elizabeth Brumbalow, Gideon Ballard, Mary Upchurch, and Emily Robinson -- and her grandson John Thomas Ballard, son of the deceased John Ballard. 

I suspect the  
land originally purchased in 1885 by James  
Monroe & II when he and Sarah Elizabeth &  
moved to Cass Co, TX. Mavis said her

Cass Co, TX in 1885 - that he owned  
adjacent Upchurch land that he was  
called "DUMP" but that his real name  
was John U. This person soon moved  
about 70-80 miles west to Mt Vernon, TX.  
Mavis does not recall if John U had  
issue. Mavis is aware of the connection  
of his ancestor to Charity Ward that the  
Green family was also involved.
