(1) Mary A Ballard married 30 Jan 1834 Lunsford Upchurch born 1810 in Franklin Co, NC. Lundsford moved to GA with parents in 1822.

(2) See letter 10 Jul 1980 Elna Era Burkhalter to RPU Page 11 – Mary Ann Ballard (1814 – 1854) married 30 Jan 1834 Lunsford Upchurch born 1810 (Franklin Co, NC) died 10 Dec 1888. Page 12 – Mary Ann Ballard born 1814 (GA) died 1854 (MS) en route to AR from GA. Lunsford took the wagon bed and built the coffin.

(3) See letter 27 Feb 1981 from John Paul Upchurch to RPU Mary Ann Ballard born 1820 died 1854 (MS) enroute to AR married 30 Jan 1834 Lunsford Upchurch, son of Claburn Upchurch. Lunsford and Mary Ann had 11 children including XID – 5125 [called John J Upchurch and James John Upchurch – RPU] and Savannah Sims Upchurch.

The wife of Lunsford Upchurch was Miss Mary Ann Ballard, who was born about 1820 and died about 1854 while on her way to AR. They had 11 children – 3 sons and 8 daughters." This from Godspeed's <u>History of Southern Arkansas</u>, Page 515, Published 1890 under the heading of "Columbia" County – written in longhand in the margin "May Ann Ballard Upchurch died in Mississippi enroute to Ark. Lunsford Upchurch tore up his wagon bed and build her coffin."

Roy says his grandfather, Jessie Lee Upchurch indicates that Ann Ballard [not Mary Ann Ballard, but wife of Phillip Ballard] is buried in the Shiloh Baptist Church Cemetery in the Lamartine community 3 miles north of Waldo, Columbia Co, AR. [Died in MS and buried in AR?? – RPU]
