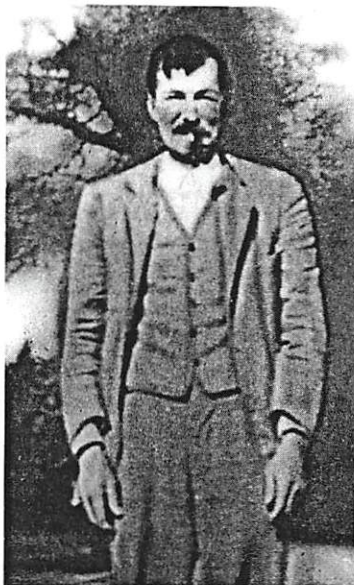

On July 20, 1763, Timothy Ryal Medlin sold to William Cade 100 acres on the north side of the Little River in Johnston County.

In 1763, William Owen Medlin (Sr.) was included on a list of insolvents in Granville County.

In 1764, William Owen Medlin (Sr.) (Madlen) (Meddelon), planter from Bute County, sold 100 acres of land to John Franklin on north side of Crooked Creek in Bute County adjoining William Maynard and Julius Alford, witnessed by William Maynard, James Bolton, and Julius Alford.

Bute County, which bordered Virginia, was formed from Granville County in 1764 and was named after John Stewart, Earl of Bute, who was the first Lord of Treasury under King George III. Bute County occupied the part of Granville County formerly known as St. John's Parish. The Medlin families slowly migrated from southeastern Bute (later Franklin) County down into the heartland of North Carolina.

On August 15, 1764, William Owen Medlin (Sr.) purchased 100 acres of land in Johnston County on the south side of Moccasin (Mockerson) Creek.

In 1766, William Owen Medlin (Sr.), Joseph Medlin, Timothy Ryal Medlin, and William (Owen) Medlin (Jr.) were listed as taxpayers in Bute County.

On April 25, 1767, John Medlin (Madlens) received a land grant from Governor William Tryon for 100 acres on Rich Land Creek, joining Joseph Dunn, Weirs line, and Henry Atkinson in the section of old Cumberland County that was later partitioned off in 1784 as Moore County.

On February 15, 1768, Timothy Ryal (Royal) Medlin, planter from Bute County, sold 100 acres of land to Andrew (Drury) Cade in Johnston County on the north side of the Little River and a fork of Julises Branch, adjacent to land owned by Drewry Cade, witnessed by James Batten and Joshua Mize.

On June 3, 1768, in Bute County, 380 acres were sold to John Young at the sale of the estate of John Medlin (Modglin), deceased, held by Julius Nichols, late sheriff, as recorded in August 1768 court by deputy sheriff William Moore. Joseph Wright was listed among the buyers.

On February 6, 1769, William Owen (Oen) Medlin (Meddelen), planter in Johnston County, sold 100 acres on the south side of Moccasin Creek adjacent to Elisha Strickland in Johnston County to Demsey Sumner, witnessed by James Bolton, Julius Johnson and Drury Cade.

In February 1769 in Johnston County Court, William Owen (Oen) Medlin proved a deed from Sampson Bracwell and Christian Bracwell to Pettipool Massey. Needham Bryan was present and was appointed a justice for Johnston County by commission from the governor.

On March 10, 1769, William Owen Medlin (Sr.) bought 177 acres of land in Bute County on the south side of Crooked Creek from Julius Johnson, witnessed by James Alford, Robert Chamblee, and James Strickland.

On March 20, 1769, John Medlin sold to Joseph Dunn the 100 acres of land granted on Richland Creek in old Cumberland County (later Moore County).

Youth succumbs to rare cancer

After a long struggle with cancer, Jamie Batten, 20, of Wendell passed away on Sunday, Jan. 17.

In March 1992, Batten was diagnosed with peripheral neuroectodermal tumor, a rare form of cancer that attacked his liver, prostate and bones.

Batten first felt the effect of the disease during his second semester as a freshman at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill — Batten graduated with honors from East Wake High School in

1991. Soon afterward, he had to obtain a medical drop from classes.

Then the unexpected happened. Due to a loophole in his family's group insurance, a bone-marrow transplant was denied. Doctors advised that the transplant would have given Batten a chance of recovery.

The community responded and came to Batten's aid. In total, the towns of Wendell, Knightdale and Zebulon raised over \$100,000 to help cover the cost of the transplant. In essence, Batten's cause

became a rallying point for the communities.

However, complications arose — the cancer spread to his spinal fluid and the transplant had to be delayed. Batten passed away soon afterward.

"We are really grief-stricken at this time," said Dot Beaman, chairman of the "Friends of Jamie Batten" fund.

Mrs. Beaman continued by saying that the friends committee will meet in the coming weeks to de-

cide what to do with the proceeds from the various fund-raising events.

"The money will be used for a

good purpose," explained Mrs. Beaman.

The Rev. Baxter Prevatte of Wendell Baptist Church, Batten's pastor, was instrumental in starting the fund drive. Having preached in Wendell for 20 years, Prevatte said he had known Jamie since birth.

"He was a very courageous young man and touched a lot of people," said Prevatte. "He will not be forgotten by the people of Wendell.

"We are all disappointed that he didn't get his chance with the bone-marrow transplant," he continued.

Prevatte added that the response to Batten's illness showed that "we were at our best as a Christian community."

After a 2 p.m. funeral service on Tuesday at Wendell Baptist Church, Batten was laid to rest at Greenmount Cemetery. In lieu of flowers, contributions may be made to the James Franklin Batten Scholarship Fund, c/o East Wake High School, 5101 Rolesville Road, Wendell 27591.

An area woman got an early Christmas present last month when she was reunited with a brother she had not seen for 29 years.

Rachel Strickland, 72, who lives between Wendell and Zebulon on U.S. 64, and her sister, Dorothy Wilson of Hickory, traveled to North Little Rock, Ark. early last month to visit their long-lost brother, James Batten, 60.

Batten had left Hickory in 1959 to see the country and had not returned.

"I rushed up and gave him a hug, and the more I looked at him, the more the resemblance came back. We were tickled to death," Mrs. Strickland said.

Mrs. Strickland said her brother had changed physically, but his personality had not.

"He had the very same personality," she said. "He has always enjoyed life."

Mrs. Strickland said she and her sister were hoping that Batten could come back to North Carolina for the Christmas holidays, but that he had called last week and said he would be unable to. Instead, she said, they are hoping for another reunion this summer.

An old income report stub of Batten's was the key to finding him, said Mrs. Strickland. She found the stub, which had his Social Security number on it, several months ago, and she contacted the local Social Security office for any information on the whereabouts of Batten.

That night, however, Batten was

rushed to the hospital because of a collapsed lung, but he asked a friend of his to contact Mrs. Strickland, which was done Nov. 2.

Mrs. Strickland said she and her sister were still a little in doubt, and so they decided to travel to Arkansas to find out if it was really their brother.
