RE: EARLY CHURCHES IN RALEIGH

The Baptists were next to organize a congregation. This was in 1812, and a church building of an humble character was erected on Moore Square, or in what was then known as the Baptist Grove. The bell was of the size and sound of those generally in use by tobacco factories. In this Grove the founders of the First Baptist church worshipped. There is high authority for the statement that the members were accustomed each to take a tallow candle to this humble building in order to produce a "dim, religious light" (so conducive to spirituality, it was thought) for services at night. The membership of the church, says Mr. W. C. Upchurch, was never more than eighteen—seven males and eleven females. Of the former there

were Madison Royster, Jas. Nunn, J. D. Briggs, Mark Williams, and W. C. Upchurch; the late Mrs. Alfred Williams was among the female members.

About 1835, owing to differences of opinion among the members, dissension arose, and a new and better edifice was accordingly erected at the southeast corner of Wilmington and Morgan streets. The pastors of this church, in the order named, were Revs. Amos J. Battle, Louis Dupree, T. W. Toby, J. J. Finch, G. W. Johnston, T. E. Skinner.

In 1858 the present imposing First Baptist Church was erected. Rev. Dr. T. E. Skinner, one of our most distinguished theologians (who is yet living and much beloved by all) was the first pastor. The late Rev. Dr. T. H. Pritchard was another of the early pastors.

Among the members of this church in the old days were, Mrs. Alfred Williams, Miss Lucinda Briggs, P. F. Pescud, J. J. Biggs, Miss Sallie Towles, M. B. Royster, Jas. D. Royster, Lynn Adams, W. D. Williams, Caswell Lee, Jas. D. Nunn, Jordan Womble, Jr., Robert Jones, Miss Selina Jenkins.

A prominent feature of the Sunday School of this church is the Infant Class, which numbers one hundred and sixty-five. The class was organized in 1865, with but twelve pupils. Dr. W. I. Royster was the first teacher in charge. It is now conducted by Mr. and Mrs. W. H. Dodd and Miss Elizabeth Briggs.

In 1874 a few members of this church, led by Messrs. N. B. Broughton and J. S. Allen, organized a new congregation, and purchased on Swain street a house of worship and denominated it the Second Baptist Church. The congregation assumed in a year or two such proportions that it became necessary to secure a more commodious structure, and a site was accordingly purchased on the corner of Hargett and Person streets, upon which was erected the present edifice,

known as the Tabernacle Baptist Church. Its seating capacity is about one thousand. The Sunday School is the largest in the city and its fame in this department of religious work extends throughout the country, due, in a great measure, to the zeal and popularity of Mr. N. B. Broughton, known throughout the State as foremost in all that makes for the advancement—moral and material—of the people.

⑤ Raleigh, NC "Kemp P. Battle recalls drinking habits among the elite: "our forefathers... thought they were drinking down health and long life. In fact, even when they did not become drunkards and die the drunkard's death, they were gathering to themselves all such evils as gout, disease of the liver, of the heart, of the kidneys. It was the fashion to offer spirits on all occasions. My father told me that when he was in the Legislature in 1833-1834, the members, as a rule, kept a jug in their room and offered a glass to every visitor."

⑥ A brother of Kemp P. Battle, Wesley Senior Battle, died in a Philadelphia, PA hospital as a result of having lost an arm in Pickett's Charge at Gettysburg. He was a Raleigh, NC citizen (37, pg 52)

AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE RALEIGH CEMETERY ASSOCIATION

The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

SECTION 1. That George W. Mordecai, Kemp P. Battle, W. C. Stronach, Charles Dewey, George W. Swepson, P. A. Wiley, P. F. Pescud, Wm. E. Anderson, R. B. Haywood, Thomas H. Briggs, W. H. Crow, A. P. Bryan, John G. Williams, J. Brinton Smith, S. C. White, W. R. Miller, R. H. Battle, Jr., W. W. Vass, A. Smedes, Henry Mordecai, Robert G. Lewis, W. R. Cox, J. M. Heck, and such other persons as may associate themselves with them for the purpose hereinafter mentioned, be and they are hereby made a body politic and corporate, under the name and style of "The Raleigh Cemetery Association,"

① In June 1873 in Raleigh, NC. Kemp P. Battle, W.R. Cox, W.C. Stovoch, W.H. Dobb, R.T. Fulghum and others put up \$10,000 to incorporate the N.C. Fertilizer Co.

(37, Pg 65)

B. In an 1881 Raleigh, NC Pamphlet City Engineer ^{T.D. Hogg} urged street improvement. Kemp P. Battle objected to the loss of elms such as from the Park Hotel to the Holden corner which would result from a straightened curve. Battle lost. Street Committee ~~was~~ Chairman John C. Brewery defended Hogg's plan. (37, Pg 69)

② In Raleigh, NC on 18 NOV 1892 Dr Kemp P. Battle gave a 1 hour + 40 minutes address on the early history of Raleigh, NC on the occasion of the 100th year centennial celebration (37, Pg 91)

③ The State House in Raleigh, NC burned 21 JUN 1831. The Cumberland Co, NC constituents criticized their house member, Louis D. Henry, because he did not fight hard enough to move the Capital to Fayetteville, NC. Kemp P. Battle said they let Henry off because they knew he had already killed one man in a duel (37, Pg 32)

④ Kemp P. Battle observed the movement of Gen. Hugh Judson Kilpatrick (General, GAR) into Raleigh, NC on 13 APR 1865 and the fool-hardy poking shot of Texas St Walsh who was promptly hung on the order of Kilpatrick. Battle condemned Walsh (37, Pg 51)





— Yesterday Mr. William G. Upchurch sold from his stock farm, to Mr. J. T. Breodon, a prominent and progressive farmer of Bennettville, S. C., a number of fine cattle from his herd of Jerseys. There was a bull, "Duke of Norfolk," five years old, and three cows, aged nine, seven and two years, each with a calf by her side, the price paid for the lot being \$735. The cattle are all thoroughbreds. We regret, to see such splendid stock leave the State.



Mr. Richard H. Battle for more than a generation has been prominently identified with Raleigh, having been a resident since 1862, when he was appointed by Gov. Z. B. Vance as his private secretary. Two years later he was appointed to the office of Secretary of State by the same authority, to fill the vacancy occasioned by the resignation of Hon. Sam'l F. Phillips. He has filled many other positions of honor and trust, and in them all proved faithful. Mr. Battle was born in Louisburg in 1835. He married in 1860 Annie Ruffin, daughter of Hon. Thos. S. Ashe, a lady of rare endowments of mind and person. She died in 1883.

BACKGROUND: William George reported that his law firm was BATTLE & MORDECAI. My research reveals that the Mordecai involved in the firm was Samuel Fox Mordecai II 1856-1927. He went on to become Dean of the Duke University Law School. S.F.M., II would have been an active lawyer in Wake Co., NC in the 1880's[±]. Circumstances dictate he was the S.F. Mordecai associated with land transactions in my deed files.

Now it develops that the firm of Battle & Mordecai still exists as evidenced by the download shown below. I will label the Mordecai Partner as SAMUEL FOX MORDECAI, III - a presumed grandson of Samuel Fox Mordecai, II

Samuel F. Mordecai was admitted to the North Carolina bar in 1875, beginning a 50 year career of legal work and scholarship. Mordecai practiced in Raleigh and lectured at Wake Forest College. Mordecai's success in these positions coupled with his early publications led to his reputation throughout the state as an excellent lawyer and accomplished scholar

Following the creation of a law school at Trinity College (the current Under Graduate School of Duke University), Mordecai was named senior professor and chosen to serve as the Law School's first dean when it opened in 1904. He served in this capacity until his death in 1927. Mordecai was known throughout the campus and the legal community as an able administrator, dedicated teacher, and prolific scholar. He published pamphlets and lectures that were requested from lawyers and legal scholars across the state.
