U is not found on the 1870 KY Census and perhaps had moved to Ala, MO by that time. Melissa U is not found on the 1860 or 1880 Census for KY - presume she may have been born after 1860 and either died, married or moved before the 1880 Census. It would be nice to know her age. She is most likely of the George U / Mason U subclass.
