

Dear Cousin:

This is to let you know that your two kind letters came to hand and I was glad to hear from you and the rest of the family.

Kempey, I have been after Indians the last forty days and have had no chance to answer your last letter, and I put off answering your first 'til it was too late.

Kempey, I had a bad scout but was in good health all the time, and also I am yet, and I hope these few lines will find you all in good health and the rest of the family.

Red Skins have been on the war path again and killed several families, and we were sent out after them and drove them back to their reservation again. We had two short skirmishes. Three or four soldiers were wounded and one killed. Seven Redskins were killed and fifteen taken prisoners before we could make them stop fighting. I come very near getting shot myself. I was standing behind a stump when a bullet struck my tin cup that was hanging to my haversack. I thought that was pretty close and a little too close to suit me because I want to come back and see you before I kick the bucket. I guess I will get back some of these times all right.

Kempey, tell Cousin Almira and Ida and Isabella I will write them soon. I would write now, but as I am writing to you, I will write again next week.

Kempey, give my love to all the family and to Uncle William's family, as I must close. No more at present.

Joseph O. Blackwood

One of the frequent over-night guests was his brother-in-law, "Uncle Bill Blackwood" ... a charming rascal, who loved strong coffee and straight liquor. On the cold winter nights, when he came in for his abode, the Johnson girls, Almira, Ida, or Lorena made their way to the kitchen and dinning room that were some fifty feet from the back of what was commonly called the "Big House" or "Mansion House" in those days, to set the table with fried ham or sausage, hot biscuits and honey and plenty of strong coffee for "Uncle Blackwood". His language was usually made emphatic with a great variety of "cuss words", profanity was a part of his vocabulary, but the warmth of his nieces' attention, the warmth of the food and coffee were so vigorating that his expression of pleasure has often been repeated in the family circle ... sipping the coffee audibly; and saying "Bless the coffee, it acts like a charm". He always had a story to tell of excitement and adventure -- life was never dull when "Uncle Bill" was around.
